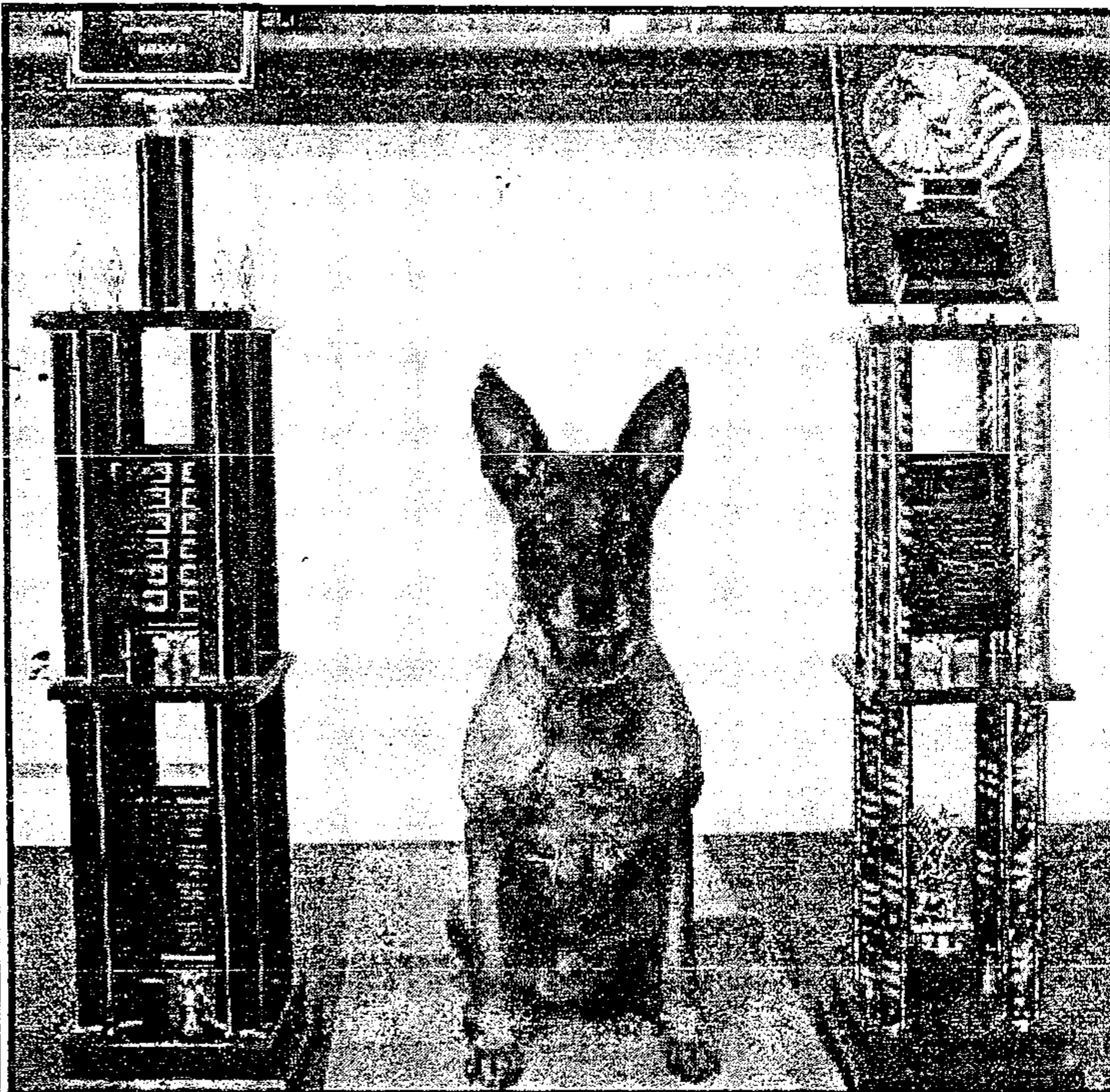

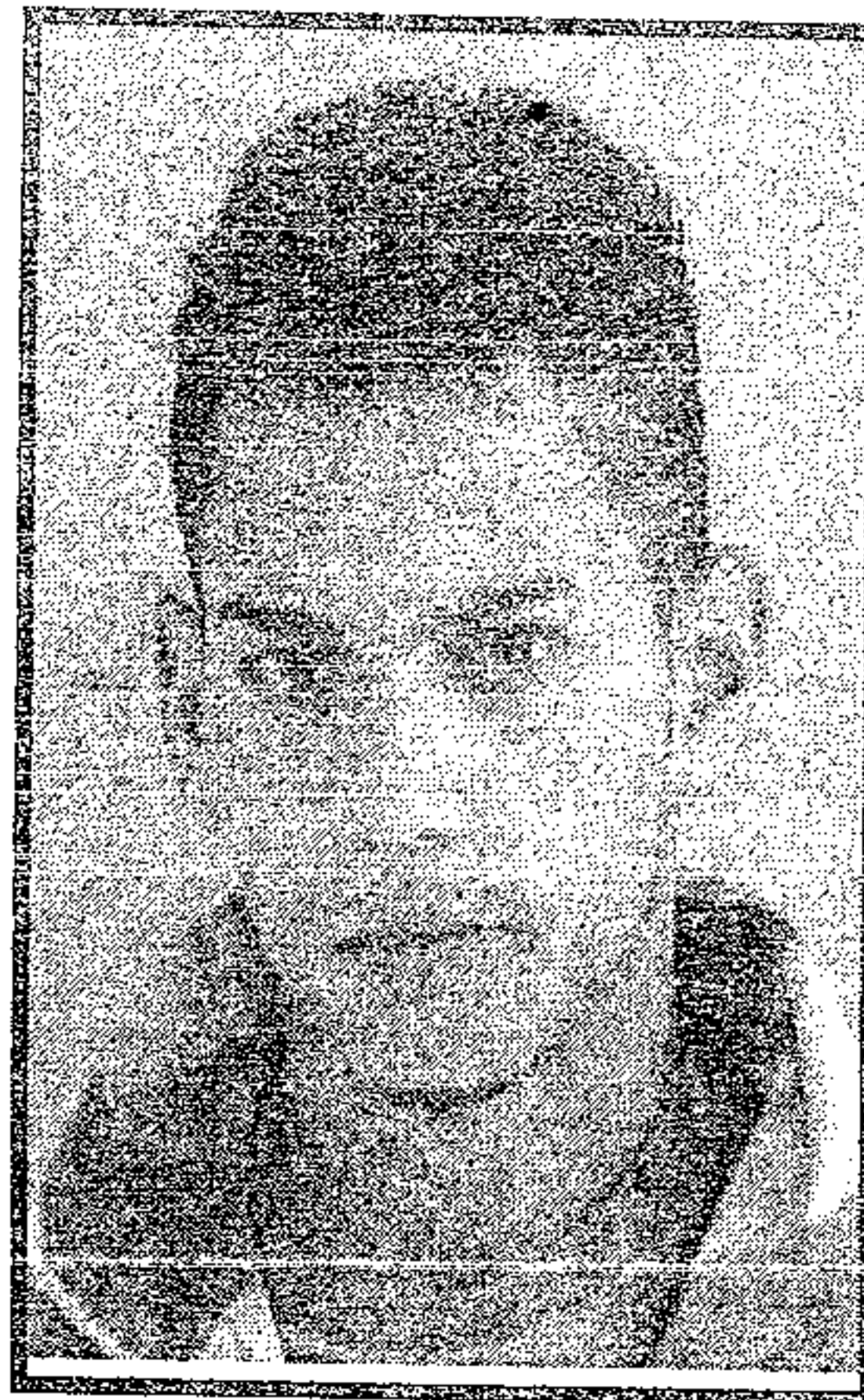
sign his name and said it was done without his consent.

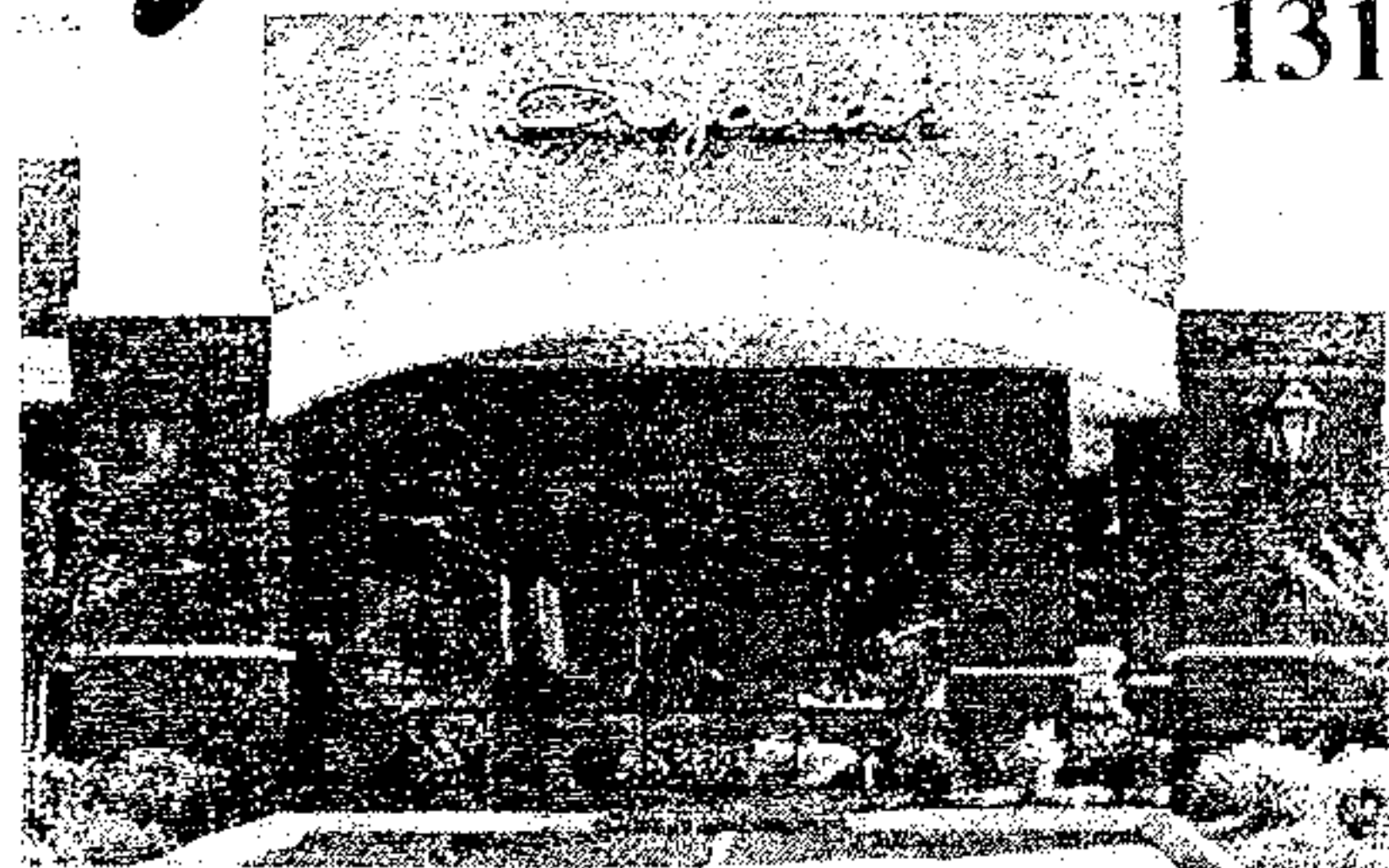

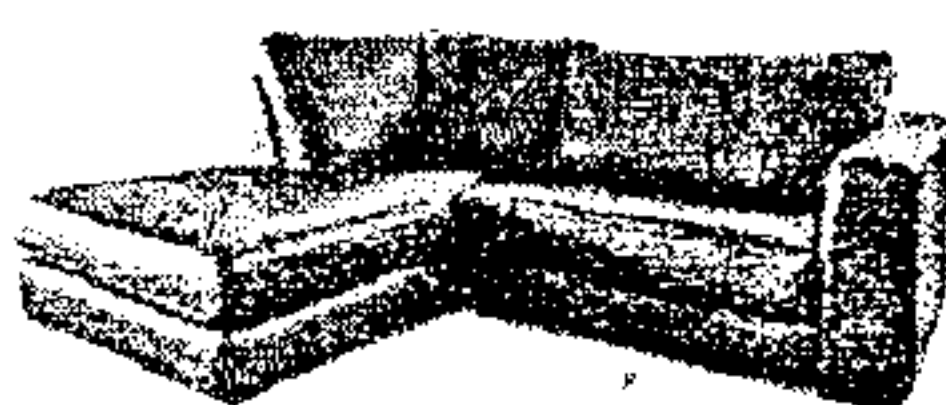

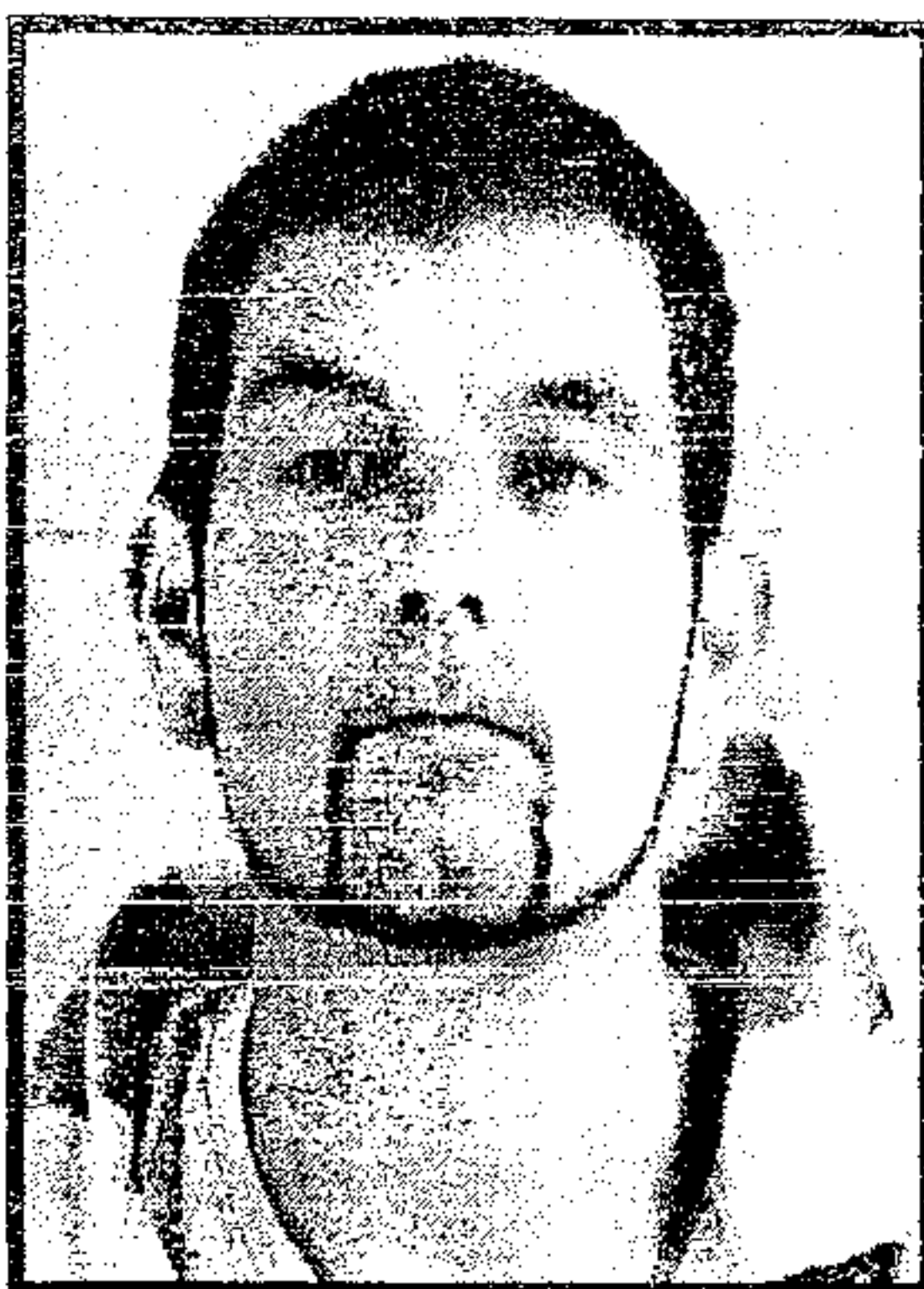

Christy Annette Smallwood, 35, Scenic Circle, Tellico was charged with violation of probation.







Ms. Smallwood turned herself in at the Loudon County Jail where Corporal Angi M. Martin, LCSO served the warrant and placed her under arrest.
