to him and he smokes it for medical reasons and has smoked it since 1970.

Deputy Hamilton then asked for permission to search Mr. Gibson's truck and he consented.

During the search, the deputy looked through a soft brief case and discovered a cigarette pack containing ten round white pills with Watson and 749 on them. They were identified as 325 mg. acetaminophen/oxycodone.

Mr. Gibson did not have a prescription for the medication.

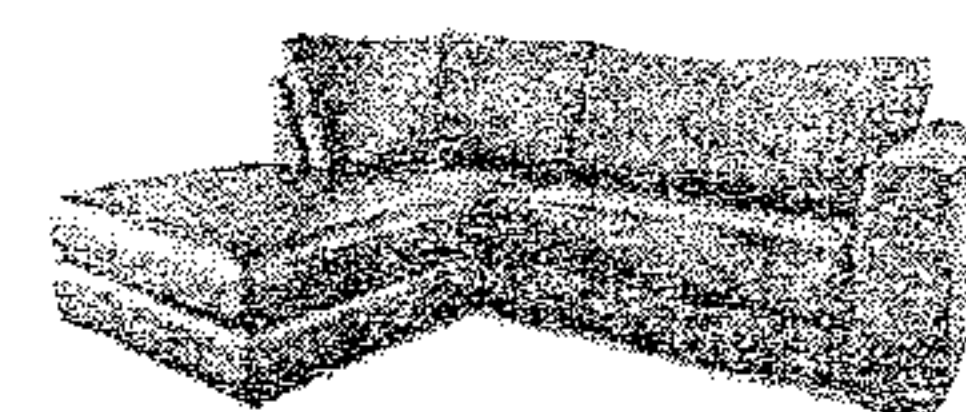
