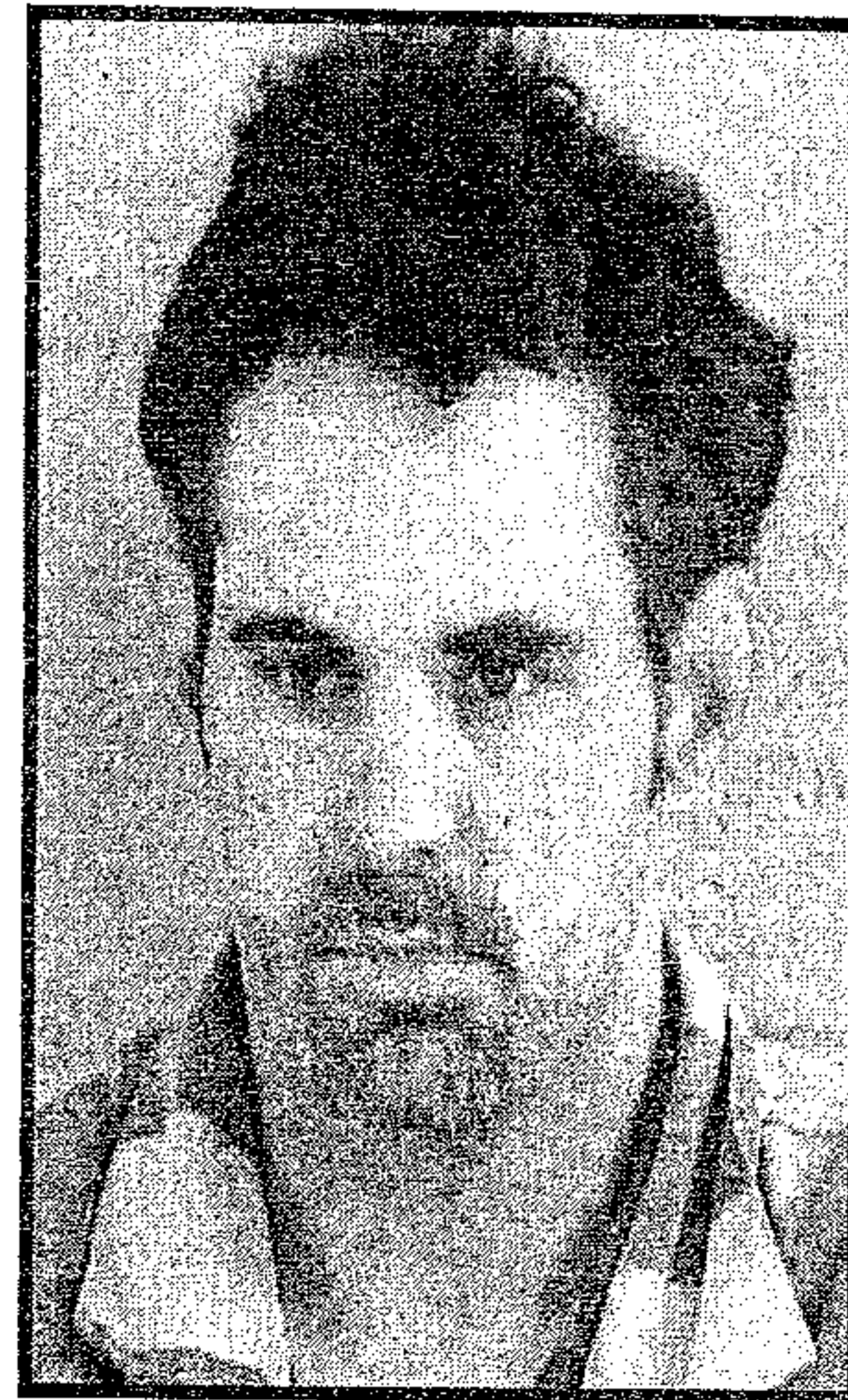

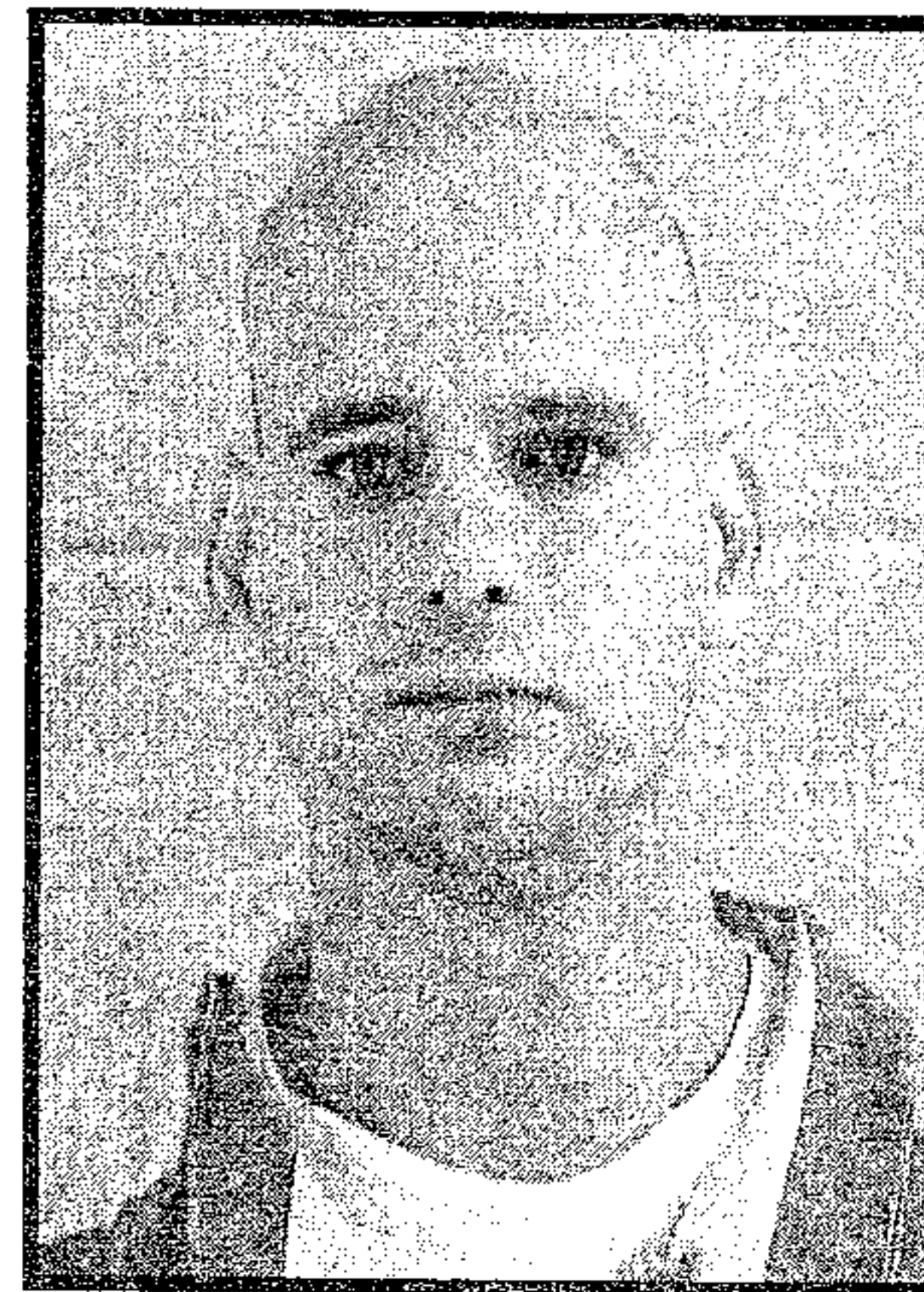
## Man charged after using stolen credit card
