charged with forgery and three counts of theft under \$500.

According to affidavits filed by Detective Jason R. Smith, LCSO-CID; on Tuesday, March 29th, 2011, Daniel DeLaney went to Walmart on Highway 321 in Lenoir City where he purchased a hard drive and used a check for \$118.81. The

check belonged to Wanda King, Foster Road, Lenoir City and she advised she did not authorize anyone to use the check for the purchase at Walmart. Video from Walmart showed Daniel DeLaney making the purchase.

On Wednesday, March 30th, 2011, Mr. Daniel DeLaney went to Walmart again, purchased another hard

drive, and used a check for \$118.81 to pay for it. That check also belonged to Wanda King and she did not authorize anyone to use the check for the purchase at Walmart. Video from Walmart again showed Daniel DeLaney making the purchase.

On Monday, April 4th, 2011, Daniel DeLaney cashed check another check on Wanda

King's account at the First National Bank on East Broadway in Lenoir City for the amount of \$195.

The check was made payable to Daniel DeLaney. The name Wanda King appeared in the signature line and was endorsed on the back along with Daniel DeLaney's drivers license number.

Still images received from the bank for the date and time the check was cashed showed Daniel DeLaney using the drive-thru at

the time the check was cashed.

Ms. King stated she did not give Daniel DeLaney permission to cash the check made payable to himself and she did not sign the check.

Corporal Michael Wilson, LCSO served the warrants and made the arrest Friday at the Loudon County Jail.

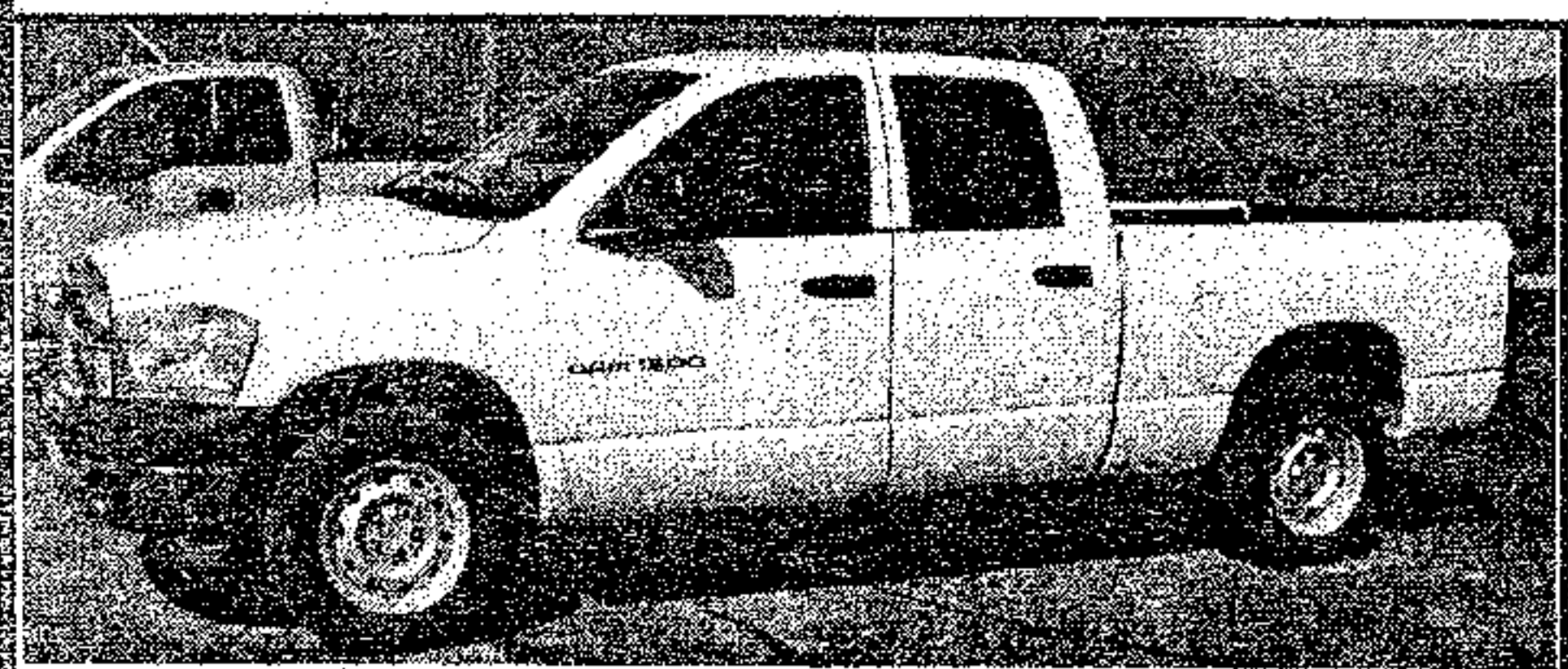

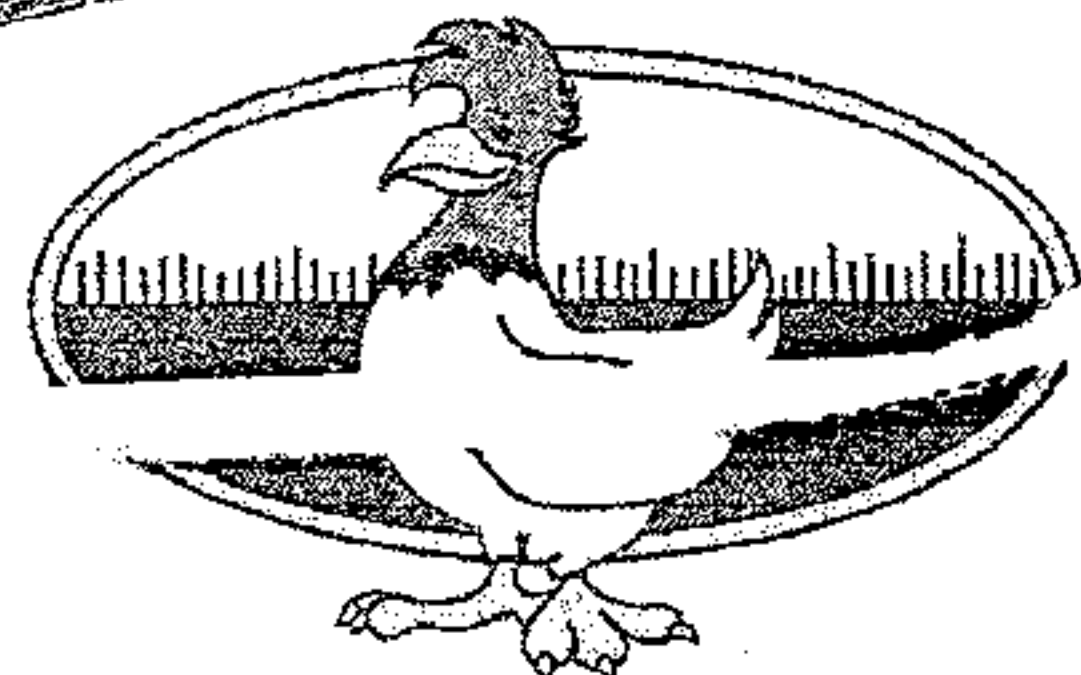

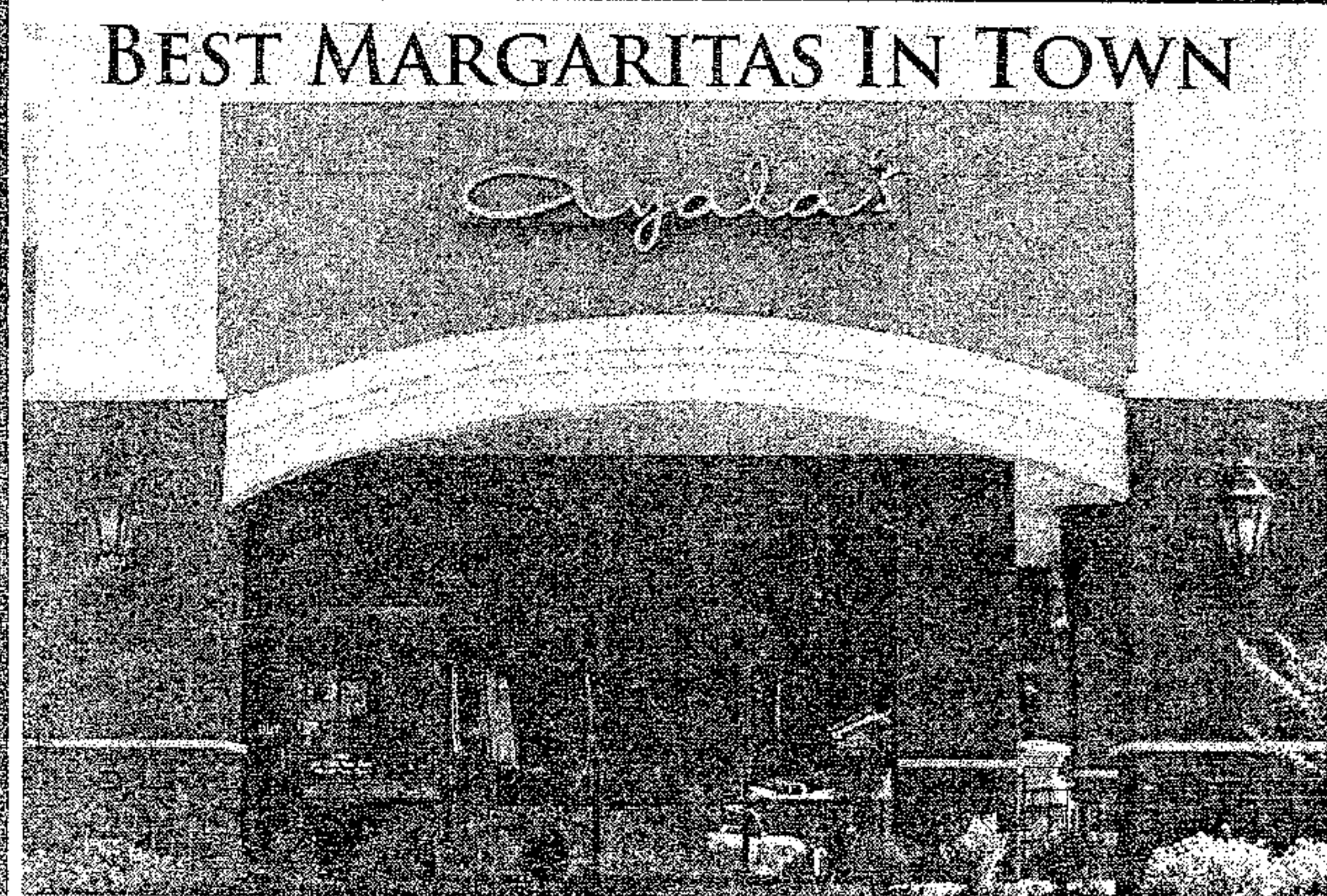
