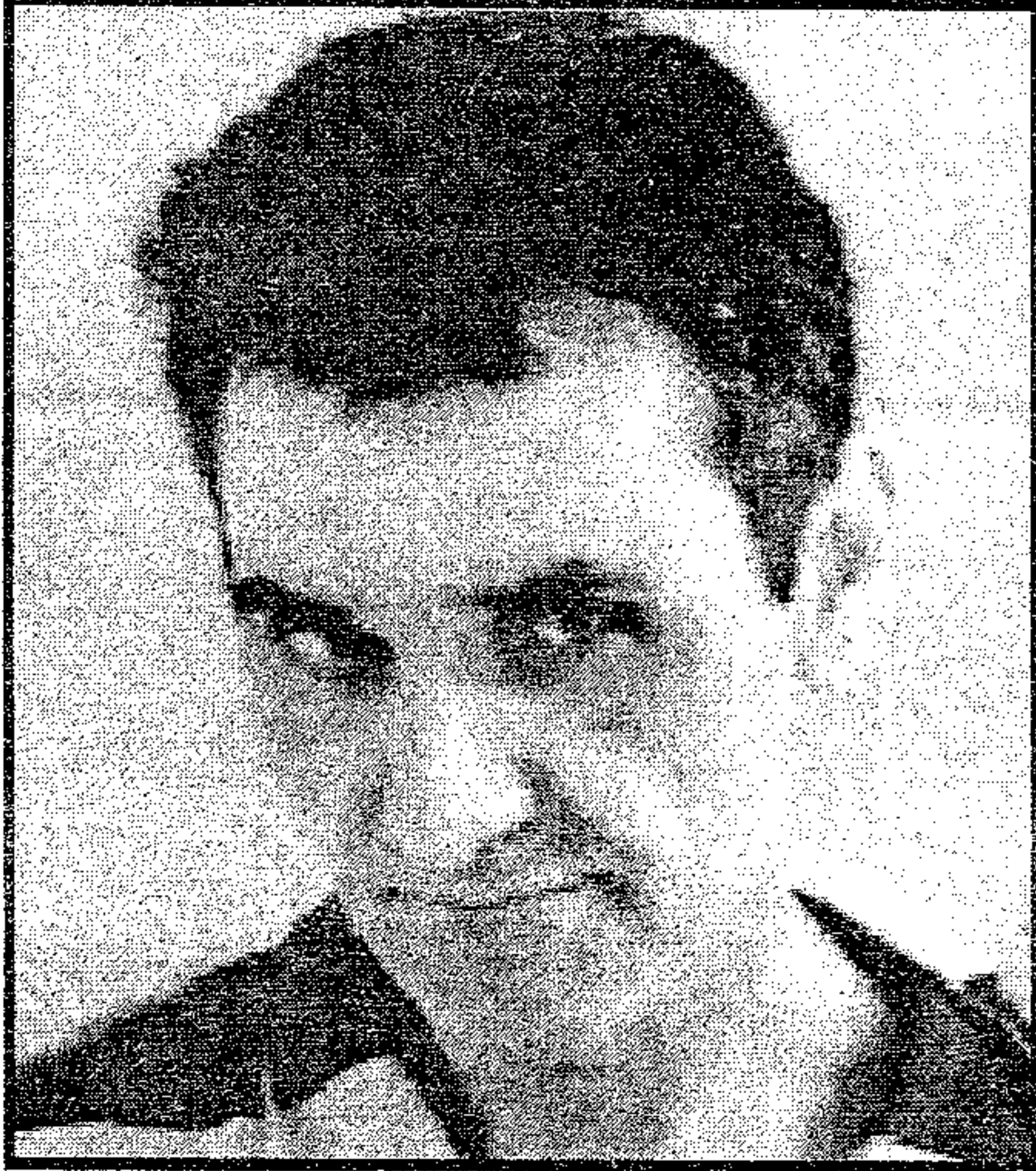


Drunk & down embankment in stolen van

charged Wednesday with DUI 2nd Offense and theft over \$10,000.

According to reports, Deputy Michael Watkins, LCSO was dispatched to a reckless driver on Washington Pike and spotted a white 1999 box van matching the description off an embankment beside the driveway of 4161 Washington Pike.

Deputy Watkins found the driver, who was slumped over the steering wheel, and reported he couldn't wake him up. He knocked on the window

several times and the driver would not respond.

When the driver finally woke up and got out on the passenger side, the deputy smelled a strong odor of alcohol coming from the vehicle and noticed several beer bottles.

The driver was identified as Frederick Carroll. Carroll was asked if he'd had anything to drink and he said no. Carroll performed poorly on all field sobriety tasks.

Deputy Watkins ran Carroll's social security number through NCIC and his driver's license came back revoked for DUI on August 10th, 2010.

Mr. Carroll was placed under arrest.

The lawman then ran the vehicle registration and the vehicle came back stolen from Web Tech Converting LLC. in Knox County. Mr. Carroll was transported to the Loudon County Jail where he was read the implied consent law. He refused.

According to affidavit filed by Detective Jack Fine, LCPD; on February 1st 2011, sometime between the hours of 6:10 PM and 11:00 PM, Bradley Williams committed the offense of burglary and theft by cutting the padlock off the construction office at 225 Creekwood Cove Lane and removed

Deputy Mickey Patterson, LCSO arrived and observed a video recorded by the store. A female was seen going to the table the


wallet was on and picking it up.
