Jeremy Dishner, LCPD, on March 25th, 2012, the victim was found playing on a scooter on US Highway 11, by Lt. Paul Curtis, LCSO. Lt. Curtis determined the child, who is less than 2 years old resides at a residence on West Broadway.

Officer Dishner spoke to the child's mother Michelle Hardy. Ms. Hardy stated the door had been left open for the dog to come and go. Ms. Hardy failed to adequately protect her son's health and welfare by her actions.

The child traveled approximately 80 feet from the front door to the roadway. At no time

did Ms. Hardy have any contact with her son until police advised her what had occurred.

On March 27th, 2012, Officer M. Hodges, LCPD, responded to the Hardy residence on West Broadway, attempting to serve an outstanding warrant on Michelle Hardy for child abuse/neglect.

Officer Dishner, LCPD, saw a female who he believed was Michelle Hardy, laying on the couch as he knocked on the door attempting to get someone to answer.

Officers spoke to Michelle Hardy's sister, Mallory Elizabeth Hardy. They asked Mallory if Michelle was at the

residence and Mallory told them several times, her sister was not there, she was in Knoxville. Mallory Hardy did eventually admit to officers her sister was in fact in the residence in a back bedroom.

Mallory Hardy was

arrested by Officer Mike Hodges, LCPD, and duly charged. Michelle Hardy was taken into custody on the outstanding warrant by Officer C. Dustin, LCPD.
