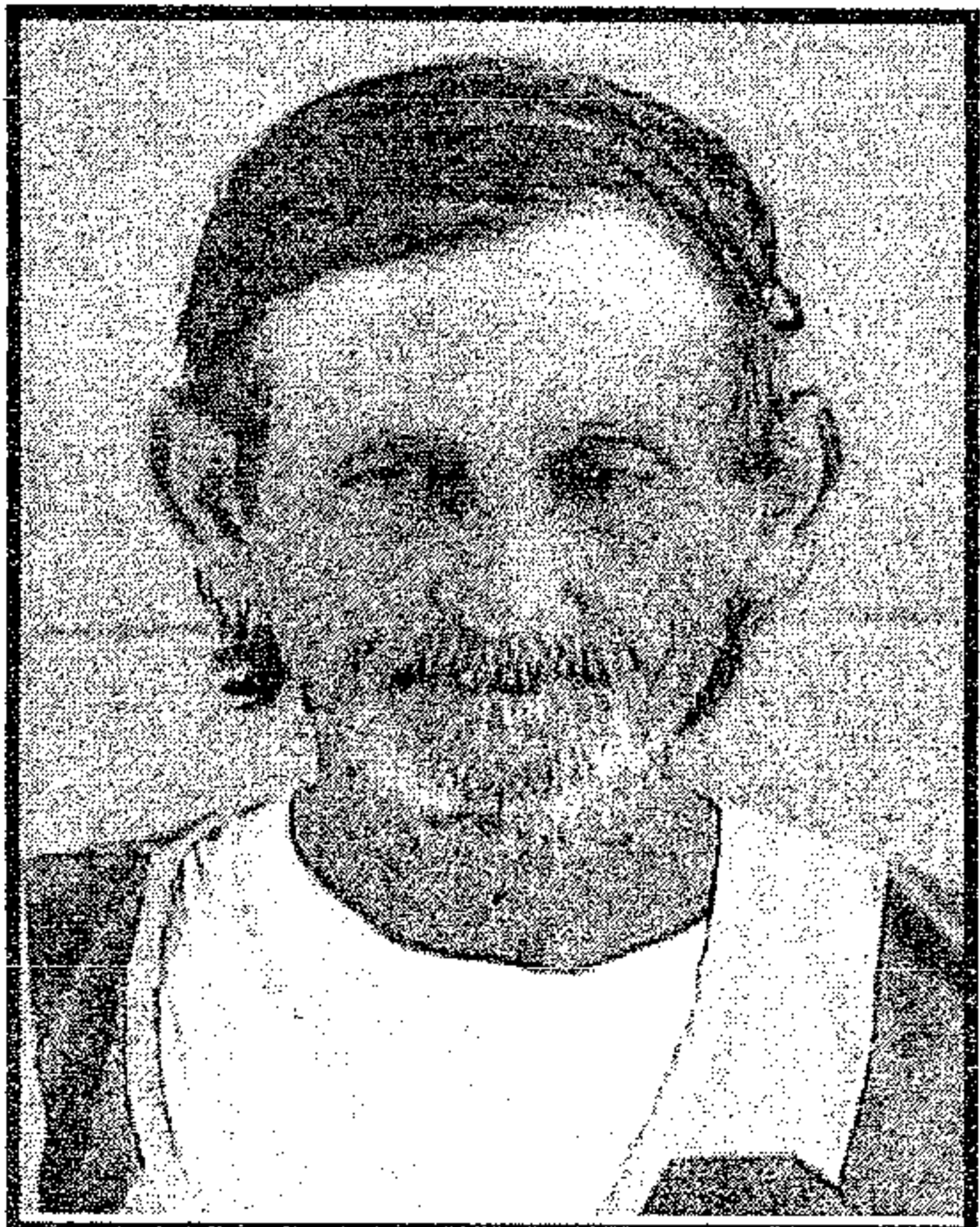

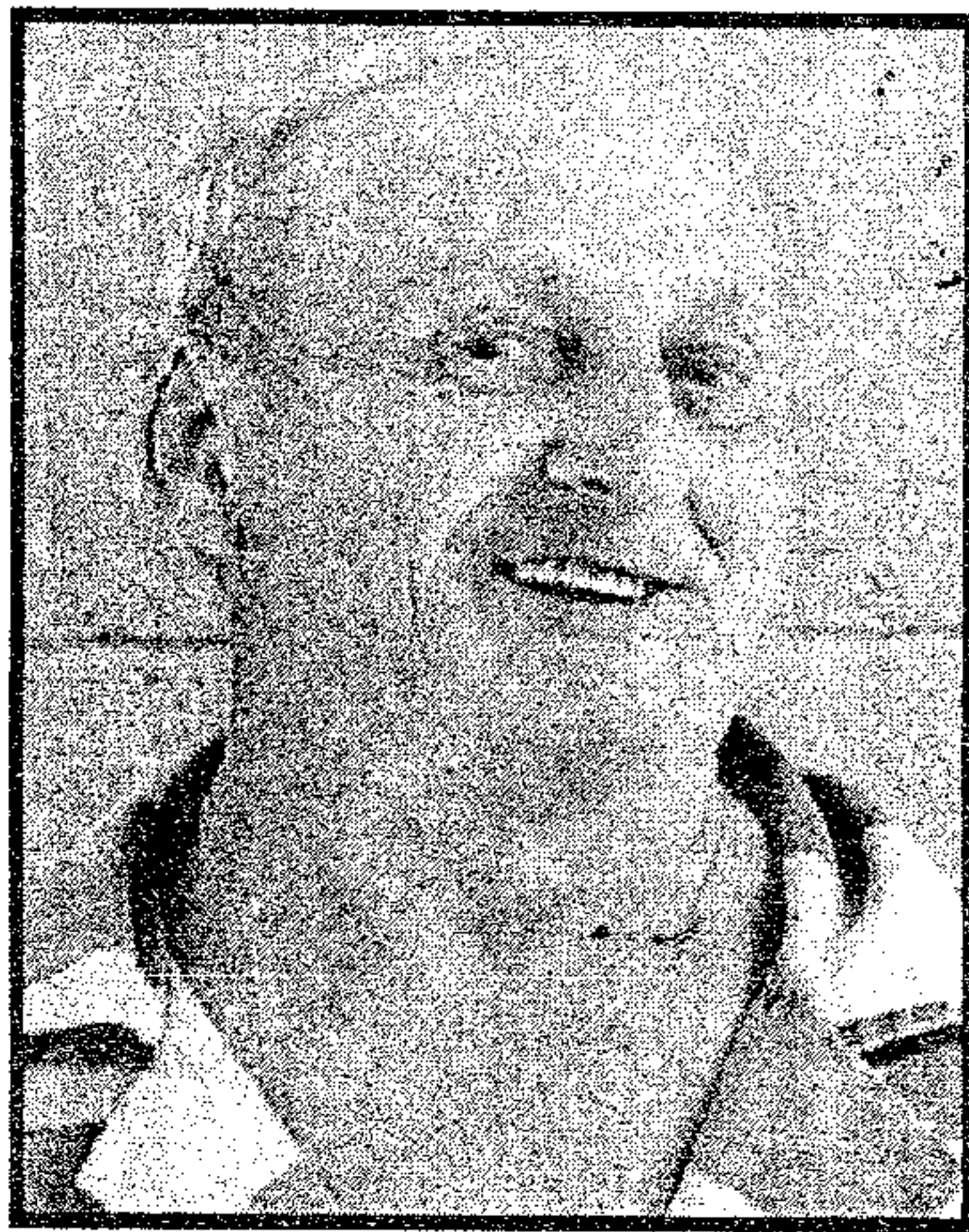

## TDOT Halts Interstate Construction for Easter Travel Holiday

NASHVILLE, Tenn. – The Tennessee Department of Transportation will suspend all interstate construction work this Easter weekend in anticipation of increased holiday travel.

TDOT crews and contractors will stop all road construction work that requires lane closures beginning Thursday, April 5 at 6:00 p.m. through Monday, April 9 at 6:00 a.m. This will provide maximum roadway capacity to motorists

expected to travel across the state this holiday weekend.

“Suspending interstate construction in Tennessee during the Easter holiday will permit a free flow of traffic,” said TDOT Commissioner John Schroer. “This should lessen travel interruptions for the many motorists traveling on our roadways to spend time with their families this holiday weekend.”

Motorists will still encounter some long term lane clo-

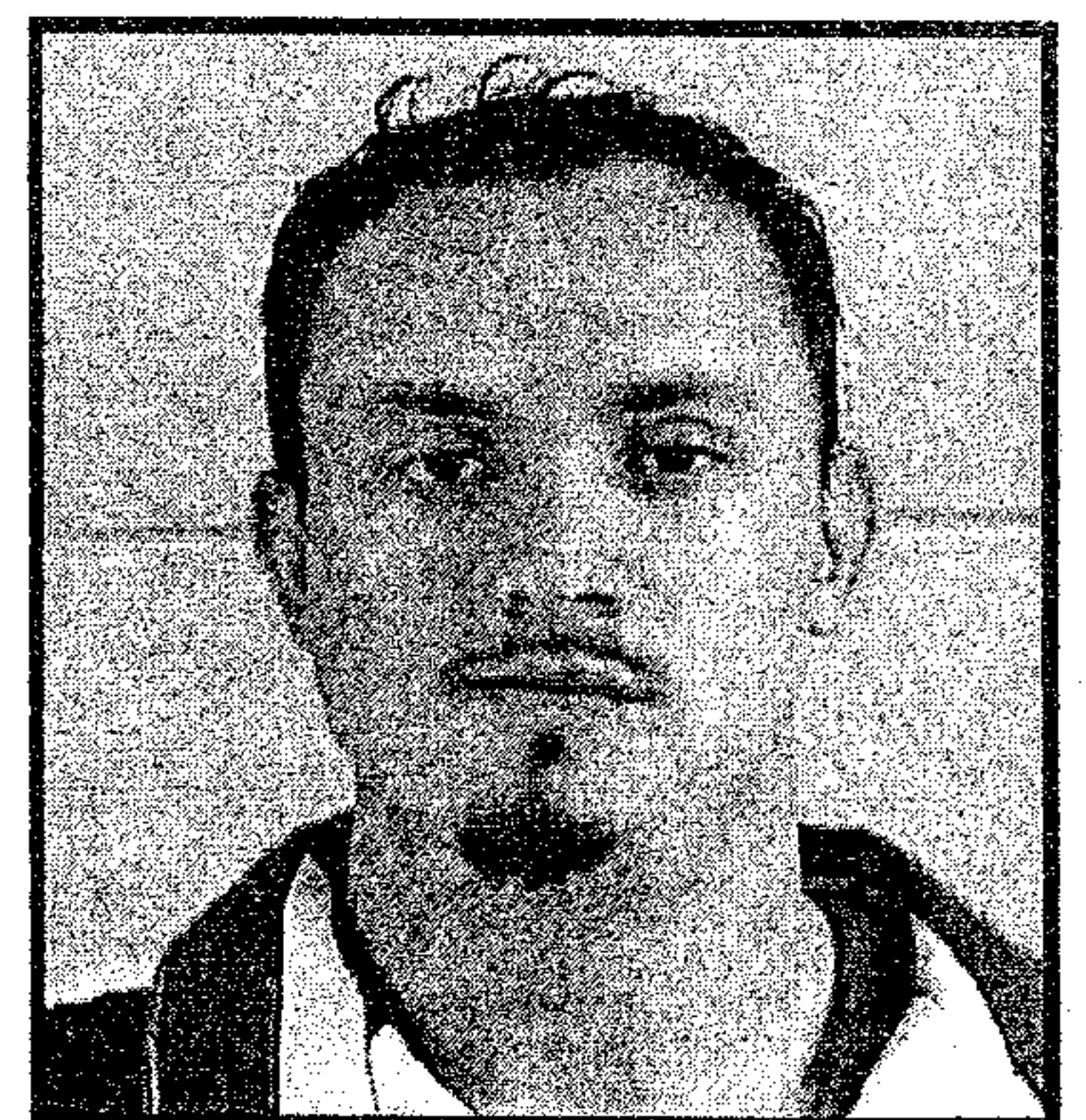

He was advised he was under arrest and when asked to place his hands behind his back he started to resist deputies efforts to take him into custody. A struggle went from the porch to the hood of a vehicle in the driveway and Johnny kept resisting and several empty hands tactics were used due to his heart condition. He was later cuffed and transported to the Loudon County Jail.

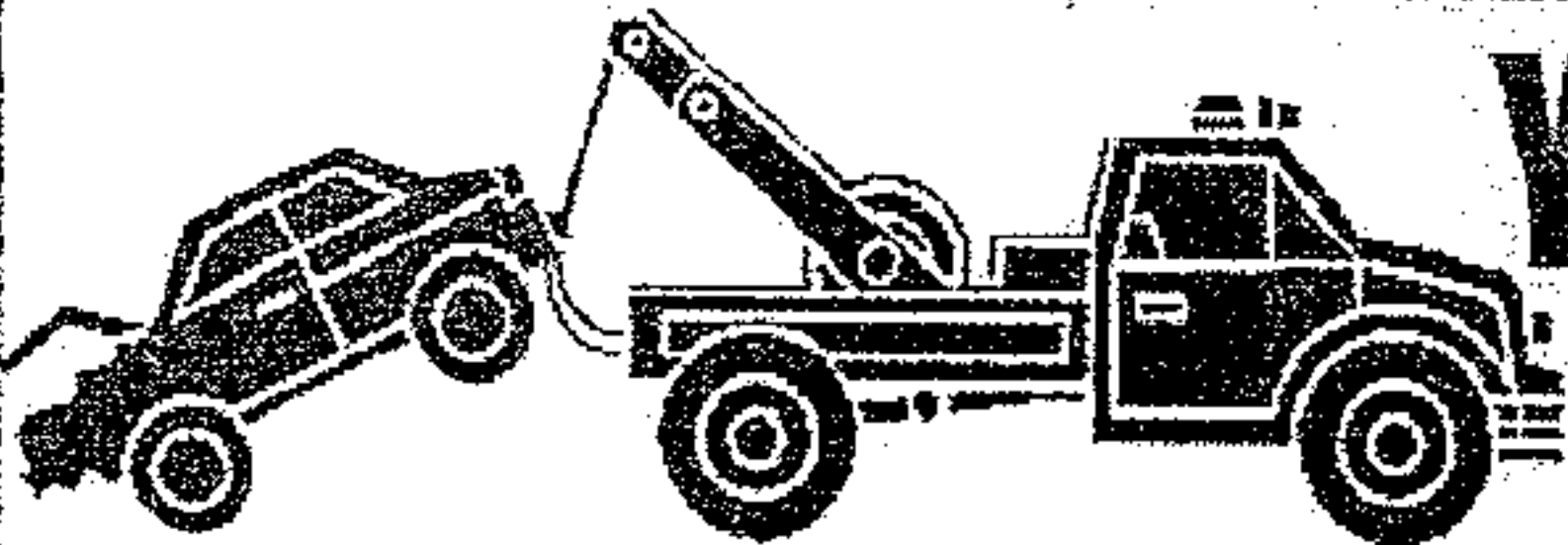

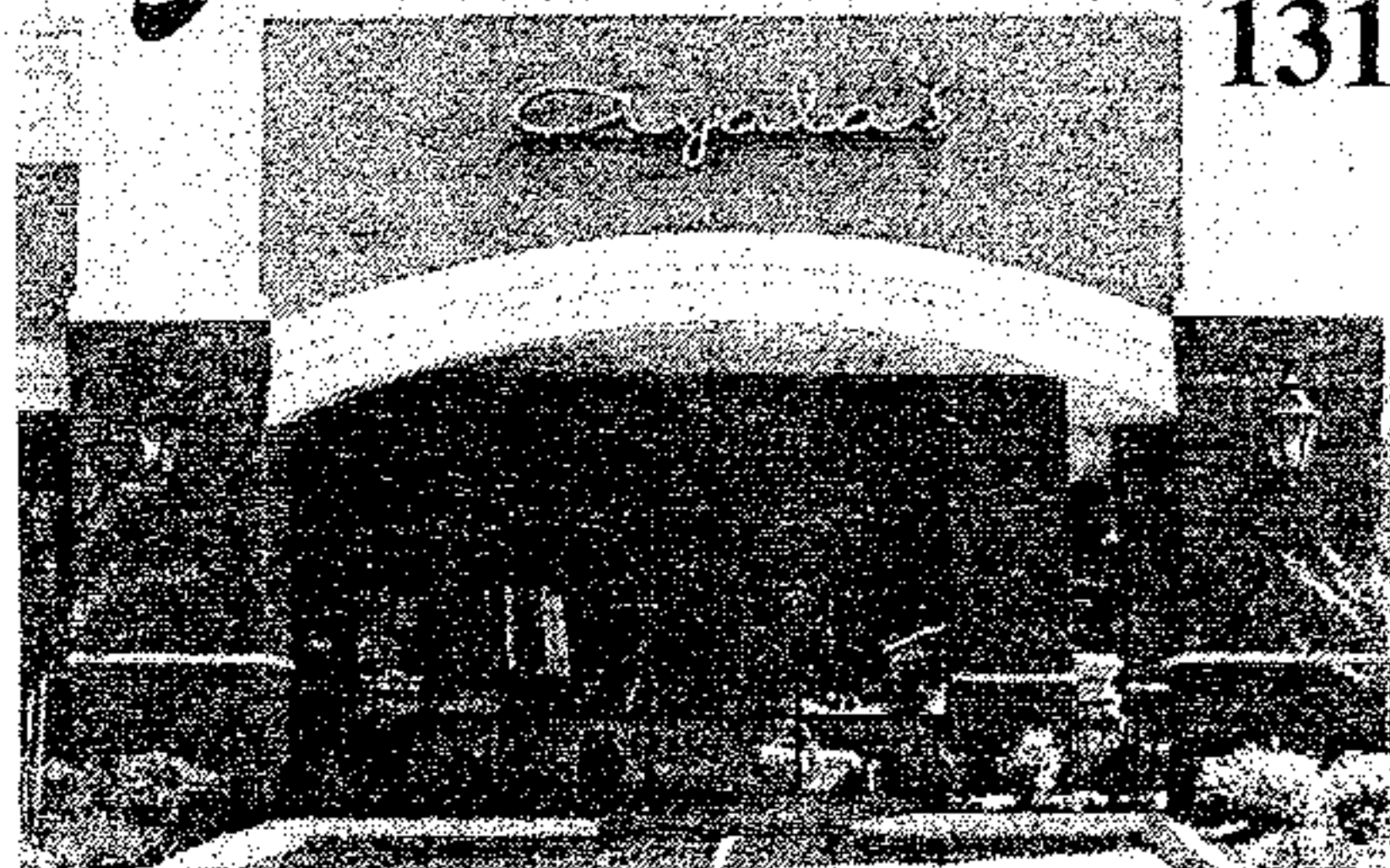

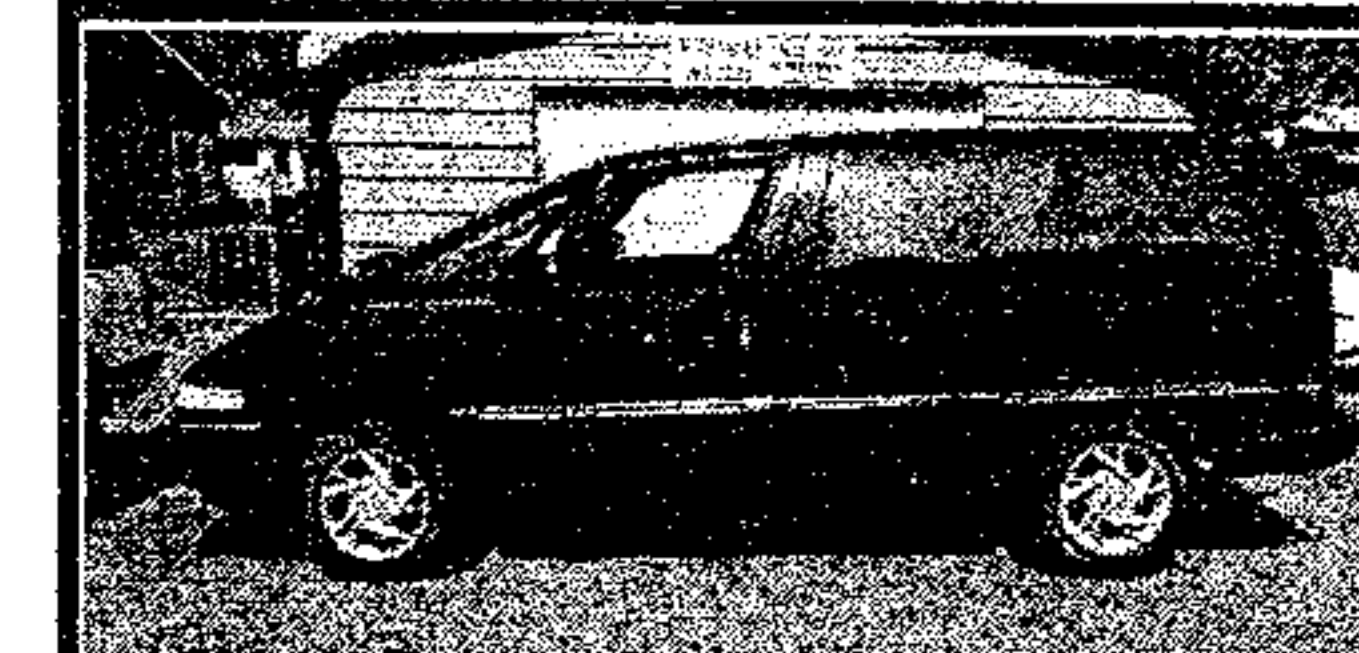
