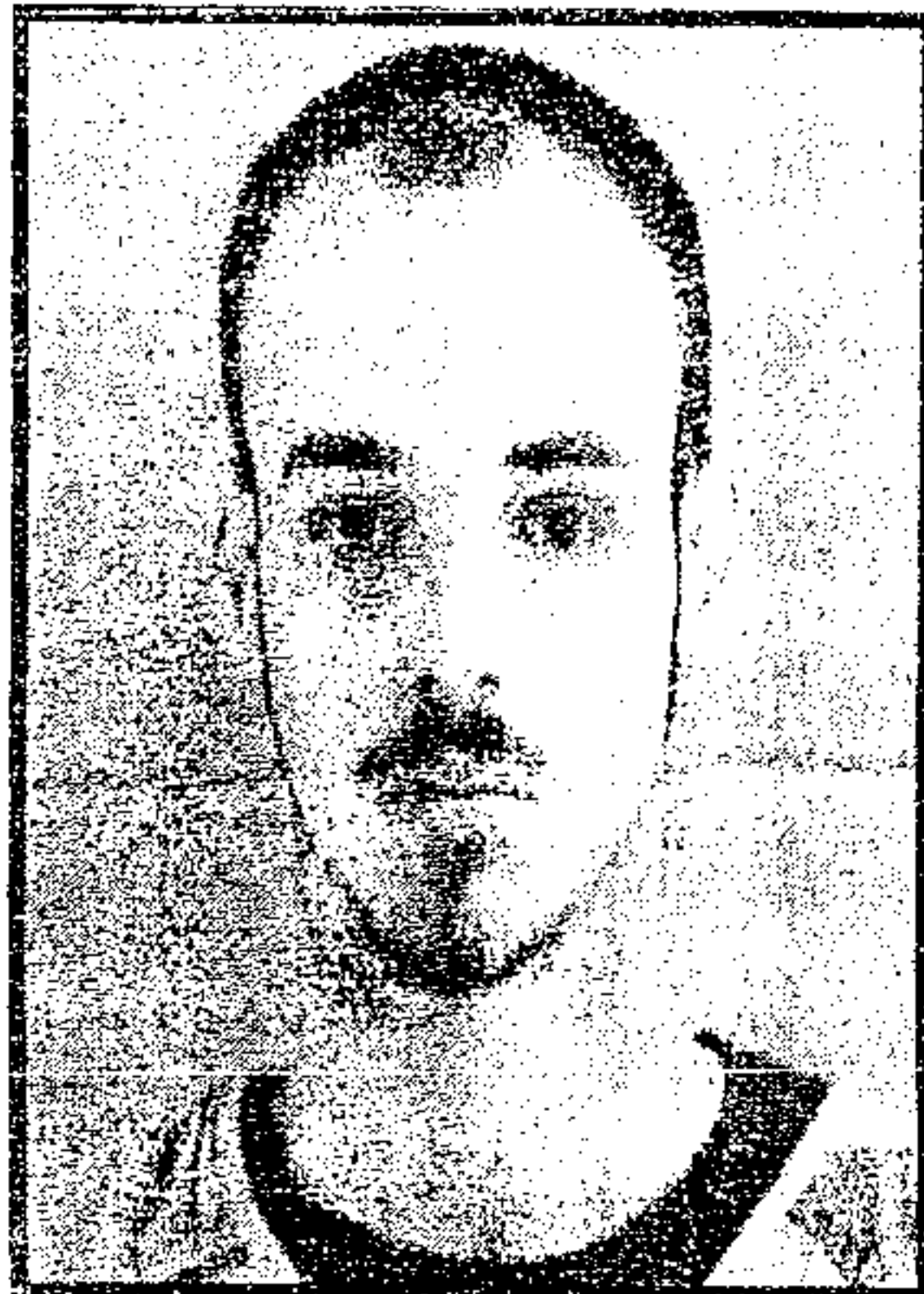


Pawning rented property bad idea for LC man





and a wallet containing credit cards was stolen in that burglary. However, in the June burglary, the suspect was

apparently cut by the glass and left blood on the window.

Working with WalMart security, the CID unit obtained a

video of the suspect using a credit card from the May burglary. News stations aired the video of the suspect and the CID unit immediately

began receiving tips to the suspect's identity. In Monroe County, investigators located Timothy Lee Moore, 34, of 2094 Green Road, Madisonville. Moore's mother's vehicle was found with blood in it, and Moore told officers he had cut himself on the foot replacing a friend's window! However, he later confessed to investigators that he was involved in the burglaries and thefts. CID also recovered a shirt that was the same shirt Moore was wearing during the transaction at WalMart. At this time Moore has been charged with burglary,

with other charges pending. The other suspect has been identified and warrants are currently being sought for his arrest, but the Sheriff declined to release the name of the suspect at this time.

Sheriff Guider would like to thank all the news channels that aired the video and assisted in getting these men identified, and noted the CID unit is still has an ongoing investigation into the burglaries. He also cautioned everyone to lock their belongings in their vehicle trunk, or better yet, leave valuables at home and just carry your driver's license.

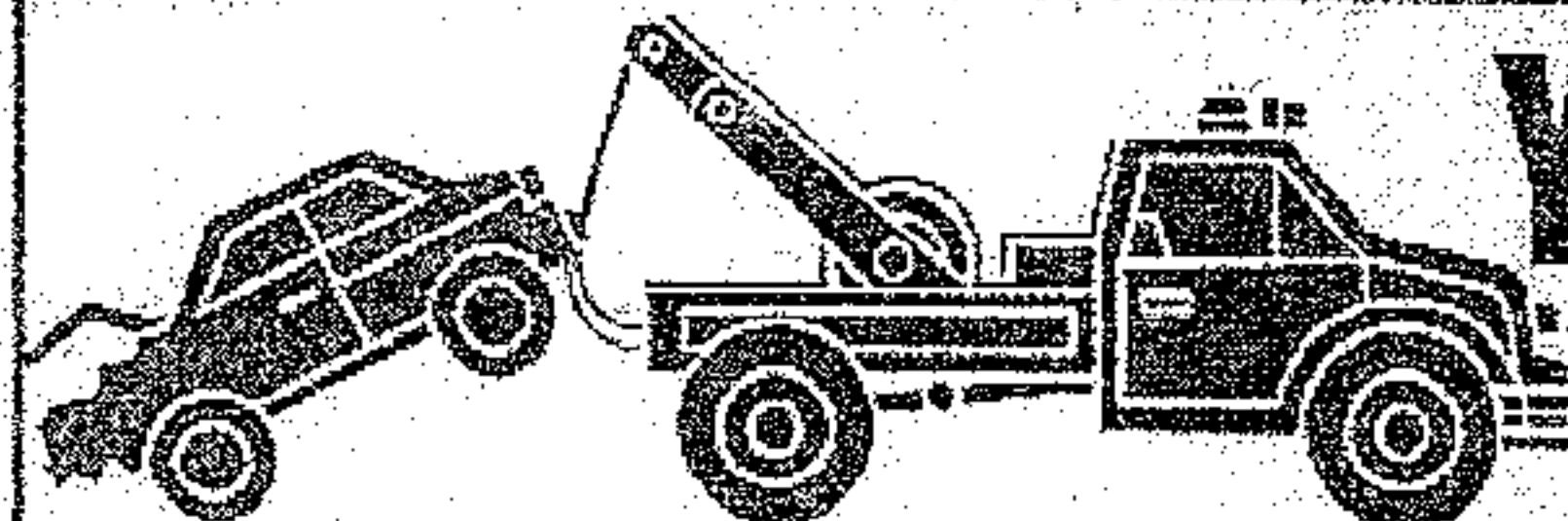

Armed and outraged

Jessika Darlene Klingensmith, 22, West Ninth Avenue, Lenoir City was charged with aggravated domestic assault and assault.

According to reports, Thursday, at approximately 2:34 AM, Officer E. Lawson, LCPD responded to a residence on West Ninth Avenue in reference to a domestic in which Jessika Klingensmith was on the property without permission. The victim was in the street in front of the residence and stated his wife Jessika was inside the residence armed with a butcher knife and advised his 2 year old son was inside as well.

As the officer approached the front of the house, Mrs. Klingensmith came out unarmed. Both parties advised Lenoir City

Police had been at the residence on a domestic disturbance earlier, around 8:15 PM and at that time, Mrs. Klingensmith was picked up by her step-mother and transported to her father's house on Waller Street where she was to stay for the night. Officers instructed her not to return to the residence on West Ninth Avenue.

Mrs. Klingensmith told Officer Lawson she had walked to her West Ninth Avenue home from Waller Street to get some tampons, but when she arrived, her key wouldn't work so she climbed through a window on the back of the house. Klingensmith said she realized a female was in the house with her husband and she became enraged.

The victim and his female guest were in

the bedroom when they heard a crash in the kitchen. He went to investigate and encountered his wife. The female guest was trying to leave the residence, but Mrs. Klingensmith began throwing punches at her.

The victim attempted to restrain his wife to allow his guest to escape and the nonresidential female was able to leave the residence and called 911.

The victim advised his wife struck him in the face and arms, then retrieved a large butcher knife from the kitchen and told him she was going to "kill him and his female guest and cut his F&\$@ing D*\$\$ off." She then began stabbing the bed.

The victim fled from the residence and met Officer Lawson at the roadway. When the of-

ficer asked Mrs. Jessika Klingensmith where the knife was, she stated she had put it back in the block.

In the bedroom, the officer observed several cuts in the bedding and in the kitchen she located a large butcher knife which was the only knife in the block.

Officer Lawson then called the female guest and she returned to the scene as requested. Written statements were taken from both victims and Jessika Klingensmith was taken into custody and transported to the Loudon County Jail.

The two year old was in a crib and was un-

harmed during the incident.

Thursday, around 6:01 PM, THP Troopers C. Huff and E. Miller were advised of a reckless driver in a blue Ford Mustang that had struck a guard rail at the 359 mile marker while traveling on Interstate 40. The troopers made contact with the Mustang in question at the 364 exit

and Highway 321.

Upon making contact with the driver, Clifton R. Dykes, the lawmen discovered he was attempting to clean the side of the car where the damage was. Dykes could not perform field sobriety tasks as instructed and was asked if he had taken any

medication. Dykes he stated he took his lorazepam which, was filled at 12:01 PM, CST. The pill bottle called for 120 pills to be present and for the patient to only take one tablet, four times daily. A pill count was conducted at 6:01 PM, EST, a five hour gap, and there were only 114 pills in the bottle. Records indicate Mr. Dykes had traveled five miles on Interstate 40 and had passed two well marked exits before finally coming to a stop for law enforce-

ment. Contact was made with Mr. Dykes approximately 35 minutes after he struck the guardrail at the 359 mile marker. Mr. Dykes had a cell phone in his possession and failed to notify authorities of his traffic crash.

Upon inventory of Mr. Dykes' vehicle a Smith & Wesson firearm was located in the left rear floor board.
