Jesus told us in Romans 3:23 (NKJ) "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God," Romans 5:8 (NKJ) "But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us," Romans 10: 9-10 (NKJ) "That if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation."

Aren't you glad that "ALL" means everybody! There is no one in that prison more of a sinner than I

am. I believe those words in Romans with all of my heart and claim them as my salvation just as anyone can. It doesn't matter where we have been or what we have done. Christ died for all of us and He wants us to accept Him, praise Him, worship Him, know Him, and someday live with Him in a home that He is preparing as we speak in a place where there is no sin and no hurt. If you don't know Jesus as your personal Savior, please consider what He's already done for you and me. He paid the price. It wouldn't hurt to consider the consequence of not knowing Him either when this life is over. Heaven is real but death and hell are also just as real. We all have to die someday but what happens after that is based SOLELY on the choice we made regarding Jesus Christ.

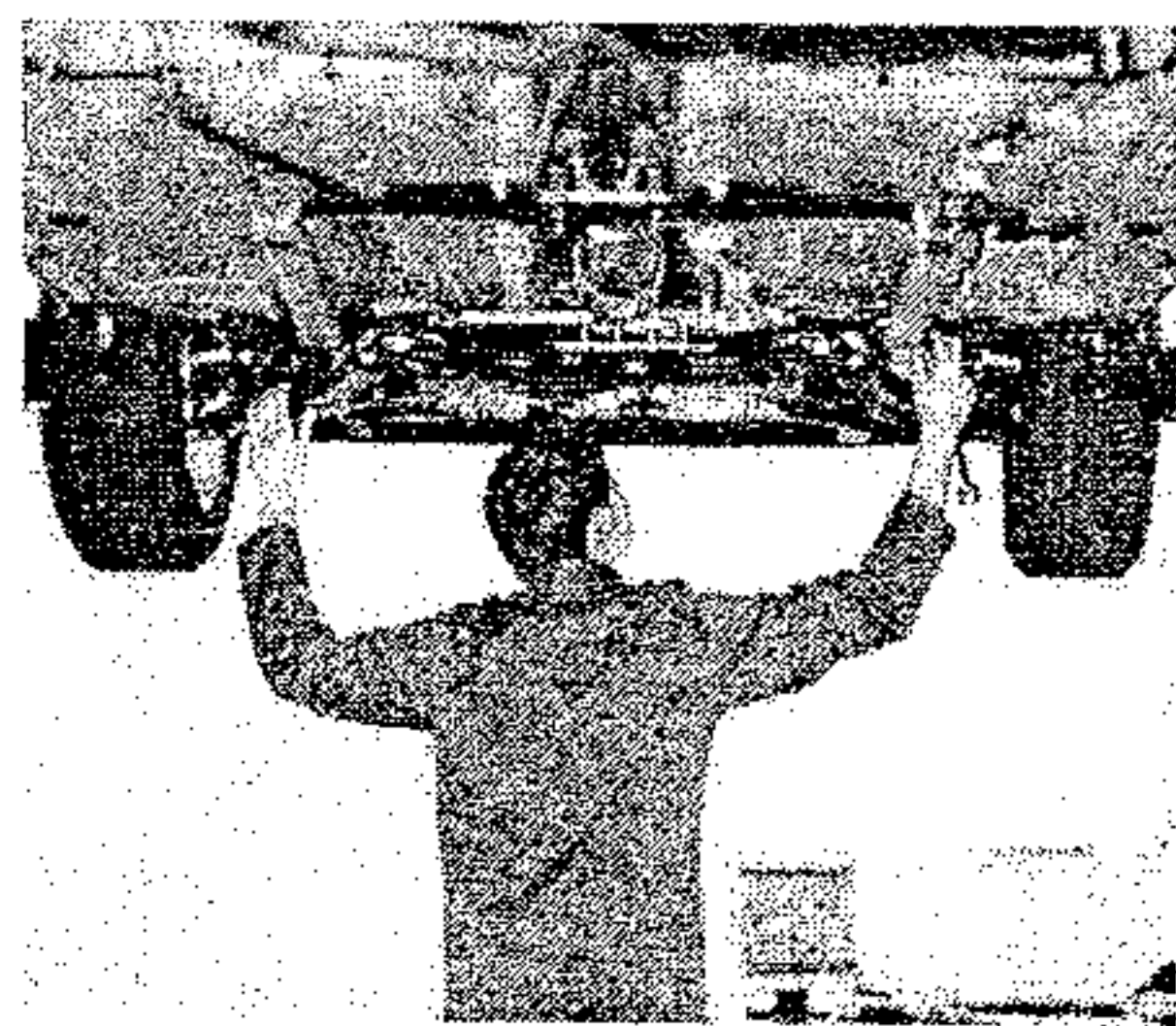
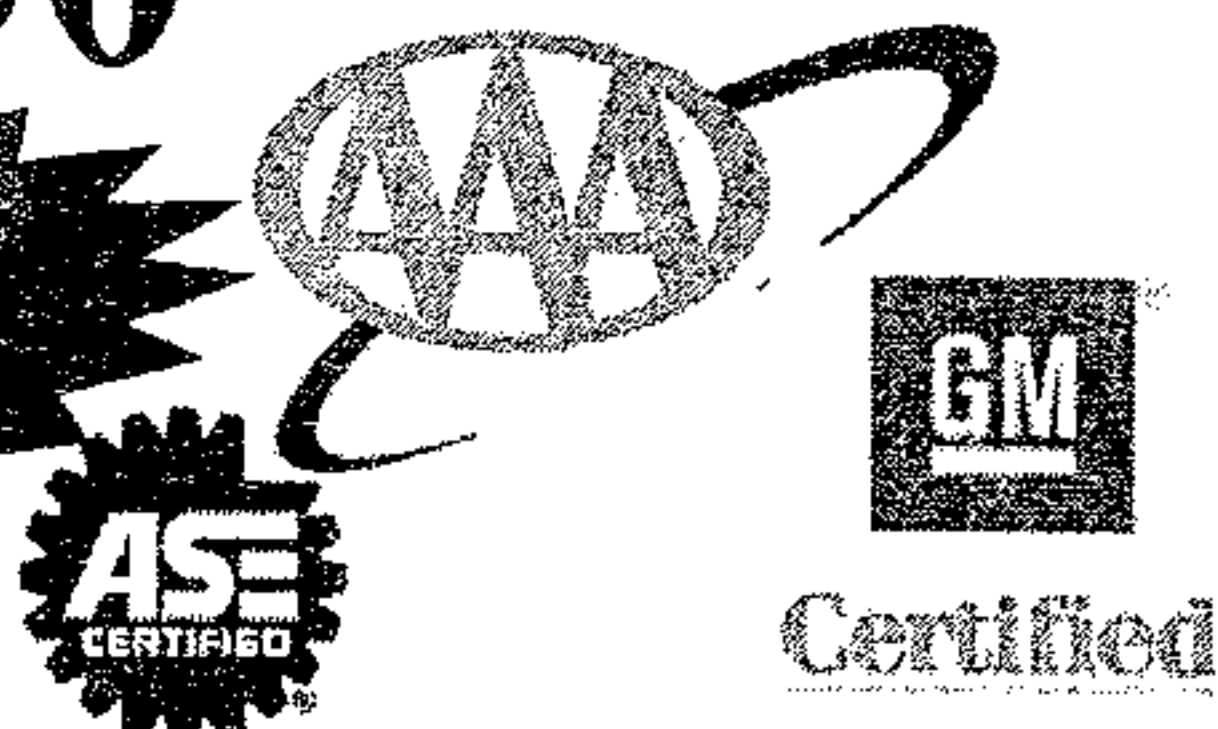

Other items including Febreeze, towels and lily bulbs were laying in the buggy amongst groceries she had preciously paid for. Then Ms. Winkler went to automotive and paid for the work on her vehicle and never paid for the other miscellaneous items.

failing to provide proof of insurance a warrants check showed she was wanted. A subsequent arrest search revealed she also had illicit pills in her possession.

Samantha Jean Wright, 34, Far View Circle, Jacksboro, Tennessee was charged with violation of probation, possession of schedule IV narcotics and possession of a legend drug without a prescription.

According to reports, Deputy Bobby Hamilton, LCSO observed Ms. Wright driving a 1995 Monte Carlo on McCarey Street Friday. When

she approached the intersection of McCarey and Spring Street, she failed to stop at the stop sign.

When Deputy Hamilton stopped Ms. Wright she couldn't provide proof of insurance. A check for warrants revealed she had a violation of probation out of Loudon County General Sessions Court. Ms. Wright was placed under arrest.

An inventory of Wright's vehicle produced a white plastic band-aid container in the glove box containing seven peach colored pills and one turquoise colored pill. Wright identified the peach colored pills as 10 mg. cyclobenprine, which is a legend drug, and the turquoise as a clonazepam, a schedule IV narcotic.

Wright didn't have the pills in the proper bottles or a prescription for the pills. Ms. Wright told the deputy she had a prescription for the cyclobenprine but didn't have one for the clonazepam.


