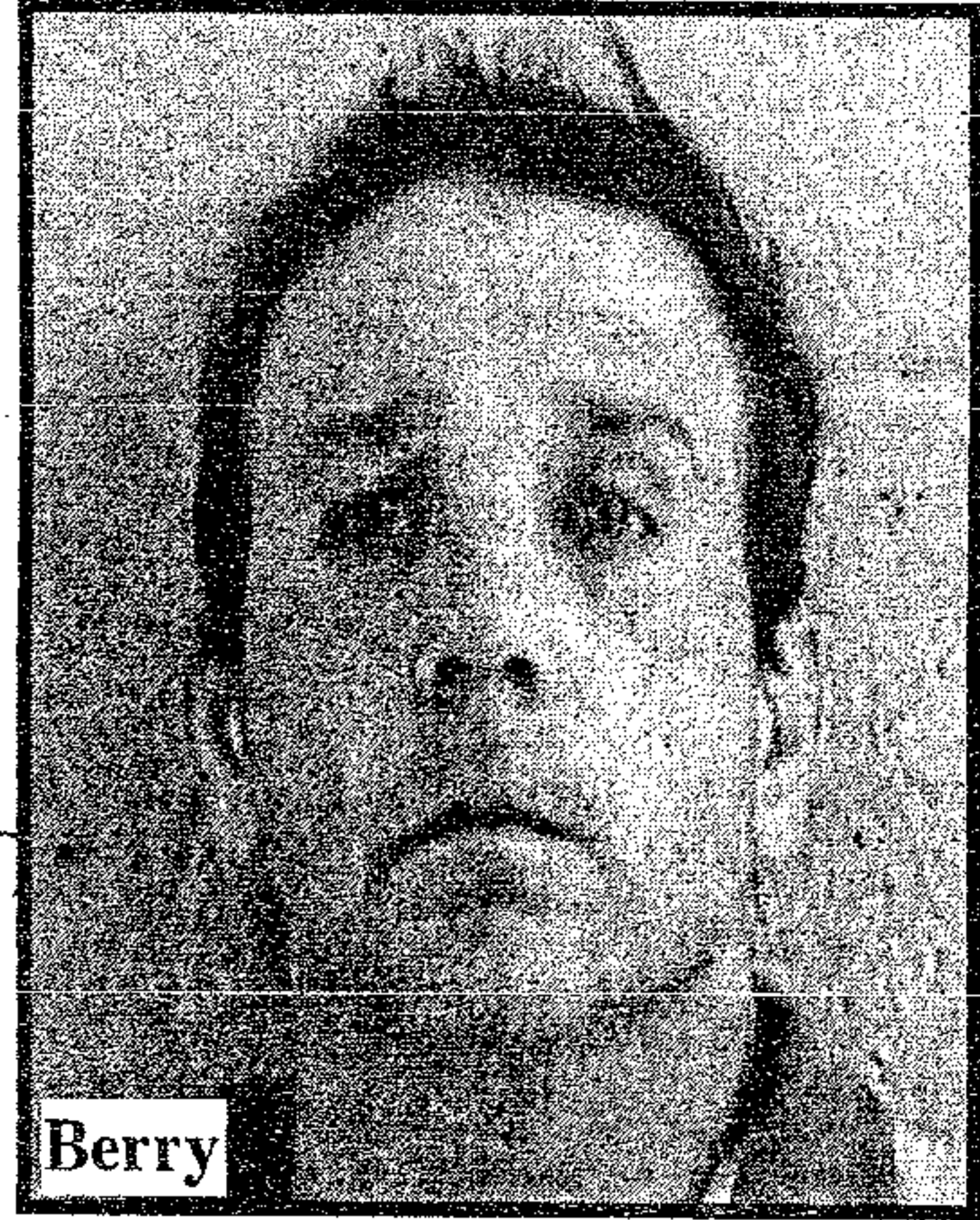

According to records, Monday, at approximately 2:11 AM, Officer Bennie Houser, LPD was dispatched to the Rocky Top Shell on a call of a

possible drunk driver on a motorcycle. On arrival the motorcycle was pulling out of the parking lot onto Highway 72, then turned onto Corporate Park Drive.

The officer reported he noticed the left rear tail light was broken out and it was traveling 42 mph in a 30 mph zone, drifting from the center line to the white line.

Officer Houser conducted a traffic stop and identified the driver as David H. Berry. Mr. Berry had a strong odor

Officer Houser reported he felt it was unsafe for Ms. Reynolds to be left out in the public and she was taken into custody.

Berry performed poorly on field sobriety tasks and was read the implied consent advisement. He agreed and his BAC was .10%.

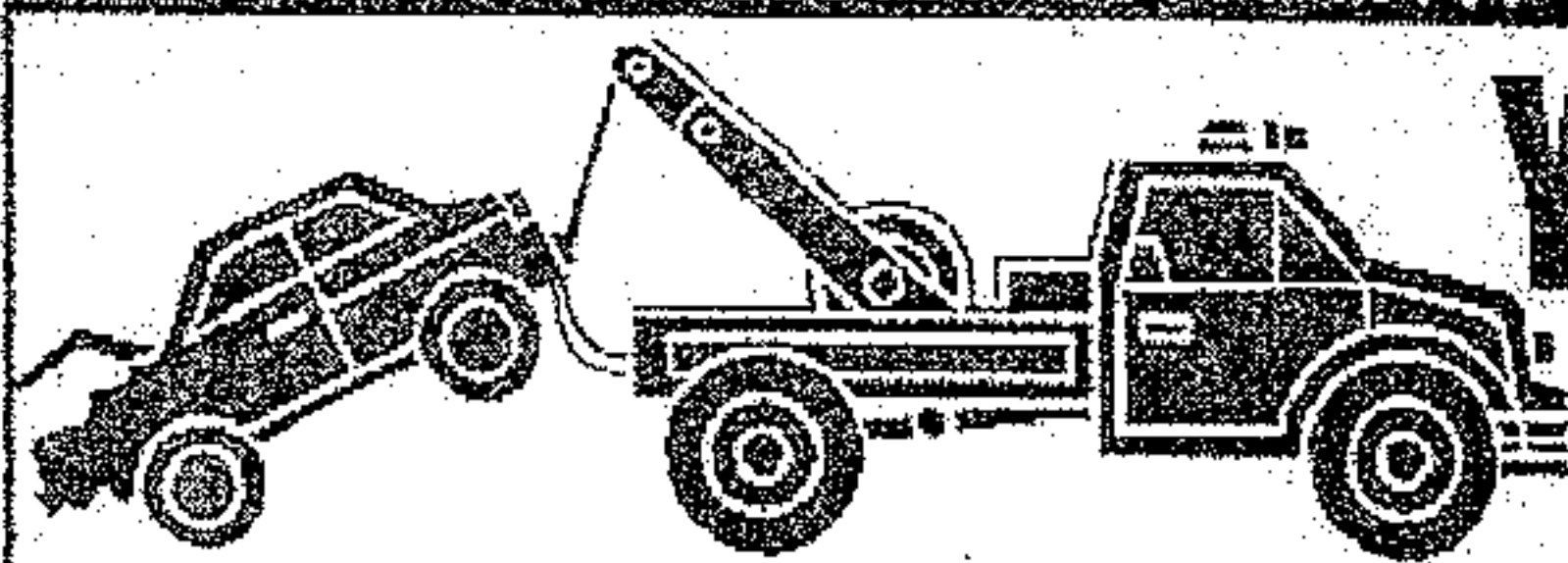

### Man Got K9'd

According to reports, Deputy Chris Jenkins, LCSO was informed by the Loudon County Jail and dispatch that Bradley A. Williams was supposed to be at a residence on Lake Forest Drive Monday. Mr. Williams was wanted in Loudon County with active warrants for violation of probation, prior thefts and vandalism, felony evading arrest, felony reckless endangerment, theft of property \$1,000 - \$10,000, theft of property \$500 - \$1,000 and aggravated burglary.

Jenkins, along with back up officers including Investigators Shane Ezell and Marty Stanley, and Deputies Chris Bowen and T. J. Scarbrough, went to the location in an attempt to locate Mr. Williams.

While officers were approaching the house, Williams was at a neighbor's porch, and upon seeing law enforcement, fled on foot to the woods.

Due to Mr. Williams' past history of resisting officers, and due to the nature of the warrants,

Before officers entered the thick wooded area, Deputy Jenkins made several loud and clear announcements for Mr. Williams to exit the woods or K9 Diego would apprehend him.

Mr. Williams made no effort and gave no response to commands, so the K9 was deployed.

Diego cleared several places behind the residence, then came to a large thick location. Deputy Jenkins and Investigator Ezell were crawling through the thick wooded area when

K9 Diego located Mr. Williams.

Due to the wooded area being so thick, Williams was advised to come to officers, but he couldn't. When Jenkins and Ezell made contact with Mr. Williams and K9 Diego, K9 Diego was engaged to Mr. Williams right arm. Williams was attempting to fight the K9 using a shirt, and kicking and punching at the K9.

Mr. Williams was advised several times to stop resisting, and he finally responded. At that time K9 Diego was commanded to release Mr. Williams and responded immediately.

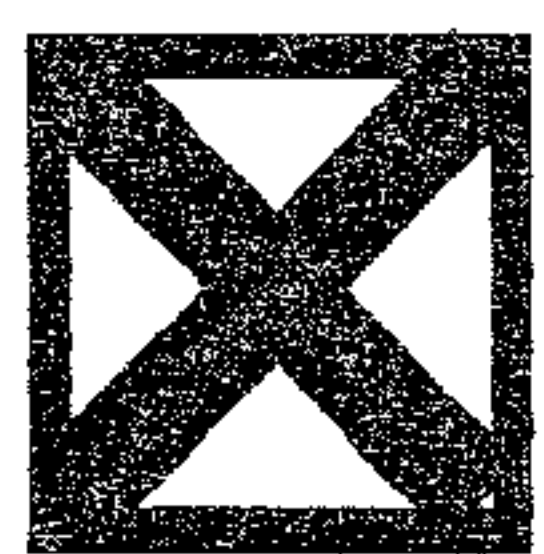
EMS were called to the scene and transported Williams to Fort Loudoun ER where his wounds were cleaned and bandaged. Williams was released from the
