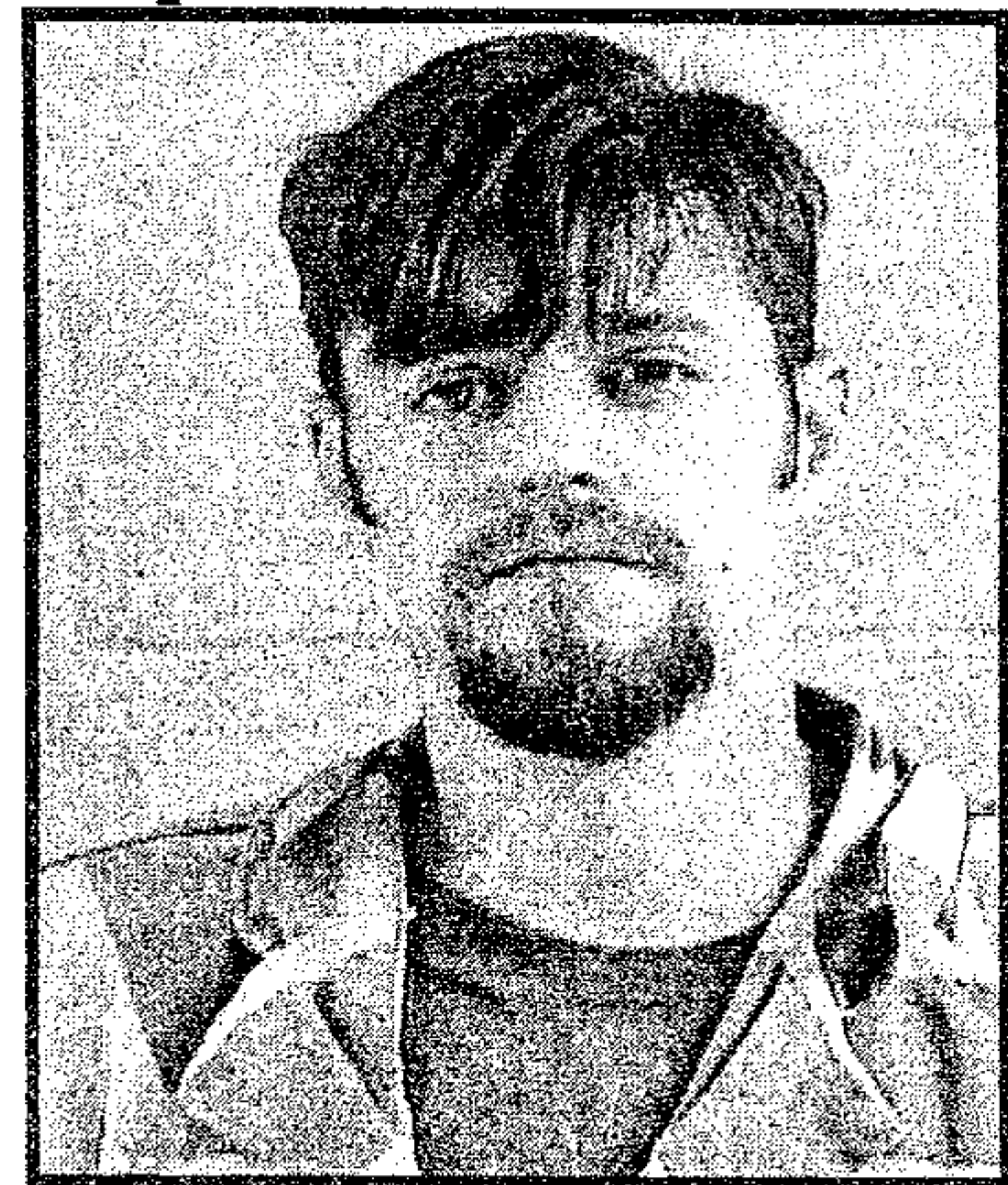
Man charged after going on shopping spree twice

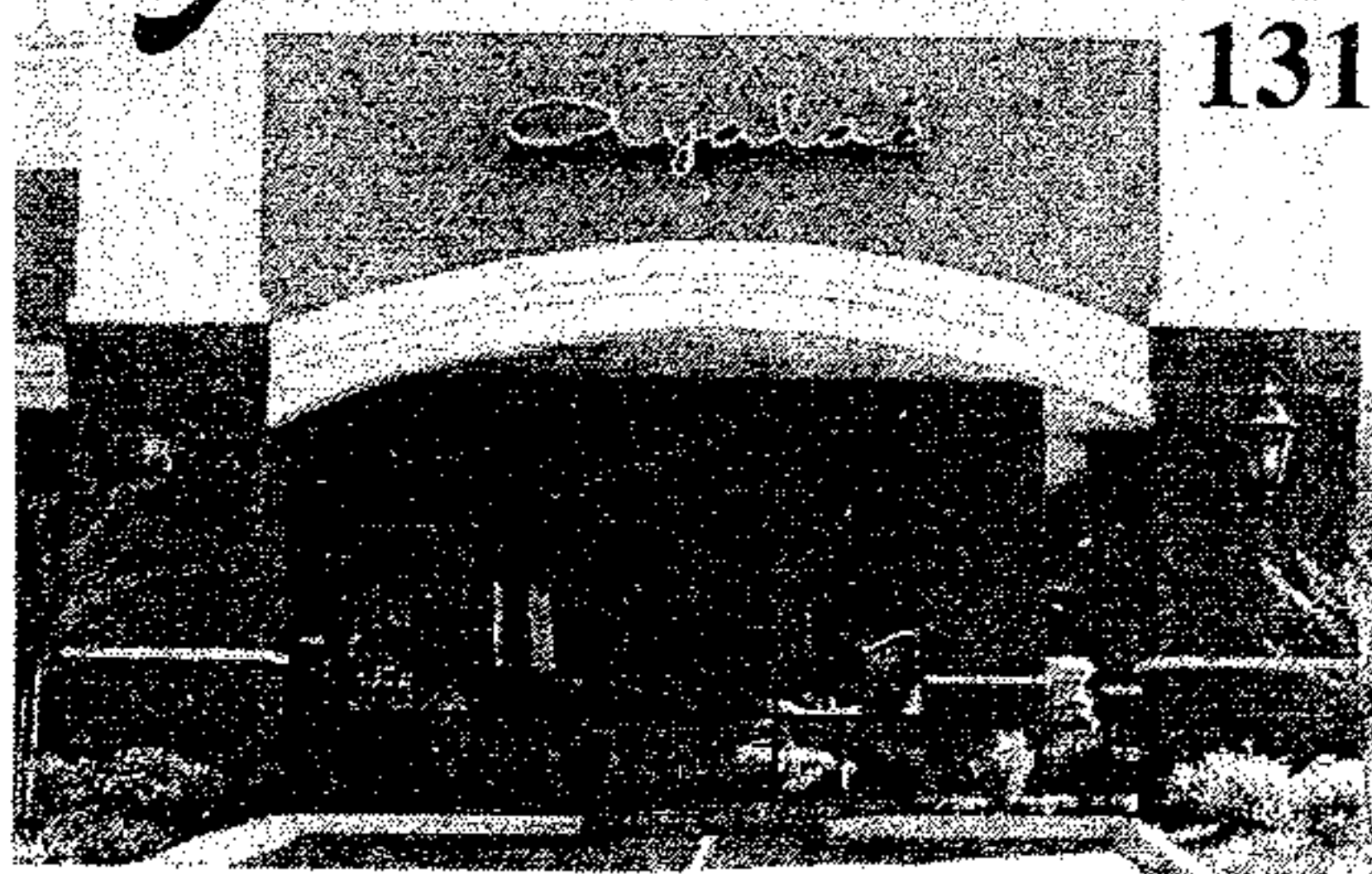
