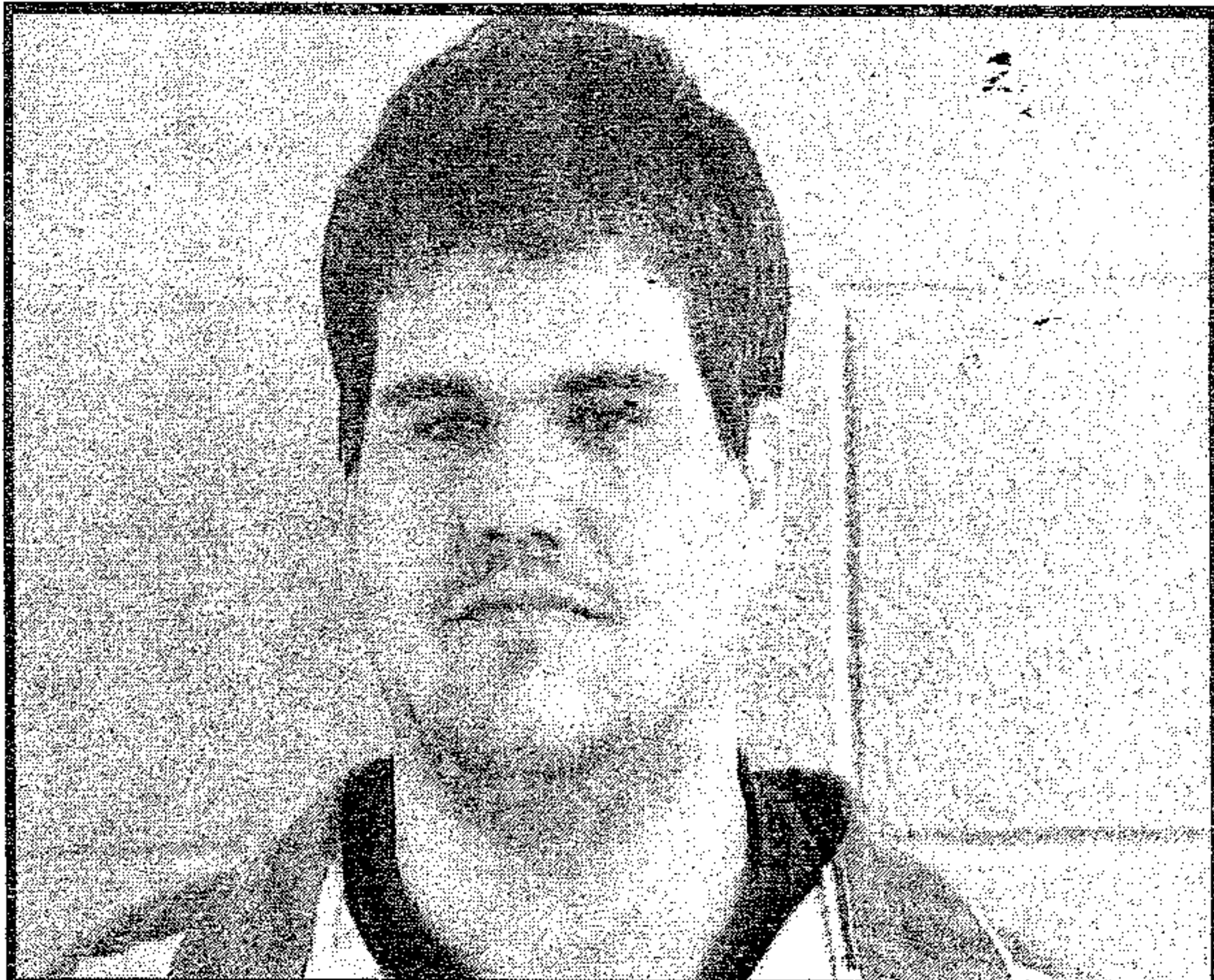

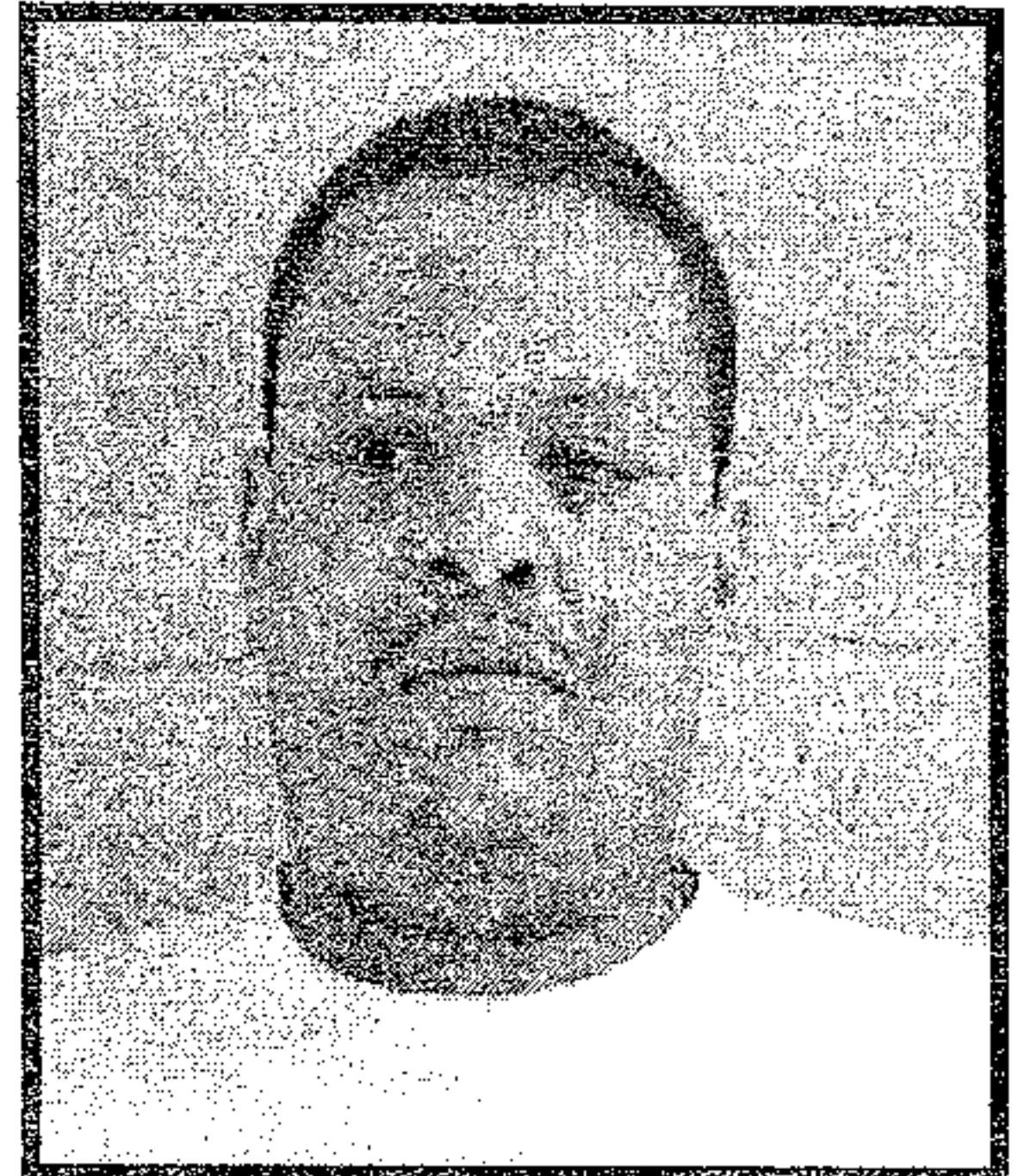

**Update**

LCSO-ND; on December 2, 2011, investigator's with the Loudon County Sheriff's Office Narcotics Unit and

the Clinton Police Department conducted a controlled buy of crack cocaine from Corey Trenton Capshaw and Latrice Yvette Thaxton.

Investigators met with a confidential informant and the informant made a recorded telephone call to Capshaw, asking Capshaw

where they could meet at. Capshaw advised the informant to call the girl, referring to Latrice Thaxton, and give the money to her.

then handed her the recorded \$100 in US currency.

Thaxton left Ferry Street driving a gold Lexus ES 300 to meet Capshaw and pick up the drugs and minutes later Capshaw left his residence at 432 Mason Lane, Loudon in a white Chevy Suburban and drove toward Commerce Street. Capshaw was observed on Rayder Avenue as he turned onto River Road toward Mulberry Street, in the area where Thaxton's vehicle had been spotted by investigators.

Approximately two minutes later, the informant received a recorded telephone call from Capshaw asking the informant if the informant had called Thaxton yet.

The informant then made a recorded telephone call to Thaxton and advised Thaxton that Capshaw had said to call her.

Thaxton advised the informant to meet at her, Thaxton's mother's house, on Ferry Street in Loudon. The informant was searched and no contraband was found. The informant was equipped with a recording device and \$100 in recorded US currency to purchase the crack cocaine from Thaxton.

Capshaw's vehicle was observed leaving the area of Ward Avenue and Cedar Street just before Thaxton's vehicle was seen leaving from in front of a residence on Cedar Street.

The informant was then driven to the residence on Ferry Street where the informant met Thaxton next to Thaxton's vehicle. Thaxton asked the informant how much the informant wanted and the informant told Thaxton \$100 worth,

Thaxton met back with the informant on Ferry Street and handed over the crack cocaine while the informant sat in the passenger's side of Thaxton's vehicle.

The informant then left Ferry Street and was driven to a predetermined location by investigators where the recording device and purported crack co-

caine was relinquished to investigators, The informant was searched and no contraband was found.

Thaxton made a telephone call to the informant and advised if the informant needed anything else that day to call her instead of Capshaw.

Corey Trent Capshaw and Latrice Yvette Thaxton were both charged with sale and delivery of schedule II narcotics.

Investigator Shane Ezell, LCSO-ND was also on the scene. Investigator Stanley served the warrant and made the arrest Thursday at Thaxton's home in Athens.

**Police beat**

Stefani Dawn Hall, 42, of Roane Street,

Rockwood, was charged with driving under the influence. According to the report, Officer B. E. Blakney, LPD was traveling on Hwy 11 across the river bridge when a silver car almost struck him head on. The officer turned around and observed the vehicle traveling north in the southbound lane, almost running off the road into a parking lot. The officer activated his emergency equipment and the vehicle pulled off the roadway into the grass from the southbound lane of travel.

The officer approached the vehicle and the driver, Ms. Stefani Hall stated she had hit something in the parking lot that had caused her tire to have a flat. She was asked for license and insurance

information and after she was unable to get her license out of her wallet she was asked to step out of the vehicle. Ms. Hall was unsteady on her feet, was unable to follow directions and performed poorly on sobriety tasks. 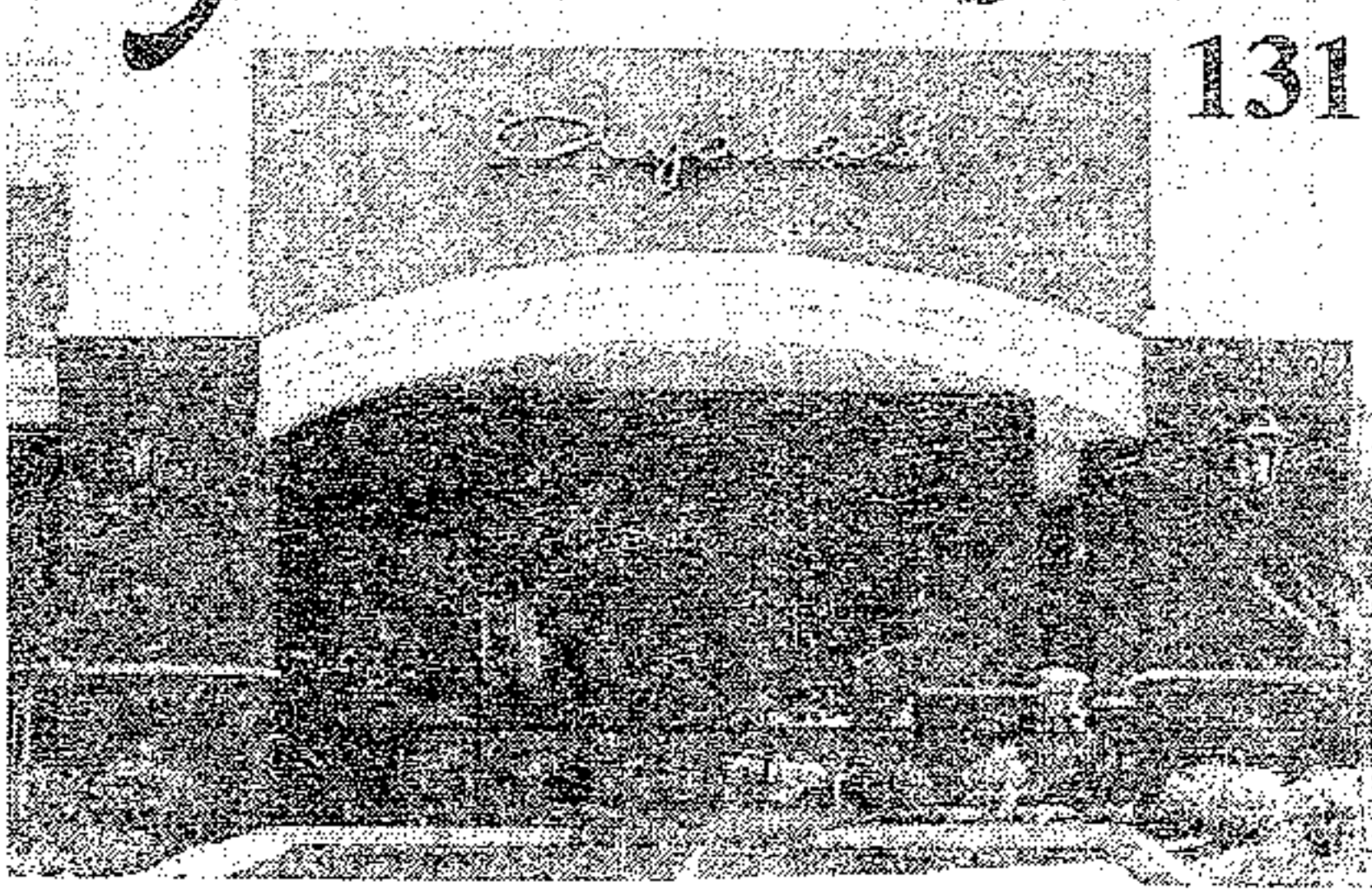

The medics were able to get the patient into the ambulance and while they were getting the patient prepared for transport, Deputy Goddard heard a loud

crashing sound and turned around and saw a car traveling west that just went by the Medic unit.

A Medic came out of the ambulance and yelled "stop that car, it just hit our ambulance." The deputy threw his hand up to try and stop the vehicle but it turned left onto Dry Ridge Road.

Deputy Goddard ran to his patrol car and took off after the offending vehicle. He caught up to the gold

Buick Century and stopped it.

The driver was identified as Barkley Wiseman. Mr. Wiseman stated he drank 6 beers around 4:00 pm and refused to do field sobriety tasks and was placed under arrest. His license came back revoked for DUI. He also refused implied consent.

No one was injured in the crash however, the Medic unit had some damage to the passenger side.

Law enforcement re-

ceived permission to search Mr. Wiseman's vehicle and found a 1-liter tvarscki vodka 100 bottle in the driver's side floorboard. The vodka bottle was 3 quarters empty and Mr. Wiseman later stated he didn't drink any beer, he drank half a bottle of vodka instead.
