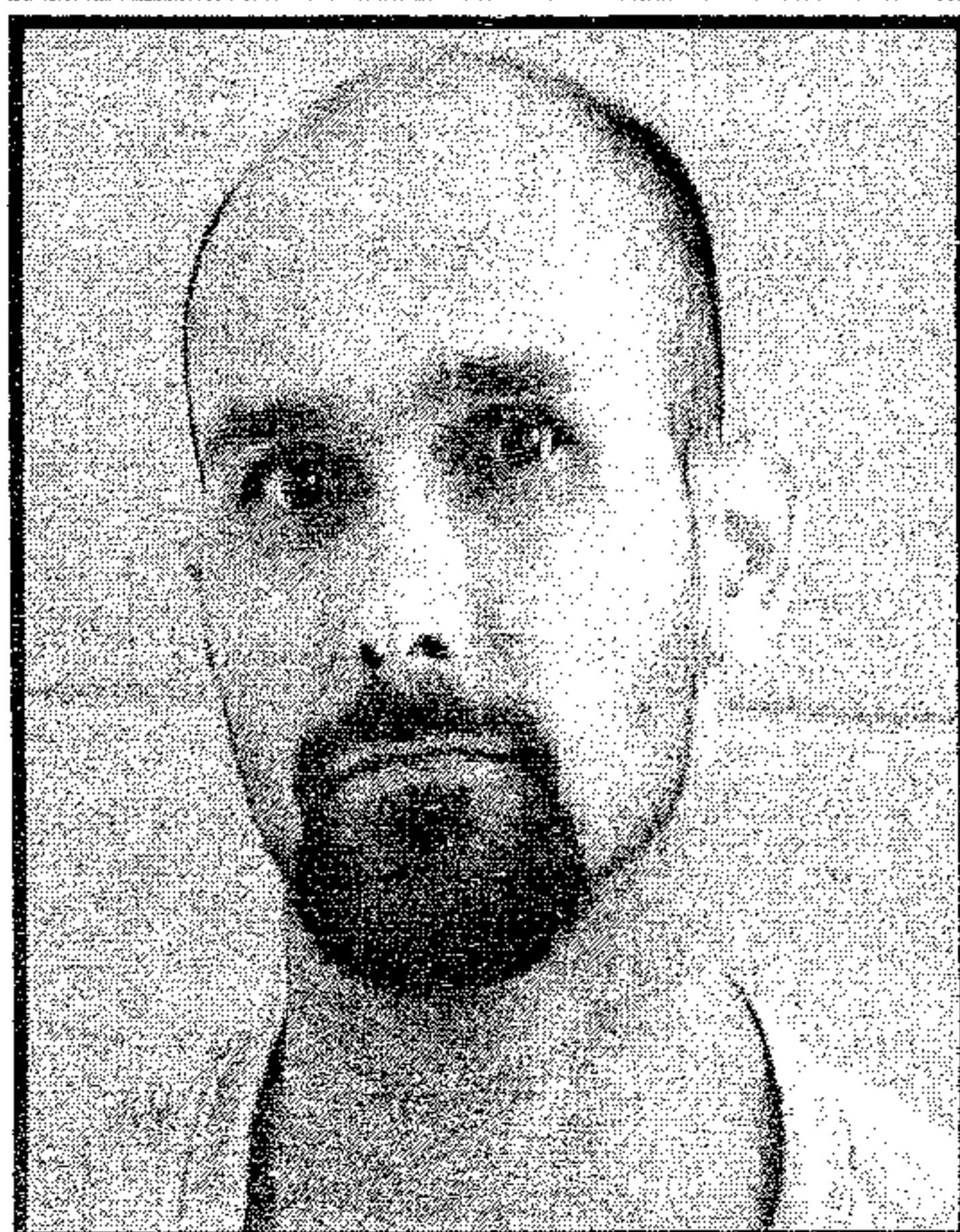

**Webb**  
 According to reports, Agent Brendan DeBoer, 9th DTF stopped a gray Nissan Altima for traveling 55 mph in a 45 mph zone on Steekee Road at Roberts Road in Loudon. The officer also observed the brake light on the Altima wasn't working and the license plate was not secured properly. The driver was iden-

tified as Justin Webb. Mr. Webb had just left the Rite-Aid Pharmacy where he'd bought a pseudoephedrine based product. After receiving verbal consent to search the vehicle, Agent DeBoer discovered a box of Aleve-D, a piece of burnt tinfoil with unknown residue on it, and two pills tentatively identified as 800 mg ibuprophen. Mr. Webb stated he'd

purchased the box to trade to a known meth cook for \$50. Mr. Webb had full knowledge of the intended use of the box of medication to manufacture meth. He was taken into custody and transported to the Loudon County Jail.  
**Charged**  
 August 10th, 2011, Ms. Henson Thomas went to Aaron's, 921 Highway 321 North in Lenoir City and entered

into a lease with Aaron's for a washer and dryer, having them delivered to her residence on Huntsville Hollow Road.  
 On August 29th, 2011, Ms. Henson Thomas sold the washer and dryer to Carroll's Bargain Box while still on lease from Aaron's. The total value of the appliances was \$899. Detective Sartin made the arrest Thursday.

### Coker

methamphetamine, driving on suspended 1st offense, and possession of schedule II vicoden.

According to reports, Agent Brendan DeBoer, 9th DTF stopped a gold Ford Taurus at Food City in Loudon for an expired tag. The driver was identified as Jamey L. Coker and the officer had prior knowledge Coker's driver's license are suspended.

Mr. Coker also is a known felon with an extensive history of methamphetamine related charges.

Coker was observed purchasing a pseudoephedrine based product from the Rite-Aid Pharmacy. After he left the pharmacy, Coker went into Food City and stole a package of lithium Energizer batteries, which were

found in his shorts pocket.

Records indicate, a consensual search of the vehicle produced one yellow pill tentatively identified as vicoden. Also found in the vehicle was a container of brake fluid, which in combination with the pseudoephedrine and lithium batteries makes three components used in the manufacture of meth.

Mr. Coker was transported to the Loudon County Jail.

### Coleman

amphetamine.

According to records, Agent Brendan DeBoer, 9th DTF, stopped Coleman's Chevy camaro for 45 mph in a 55 mph zone along Highway 72 at Vonore Road and while speaking with him noticed an unrestrained juvenile in the back

seat between two other juveniles, ages five, three and two.

The officer reported he learned Coleman had just left Rite-Aid Pharmacy in Loudon after purchasing a pseudoephedrine based product and upon being asked, Coleman advised he had several hypodermic needles in his pants pocket.

Records indicate the lawman retrieved the needles and during search of Coleman's vehicle two more needles were found in the console.

Agent DeBoer noted, "Mr. Coleman also revealed to me that he intended to sell the box of pseudoephedrine to a known meth cook in Madisonville for \$50."

Coleman and female reportedly both advised they'd purchased the box of medicine & other boxes in the past to provide to a meth cook with the understanding they would be

used to manufacture methamphetamine.

### Stolen

The value of his loss was estimated at \$1047. The theft is under investigation. A suspect was named.

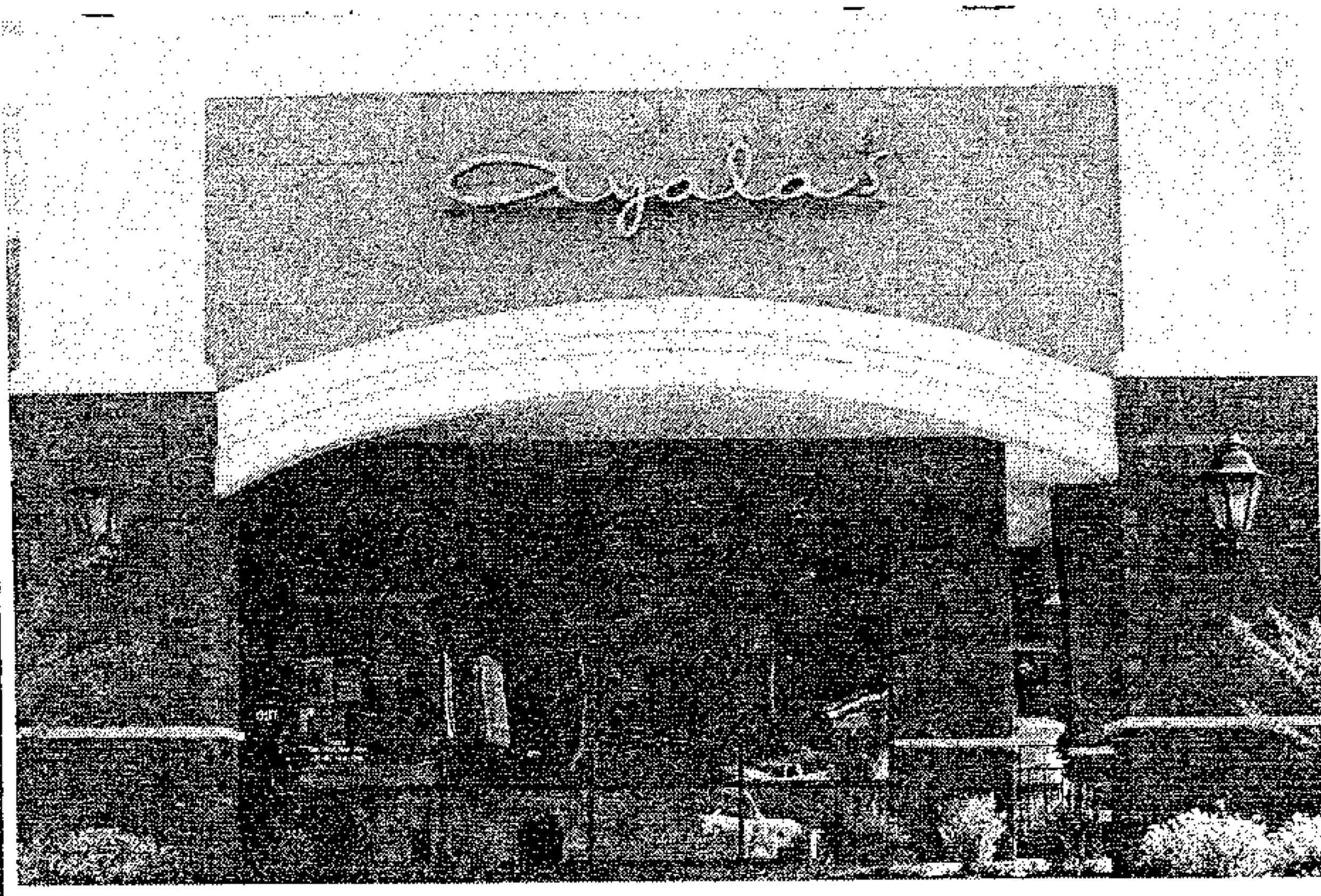

According to records, Agent Brendan DeBoer, 9th Drug Task Force conducted a traffic stop on a silver Saturn. The vehicle's registration

had expired in 2010.

Ms. Martinez was a passenger in the vehicle and appeared to be extremely nervous. It was discovered Ms. Martinez was currently on probation for a past conviction for initiating


the process of methamphetamine manufacture.

Martinez was informed of her Miranda Warnings, and told Agent DeBoer she'd purchased a pseudoephedrine based prod-

uct from the Rite-Aid Pharmacy just prior to their encounter to sell to a meth cook in exchange for money.

Martinez had made other purchases on two

seperate occasions this month, which totaled \$30 the first time and \$40 the second time. Ms. Martinez was taken into custody and duly charged.
