

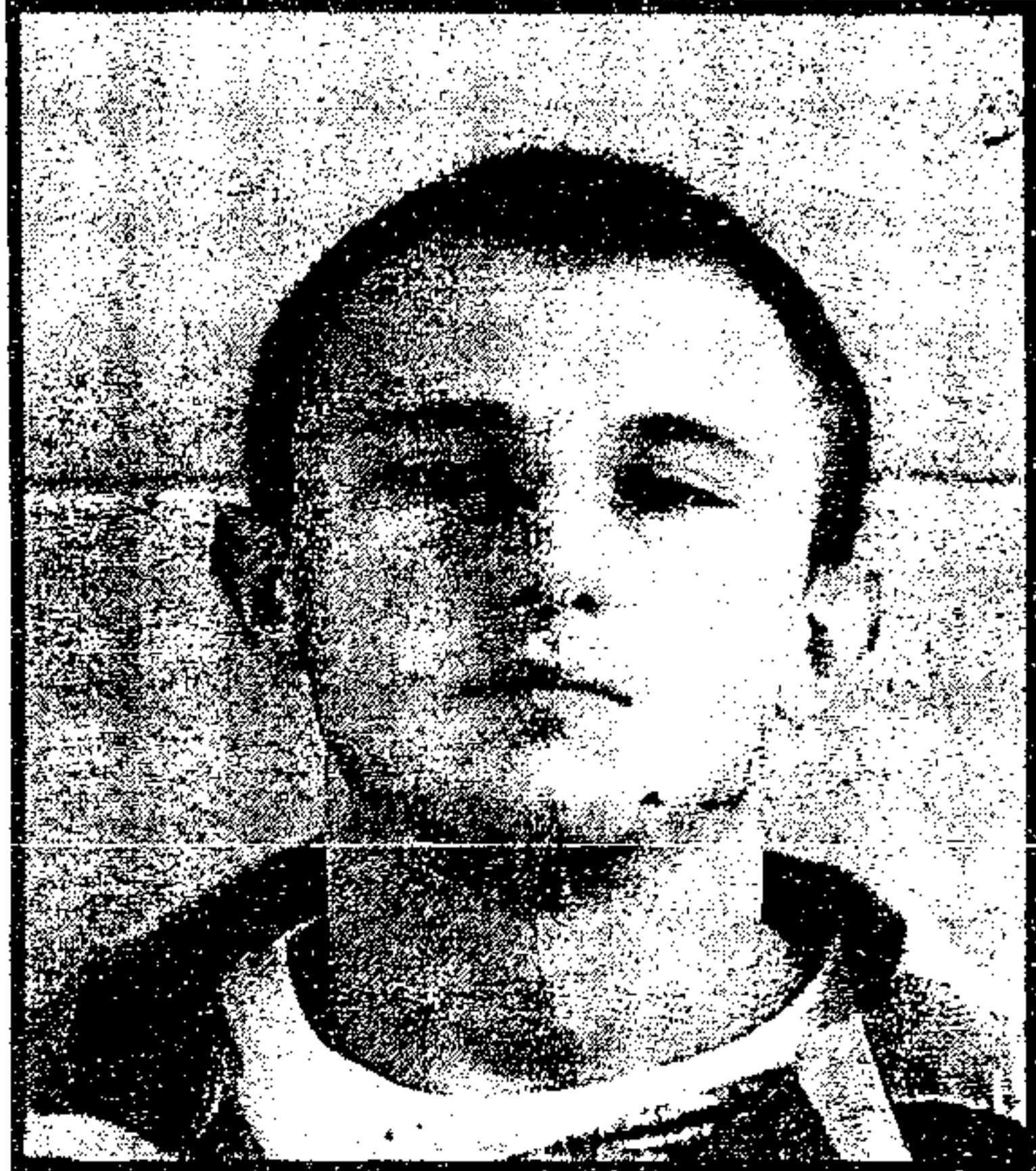

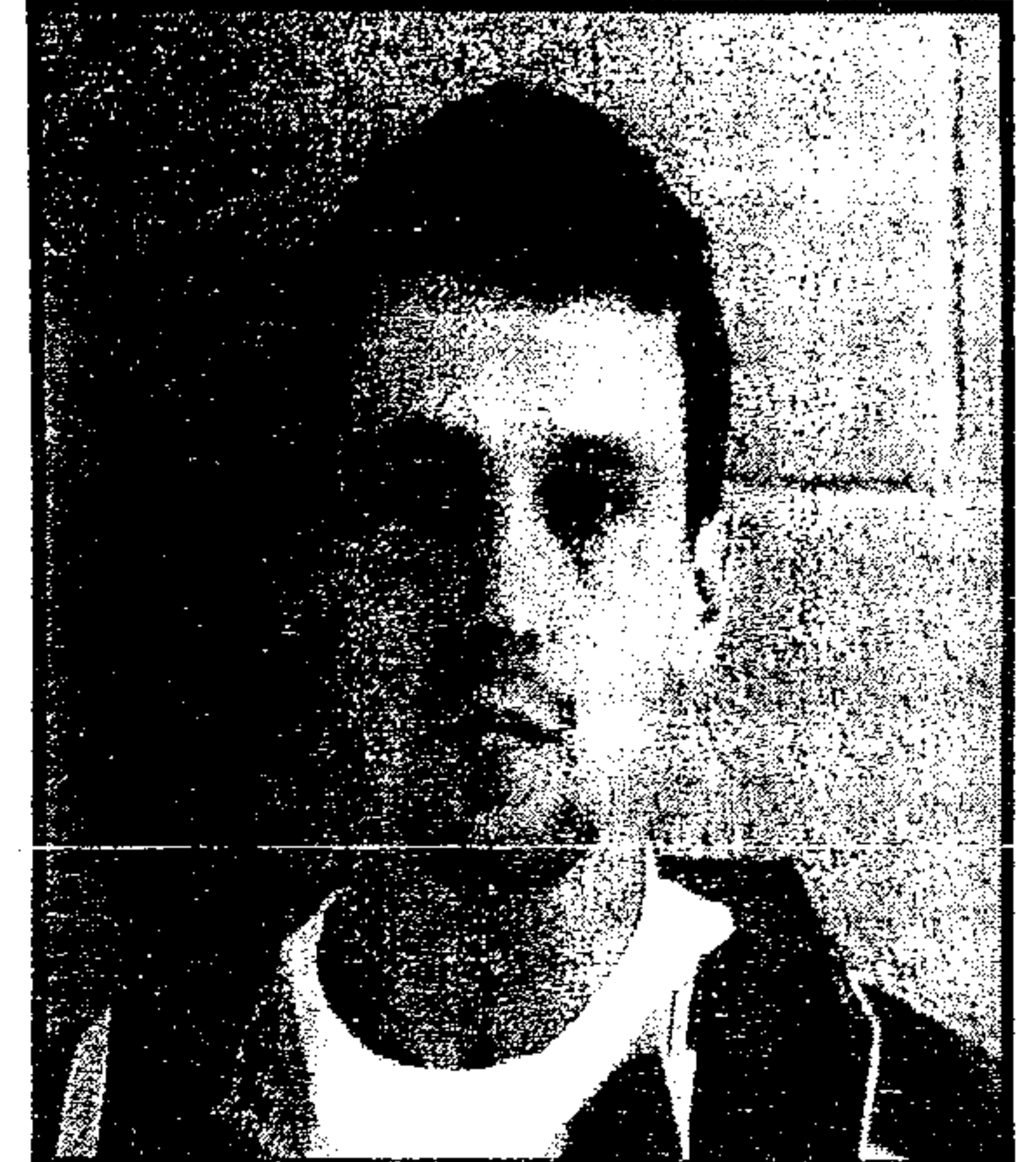

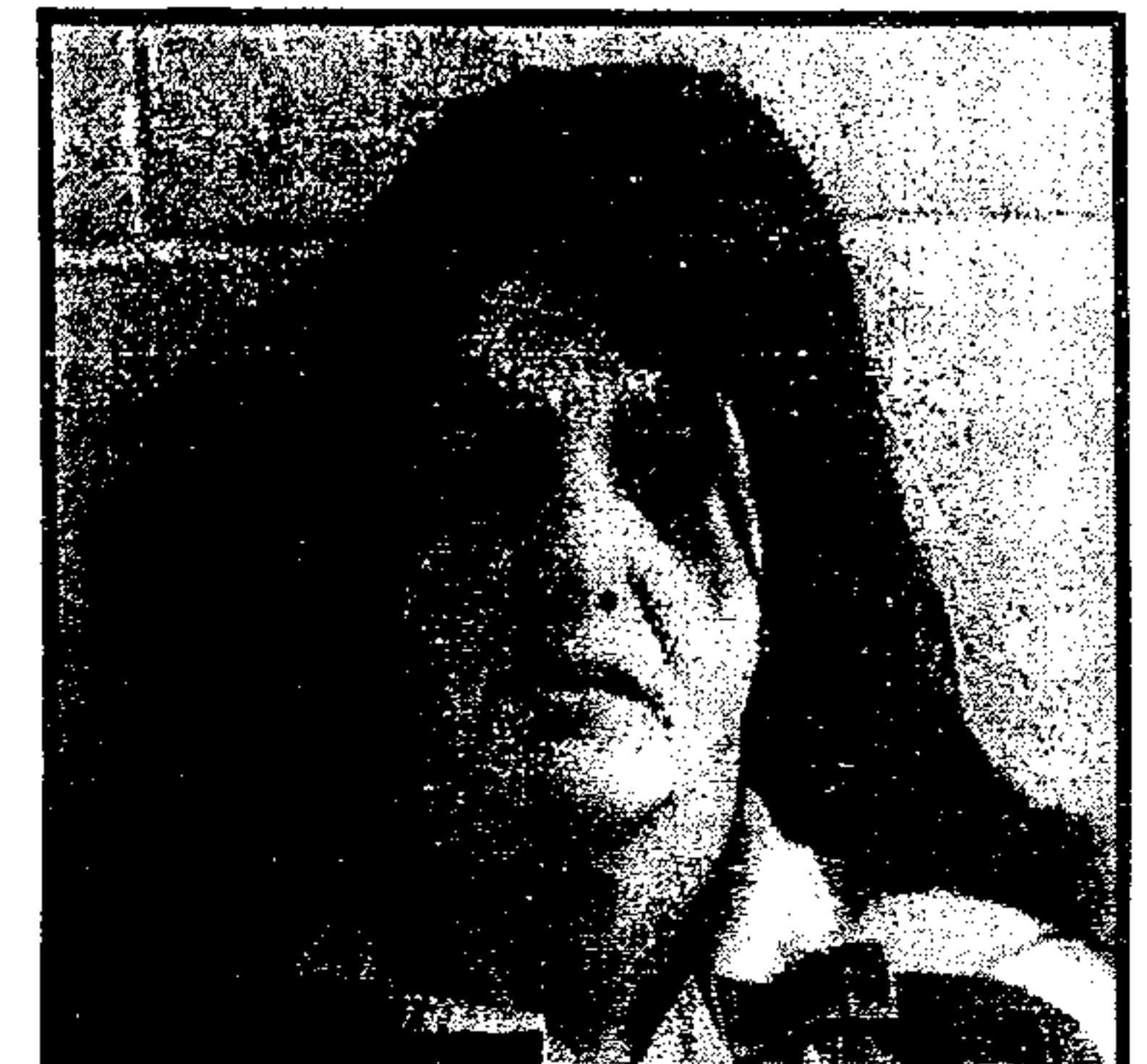
Woman tries to shop for free

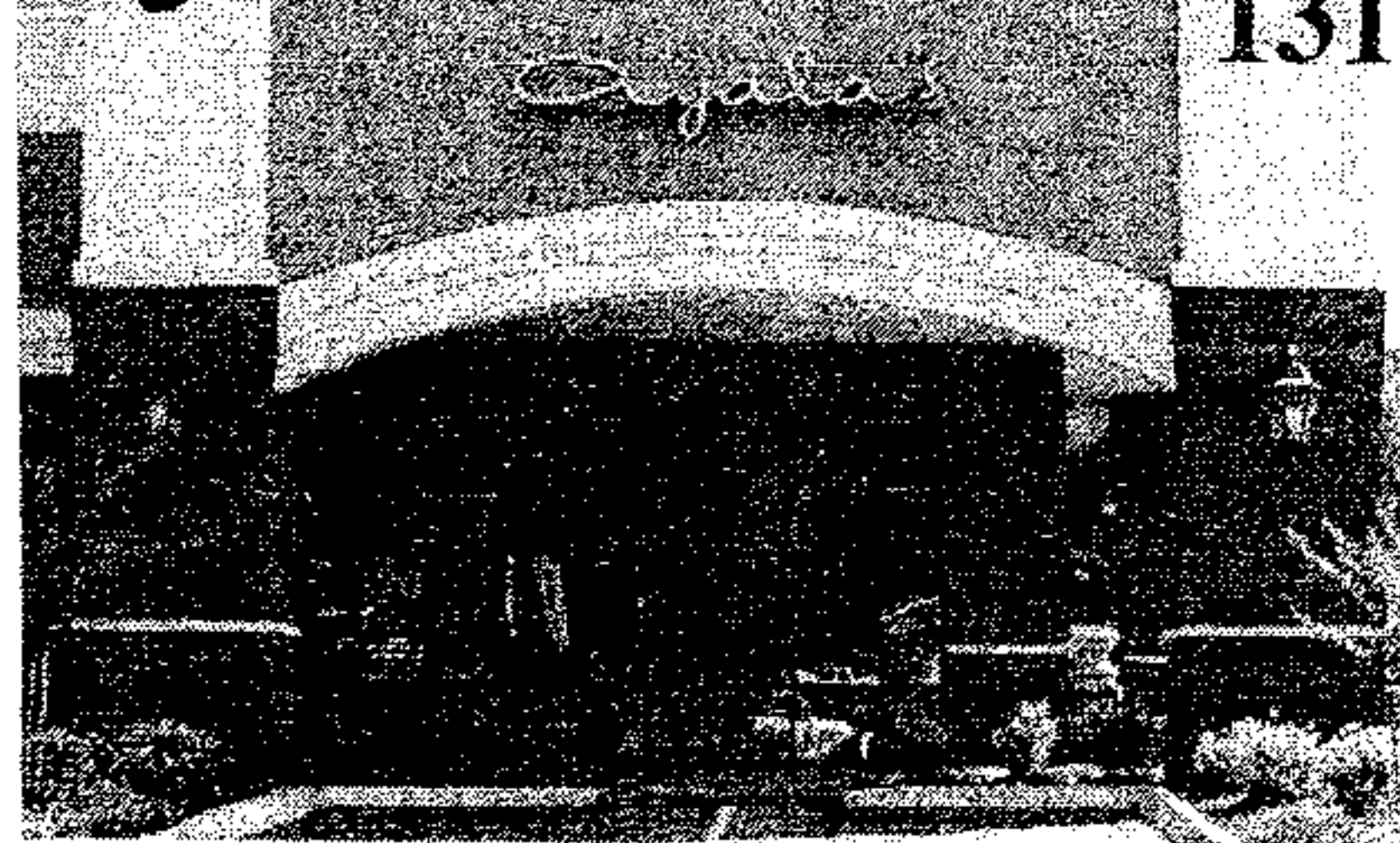
