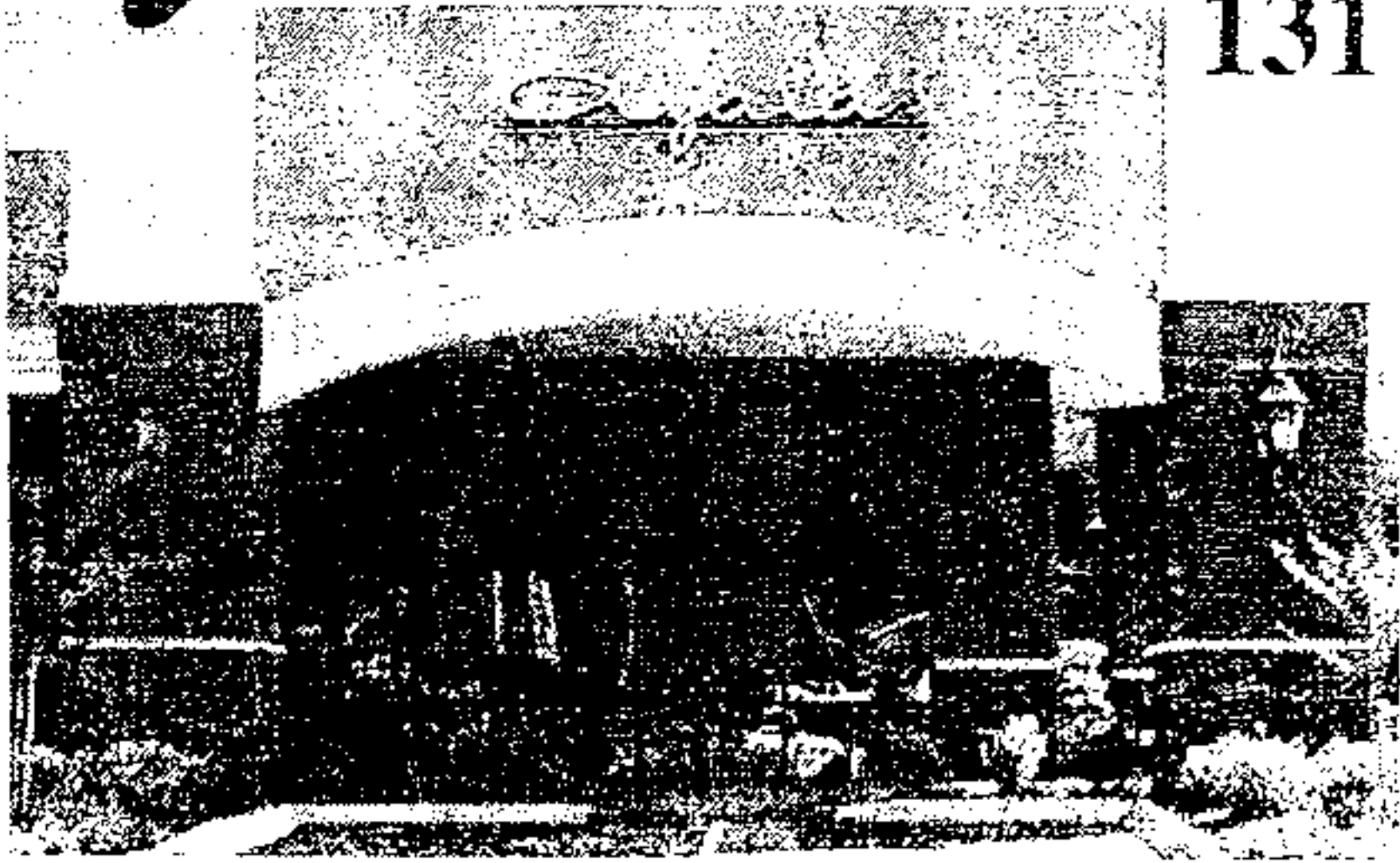

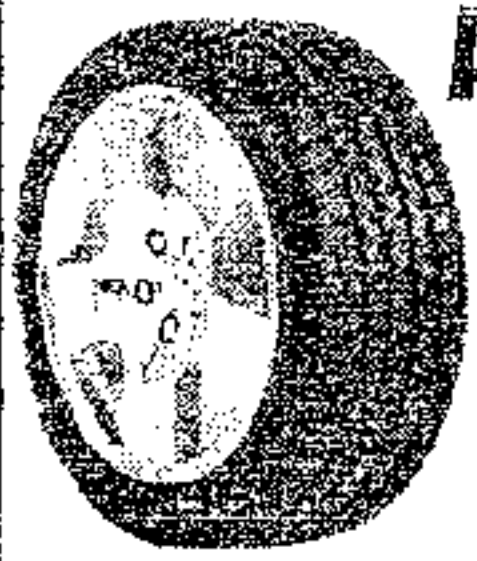

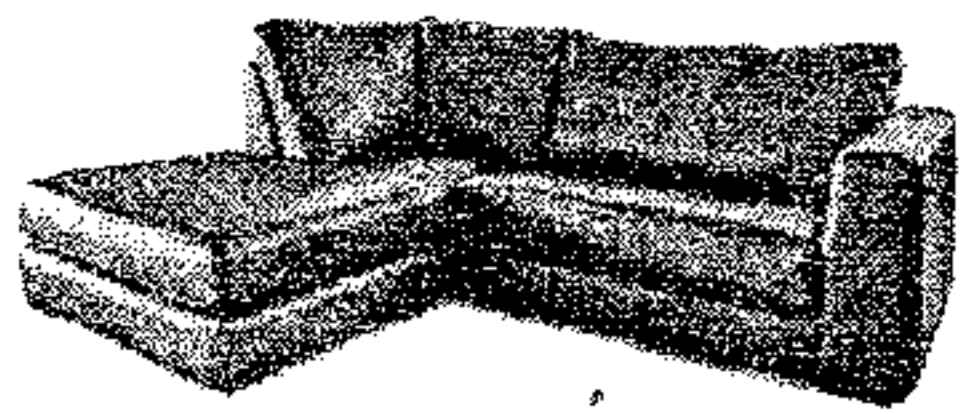

Police beat

Jaime Ochoa-De Leon, 35, Raccoon Valley Road, Powell, was charged with DUI and driving without a license.

According to records, Sunday, around 2:00 am, Officer Emily Lawson, LCPD, responded to Highway 321 southbound in reference to a reckless driver. The complainant, an off duty Lenoir City Fire Department fireman, was behind the red Ford Explorer. The fireman stayed on

the line reporting how the Explorer was driving. It reportedly ran through at least two red lights and was traveling at approximately 60 mph in a 40 mph zone and left it's lane of travel numerous times. Officer Lawson had visual contact with the vehicles as she crossed the Fort Loudon Dam. She fell in behind the Explorer, and began observing near Allen Shores Drive. The vehicle traveled out of it's lane several times and entered the grass of the median once. The officer initiated a traffic stop with her emergency equipment

and the driver was slow to respond and continued driving in the left lane for an excessive distance before finally coming to a stop in a paved crossover. The driver, identified as Jaime Ochoa-De Leon, had a strong smell of an alcoholic beverage on his breath and person, glassy bloodshot eyes and slurred speech. Mr. De-Leon advised he didn't have a drivers license and admitted to drinking alcoholic beverages at a party. He performed poorly on field sobriety tasks and was taken into custody and read the implied consent advisement which he consented to. A blood draw was performed at Fort Loudon ER before being transported to the jail.

Cano, 32, West Broadway, Lenoir City, was charged Sunday, with driving without a license.

According to reports, Deputy Cody Fritts, LCSO, noticed a silver Sport Track Explorer cross the center line and shoulder several times, then tried to pass a small car and swerved at the car before passing it. Deputy Fritts stopped the vehicle on Highway 11 at Ford Road and identified the driver as Jose Cano. He had bloodshot eyes and an odor of an alcoholic beverage on his person. The lawman was unable to perform field sobriety on Mr. Cano because he couldn't understand english. He was found to be driving without a license and was transported to the Loudon County Jail.
