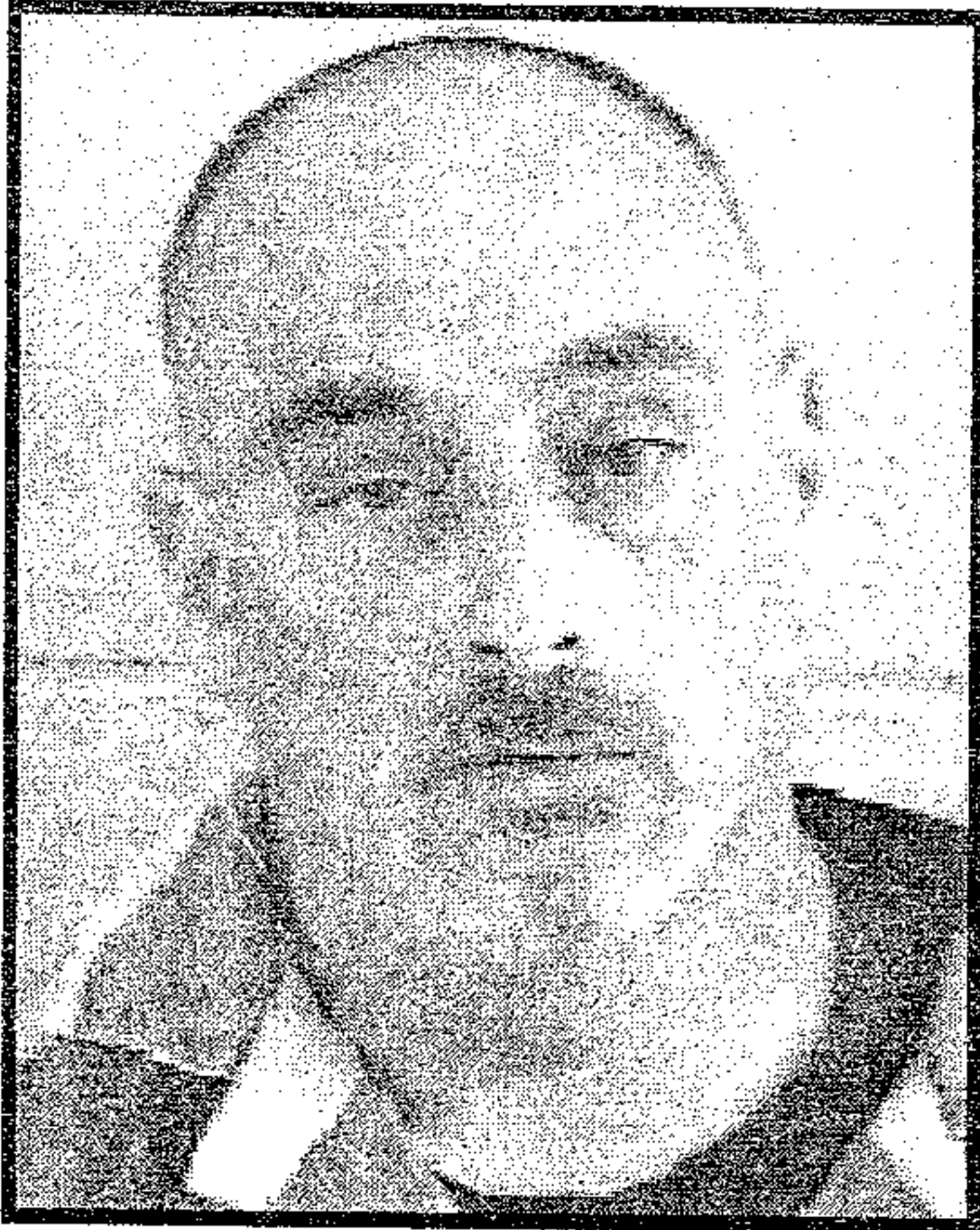

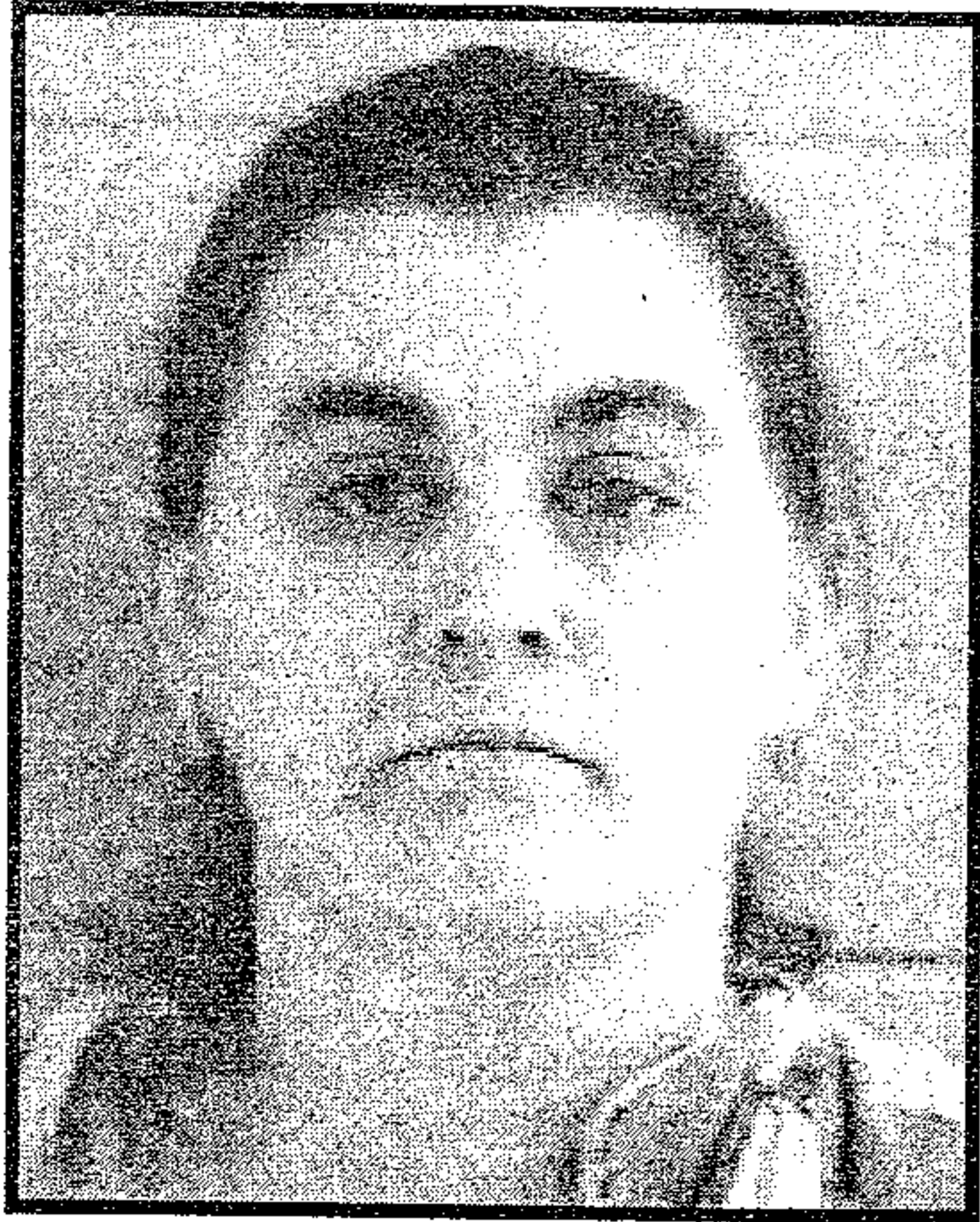



James Nelson Hyett, 39, Cox Road, Loudon was charged with violation of sex offender registry.

Renee Sue Selvidge, 39, Cox Road, Loudon was charged with prevention or obstruction of legal process.

According to an affidavit filed by Investigator Jason R. Smith,

LCSO-CID; James Nelson Hyett is a registered sex offender with the Loudon County Sheriff's Office. On March 18th, 2010, Mr. Hyett indicated his address was 11028 Beals Chapel Road, Lenoir City, Tennessee, then on October 19th, 2010,

Mr. Hyett contacted the sex offender registrar for the Loudon County Sheriff's De-

partment and advised her his new address was 5100 Glendale Community Road In Greenback. In early November, however, Detective Smith received information that James Hyett was living on Cox Road in Loudon County.

On November 3rd, 2010, Corporal Ernie Brown observed Mr. Hyett's vehicle at the

address and witnessed him there at approximately 6:00 AM.

On November 23rd, Deputy Chris Bowen went to 5100 Glendale Community Road and was advised Mr. Hyett had moved to Loudon. On December 17th, 2010, Investigator Smith interviewed 14 and 15 year old female juveniles who live on Cox Road with their mother, Renee Sue Sel-

vidge, and they advised Mr. Hyett had been living with them at the residence overnight for the past two weeks. Also living in the residence are 10 year old and 7 year old juvenile females.

Deputy Brian Smith, LCSO made the arrest Saturday.

warrant was issued on December 20th, 2010.

An unknown person called Loudon county dispatch and stated Hyett was at the residence, but no one would come to the door so the lawmen left and observed the residence from a distance. A short time later, a small car pulled into the driveway.

The deputies approached the vehicle and James Hyett was in the passenger seat and the driver was

identified as Renee Sue Selvidge, Hyett's girlfriend, who also lives at the residence.

Approximately one month earlier Corporal Chad Estes, LCSO spoke with Selvidge at the residence and advised her the Loudon County Sheriff's Office had warrants on Hyett and if she saw him to call the Sheriff's Office. Corporal Estes also advised if he found them together and she did have prior knowledge he had warrants on him, she would be charged. Selvidge was arrested and charged with prevention or obstruction of legal writ of process.

Corporal Estes made the arrest Saturday.

Bradley Alexander Williams, 18, Chertpit Road, Knoxville was charged with aggravated burglary and theft of property.

According to records, on January 30th, 2011, the victim reported someone entered her home on Lake Forest Drive in Lenoir City without her consent and took a Xbox video console, controllers, games, and other items for the machine.

During the investigation, Detective Charles Cosner, LCSO-CID interviewed Cody Chastain, who stated he and Bradley Williams went to the residence and Mr. Williams asked Mr. Chastain to help

him by watching for anyone coming to the residence. Chastain advised he stood in the attached carport and Williams entered the house through a window and then came out through a door into the carport. He was carrying a black bag containing the Xbox and accessories.

A witness who purchased the Xbox and the accessories was interviewed and Bradley Williams was identified as the seller. The witness also advised Cody Chastain was at the location and witnessed the transaction.

Detective Cosner made the arrests Thursday.

Chastain has already been charged with theft over \$500 x 2, burglary

other than habitat, and aggravated criminal trespass, and Williams with facilitation of a felony after Detective Jack Fine, LCPD filed warrants against them and a third person in connection with the burglaries of a home and South Central Bell storage lot earlier this month.
