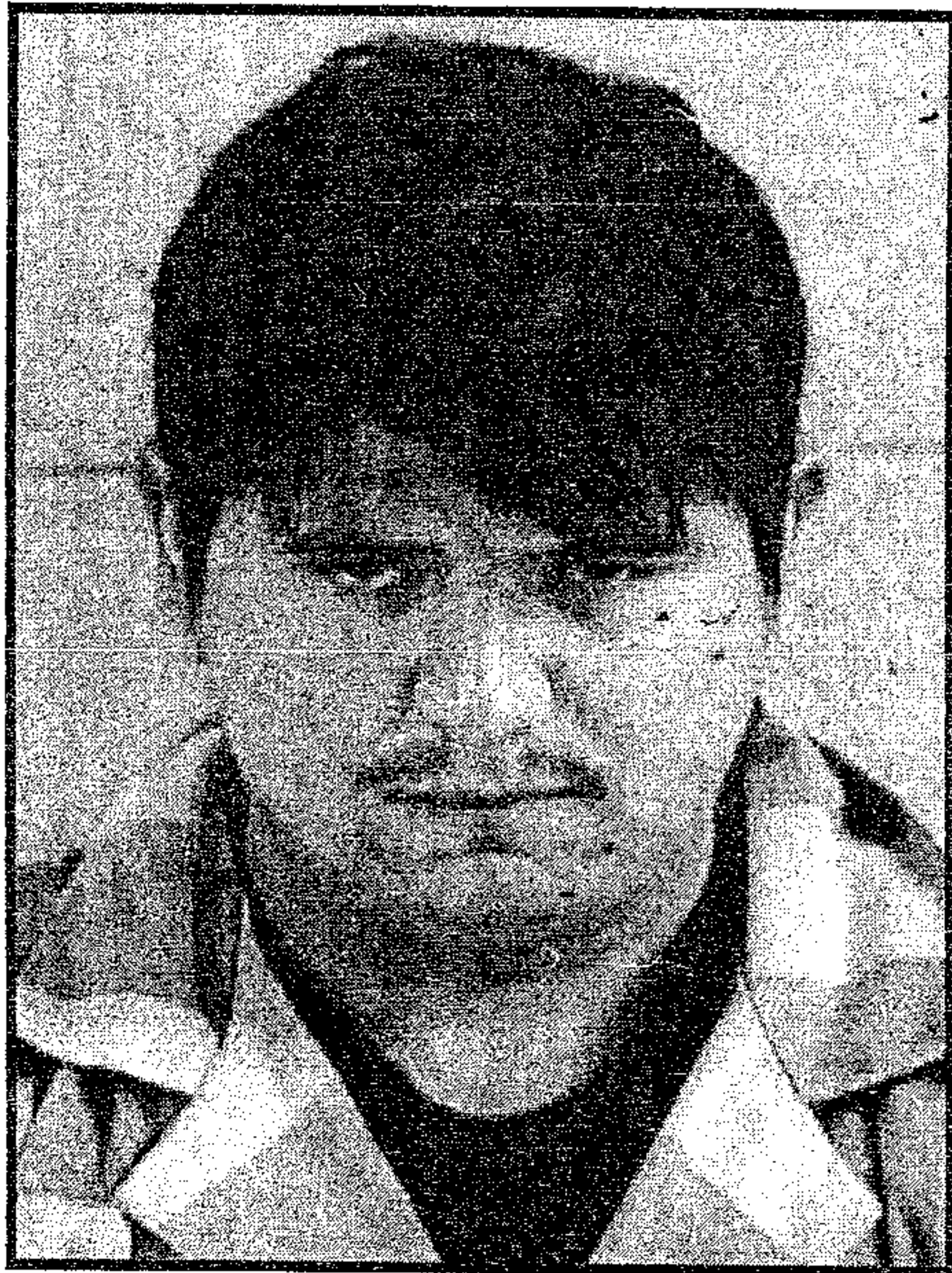
Man charged with sexual battery of 13 year old

According to records, Saturday, around 12:35 AM, Officer Brandon Nix, LPD responded to a suspicious person call on Grove Street. Officer Jonathan Yates, LPD found a man who fit the description standing on Grove Street near the fountain. The man was identified as Allen W. Lowe.

Mr. Lowe had a strong odor of an intoxicant on his breath and person and stated he'd drank alcohol earlier. He was unsteady on his feet and deemed a danger to himself and others

if left in his condition. He couldn't provide information about where lived and was uncooperative. Mr. Lowe was placed under arrest.

Officer Nix attempted to have Lowe sit in the back seat of his patrol car for transport to the jail, but he refused to

sit down. Officers gave several commands to get in the car and Lowe refused. They attempted to put him in the car and he became combative and kicked Officer Yates several times.

Lowe was told multiple times the Taser would be used if he

didn't comply. Lowe began kicking the officers again and Officer Yates Tasered him and he then complied.
