



charged Wednesday with DUI 2nd Offense and theft over \$10,000.

According to reports, Deputy Michael Watkins, LCSO was dispatched to a reckless driver on Washington Pike and spotted a white 1999 box van matching the description off an embankment beside the driveway of 4161 Washington Pike.

Deputy Watkins found the driver, who was slumped over the steering wheel, and reported he couldn't wake him up. He knocked on the window

several times and the driver would not respond.

When the driver finally woke up and got out on the passenger side, the deputy smelled a strong odor of alcohol coming from the vehicle and noticed several beer bottles.

The driver was identified as Frederick Carroll. Carroll was asked if he'd had anything to drink and he said no. Carroll performed poorly on all field sobriety tasks.

Deputy Watkins ran Carroll's social security number through NCIC and his driver's license came back revoked for DUI on August 10th, 2010.

Mr. Carroll was placed under arrest.

The lawman then ran the vehicle registration and the vehicle came back stolen from Web Tech Converting LLC. in Knox County. Mr. Carroll was transported to the Loudon County Jail where he was read the implied consent law. He refused.


A routine check of Mr. Taylor's license came back suspended since 1989 for failure to satisfy. He was taken into custody and also received a citation for speeding.


Mr. Robbins was taken into custody at the scene. The proper plates belonging to the Oldsmobile were found in the back seat.


