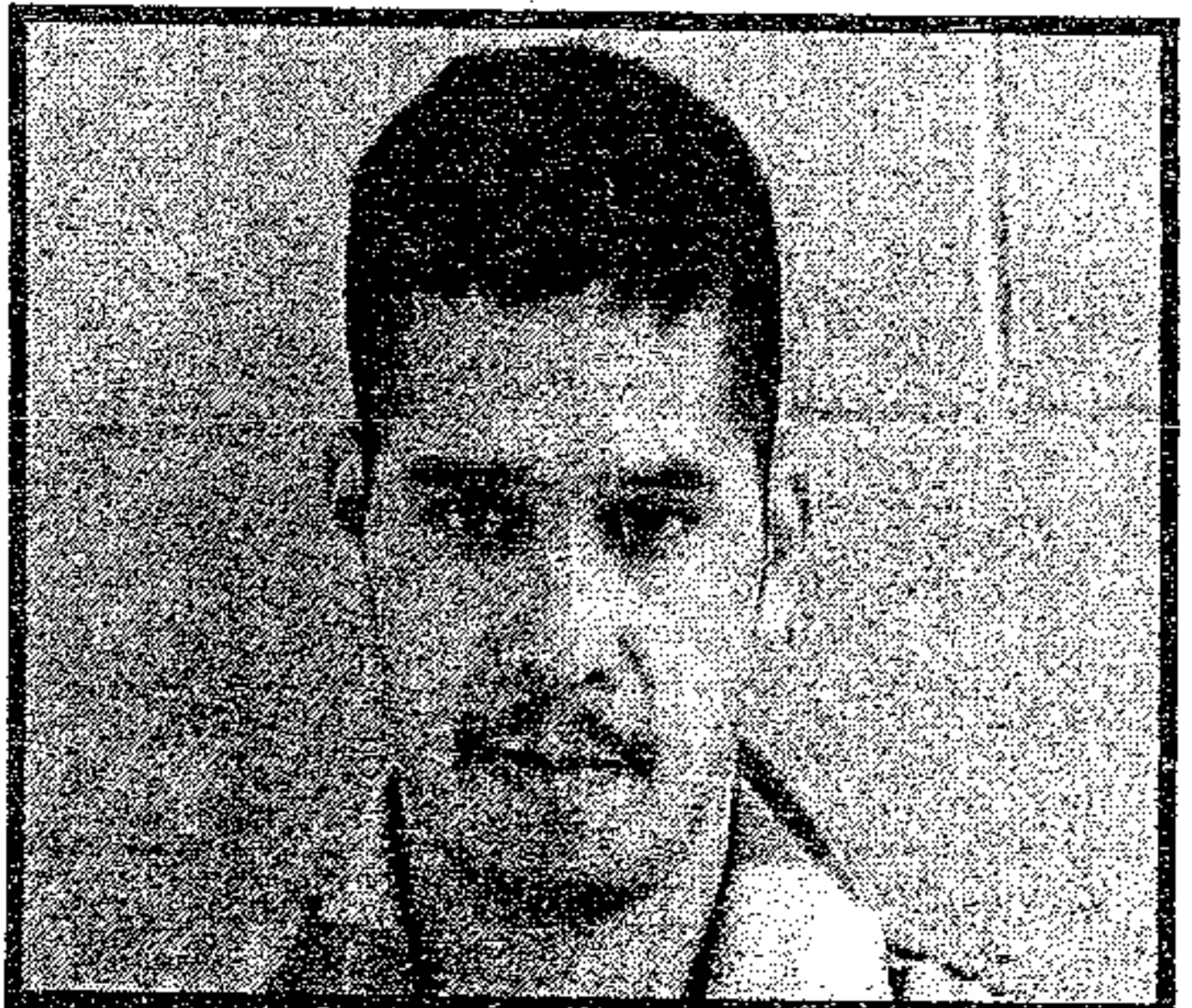

Among the changes, Tennessee sportsmen will see an increase in deer and bear harvest opportunities.

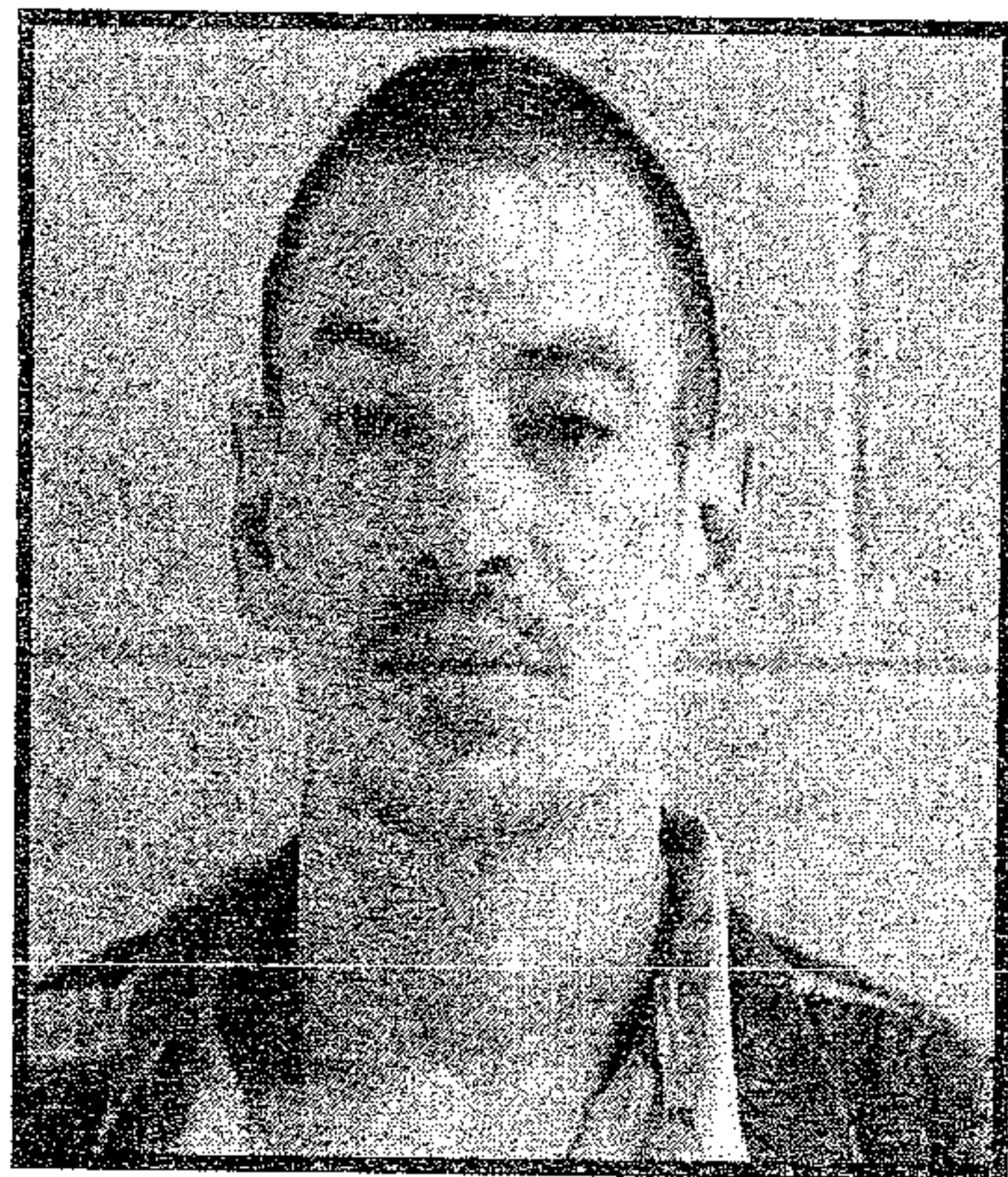
## Grown man accused of assailing mother over housework

According to affidavits; Trooper John R. Carr, THP was patrolling on Browder Hollow Road around 6:10 AM, when he saw a

Juarez was located inside the house, hiding in a bedroom and was taken into custody. At that time, Trooper Carr also learned Juarez didn't have a drivers license.

Juarez was placed under arrest and transported to the Loudon County Jail.

According to reports, Deputy Rondel M. Branam, LCSO responded to a possible physical domestic fight on Steekee Road and the victim stated he and his fiance, Jennifer L. Barsuglia, got into a verbal argument in the kitchen. She was feeding their child ravioli and the child spilled some of her food. Jennifer got mad at the child and began to yell at her, so the victim picked up the child and told Ms. Barsuglia to calm down. He then stated Jennifer got in his face and told him to move or she would hit him with the ravioli bowl.

He said "so" and at that time Ms. Barsuglia

struck him in the face with the bowl of ravioli and the palm of her hand, causing a small laceration and bleeding from his bottom lip around his gum line.

The victim told, Barsuglia he was calling the police and she left the residence in a purple Scion TC. Deputy Brian Smith, LCSO stopped the vehicle in the parking lot of Corinth Baptist Church and identified the driver as Jennifer Barsuglia.

Barsuglia told a similar story as the victim, except she said he told her to hit him in the face, which she admitted to doing. She further stated she didn't mean to do any harm to her fiance when she struck him.

Ms. Barsuglia was found to be the primary aggressor and was taken into custody at the scene.

son, Morgan, and Scott counties.

The TWRC voted to allow the gun season for white-tailed deer to

extend through the first full weekend in January, which next year will conclude Jan. 6. The second young sportsman hunt will be held the weekend

of Jan. 12-13 in 2013.

A limited season for red deer was initiated in Claiborne County last year and the TWRC approved the recommenda-

tion to have the season run concurrent with the 2012-13 white-tailed deer season. The area is south of the Powell River in Claiborne County.

Bear hunting days, with dogs permitted, will increase on three separate hunts with the increase varying 10 to 12 days, depending on the particular county. Also, there will be an increase of the bear dog training season by 4 to 14 days, also depending on the county. The state is coming off a record bear harvest from last winter and surveys indicate the population is thriving, allowing the agency to increase the number of bear hunting opportunities.

During fall turkey season, archers will be given an opportunity to harvest the full county bag limit in the counties that are open. The fall turkey counties will be expanded to include Cumberland, Grundy, Hamilton, Madison, Putnam, Sequatchie, and Van Buren counties as well as increase bag limits in many East Tennessee counties. Fall turkey bag limits will be reduced in three southern Middle Tennessee counties which are Giles, Lawrence and Wayne.

The statewide quail season will be extended through the end of February. On certain Wildlife Management Areas (WMAs), the dates

could vary.

A raccoon hunting season from Jan. 1-31 was approved for the Tellico and Ocoee bear reserves. There will be a limit of two dogs per vehicle. For falconry, an additional month was added for falconers to acquire birds.

In other agenda items at the May meeting, landowners with larger acreages (properties in excess of 1,000 acres), who receive a wild hog exemption can now provide additional signees to help with their wild hog control efforts. Up to one additional person will be allowed for every 100 acres over 1,000.

A wild hog control season (with dogs) was added on Catoosa and Skinner Mountain WMAs.

A rule amendment changes the resident commercial fishing helper license to a commercial fishing helper license, which would include both residents and non-residents. The non-resident commercial fishing helper license, as a result, is now deleted in its entirety.

The commission passed a rule which will give the agency leeway to work with those persons who have permanent duck blinds in the West Sandy waterfowl area. Located on Kentucky Reservoir in Henry County, the area will be affected by unavoidable (see Seasons etd. pg. 6)

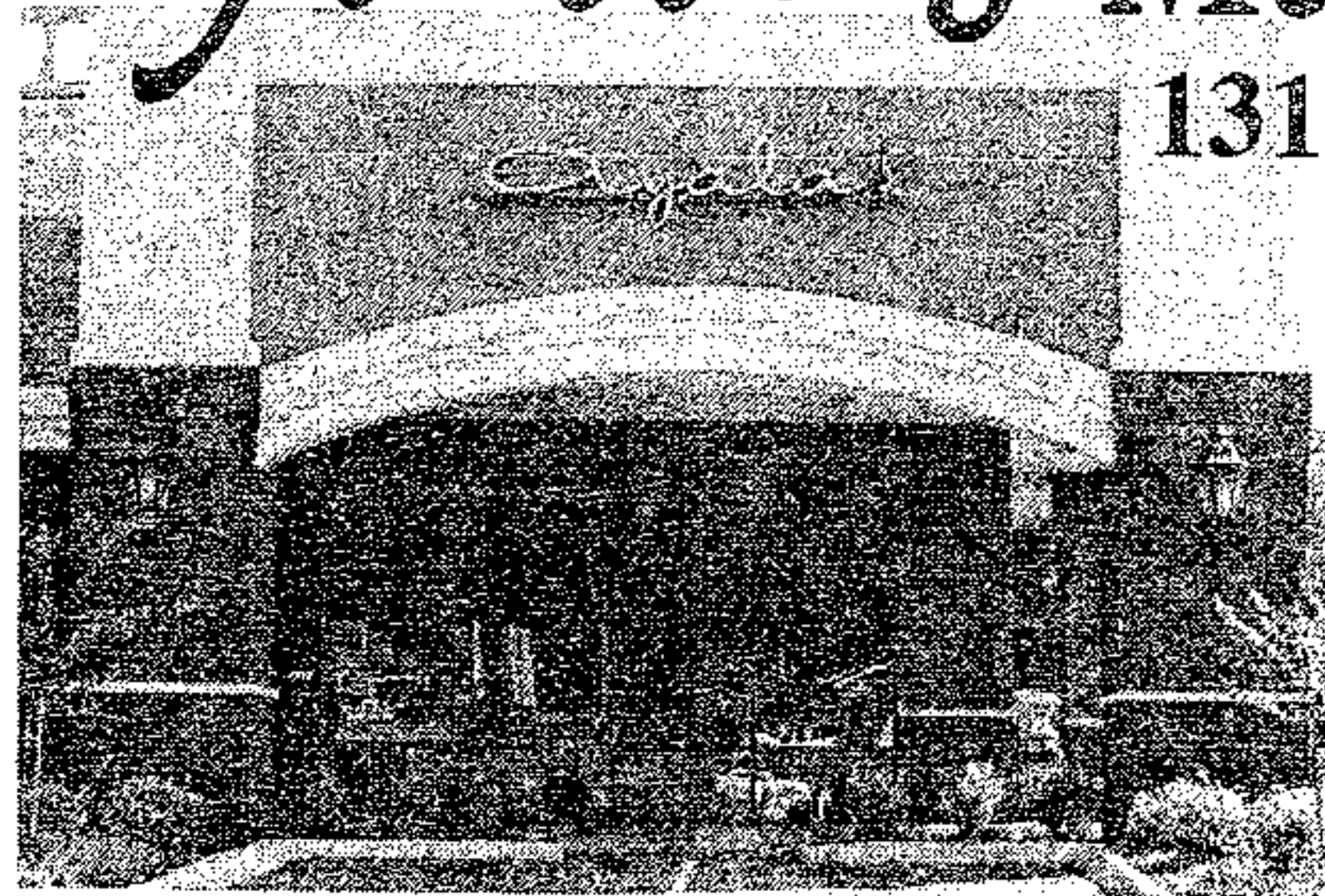

Upon arrival, LCPD K-9 Officer K. Sennett and Sgt. Lynette Ladd heard the victim screaming, "Let me out," from within the house, and asking to be released.

Upon making contact with Mr. Sokol, officers found he was extremely irate, screaming, sweating and was visually agitated. The female victim ran from

the house as soon as law enforcement provided the opportunity for her to escape. She was extremely distraught and was physically distressed.

During the course of the investigation, Mr. Sokol stated the victim attempted to leave to visit her ex-boyfriend on Browder Hollow Road and he took her keys to her car and her cell phone from her possession. He then continued to drag her into the garage portion of the house.

She was in fear for her safety during the attack, in which her boyfriend, Chandler Sokol, held her against her will while she was unable to fight back due to Mr. Sokol's overwhelming strength in comparison to hers.

Chandler T. Sokol was taken into custody and transported to the Loudon County Jail.
