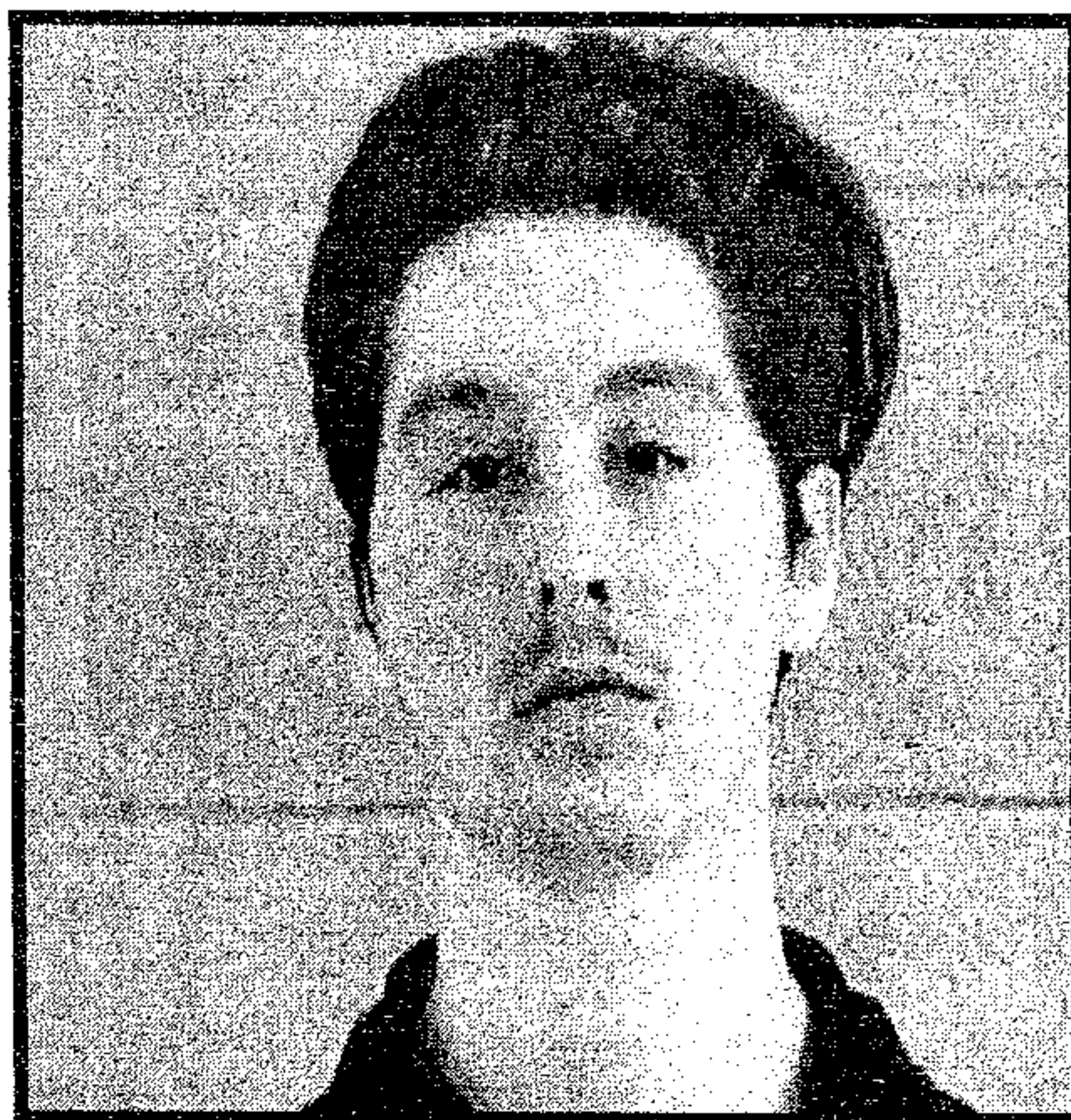

belongs to Corporal Pete McGinley of the Loudon County Sheriff's Office. Deputy Hamilton noted in his report as he talked with the man he seemed lethargic and had pin point pupils. He looked into the man's vehicle and noticed a plastic baggie containing clear crystals laying in the front passenger side floor board. When Investigator Marty Stanley, LCSO-ND, field tested the crystals in the baggie they tested positive for meth. Also Mr.

Doe/Hart's red Chevy Camaro had no tag and an open title. Doe/Hart was transported to the Loudon County Jail and duly charged.

Later that day, around 3:00 pm, Stephen Duane Hart, 'aka' John Doe, 30, Rock Creek, Stock Bridge, Georgia, was charged with tampering with evidence, introduction of drugs into a penal facility and possession of schedule IV.

According to the report, Corporal Angi M. Martin, LCSO, was attempting to remove

Stephen Hart who was an inmate at the Loudon County Jail, from Holding Cell 5 to finger print him on other charges, when she noticed Mr. Hart cupping something in his left hand. When asked what was in his hand Mr. Hart dropped his blanket and when he bent down to retrieve it he picked up what appeared to be a white pill and placed it in his mouth. Corporal Martin immediately pulled Mr. Hart out of the holding cell and ordered him to spit out what was in his mouth. Hart refused to comply and was taken to the floor and again ordered to spit out what was in his mouth. Mr. Hart still refused to comply

and made several swallowing motions. Hart was charged with tampering with evidence for swallowing a pill. He was removed from the floor and taken to the rest room to be strip searched by Deputy Carroll, LCSO, at which time Deputy Carroll retrieved a white round pill identified as a 2 mg clonazepam from Mr. Hart's left sock. When Hart first entered the Loudon County Jail he was asked if he had any contraband of any kind on his person and he said no.

of eight large bags of household garbage as well as a large cardboard box containing the same. Upon inves-

tigating the site Deputy Williams found two documents with Devin James Deerinwater's name and social security number inside one

of the bags. The documents appeared to be a print-out of Deerinwater's payroll stub from McDonald's Restaurant in Maryville. After sev-

eral attempts to contact him at his home address and place of employment, no contact was made. Deputy T.J. Scarbrough, LCSO, worked in the Greenback zone on February 2nd, 2012, and it was determined the litter was discarded sometime between the evening hours of February 2nd and the morning hours of February 3rd, 2012. 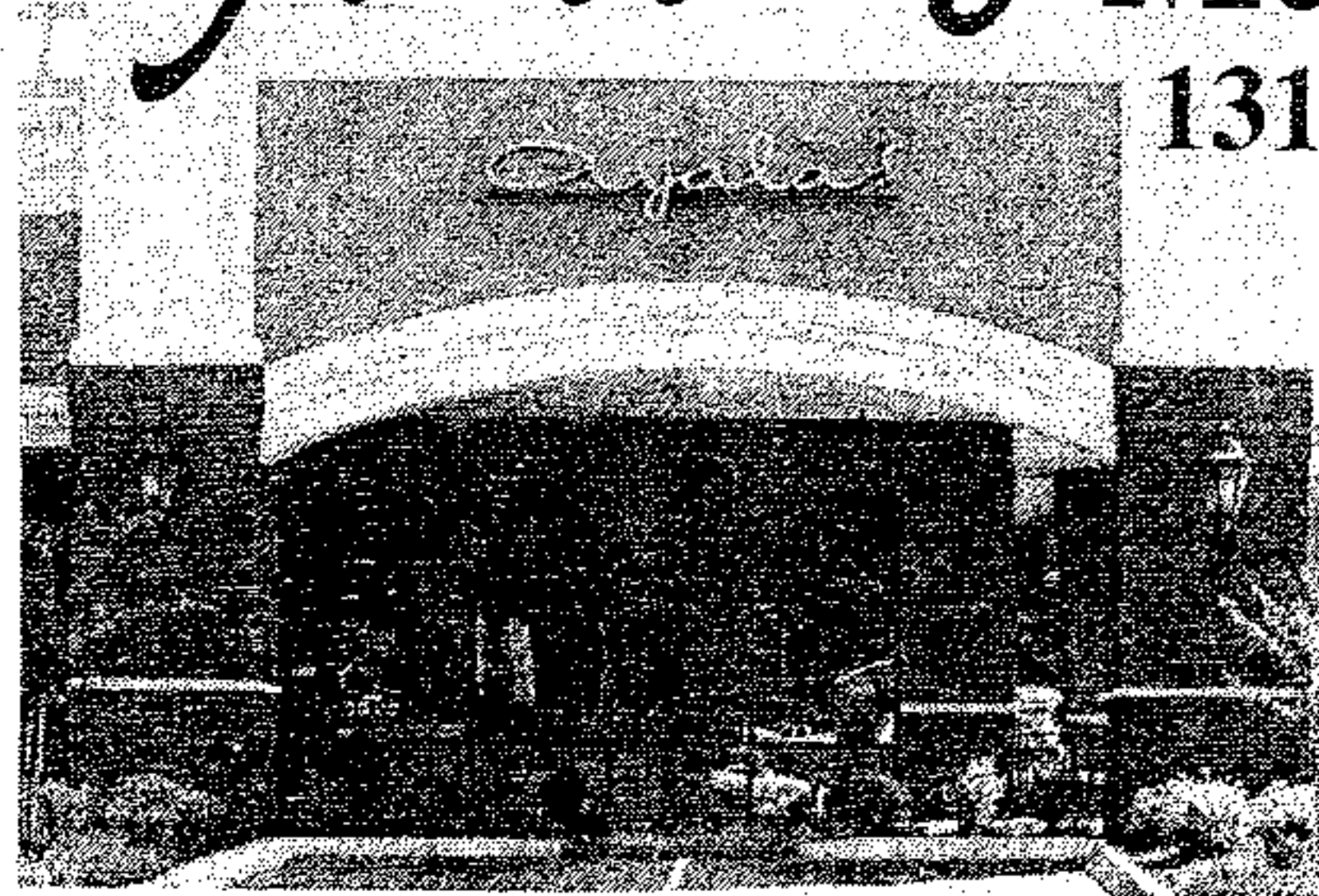

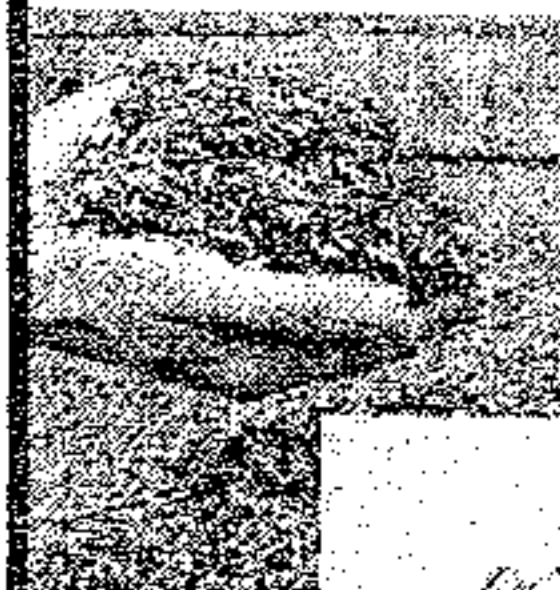

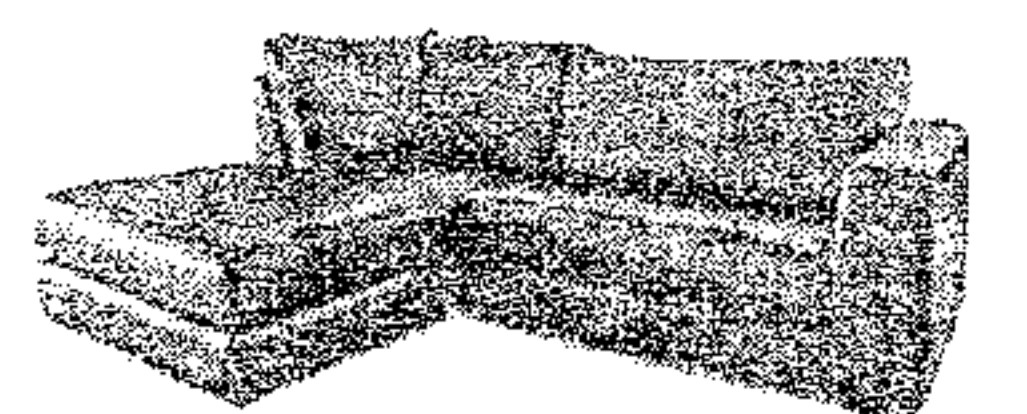
