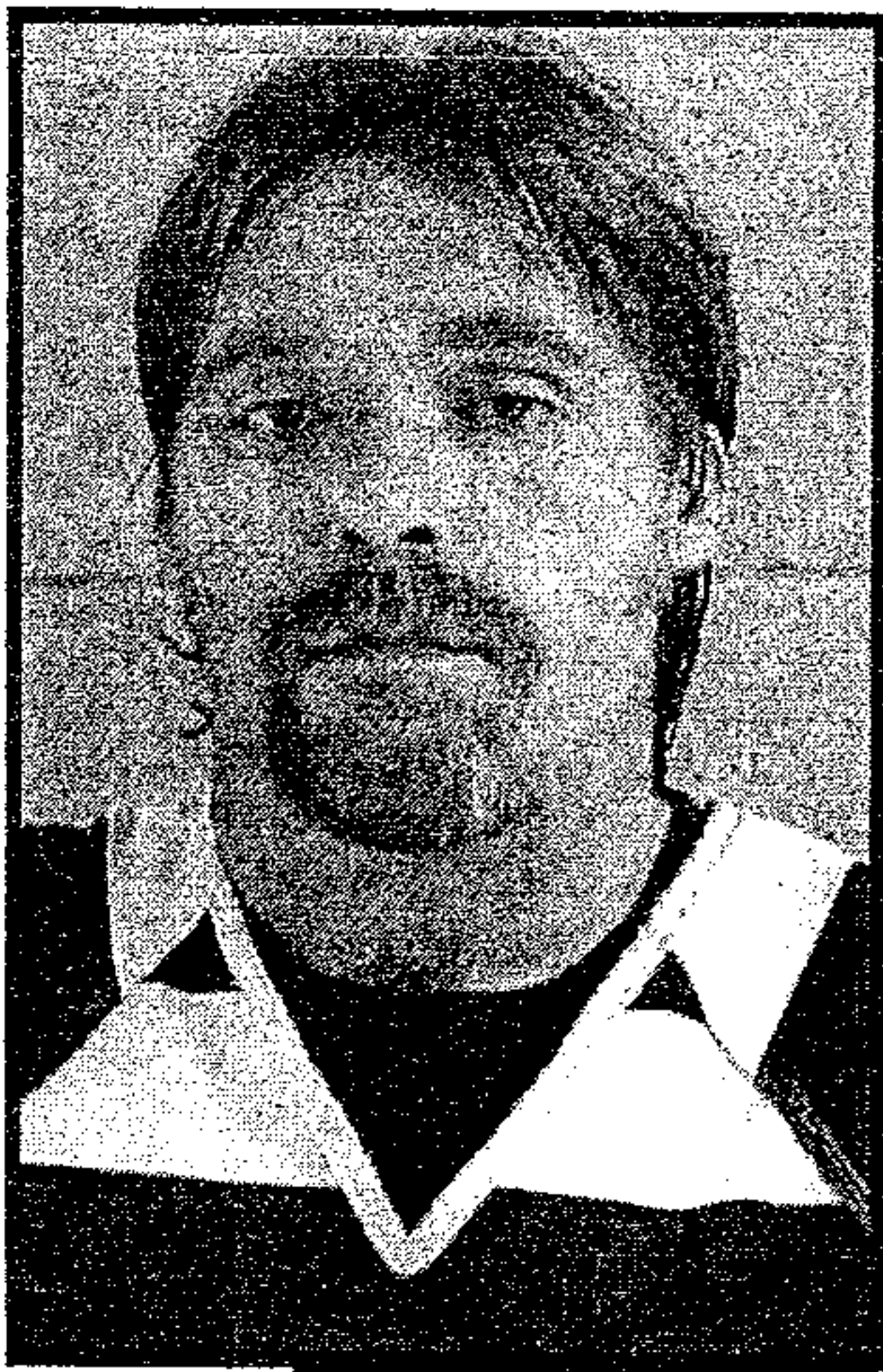

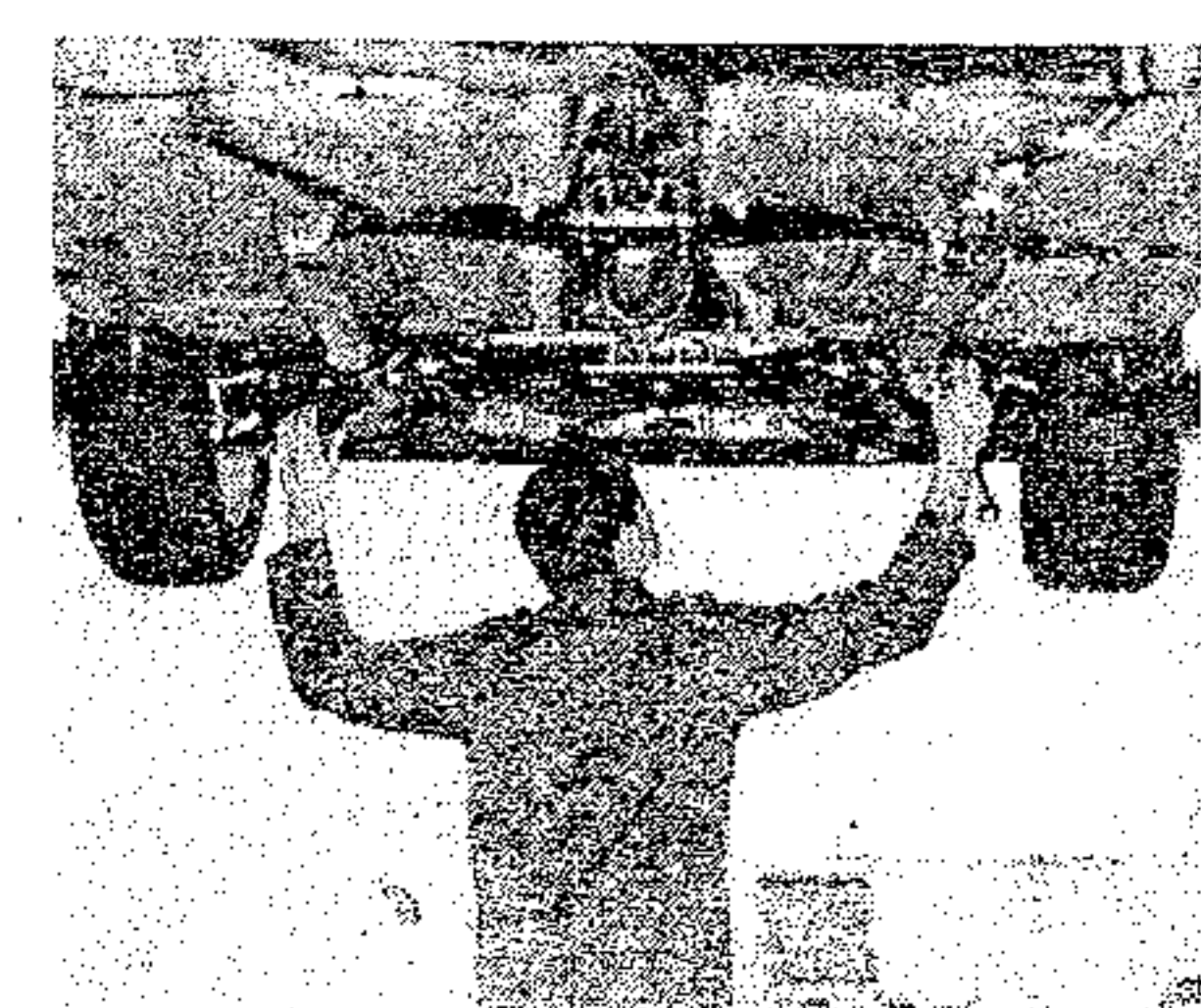

Wanted

A local man is accused of raping a ten year old child and authorities from the Loudon County Sher-

iff's Department are asking your help in locating him. A warrant charging him with rape of a child has been issued for sixty-one

year old Edward Underwood, Jr., of 3390 Simpson Road East, Lenoir City, TN.

According to the affidavit, which was filed

by Investigator Jason Smith, LCSO CID; the child reported several incidents had occurred where Underwood raped her, citing one such incident which occurred sometime in mid to late July, 2012, when Underwood raped the child in the front seat of his vehicle when they returned to his residence from an outing.

The child sought help from the Child Advocacy Center in Lenoir City and reported the alleged rapes to officials there. She said the latter rape occurred when she and Underwood returned to his Simpson Road residence and he turned off the headlights so as not to alert others inside the home to their arrival. Underwood then had her lie down on the front seat in his vehicle where he sexually penetrated her.

The investigator noted the child then told an adult family member about the rape in August.

Records indicate upon learning of the accusation, the family member confronted Underwood and he admitted to touching the child and said he would get help and "make it

right."

Underwood has since gone missing and authorities need your help in locating him. He is described as being 5'8 tall, weighs 165 lbs and has brown eyes and brown hair. Underwood was last seen in a blue Chevy S-10 pickup with a white camper top.

ber 4, 2012 at approximately 11:30pm, deputies were dispatched to Parkway Drive in Lenoir City to investigate a shooting. Upon arrival it was found the victim was Mrs. Stacy Duggan, who lived in the home. Mrs. Duggan had received a gunshot wound to the head.

Upon further investigation it was learned from witnesses that Mr. and Mrs. Duggan's son, age 11, had found a gun near the

railings in a bunk bed that he was sleeping in and had fired one shot, hitting his mother in the head.

The weapon was clearly located in a place the child could easily access the weapon. The weapon did belong to Stacy Duggan and she was aware the gun was accessible to the child and had it in a location that clearly resulted in the child firing the weapon.

Stacy Renee Duggan, 36, of Parkway Drive, Lenoir City was charged with child neglect and two counts of violation of probation.

According to those

affidavits, Duggan was convicted of DORL on May 2, 2012 and sentenced to probation for 6 months. Since then she has failed to follow instructions of probation officer, and failed to report to jail after she was ordered to report to the Loudon County Jail on June 18, 2012 for ordered 45 days replot time per judgment order.

Probation Officer Chris Goddard told Duggan on June 19, 2012 to report to jail at 12:30pm. Duggan did not report to the jail, however, she was admitted to Tennova Healthcare for having a seizure and a sprained knee. Per ADA Frank Harvey this violation

is being.

Duggan also has failed to pay costs/fines, owes \$333.50.

In another affidavit, Duggan was convicted October 14, 2010 of casual exchange, February 7, 2011 VOP, and February 1313, 2012 of DUI and sentenced to probation for 11 months 29 days. Since then she has failed to report for jail time, failed to pay costs/fines, owes 4358.50, failed to pay supervision fees, owes \$87.75. This is her 2nd VOP.

The child's father, Mr. Dan Duggan, also was charged with child neglect in connection with the incident. (See the Friday, September 7, 2012 edition of The Daily Edition for details.)

Deputy Bruce Padgett, LCSO made

the arrest at UT Hospital.

Angel W. Cobbs, 50, Bridgewood Drive, Boca Raton, Florida was charged with driving on suspended and violation of the move over law.

According to reports, Trooper Rodney Best, THP was sitting behind another unit on Interstate 75 northbound and noticed a green Kia SUV fail to move over for emergency vehicles. He stopped the vehicle at the 72 mile marker and identified the driver as Angel W. Cobbs.

A check of her license revealed Cobbs was suspended.

Ms. Cobbs was placed under arrest and transported to the Loudon County Jail.
