Woman charged with calling in false prescriptions and more

Daphine L. Webb, 32, West 6th Avenue, Lenoir City, was charged with prescription fraud x 5, identity theft and possession of schedule IV.

According to affidavits, filed by Investigator Jason Butler, LCPD-ND, on or about April 20th, 2012, Daphine Webb called in five fraudulent prescriptions for 90 alprazolam, 60 hydrocodone, 190 alprazolam, 120 hydrocodone and 90 hydrocodone tablets to

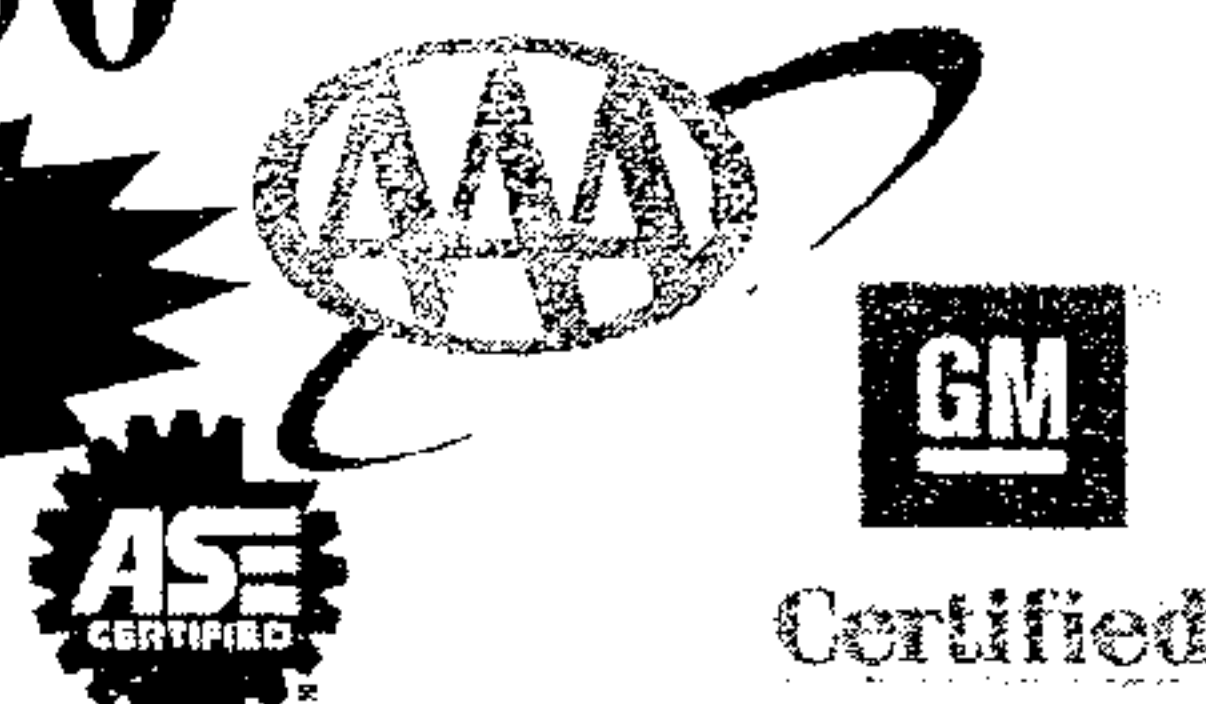

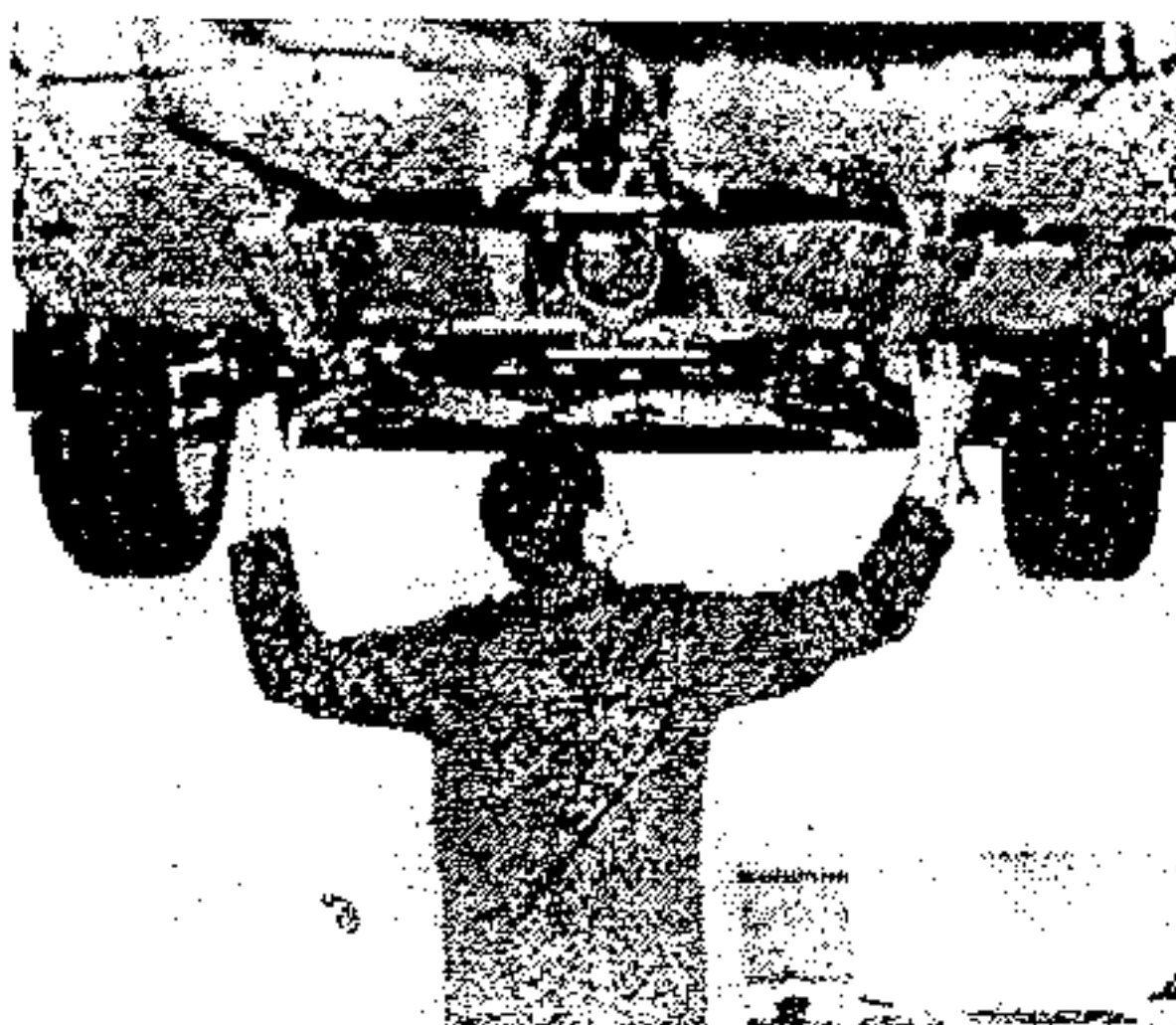

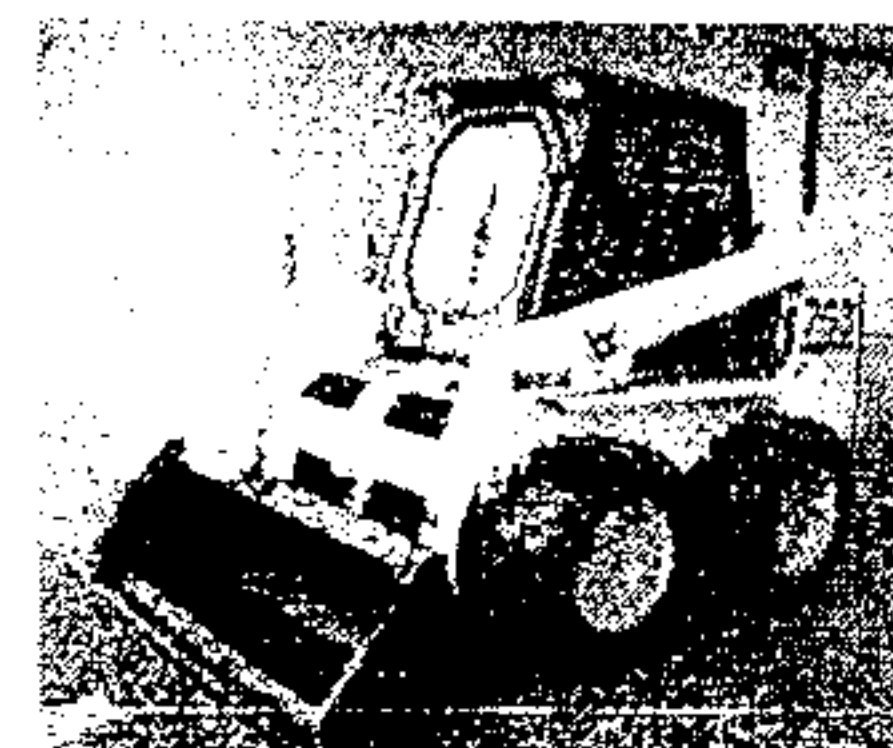

Andrew Monroe Pettry, 31, Elk Street, Gassaway, West Virginia, was charged with simple possession of marijuana.

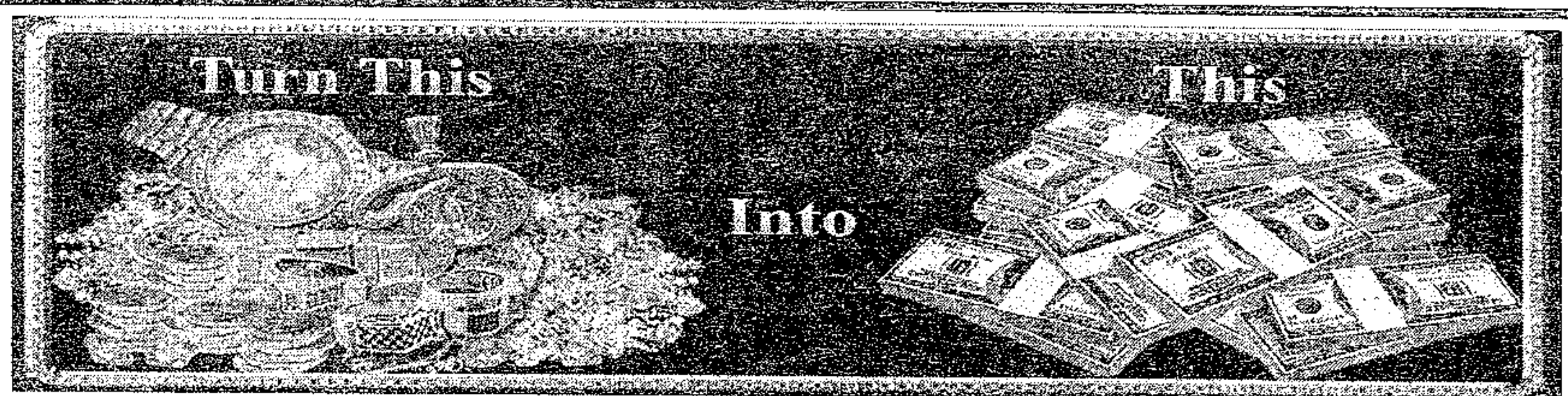
