

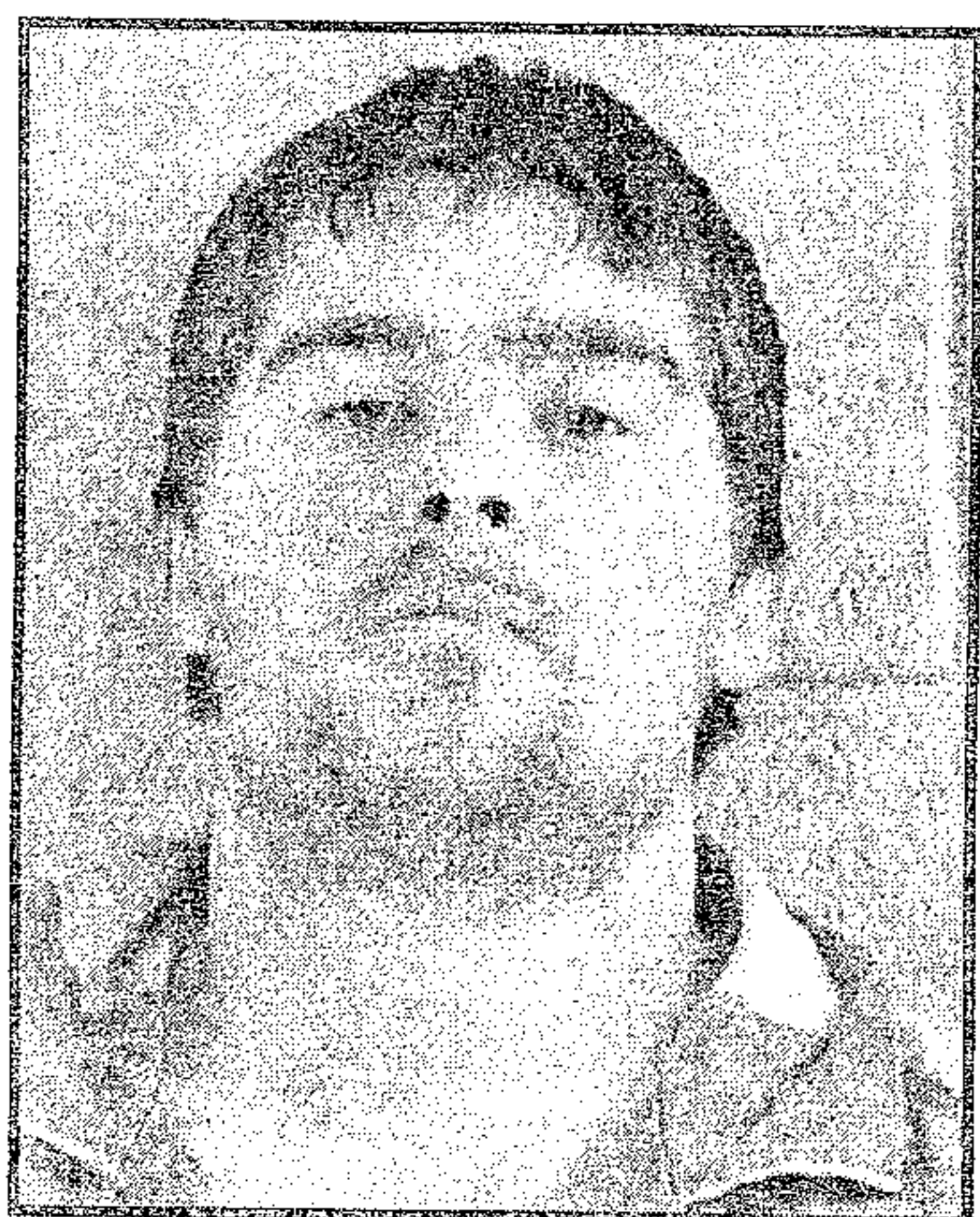

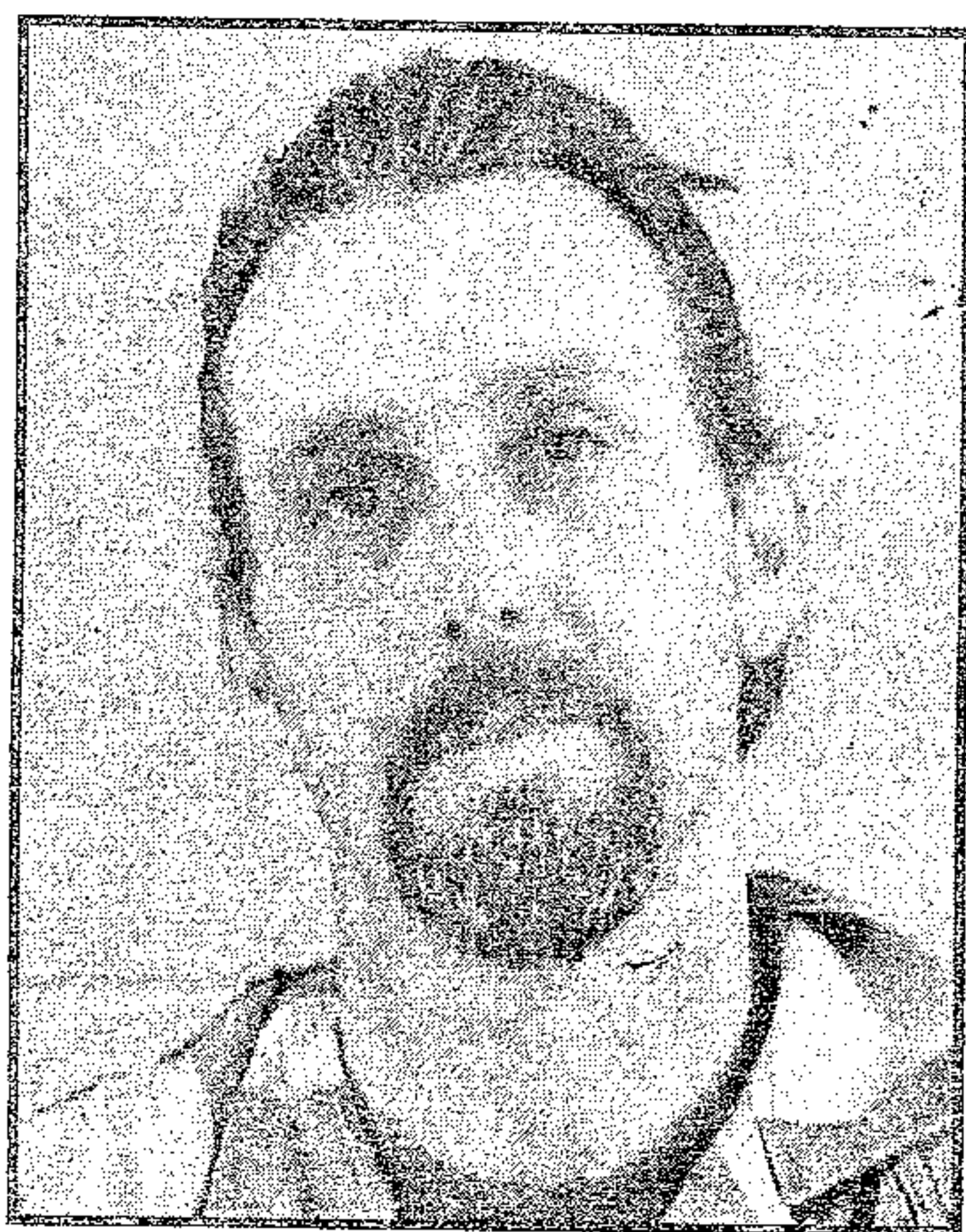

Harassment, theft and vandalism reported

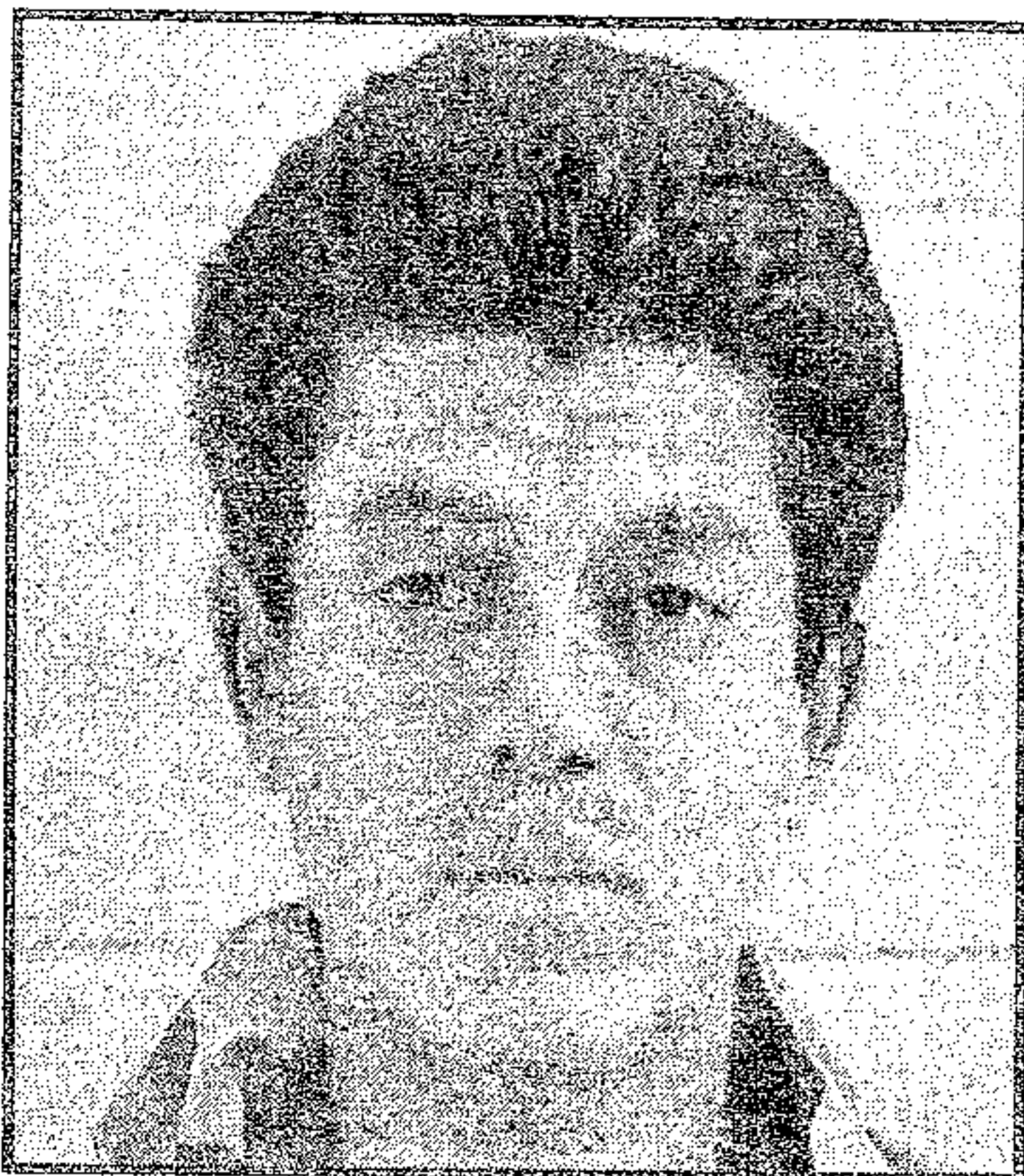

Internet Crime Complaint Center's (IC3) Scam Alerts Modeling Scam

The IC3 has received several complaints from individuals reporting modeling scams. Complainants reported receiving unsolicited e-mails offering them a modeling position, while others reportedly responded to advertisements offering modeling jobs from what appeared to be reputable modeling agencies.

Those who received the unsolicited e-mails reported that the e-mail contained a link to what appeared to be a website for a legitimate modeling agency. The recipient was instructed to click the link to log on and create an account. Afterwards, the recipient reportedly realized the link was to a fraudulent website and that their computer was possibly infected with a keylogger as a result.

Other complainants reported they were told they would make \$7,000 for a photo shoot. However, they were asked to first pay "fees" up front which covered registration, licensing, clothes, photos, etc. Victims were instructed to wire their fees. Once the fees were wired, complainants were requested to pay additional fees, but were promised they would be paid half of their salary up front before the photo shoot.

According to the report, Deputy Billy Hall, LCSO stopped a black Chevy Sedan for viola-

tion of registration on Broadway at E Street in Lenoir City.

As the vehicle pulled over the female passenger bent over and ap-

peared to be concealing something.

While talking to the driver, Stacy Vance, and passenger, Jessica

Roberts, they both appeared extremely nervous.

The deputy asked both subjects to step out of the vehicle while he checked their information. While conducting the traffic stop Deputy Michael Watkins deployed his K9 to sniff the vehicle that alerted in the area of the open passenger window.

While searching the vehicle the deputy discovered a ceramic tile with a white powder residue that field-tested positive for opiates. While a female officer was trying to search Ms. Roberts she became uncooperative and would not let the officer complete the search. Ms. Roberts was placed under arrest for possession of drug paraphernalia.

When the deputy pulled into the jail Ms. Roberts stated she had pills on her person in between her legs. Ms. Roberts produced a black bag with 3 small unmarked bottles containing 15 Xanax, a schedule IV narcotic, 8 Oxycodone pills and 6 Opana pills, both a schedule II narcotic along with a cut straw used to snort pills.

While patting down the driver Stacy Vance a pill bottle containing 15 Soma pills that belonged to another person were found in his pocket. The medication was filled the day prior for 30 pills and 15 were missing. Mr. Vance was placed in Deputy Stegal's patrol car where he placed a cut straw with white residue under the back seat.

Stacey N. Vance, 40, of Decatur Hwy, Ten

Mile, was charged with possession of prescription drug and possession of drug paraphernalia.

Jessica N. Roberts, 27, of Ellis Road, Kingston, was charged with possession of schedule II x2, possession of schedule IV and possession of drug paraphernalia. Deputy Billy Hall LCSO made the arrests.

Elijah Morgan was found to have a suspended license and performed poorly on sobriety tasks. Morgan admitted to taking 2 Xanax a couple of hours prior to driving and refused a BAC test. Officer B. 

According to the reports, Harlan S. Clower, Jason O. Parrish and Danny E. Phillips were observed by 9th Drug Task Force agents in the parking lot of East Tennessee Drugs on hwy 321 in Lenoir City meeting with another vehicle. The two vehicles then met again across the street at the Taco Bell.

Agents observed Harland Clower exchange something with a passenger of the other vehicle. Agents also observed Danny Phillips exchange something with a passenger of the other vehicle.

Both vehicles were then detained by 9th DTF agents and of-

ficers with the Lenoir City Police Department. During a probable cause search and subsequent to further interviews it was determined that Danny Phillips was in possession of a pill bottle that was just filled for 120 oxycodone 30mg pills and the bottle contained 100 pills. The missing 20 pills were found on the passenger of the other vehicle.

The pill bottle belongs to Billy Norris but the pills were delivered by Danny Phillips. Harlan Shane Clower was found to be in possession of the 20 pills believed to be 30mg oxycodone.

The pills were wrapped in a napkin and recovered from

the inside of Clower's coveralls. Further investigation revealed that Clower had just received the pills from Danny Phillips, the passenger of the other vehicle detained. Jason Parrish was a passenger and was in possession of several hypodermic needles, a spoon and other items of drug

paraphernalia used to inject drugs.

Harlan S. Clower, 29, of N. Chamberlain Avenue, Rockwood, was charged with possession of schedule II for resale.

Danny E. Phillips, 45, of Hillendale Avenue, Crossville, was charged with possession of schedule II for

resale.

Jason O. Parrish, 29, of Clymersville Road, Rockwood, was charged with possession of drug paraphernalia.

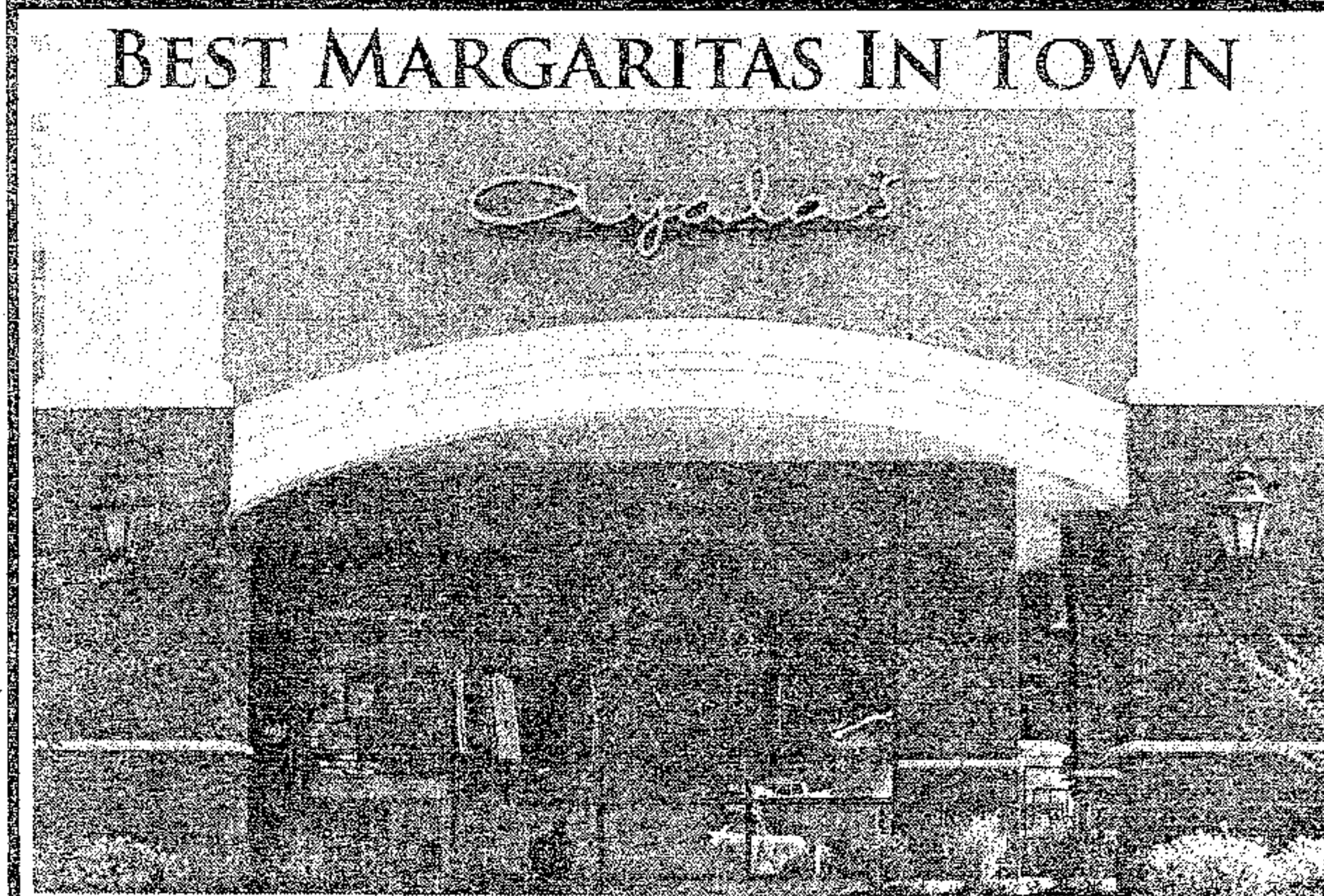

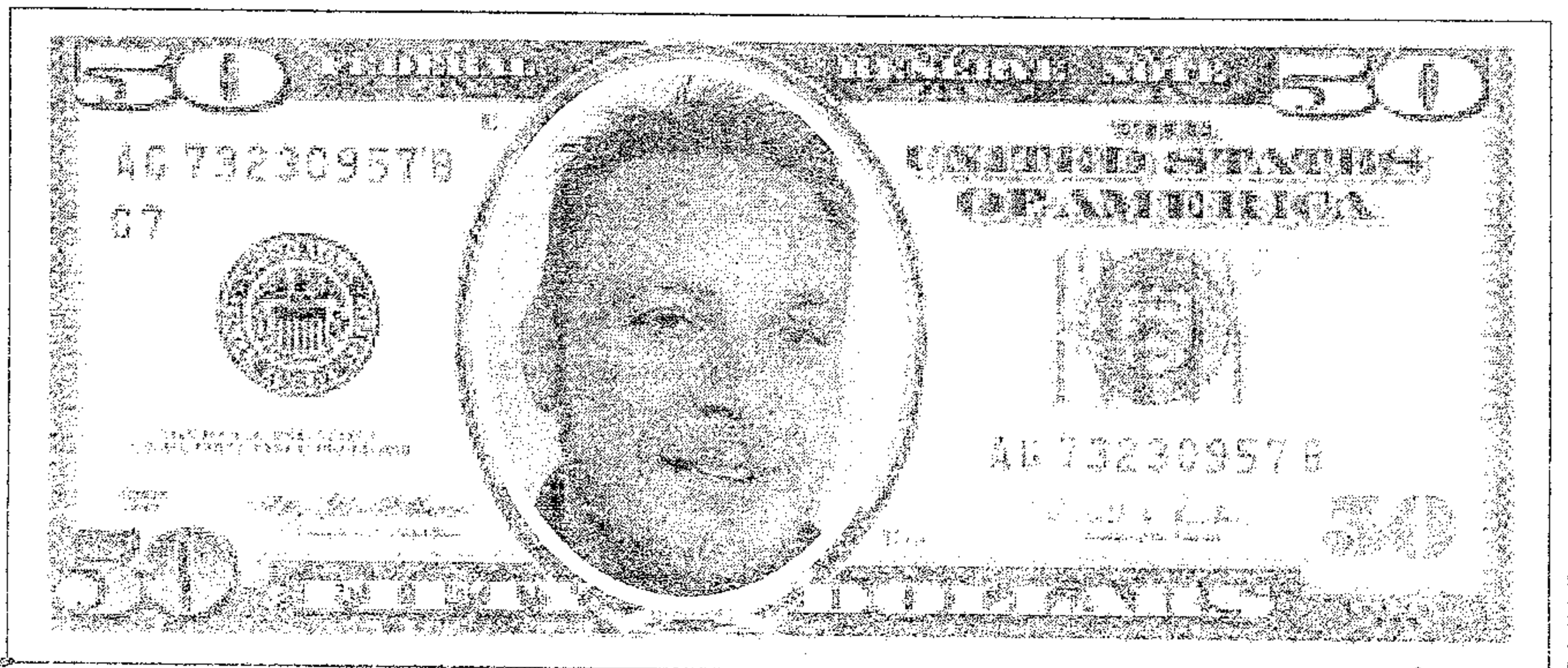
