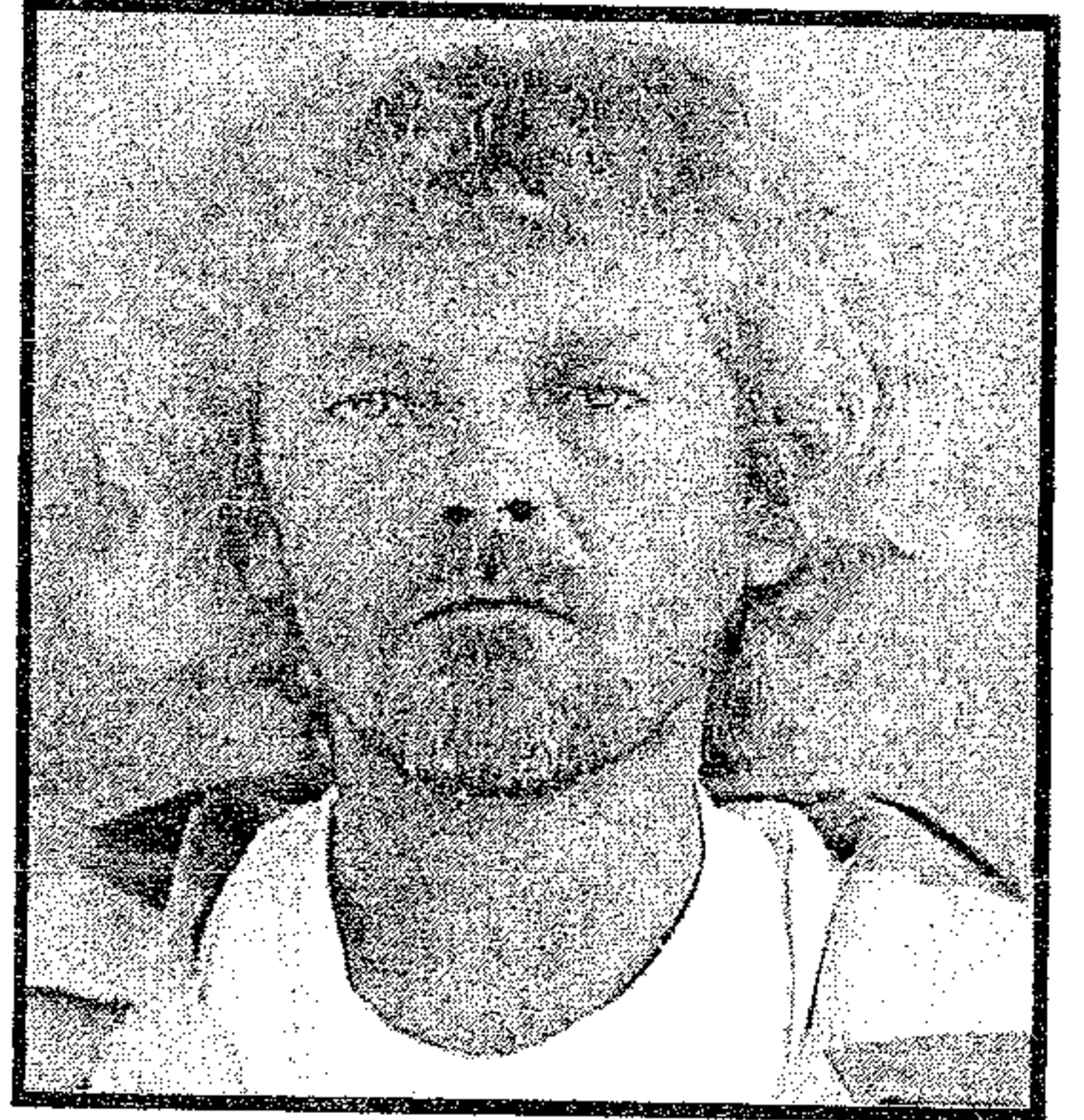
Man charged after hitting victim with pipe

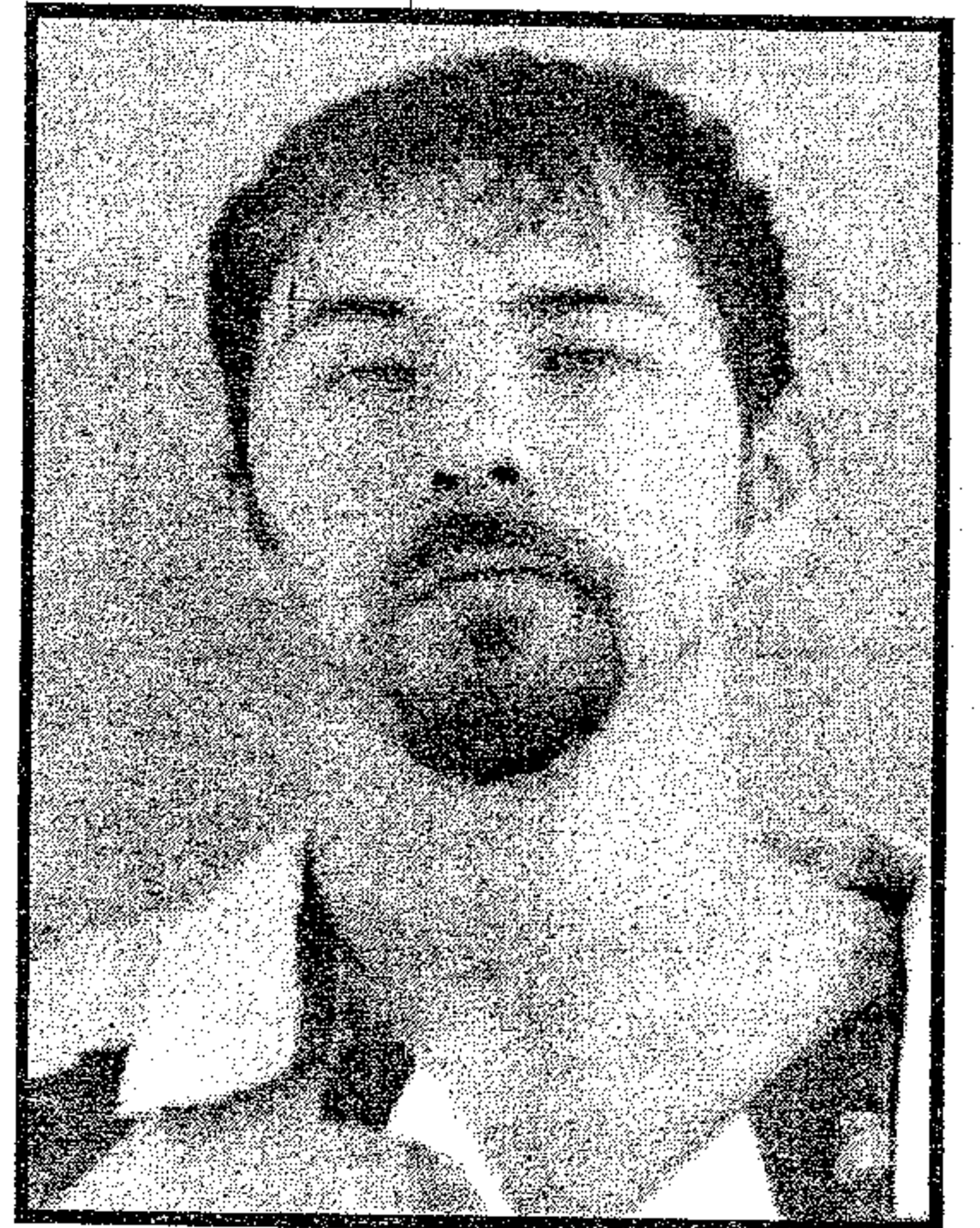
4th Revoked charge for Ldn man

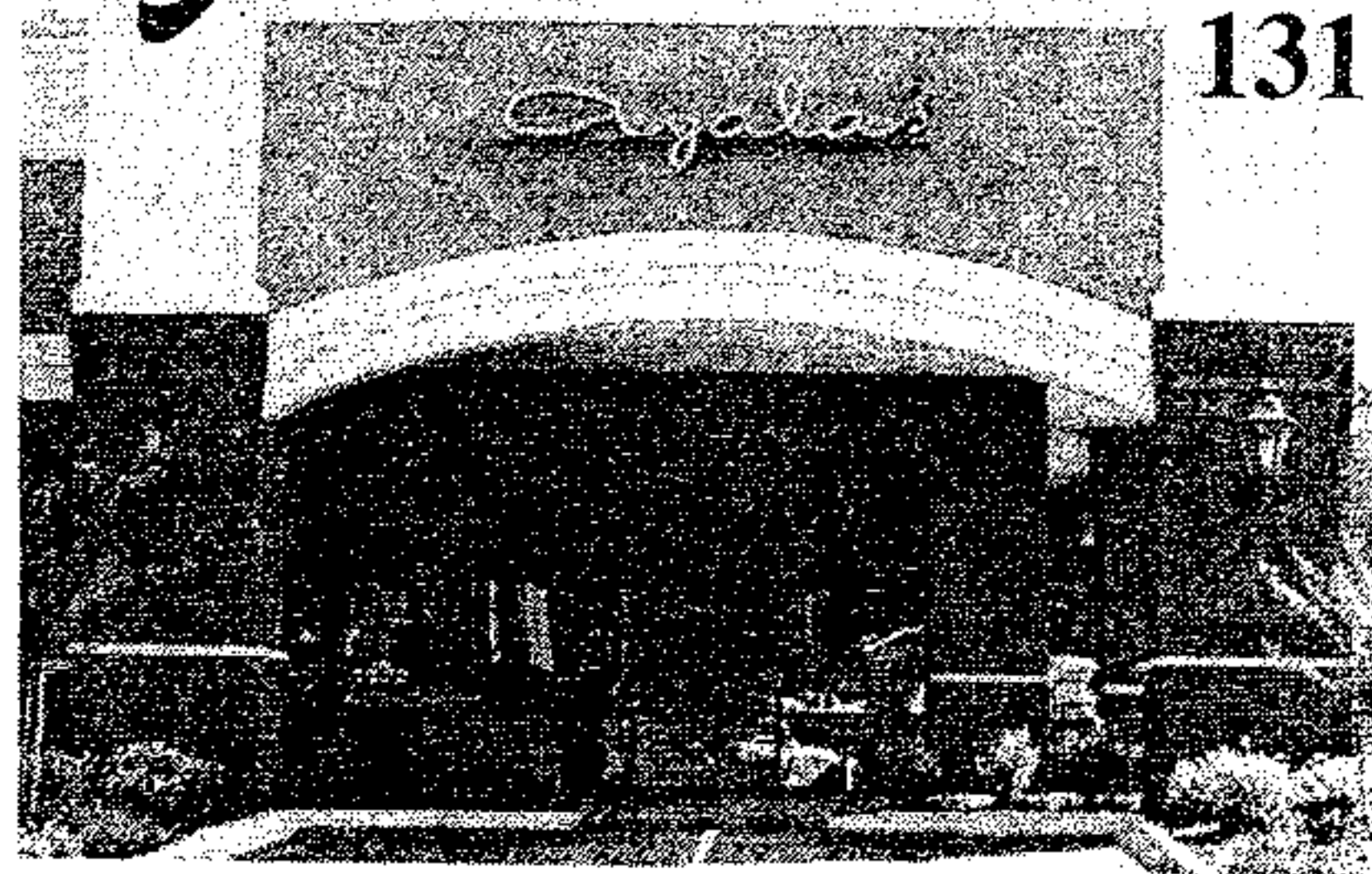

Officer Brad Parks, LPD, made the arrest Friday, at his residence.

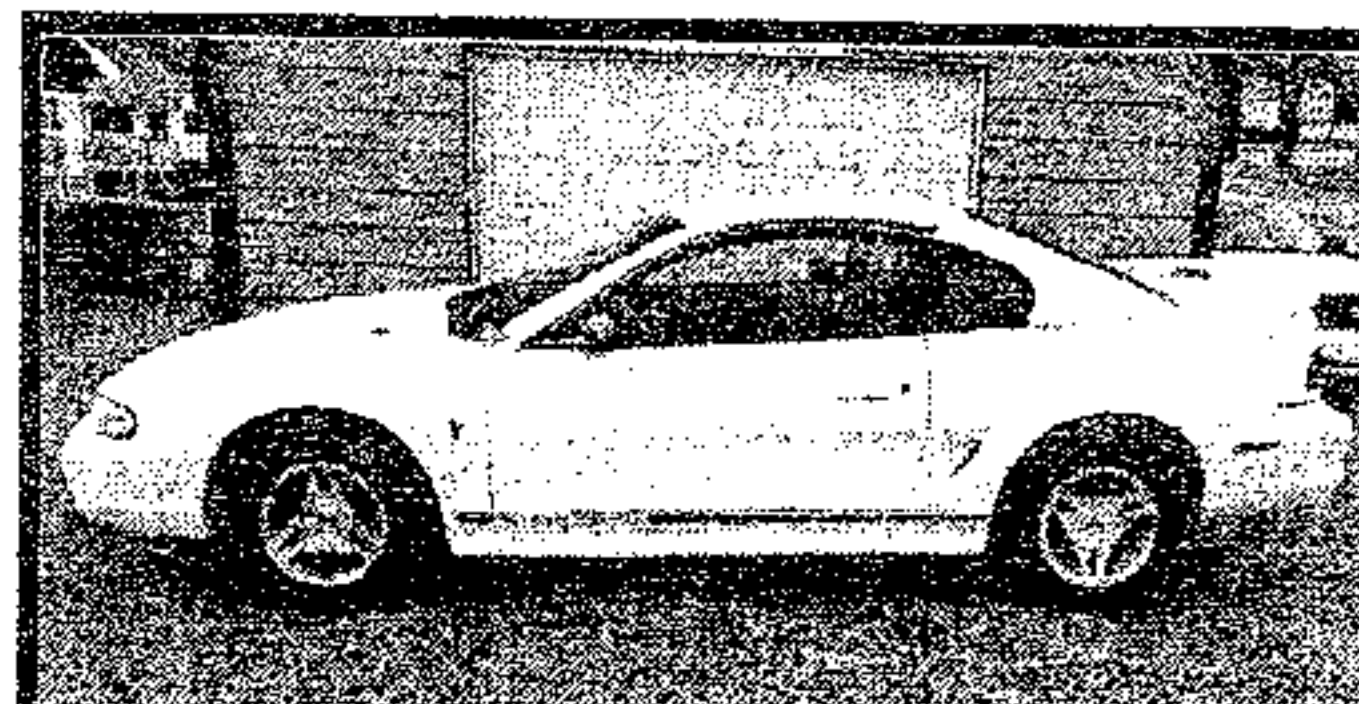
