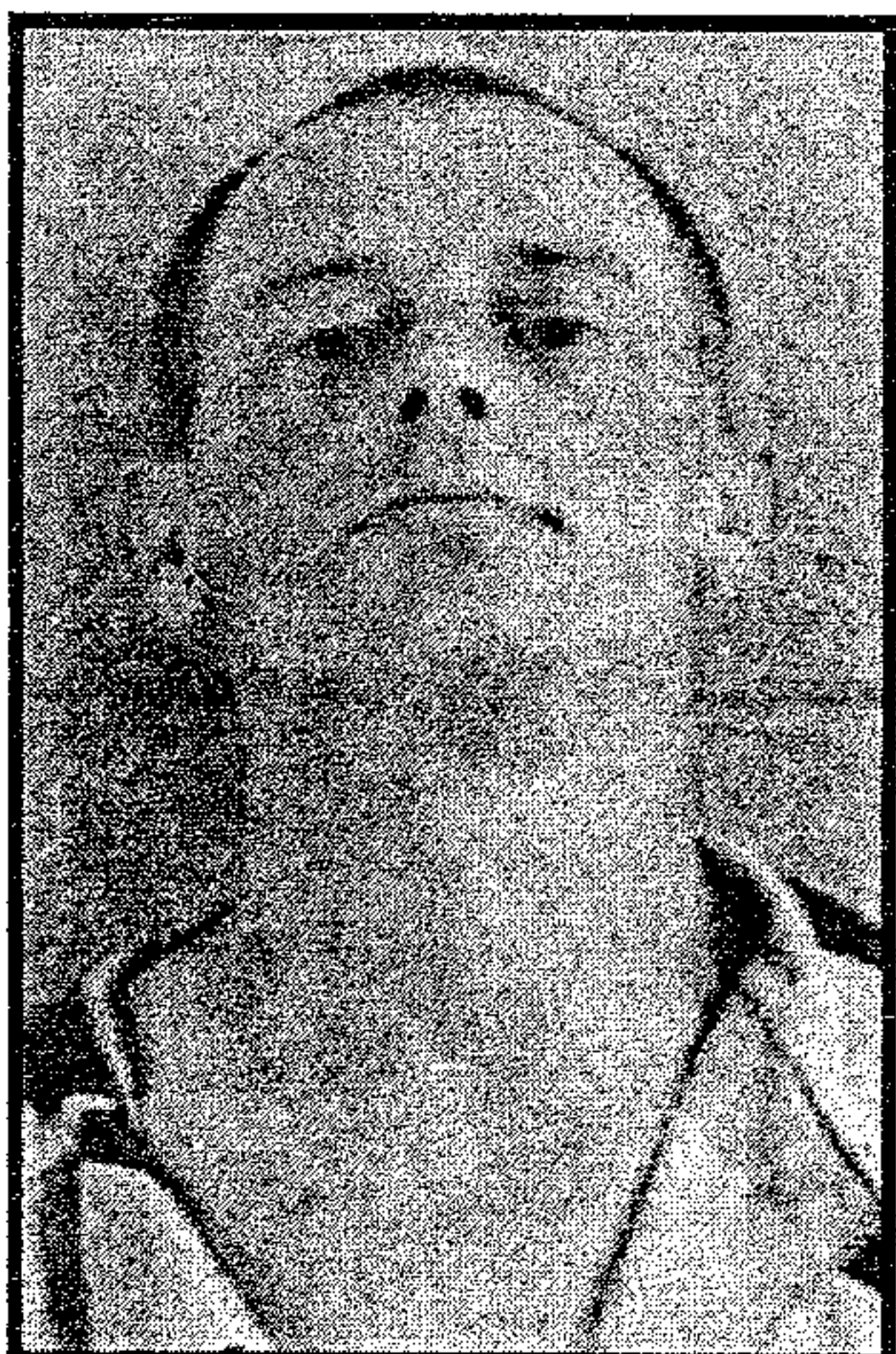
## Accused shoplifter nabbed

LCSO was dispatched to Old Highway 95 on a possible physical domestic and upon arrival found a man sitting on the bank next to his house. He had visible injuries to his

face, chest, and arms.

Deputy Rayfield asked the man what happened and he advised he and a friend were cleaning out the empty pool at his house and his soon to be girlfriend, Katie Webb, came outside screaming at him and telling him she was going to knock his teeth out because of a text message in his

friend's phone.

The victim further advised Webb kept going inside the house and coming back outside screaming. Then she started throwing porch items at him, hitting him, before she finally got down in the pool and started assailing him. The victim stated the only time he touched Webb was to try to

ward off punches and kicks. That's when he went to a neighbor's to get away from her.

After hearing the victim's side, Deputy Rayfield reported he went to talk to Ms. Webb, who was in the house. All she would tell him was she wanted to go home.

Ms. Webb had one rub mark on her left

forearm. The victim had several visible cuts and scrapes on his chest and torso and also a busted and swelled bottom lip. He refused medical attention.

A witness who was on the scene confirmed the victim's statement. Ms. Webb was taken into custody and transported to the Loudon County Jail.

### Leatherwood

was charged with DUI, disregarding a red light, speeding, no drivers license and possession of schedule IV.

According to reports,

Wednesday, around 1:33 AM, Ms. Leatherwood was observed driving a 1995 Mazda 626 on the Interstate 75 ramp to Highway 321 south. She didn't stop at the red light at 321, but continued south on

Highway 321.

Ms. Leatherwood was speeding 60 mph in a 40 mph zone, certified by pacing her vehicle.

When Lt. David Flynn, LCPD stopped her for speeding, Ms. Leatherwood had a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage about her breath and person. She was unsteady on her feet, had slurred speech, glassy eyes and slowed motor skills.

Leatherwood admitted to consuming several alcoholic beverages and was placed under arrest.

During a search of Ms. Leatherwood's purse, incident to arrest, two zolpeden pills and a small amount of marijuana were found. She submitted to a blood test to be sent to TBI for analysis.

### Smallwood

Christy A. Smallwood, 34, Scenic Circle, Tellico Plains was charged with DUI 2nd offense and failure to maintain her travel lane.

The report states, Friday, at approximately 10:22 PM, Trooper

Eric Miller, THP observed Ms. Smallwood's white Honda Civic on Interstate 75 south cross the fog line, three times for approximately 3 to 5 seconds. Her vehicle straddled the fog line and went onto the rumble strip for another 3 to 5 seconds.

Trooper Miller stopped her at the 81 mile marker. Ms. Smallwood seemed confused and lethargic. She said she was coming from her job at Shoney's off of Lovell Road.

Smallwood advised she'd taken a kolonopin earlier that day.

Ms. Smallwood could not perform field sobriety tasks as instructed and was placed under arrest.

The trooper read and explained the implied consent law and Ms. Smallwood consented to a blood draw at Fort Loudoun Medical Center.

Once at the jail, a drivers license check revealed interim restricted, which means Ms. Smallwood is allowed to operate a motor vehicle Monday thru Sunday from 8:00 AM to 9:00 PM. She was in violation of that order by approximately 2 hours.

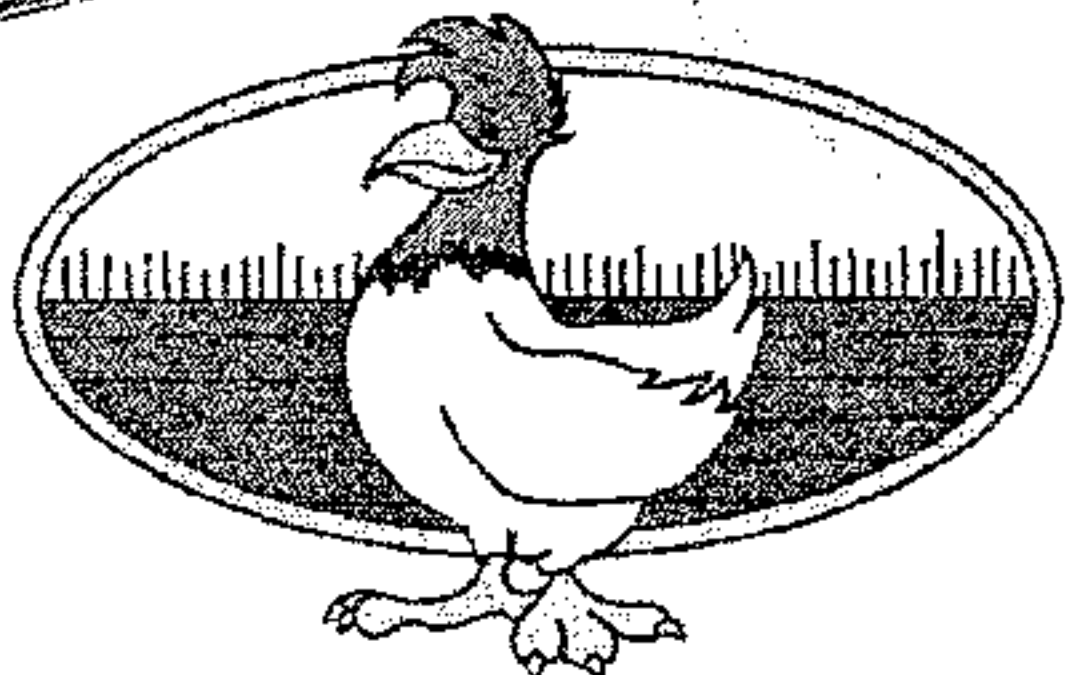

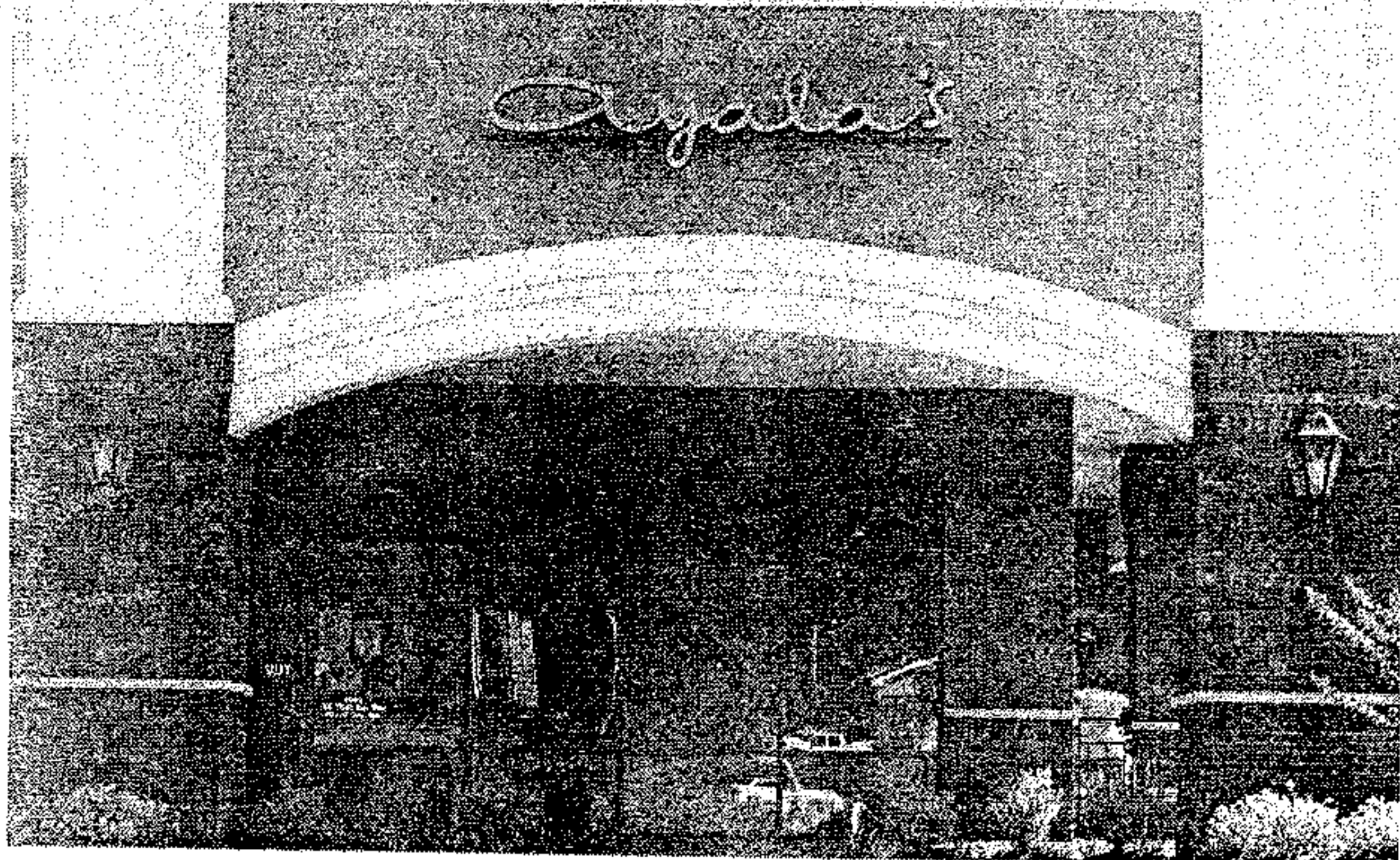

alprazolam but instead it contained multiple kinds of pills.

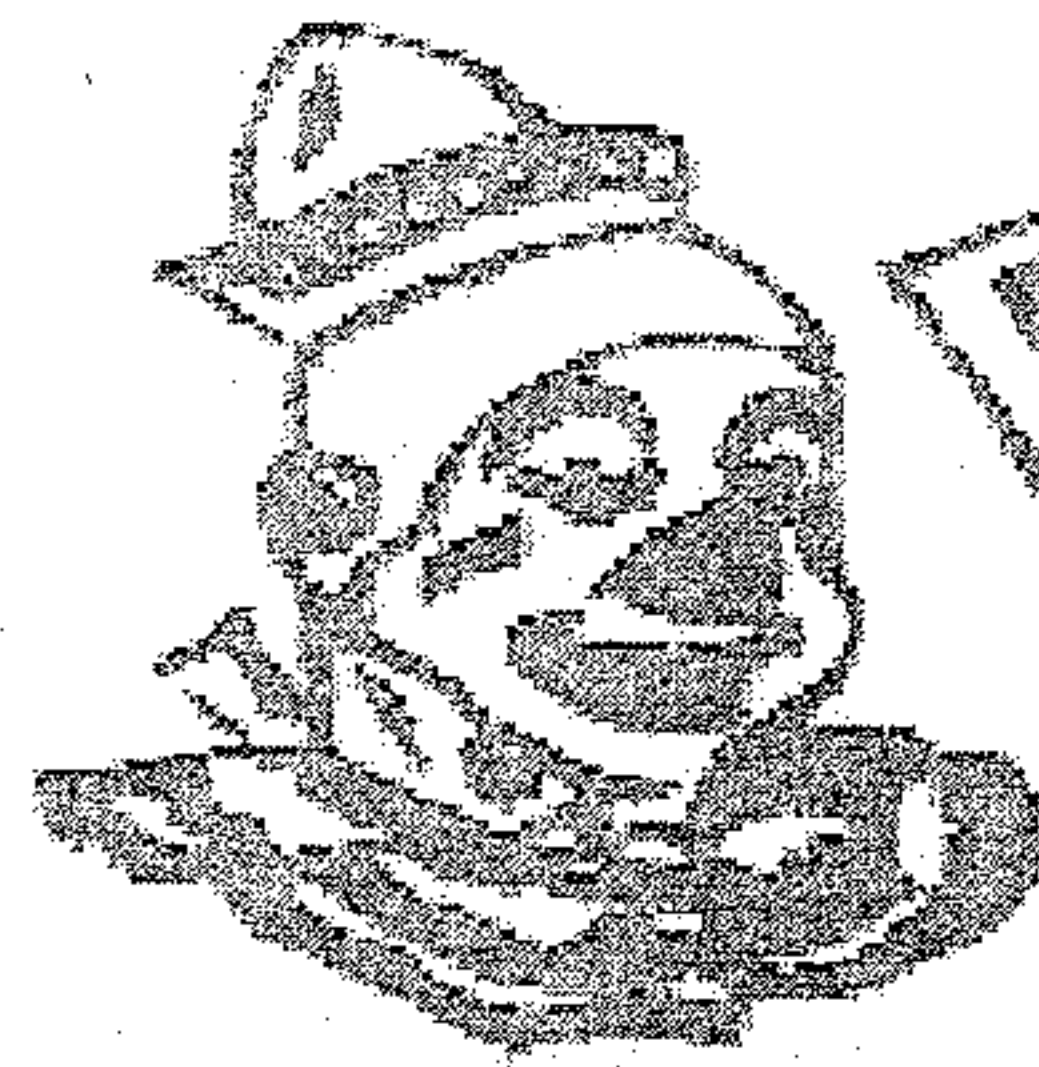
One pill was believed to be 1 mg. alprazolam and 5 1/2 small round blue pills with

asked God to give me words for this week's article I found myself reading Psalm 94. Being a book of the Old Testament we know this Psalm is at least 2000 years old. I don't know who the author is or the date it was written. I'm not sure if it was recited as a poem or sang to music but it does tell a story about our God. The 94th Psalm describes God's love and mercy but more so serves as a reminder that God will judge the wicked in His own time and in His own way. The wicked of our world will stand before an Almighty God just as you and I. How will He find you? Will you be found serving or sinning when it's your day to be judged? Please read this entire Psalm as if it was written yesterday. Read it slowly and examine your life in contrast with this Psalm.

**Psalm 94 (NKJV)**  
*Oh Lord God, to whom vengeance belongs—  
 Oh God, to whom vengeance belongs,  
 shine forth!  
 Rise up, O Judge of the earth;  
 Render punishment to the proud.  
 Lord, how long will the wicked,  
 How long will the wicked triumph?  
 They utter speech, and speak  
 Insolent things;  
 All the workers of iniquity boast in themselves.  
 They break in pieces Your people,  
 O Lord,  
 And afflict Your heritage.  
 They slay the widow and the stranger,  
 And murder the fatherless.  
 As they say, "The Lord does not see,*

*Nor does the God of Jacob understand."  
 Understand, you senseless among the people;  
 And you fools, when will you be wise?  
 He who planted the ear, shall He not hear?  
 He who formed the eye, shall He not see?  
 He who instructs the nations, shall He not correct?  
 He who teaches man knowledge,  
 The Lord knows the thoughts of man,  
 That they are futile.  
 Blessed is the man whom You instruct, O Lord,  
 And teach out of Your law,  
 That You may give him rest from the days of adversity,  
 Until the pit is dug for the wicked.  
 For the Lord will not cast off His people,  
 Nor will He forsake His inheritance.  
 But judgement will return to righteousness,  
 And all the upright in heart will follow it.  
 Who will rise up for me against the evildoers?
