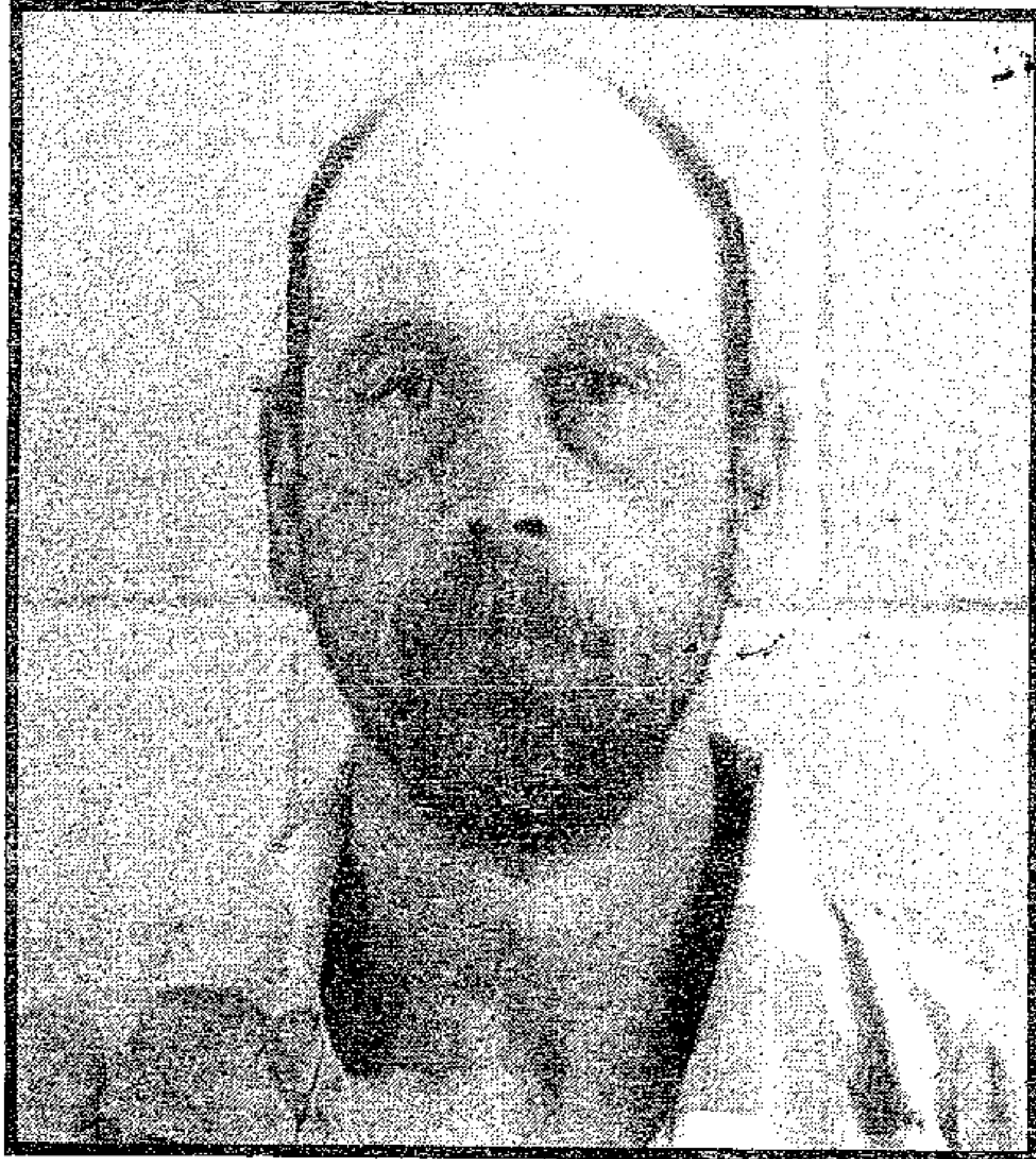


GB man scraps job for stolen metals

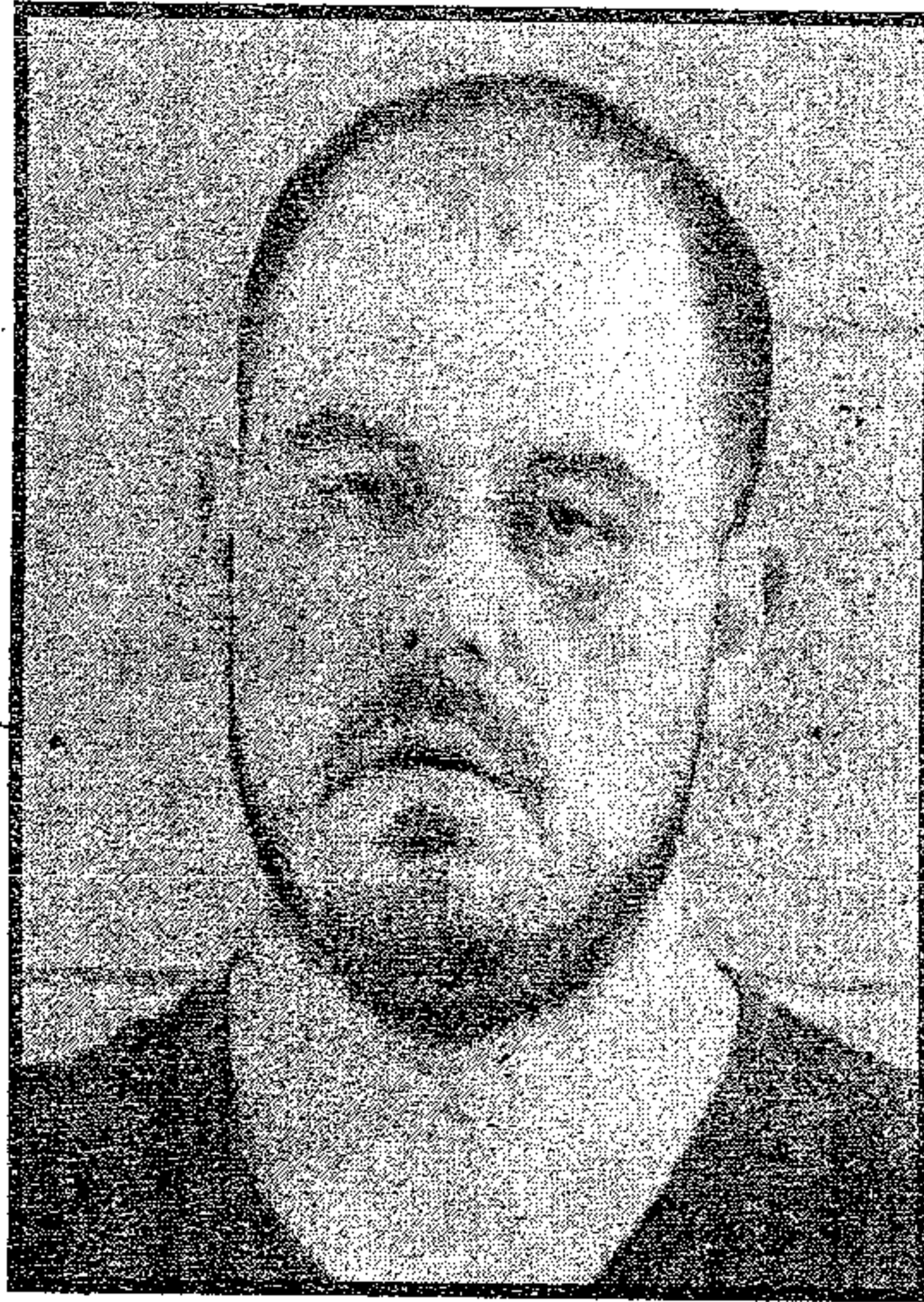

Trio leads police on high speed chase, racks up charges after theft call



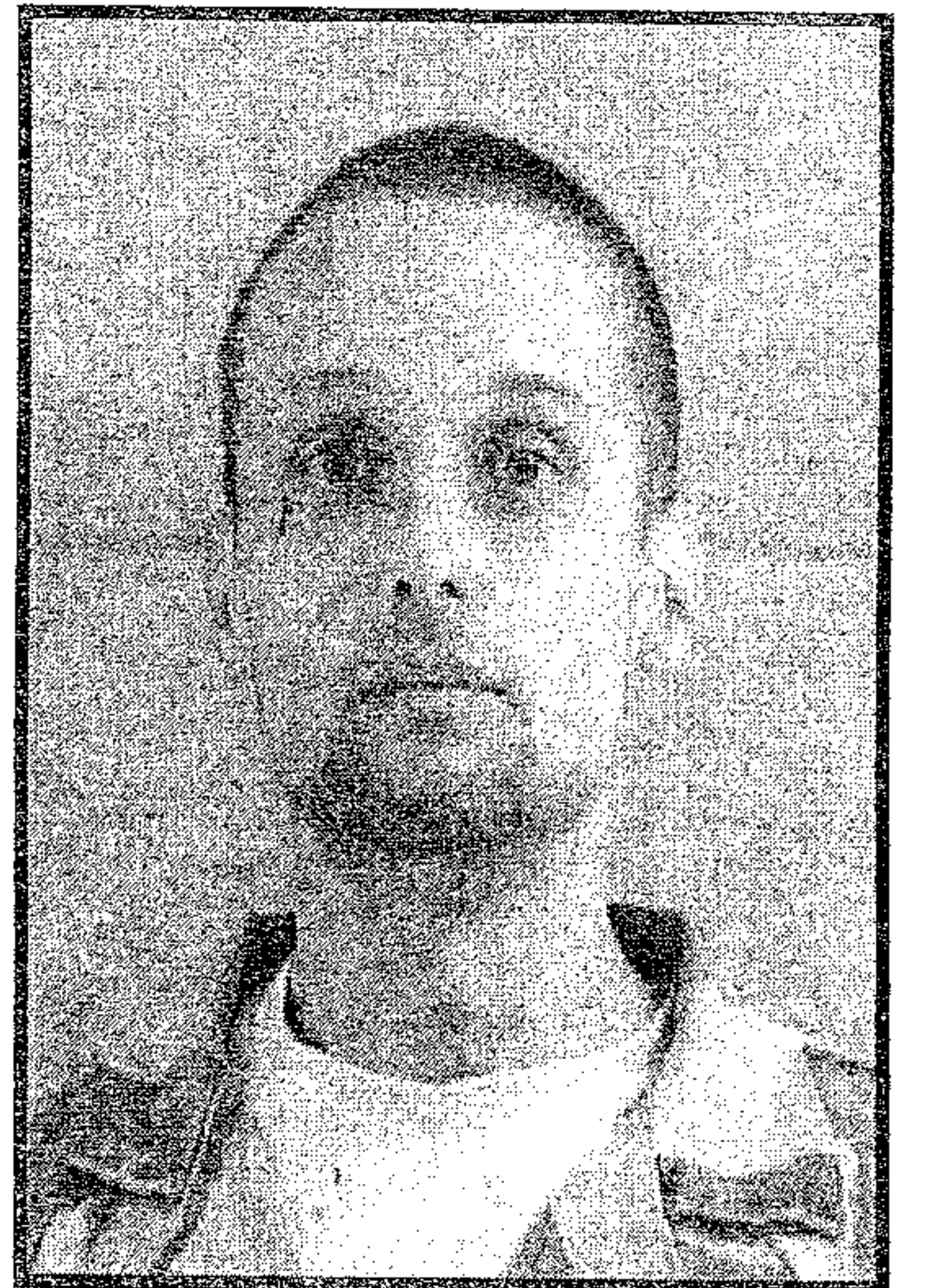

April Gail Moses, 31, County Road 279, Niota was charged with assault, possession of drug paraphernalia and resisting stop, frisk, halt, arrest or search.

Trevor Allen Coleman, 21, Spence Street, Athens was charged with resisting stop, frisk, halt, arrest or search and possession

of drug paraphernalia.

According to affidavits; on April 20, 2012, Officer B. Burley, LCPD was conducting an investigation at Walmart for theft of property. During the investigation Ricky Joe Gennoe fled the scene in a silver Pontiac Sunfire causing a vehicle pursuit for 20.7 miles.

Officer Burley, with lights and siren activated tried to stop Gennoe to no avail. During the pursuit Gennoe nearly struck multiple vehicles; including vehicles on Highway 321 north and Interstate

75 south. He drove at speeds in excess of 100 mph.

During the pursuit Gennoe swerved his vehicle to the left in an apparent attempt to ram a police vehicle. Police utilized spike strips to disable the vehicle,

thereby forcing Gennoe to eventually stop. Once the pursuit ended Officer Burley engaged Gennoe on a foot pursuit.

A check through dispatch revealed Ricky Gennoe's drivers license

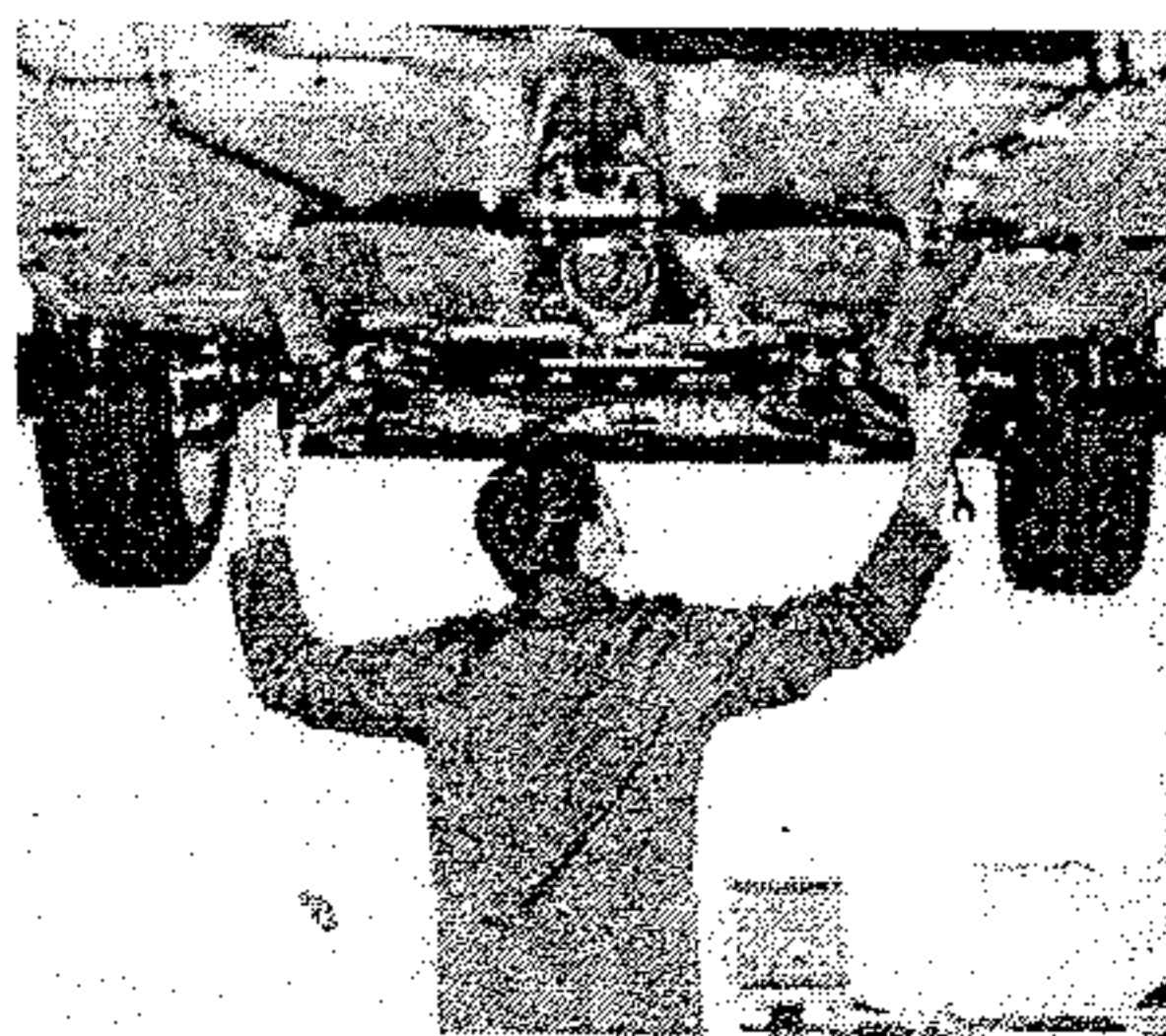

Chapel Road, Greenback was charged with three counts of theft over \$500 and three counts of theft under

\$500.

According to affidavits filed by Officer Samuel Harrison, LPD; between July 15, and August 2, 2011, Chris-

topher Randall Milsaps committed the act of theft at the Tate & Lyle facility located at 198 Blair Bend Drive in Loudon, where he

was employed. Without permission or consent, Milsaps took 906 pounds of scrap copper wiring out of the scrap metal dumpster belong to Tate & Lyle. He took the stolen copper to Davis Recycling in Vonnore on eleven separate dates and received a total of \$2396.

Between September 19, and September 30, 2011, Milsaps took approximately 241 pounds of scrap copper from a barge owned by Tate & Lyle. He sold the copper for \$536.50 on September 19, Sep-

tember 26, September 27 and September 30, 2011, at Davis Recycling.

Between September 8, and October 26, 2011, Milsaps took approximately 828 pounds of scrap copper wiring out of the scrap metal dumpster belonging to Tate & Lyle. He took the stolen copper to Davis Recycling on nine separate occasions and received a total of \$1978 for the scrap copper.

October 3, 2011, Milsaps took approximately 25 feet of green welding leads with disconnect belonging to Kelly Construction that were located at the tarpe-off work station east of the boiler house. He sold the leads to Davis Recycling for \$40.

On November 14, 2011, Milsaps took approximately 50 feet of black welding leads off of a welder located next to the germ press. After stripping the leads, Milsaps sold the copper for \$10 at Davis Recycling.

On January 18, 2012, Milsaps took approximately 170 pounds of copper from the breaker box located in the lay-down yard. He sold (see Unemployed ctd. pg. 7)

was suspended for failure to satisfy citations and there was no insurance on the vehicle nor the driver, Mr. Gennoe. Mr. Gennoe wrote a statement stating he was not the driver and further stated he told the driver to stop on many occasions.

During the course of the investigation at Walmart, Officer Burley made

contact with Trevor Coleman. After ordering Coleman to exit the vehicle Officer Burley conducted a pat down search on him. During the search Officer Burley ordered Coleman not to move while he was required to apprehend April Gail Moses, who was fleeing on foot.

Moses was running through the parking lot away from the business

and was ordered to stop by Lt. M. Tinnel, LCPD. Moses disobeyed the order to stop. Officer Burley was able to catch up to her and during the struggle to arrest her Officer Burley suffered two lacerations to his left arm and two marks to his left shin.

In the meantime Coleman disobeyed the stop order and willfully re-entered the vehicle. The vehicle then left the scene driven by Ricky Genoe, with Coleman as the passenger.

At the end of the pursuit Coleman also fled on foot.

An inventory search of the vehicle revealed multi-

ple items commonly used when taking narcotics including one pill crusher, multiple razor blades, drinking straws that had been cut and two spoons with burn marks on them. The items were located within reach of Gennoe, Coleman and Moses.

Several law enforcement officers were involved in the apprehension including those from LCPD as well as officials from LCSO.



The father had a large red abrasion on the left side of his face near his ear. Mr. Lynn further stated his son broke the house phone and the deputy reported he saw the telephone laying in the kitchen, broken into several pieces.

During the struggle Mr. Lynn advised he was afraid for his life and pulled a pistol out, but Joel attempted to take it from him. The

younger man turned the weapon towards himself and told his father to just shoot him.

There were no shots fired during the incident.

The struggle occurred in the presence of a 15 year old minor. Joel Lynn was taken into custody and transported to the Loudon County Jail.

On January 28, 2012, Milsaps took approximately 145 pounds of scrap copper wiring while cleaning out a barge belonging to Tate & Lyle. He sold the copper for \$193 at Davis Recycling.

On January 31, 2012, at approximately 3:57 PM, while on the secured property of Tate

& Lyle, Milsaps drove up to a welding generator in a 1995 blue Chevy pickup and took approximately 138 feet of black welding leads belonging to Tate & Lyle. Milsaps did so by cutting the leads off the generator and then cut a chain that was used to secure the leads to the generator. Milsaps did the cutting with a yellow set of bolt cutters, that also belonged to Tate & Lyle. He then placed the leads, bolt cutters and the cut chain with the lock still attached in the pickup.

Milsaps left the Tate & Lyle property, drove to Davis Recycling and sold the stolen leads as scrap for \$35.

Deputy Rondel M. Branam, LCSO served the warrants and made the arrest Monday at Milsaps's home.
