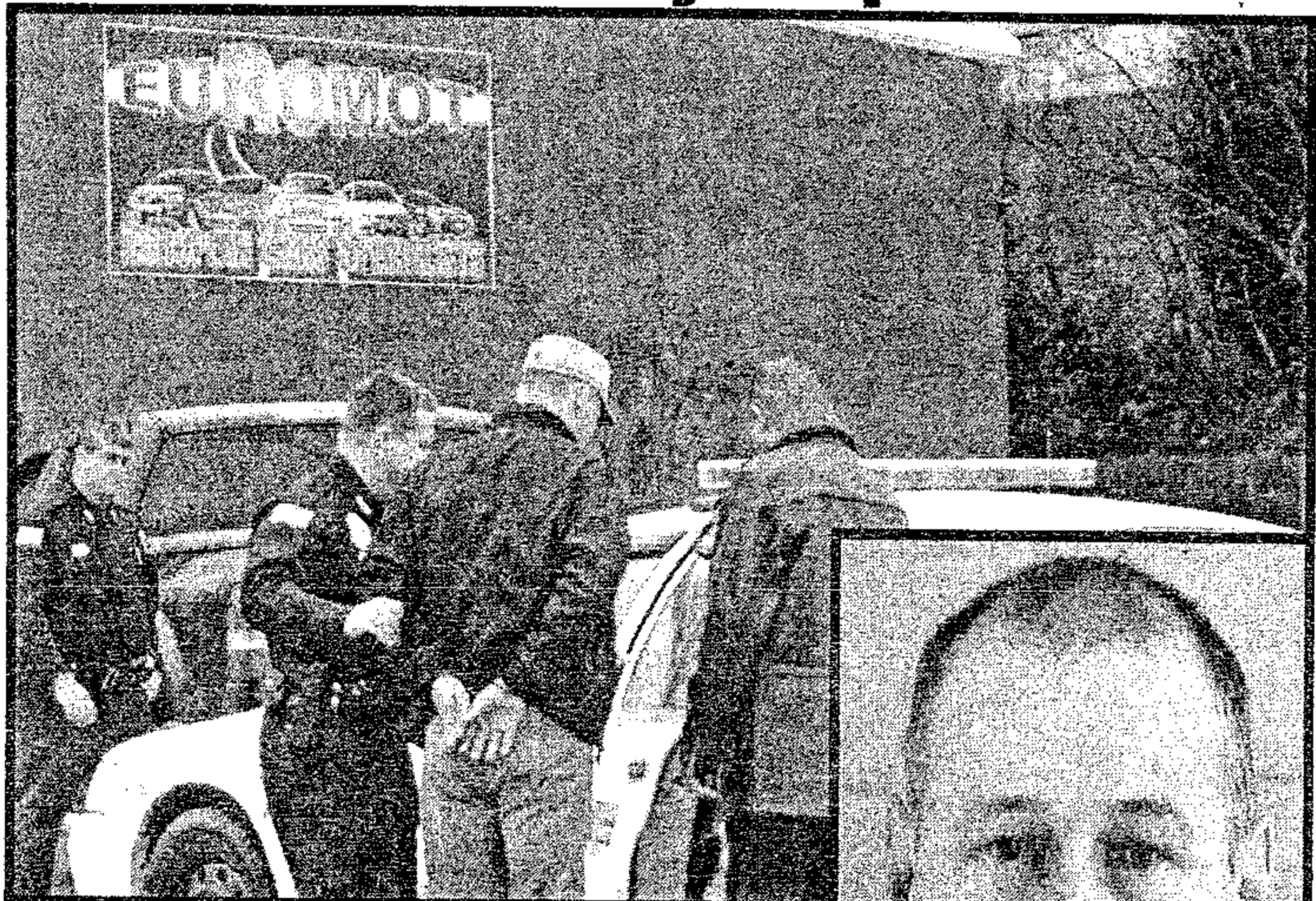
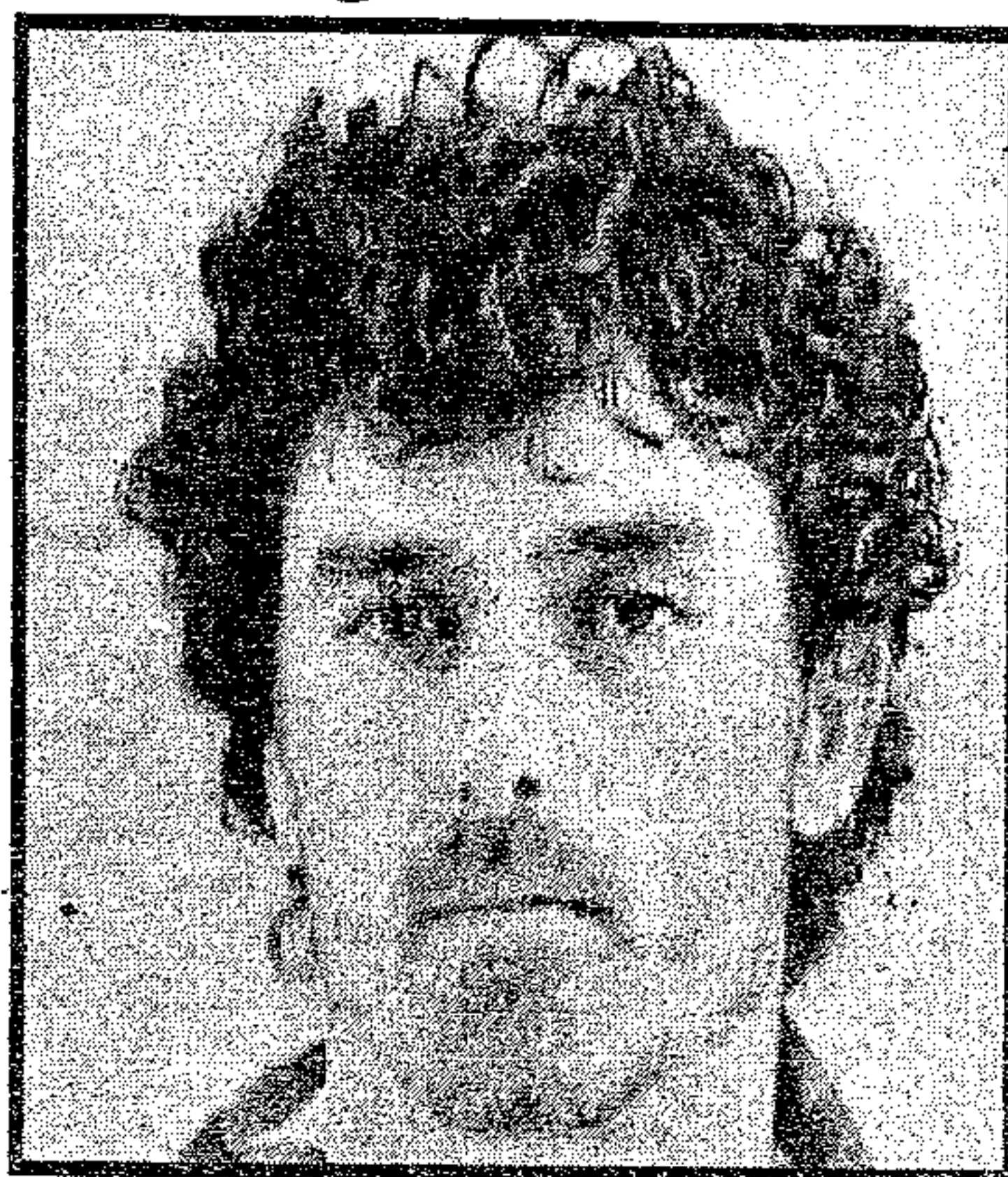


photo: Romot is placed in the patrol car by Lt. Upton and Deputy Dixon at his business on Friday morning and transported to jail where he bonded out a short time later.

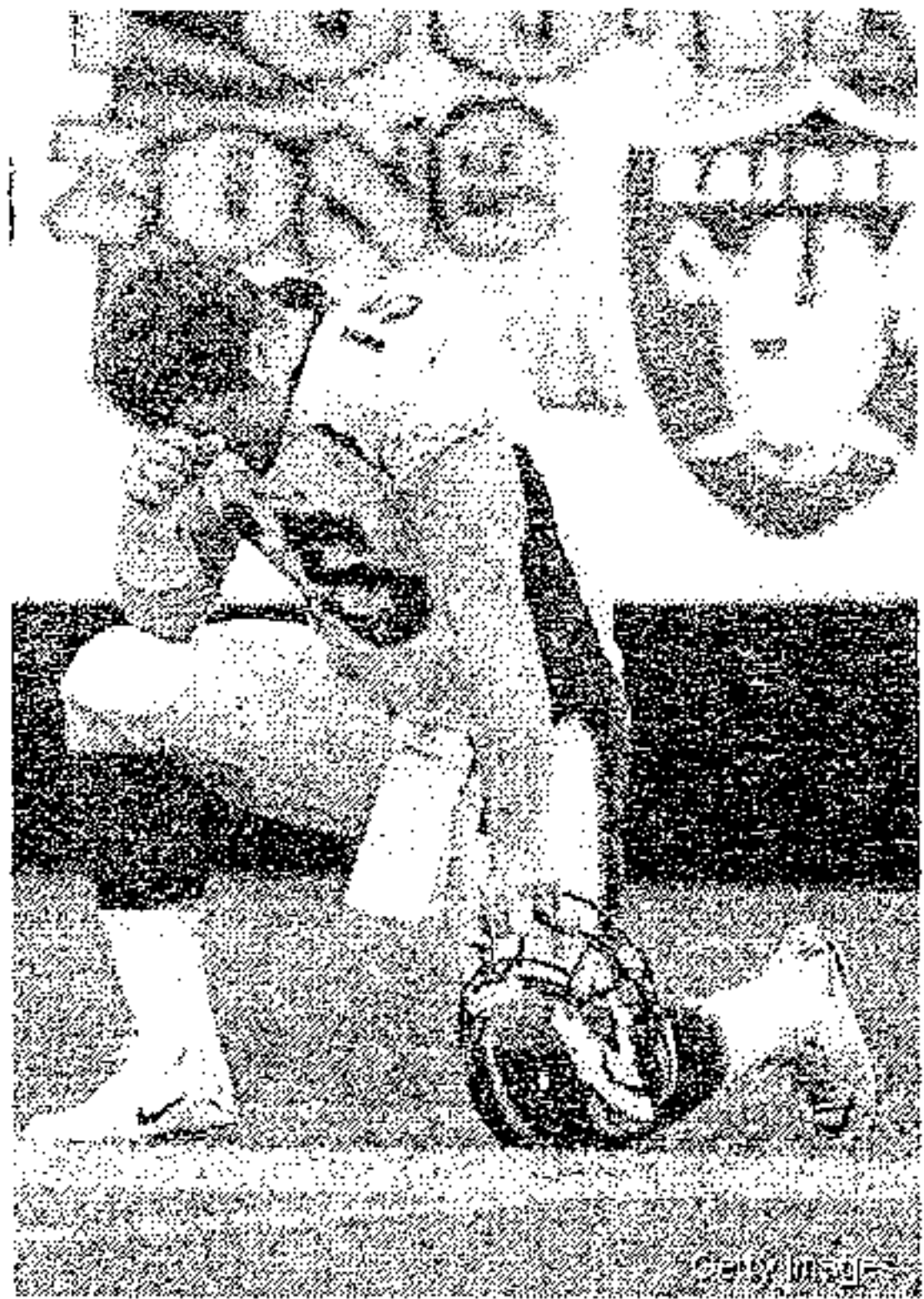

**DUI**

It doesn't seem to bother a certain quarterback who's prayer life and faith in Jesus is becoming nationally known and both respected and criticized.



After the recent 13-10 victory over the Chicago Bears, Denver

Broncos quarterback Tim Tebow said this on national television; "First and foremost I'd like to thank my Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, and after that I want to thank my teammates and coaches."

This type of bold acknowledgement of his relationship with Jesus has been commonplace for Tebow for several years now, first as a college standout at Florida and now as an NFL starting quarterback.

He has received so much attention by his sideline prayer sessions with the Lord that his single knee prayer has been officially named "Tebowing". I'm not kidding! There is

even a website named Tebowing.com where people from all over the world are pictured on a knee mimicking Tebow's game day prayer stance.

Tebowing; (vb) To get down on a knee and start praying, even if everyone else around you is doing something completely different.

I'm not a huge sports fan but I caught this story on the local news while getting ready for work the other morning and have thought of this all week. The news anchor made the statement that Tebow's sideline prayers make her "uncomfortable".

I couldn't decide within myself if I

should be offended by the term or just proud of Tebow for not being ashamed of his relationship with Jesus. I was definitely disappointed by the comment made by the newscaster but it only shows where our world is heading and how desperately we need more prayer warriors and many more bold Christians. Let's explore God's Word and see what it says about the issue.

II Chronicles 7:14 (NKJV) if My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.

I Thessalonians 5:17-18 (NKJV) (17) pray without ceasing, (18) in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.

WARNING: The following verses of scripture are most important and should be read twice if needed to understand who all it ap-

plies to; Romans 14:11-12 (NKJV) (11) For it is written: As I live, says the Lord, EVERY knee shall bow to Me, And every tongue shall confess to God. (12) So then each of us shall give account of himself to God. (capitalization and bold was added for emphasis)

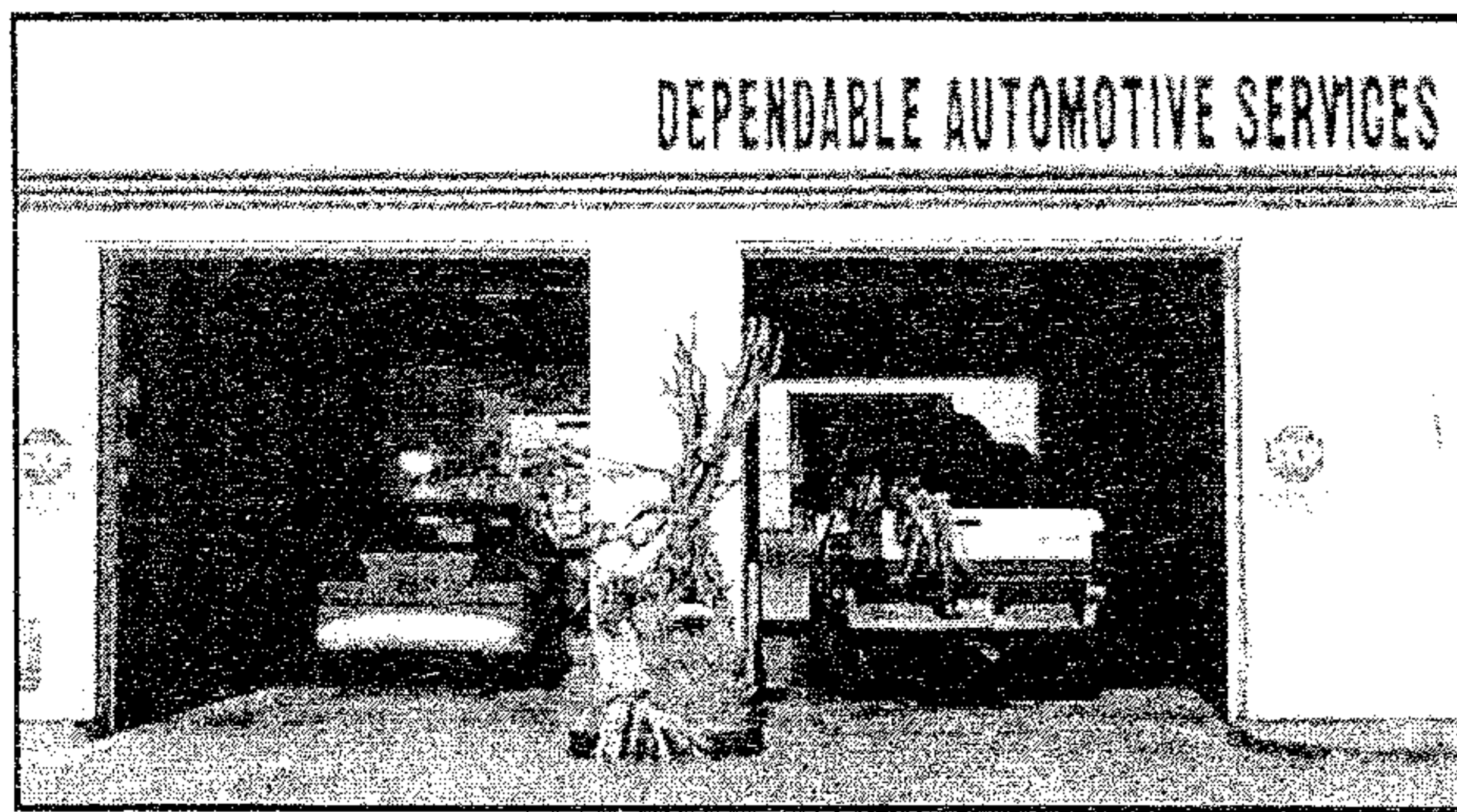

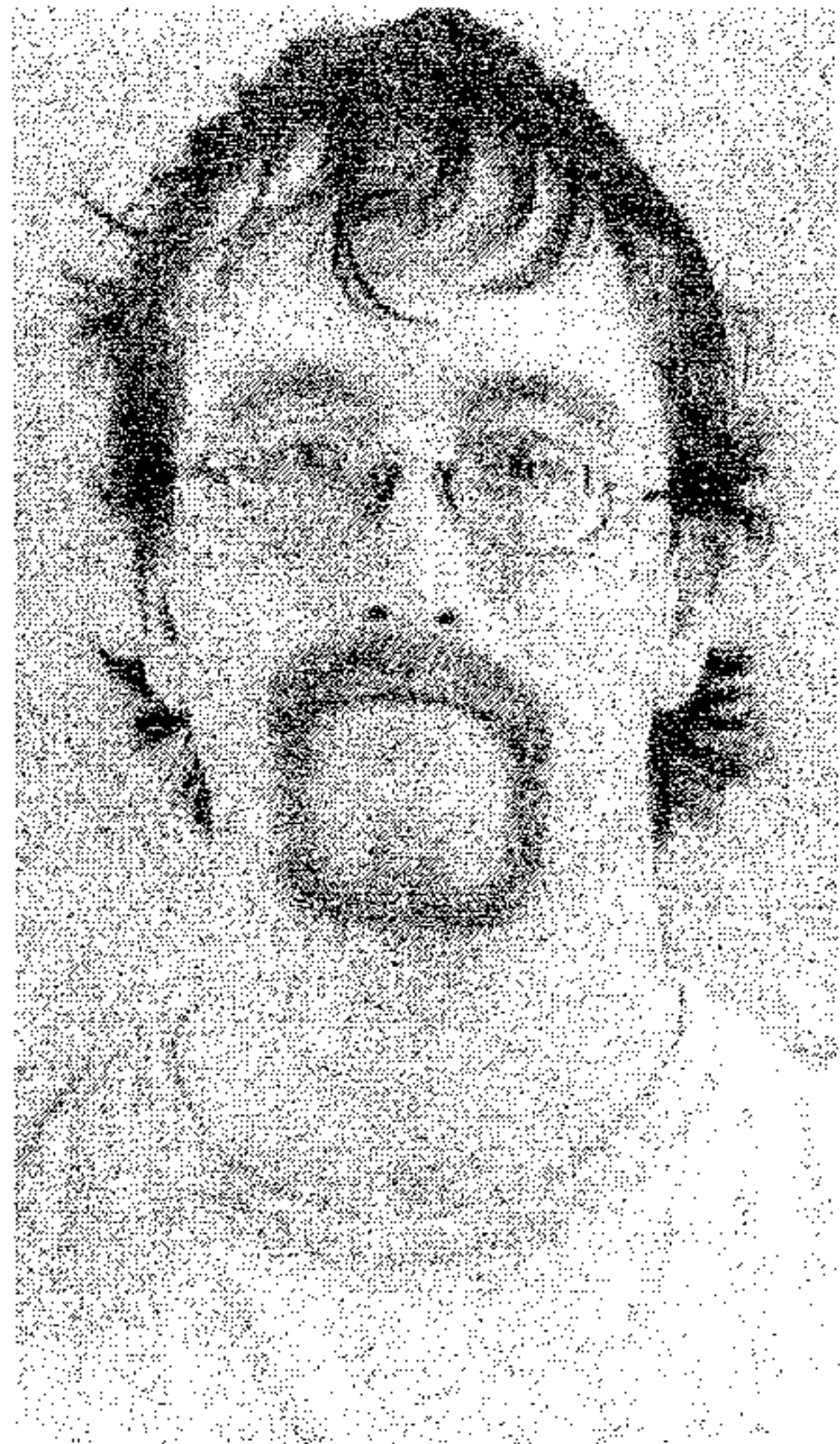

## Rape

The owner of the Euromot in Lenoir City, Wjociech Dariusz Romot was taken into custody shortly after 11am Friday. Lt. Detective Patrick Upton, Detective Jeff Russell and Deputy Brandon Dixon served an indictment handed down by the Grand Jury earlier in the week. Romot is charged with statutory rape.

Details were not available at press time on the indictment and we will bring you more as it becomes available. Detective Jason Smith, LCSO CID filed the charges.

## DUI and no license

Samayoa Lopez Osveli, 28, Foster Road, Lenoir City was charged Sunday with DUI 1st offense and driving without a license.

According to reports, Officer Brandon Burley, LCPD was dispatched to a reckless driver on Highway 11 approaching Lenoir City. Officer Burley witnessed the vehicle, a green Ford F-150 make a left turn from Highland Park to Highway 321 going southbound. The vehicle made an abnormally

wide turn, nearly went off the road and crossed the right lane fog line.

The truck went from the far right lane to the left turn lane at a high rate of speed without signaling and cut off another vehicle. Officer Burley stopped the vehicle and identified the driver as Samayoa L. Osveli.

When asked for his driver's license, Osveli handed the officer a Guatemala passport.

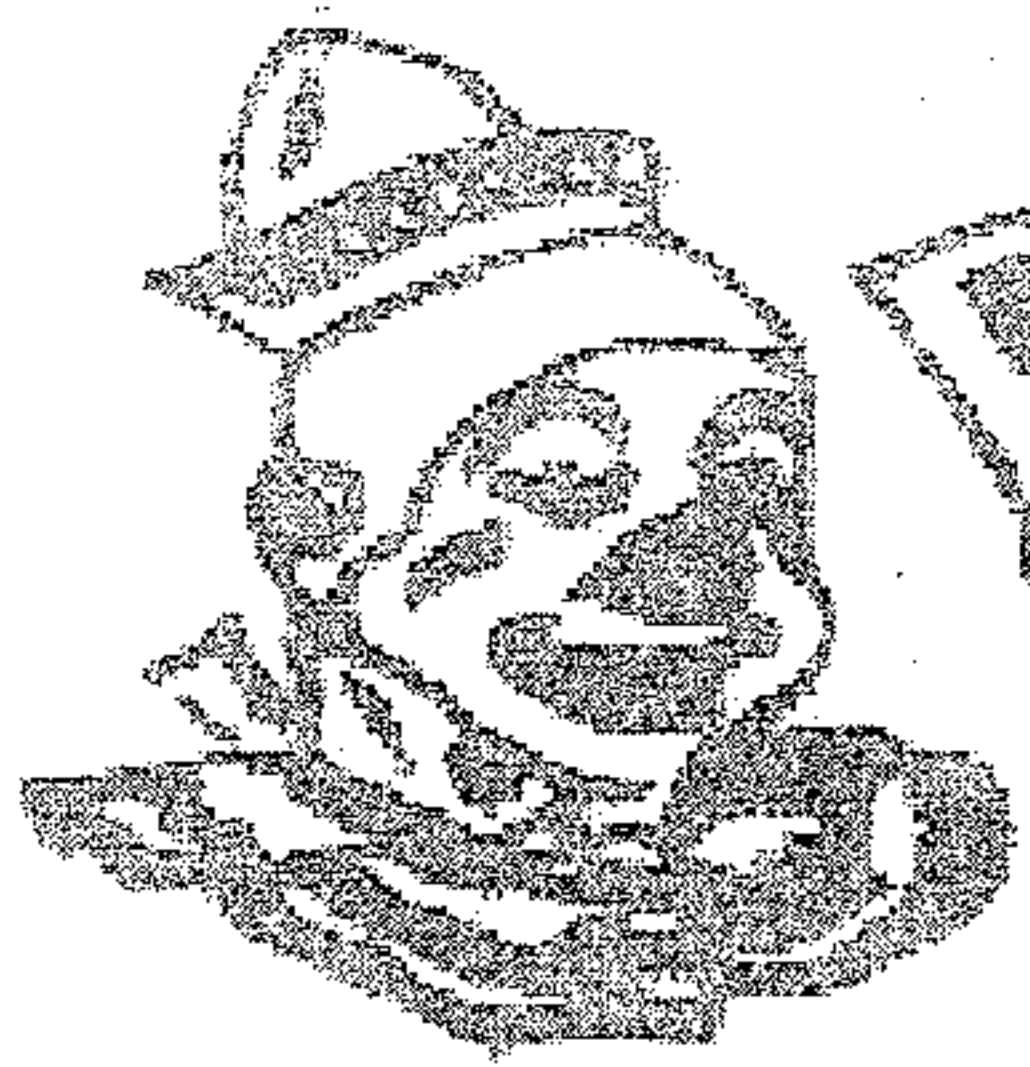
Mr. Osveli had a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage on his person and was unable

to talk without laughing. Osveli was asked to step out of the truck and perform field sobriety. He was very unsteady on his feet and when he nearly fell over multiple times, the tasks were stopped for his safety.

Mr. Osveli was placed under arrest and transported to the Loudon County Jail where he waived implied consent and after 21 minutes of observation he blew a .15% BAC on the Intoximeter.
