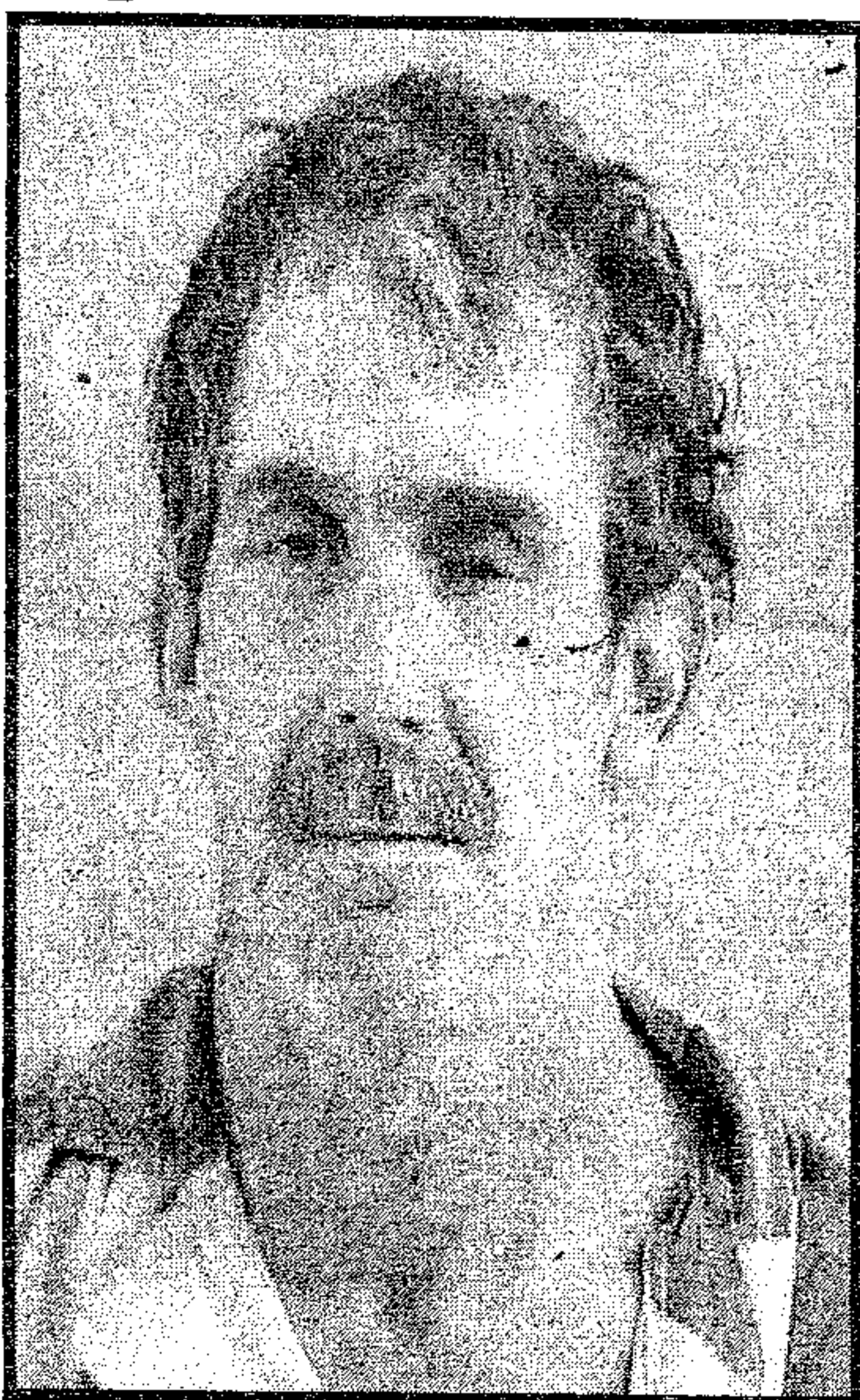
## LC man stabbed by man he helped

Patrick Eugene Moore, 47, Williams Ferry Road, Lenoir City, was charged with aggravated assault.

According to reports, Friday, around 8:46 pm, Deputy Brad Rayfield, LCSO, was dispatched to Williams Ferry Road on a fight involving two males and one of them had a knife.

While enroute, dispatch advised Deputy Rayfield the male with the knife was standing in the front yard beating on vehicles. When the deputy arrived on the scene he saw a male later identified as Patrick E. Moore, standing in the front yard bleeding from the left side

safely. The vehicle had crossed the fog line and rumble strip twice for approximately 2-4 seconds each time.

The driver Ms. Correll, had constricted pupils and was very nervous. She could not perform field sobriety as instructed and was placed under arrest for DUI. Ms. Correll was read the implied consent advisement and agreed to a blood draw.

of his head. Deputy Rayfield asked who had the knife and Moore advised he had it but threw it in the woods before

the deputy arrived. Mr. Moore seemed very intoxicated according to the report.

The other male/victim was standing on the

porch bleeding from the left side of his head and he had blood on his shirt. The victim reported Mr. Moore had been staying in their base-

ment because he was homeless. He went on to say Mr. Moore came home drunk that night and he told Moore to go downstairs and sleep it off.

The victim reported Mr. Moore came back up the stairs to the back door with an open pocket knife and said "I've got something for you." The victim said he and Mr. Moore struggled inside the kitchen door for he was trying to protect his mother, wife and baby who were all on the scene and witnessed the fight. He further advised, in self defense, he hit Moore in the head several times with a kitchen dough roller while trying to dodge the knife Mr. Moore had in his hand.

The victim did receive a minor stab wound in the chest, two minor stab wounds in the up-

per left arm and shoulder and possibly a small cut to his left upper ear. EMS checked the man but he refused medical treatment. All witnesses were in agreement as to what happened and saw the knife. The knife was looked for but not recovered.

Mr. Moore was arrested for aggravated assault, transported to Fort Loudoun ER for his injuries, then to the Loudon County Jail.
