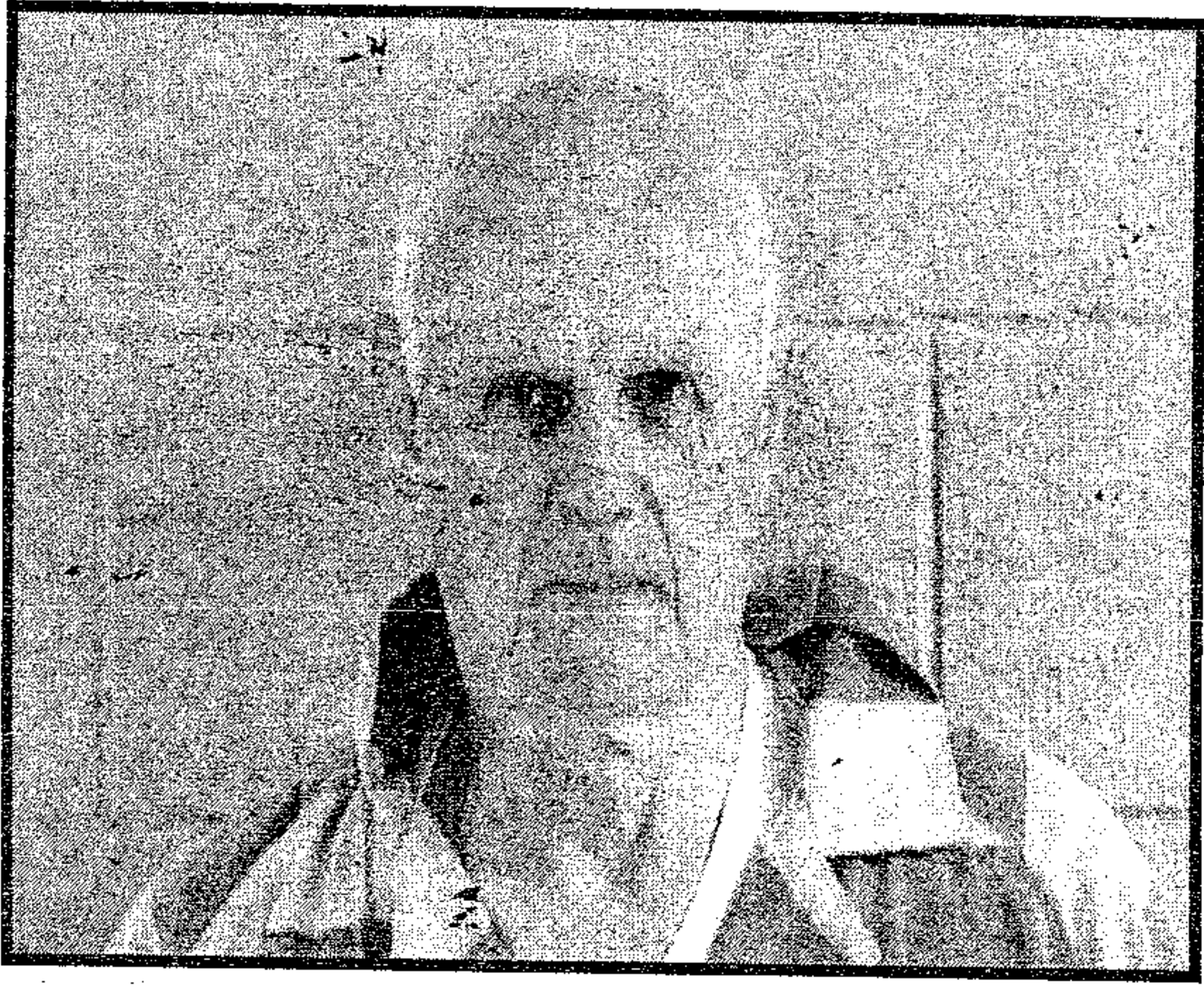

## Dad comes in with stick, pulls gun at daughter's residence

A Knoxville man was jailed when he went to his daughter's residence where he allegedly brandished a handgun while trying to get past his son-in-law with a stick after using a key to let himself in late Sunday night.

Herbert A. Hall, 75, Lanesborough Way, Knoxville was charged with aggravated assault.

According to an affidavit filed by Investigator Jeff Russell, LCSO-CID; on April 29, 2012, at approximately 10:30 PM, Deputy Brian Smith respnded to a residence on Tanglewood Drive in Lenoir City on an unwanted person with a gun. With further investigation, Investigator Russell found Herbert Hall had

### McGhee Square

LCPD responded to a theft of property call Monday, just after 3:00 PM, at Walmart in Lenoir City. While the officer was enroute, Jeremy H. Morgan began walking on foot from the area. Loss Prevention

provided a description of Morgan and advised he was wearing a gray shirt, blue pants and a hat, and he was walking towards Burger King.

Officer Burley spotted Morgan on Simpson Road East next to Burger King and detained him. He was transported back to Walmart and was positively identified by the asset protection agent.

The officer removed Mr. Morgan from his patrol unit in order to escort him into the Loss Prevention office at Walmart. While walking to the office, Morgan fled on foot in the direction of Shaw Ferry Road. He was ordered to stop but refused to do so.

Later that evening, around 8:30 PM, Officer

Burley verified through dispatch there were multiple warrants for Morgan. Officer Burley, Agent Brendon DeBoer, 9th DTF, Investigator J. Butler, LCPD, Officer K. Condee, LCPD, and K-9 Officer K. Sennett, LCPD went to McGhee Square where Officer Burley had previous information Morgan was residing.

Morgan was found with the gift card received from the stolen

merchandise in his possession.
