According to the affidavit filed by Detective Jonathan Sartin, LCPD; on or about January 28, 2012, Ms. Mickel was at the Lenoir City High

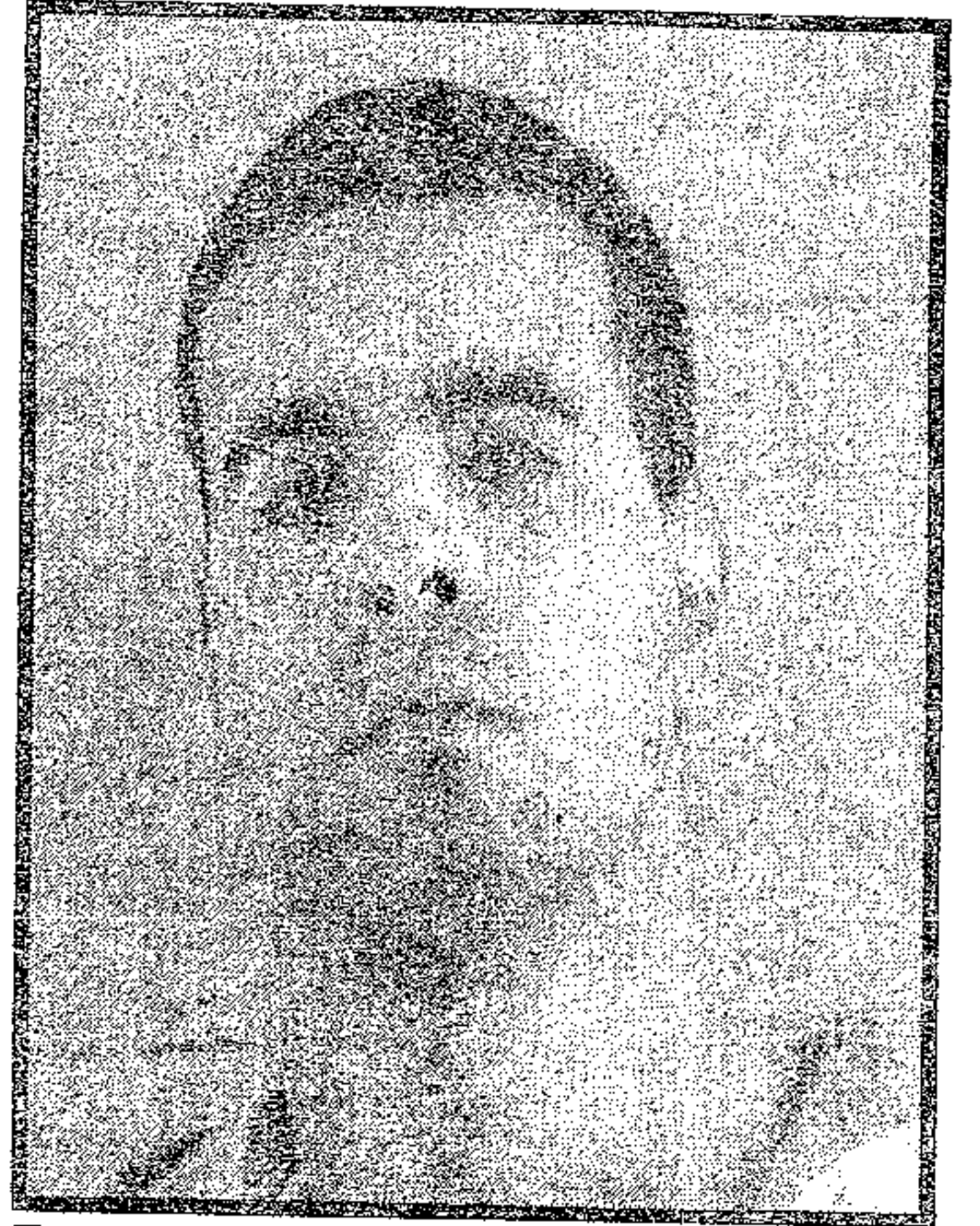

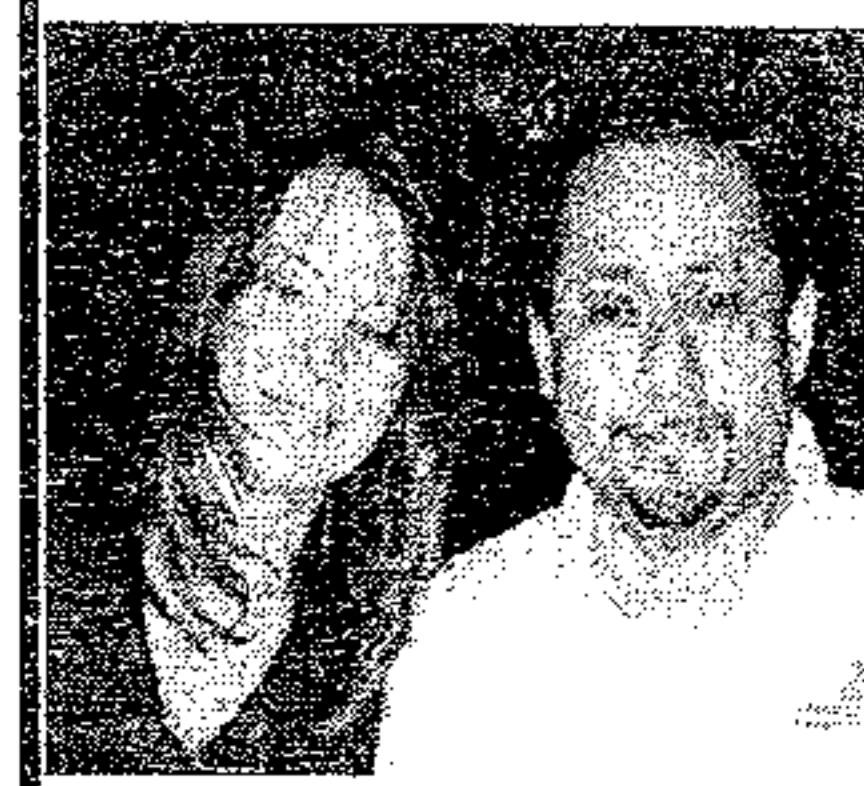

credit/debit card, theft over \$500, theft over \$1000 and two counts of forgery.

According to affidavits filed by Detective Jonathan Sartin, LCPD; on or about February 2 2012, Mr. Perez went to Walmart in Lenoir City where he used a credit/debit card belonging to a female victim who lives in Millersburg, Michigan.

Perez used the card in the amounts of \$506.41 and \$1043.91 and signed the name Bryan Wilson to the receipt both times.

Perez used the credit/debit card and purchased gift cards with it, then on the same date, he used the card to purchase gift cards and an iPad without the permission of the vic-

tim.

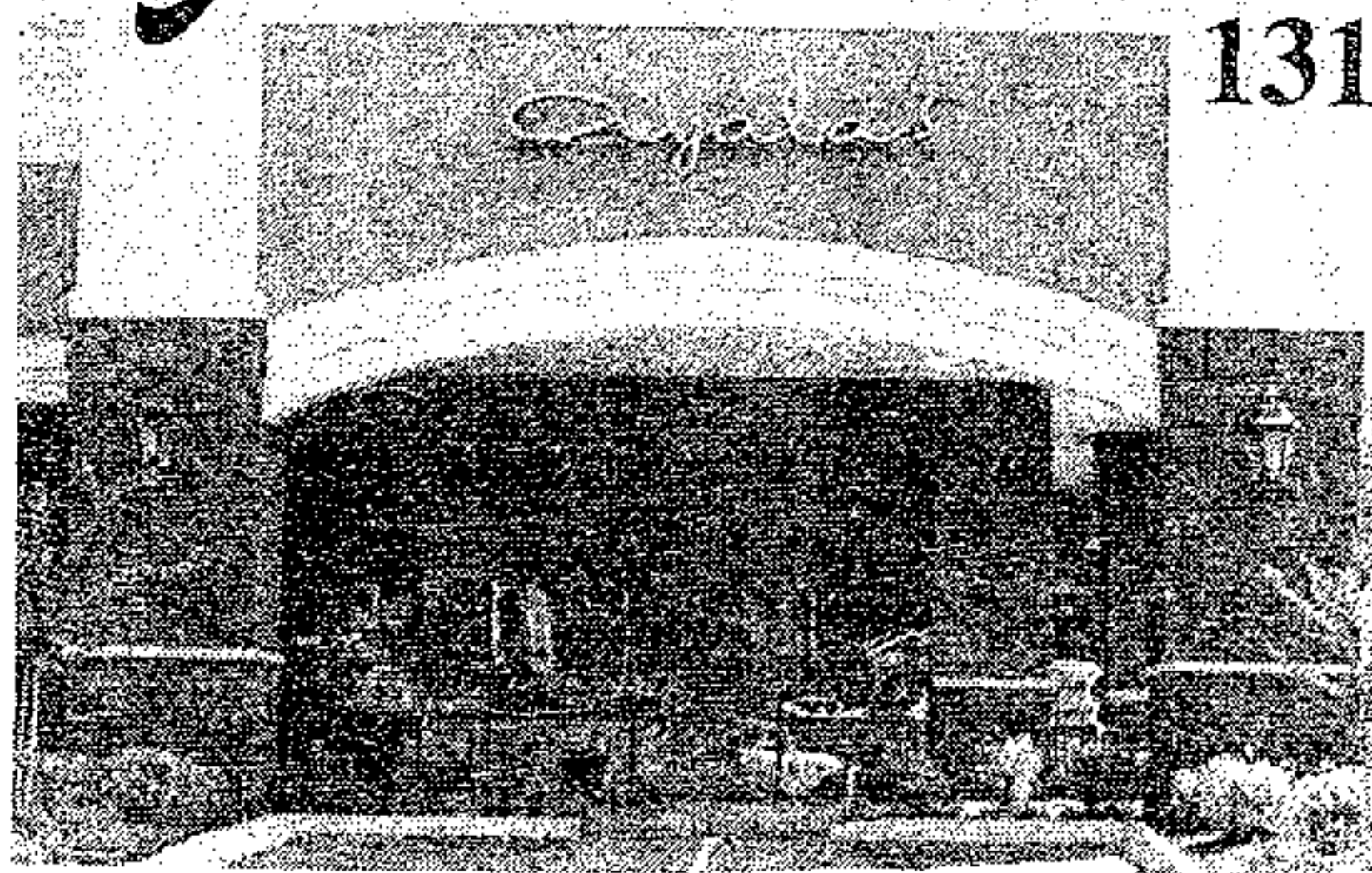

He got her down on the floor and when his daughter tried to get him off the woman, he pushed his daughter through the bedroom door and started to threaten to kill her and

The daughter further stated while she was trying to help the woman she struck her father in the head to get him off of the woman. The daughter was transported to the Fort Loudoun ER where medical personnel discovered her right hand was broken.
