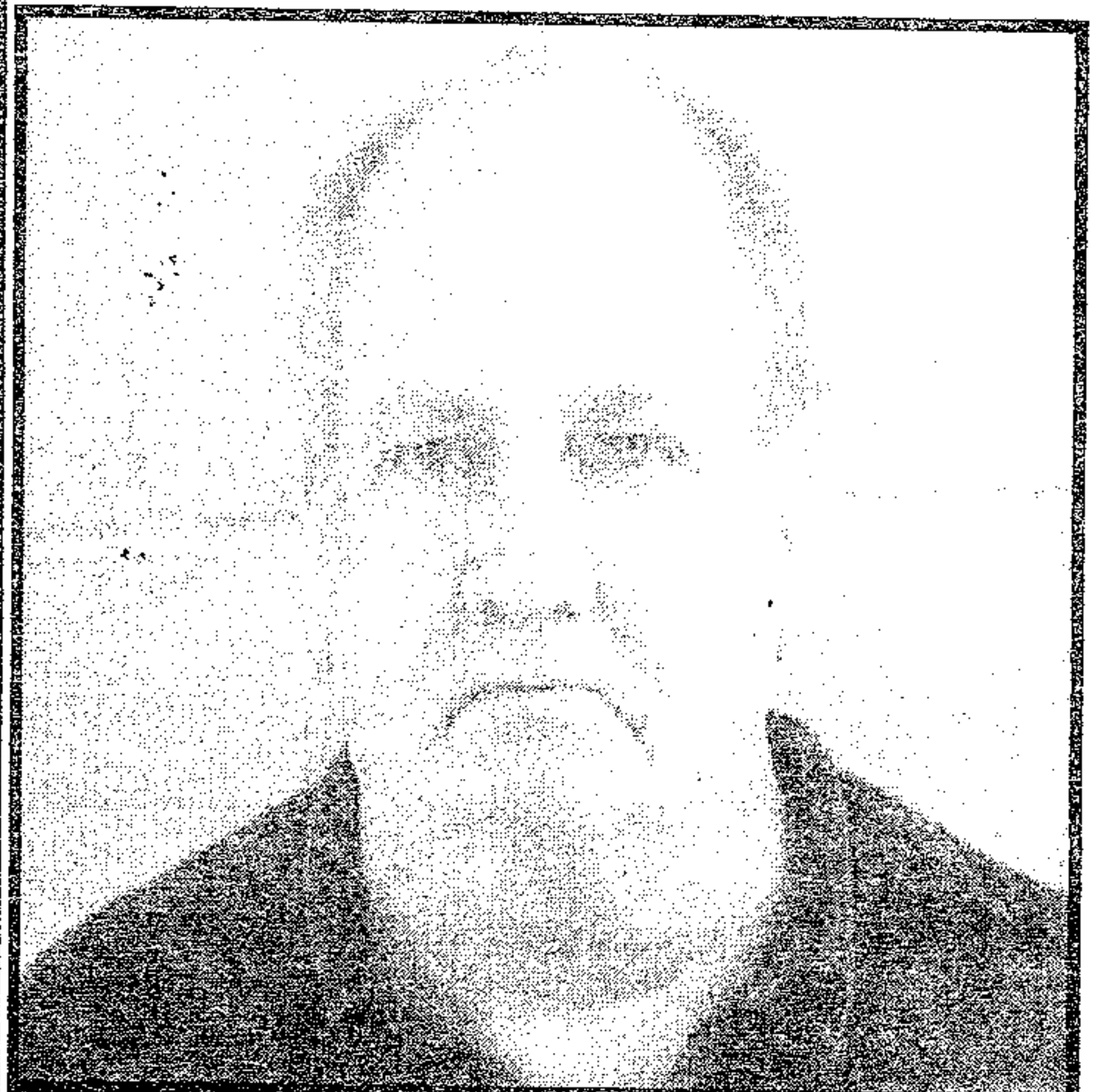

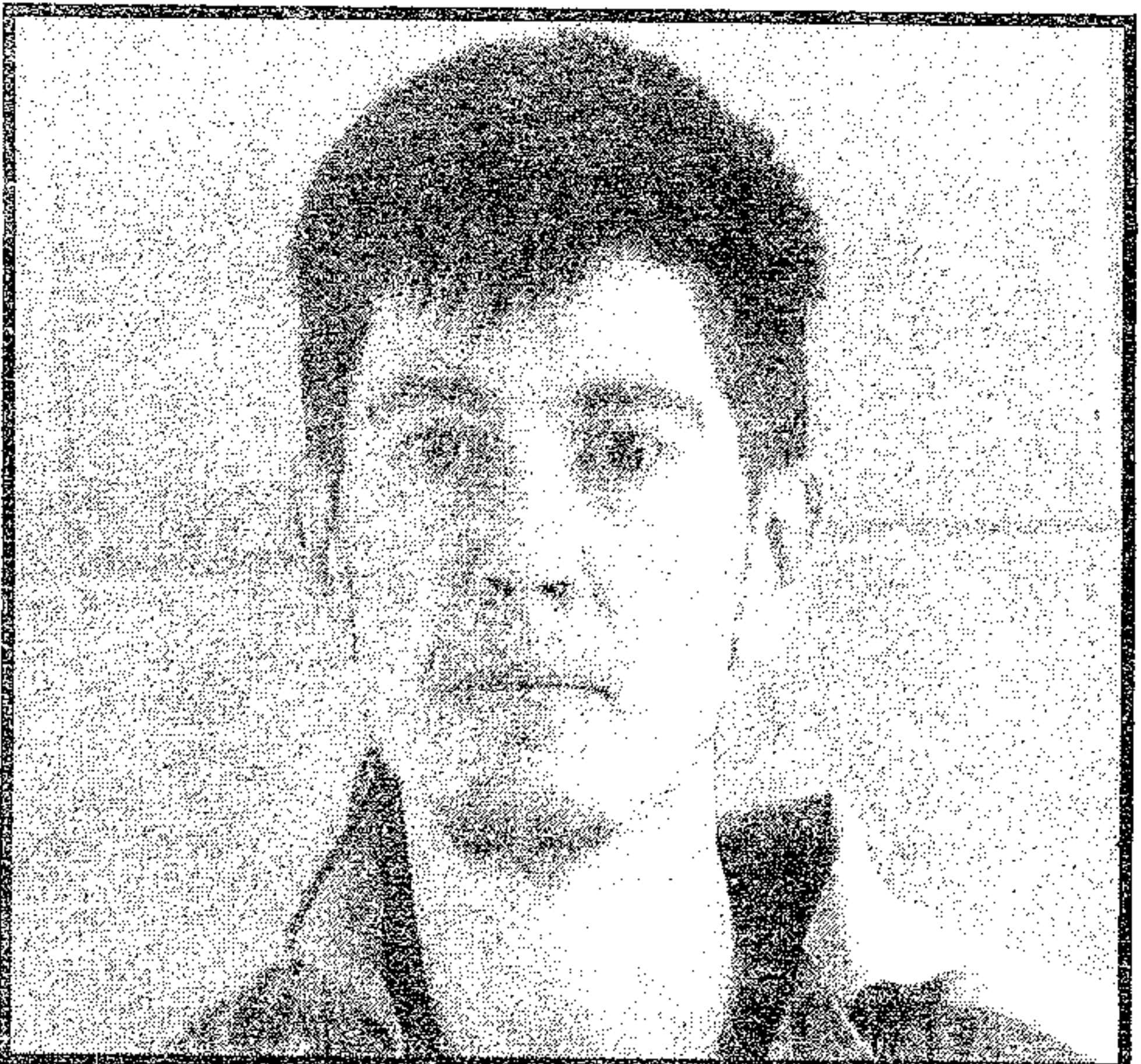

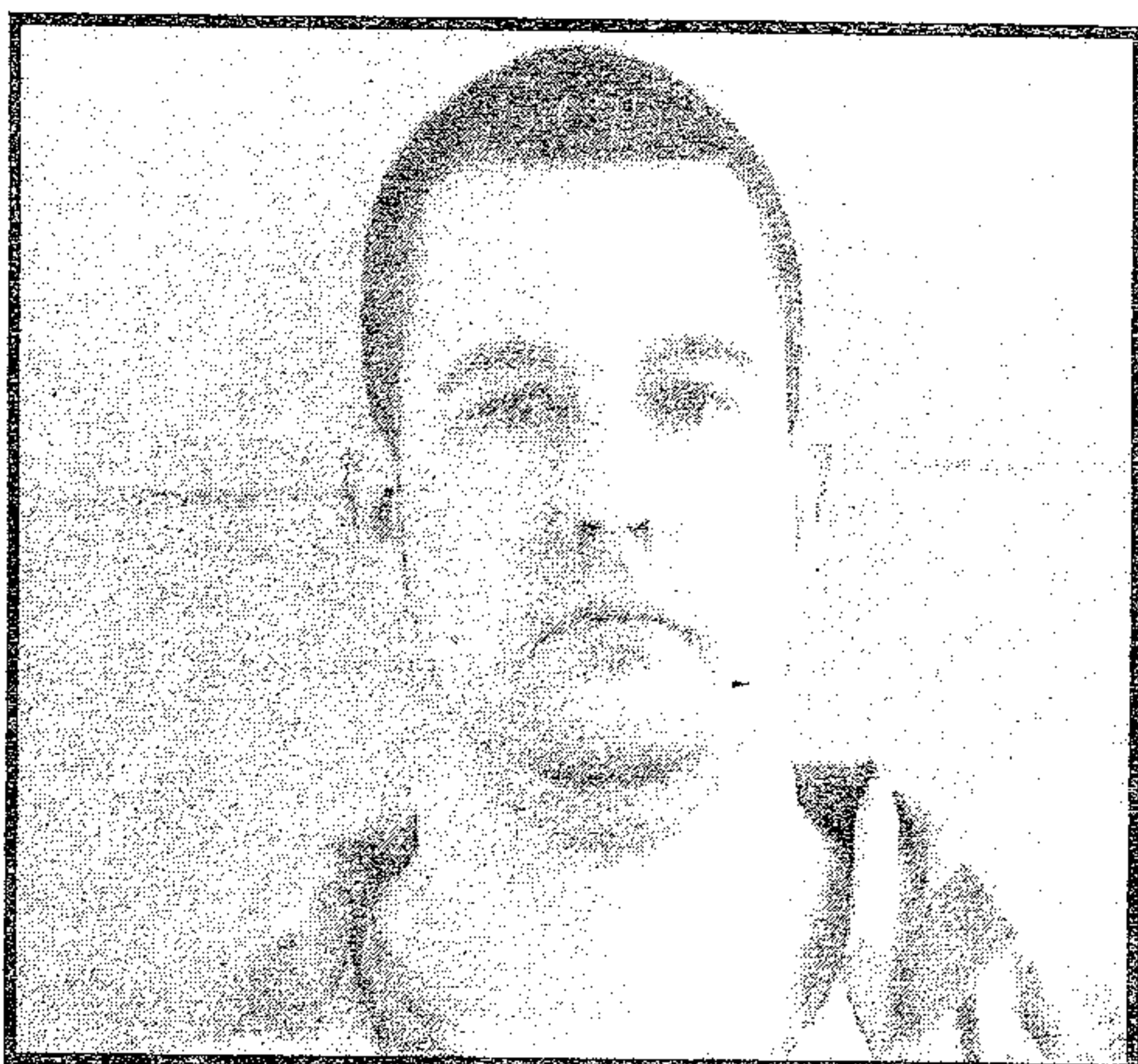

### Nine Times!

A Philadelphia man received two felony charges Sunday after Trooper Eric Miller stopped his vehicle for suspicion of DUI and upon finding he was under the influence and had an open container of alcohol issued him his ninth DUI and ninth DORL charges.

Charles L. Duncan, 64, Gateway Circle, Philadelphia was charged with felony DUI 9th offense and felony driving on revoked license 9th offense.

According to reports, Sunday, at approximately 8:43 AM, Trooper Eric Miller, THP conducted a traf-

fic stop on Mr. Duncan at the 77 mile marker of Interstate 75 for failure to maintain his travel lane safely and not wearing his seat belt. Duncan had a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage about his person, bloodshot watery eyes, constricted pupils, and seemed very lethargic and confused.

Duncan couldn't perform field sobriety tasks as instructed and was placed under arrest.

During a search of Mr. Duncan's Chevrolet El Camino, a cup was discovered in the driver's cup holder which contained an amber colored liquid that smelled like an alcoholic beverage. A plas-

tic grocery bag found behind the driver's seat contained six unopened beers and five unopened mini bottles of mixed liquor, whiskey, vodka and cinnamon liquor.

Mr. Duncan was transported to Fort Loudoun Medical Center for a mandatory blood draw and then to the Loudon County Jail.

Mr. Lowe stated he and his girlfriend's son-in-law got into an argument and he hit him. According to the son-in-law, he and Mr.

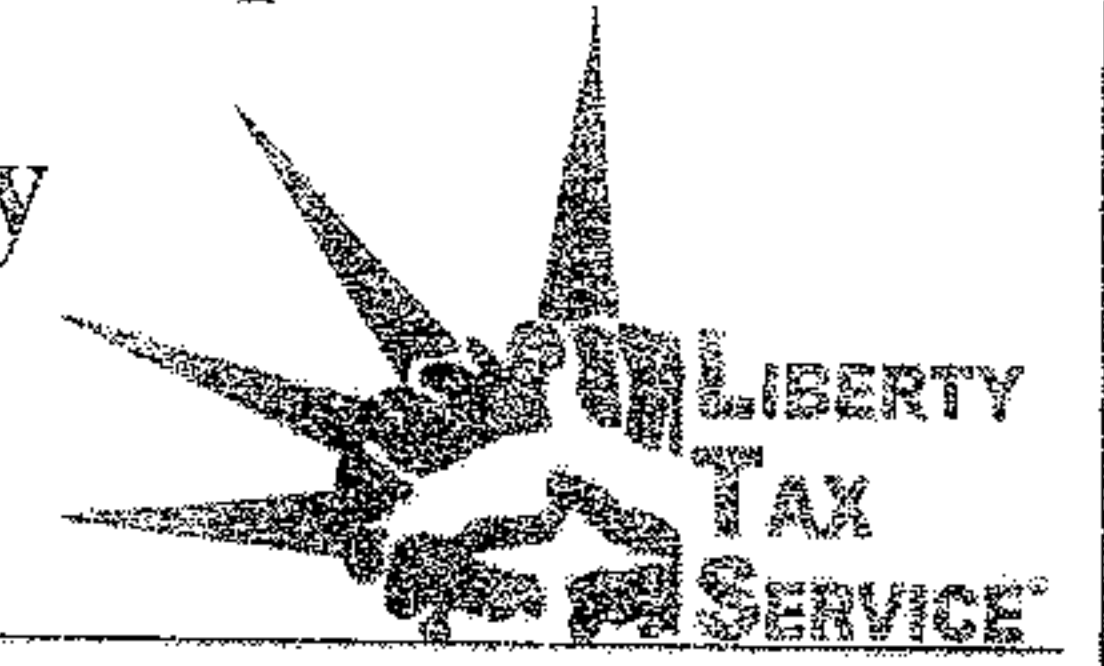
Lowe were arguing and Mr. Lowe hit him in the mouth.

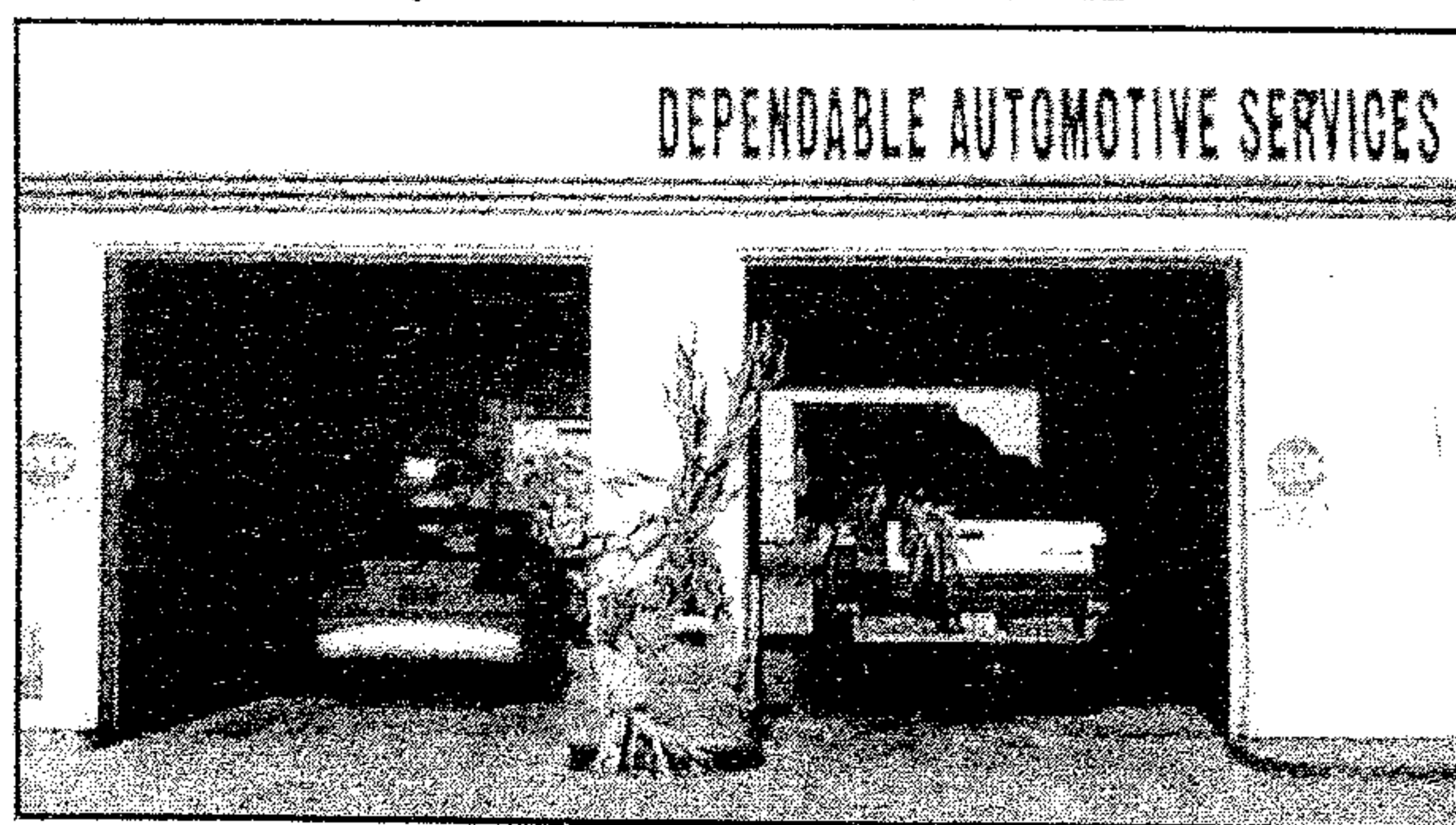

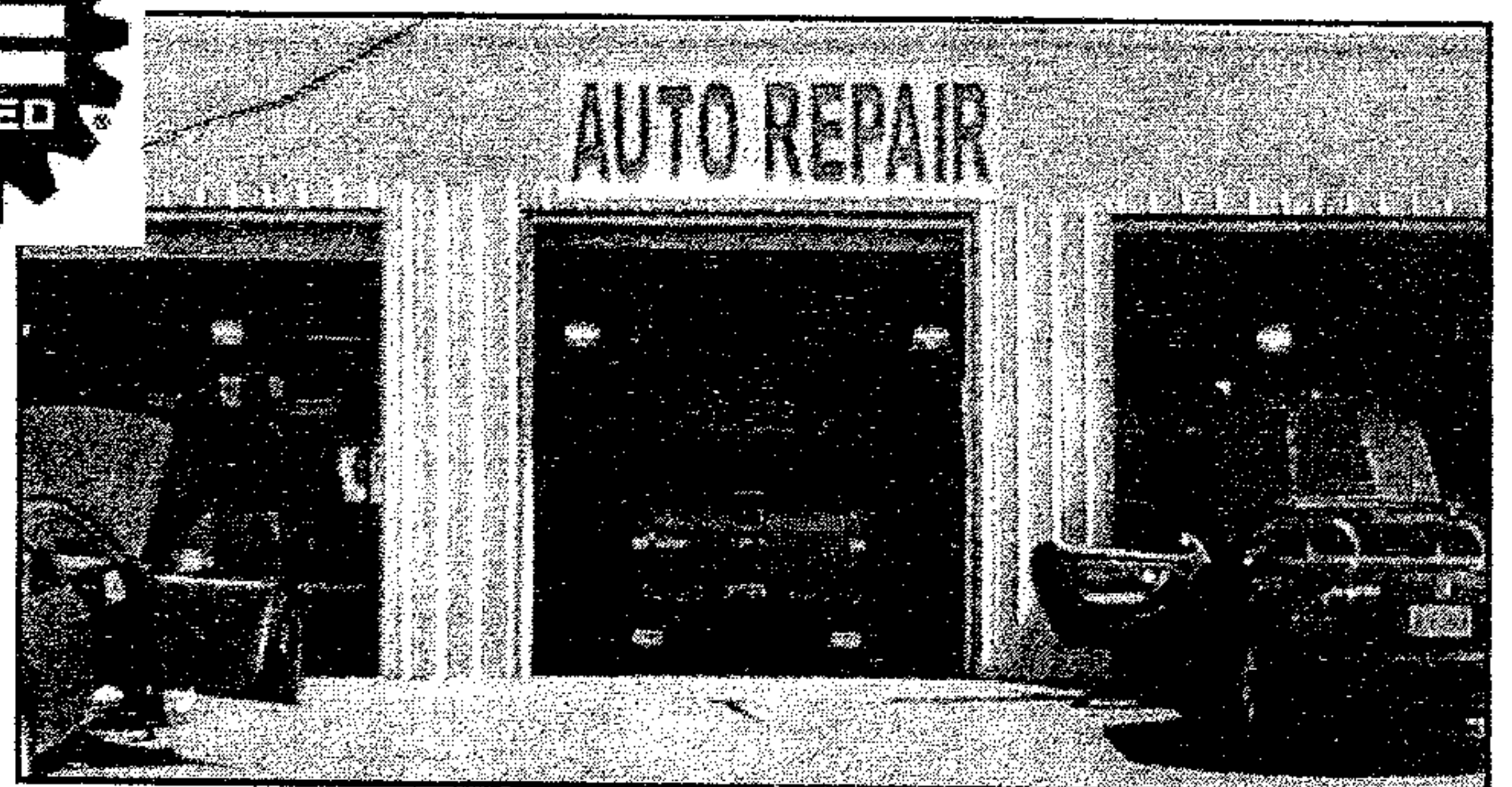

A Lenoir City man is accused of victimizing at least two people when he reportedly helped himself to another

man's credit card and used it to pay a bill and go shopping, just three days before he dipped into a woman's purse at church and took her

credit card to go on an \$1100 shopping spree. Robert Franklin Russell, 31, Old Highway 95, Lenoir City was charged with two

counts of theft under \$500 and three counts of fraudulent use of a credit card.

According to affidavits filed by Detective Jonathan Sartin, LCPD; on January 5, 2012, Robert F. Russell took the victim's credit card from his wallet and used it to pay his Lenoir City Utilities bill totaling \$663.04.

The victim advised




