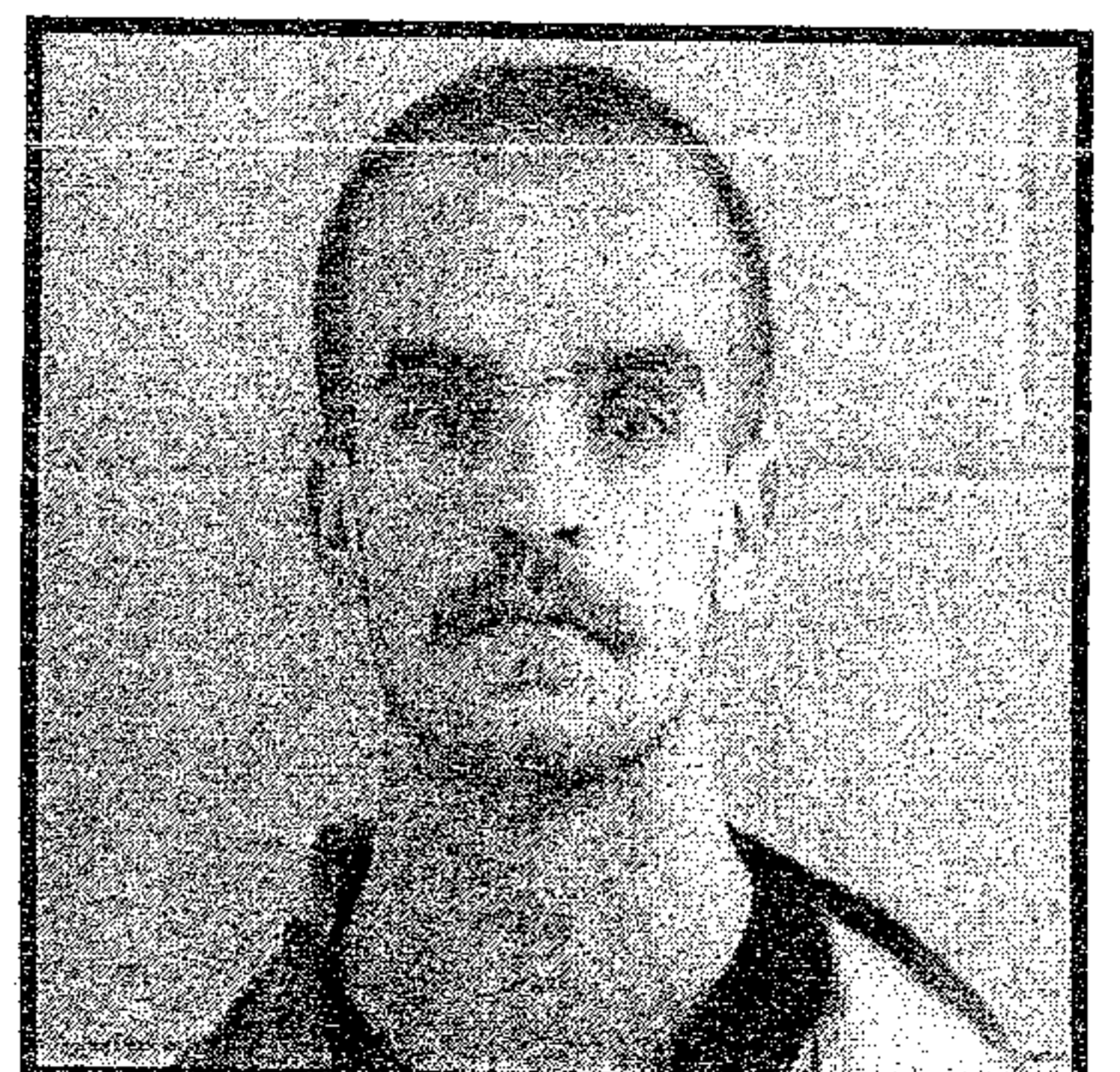

Justin Allen Walker, 22, homeless was charged with theft of property under \$500.

According to reports, Mr. Vineyard and Mr. Walker went to Walmart where they were seen selecting a Mt. Dew soft drink and

an energy drink. Mr. Walker was observed by Walmart Asset Protection concealing multiple items in the front of his pants, including a

flashlight and cologne. He also selected and consumed a Mt. Dew.

Records indicate when Walker noticed Asset Protection watching him, he discarded the concealed merchandise and the drink. After several trips around the store, both men exited through the garden center, passing all points of sale without paying \$3.16.

Mr. Vineyard was charged and convicted of theft at the Alcoa Walmart on February 11, 2012 and signed a notice of being banned from Walmart properties.

Officer Kevin Condee, LCPD responded and made the arrests. **No Fatalities** injuries and the other three were property damage accidents.

TWRA officers made 22 boating under the

influence (BUI) arrests over the weekend, an increase of nine from the same period last year. Officers also issued 12 reckless/negligent operation citations, down two from 2011.

This marks the second consecutive Memorial Day holiday weekend that there were no boating fatalities. Last year, there were six reported accidents, two of which resulted in injuries.

There have been seven boating-related fatalities from five accidents thus far in 2012 in Tennessee. There were also seven fatalities at this time last year.

TWRA officers have worked 39 reportable boating accidents in 2012. Officers have now made 42 BUI arrests.

According to reports, Deputy Craig Brewer, Lt. A.J. **2012 Becoming an Outdoors-Woman Field Day To Be Held June 16 in Knoxville**

NASHVILLE - The Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency (TWRA) will host a Becoming an Outdoors-Woman (BOW) Field Day on Saturday, June 16 in Knoxville at the John Sevier Hunter Education Facility.

The relaxed atmosphere of the BOW Field Day is primarily aimed at women, but is an opportunity for anyone 18 or older to learn outdoor skills usually associated with hunting and fishing, however it is useful for many outdoor pursuits. Workshop participants will have a chance to take two classes (one morning, one afternoon) during the event.

This year's BOW Field Day offers classes in basic archery, all ter-

rain vehicle operation, introduction to pistol shooting, introduction to firearms, nature photography basics, Dutch oven cooking, women's self defense, backyard habitat, boating safety education, and introduction to turkey hunting. The BOW Field Day will be held rain or shine.
