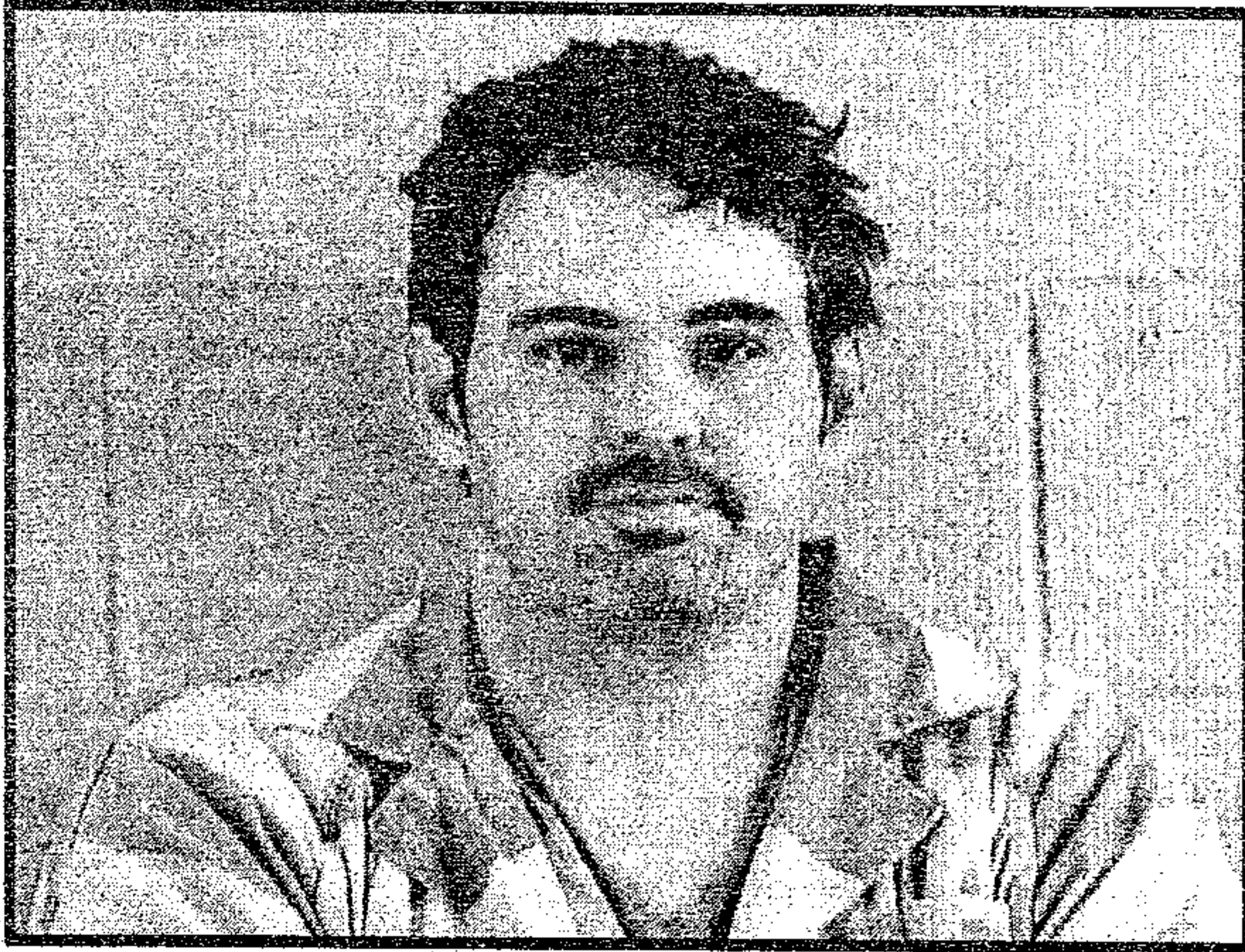

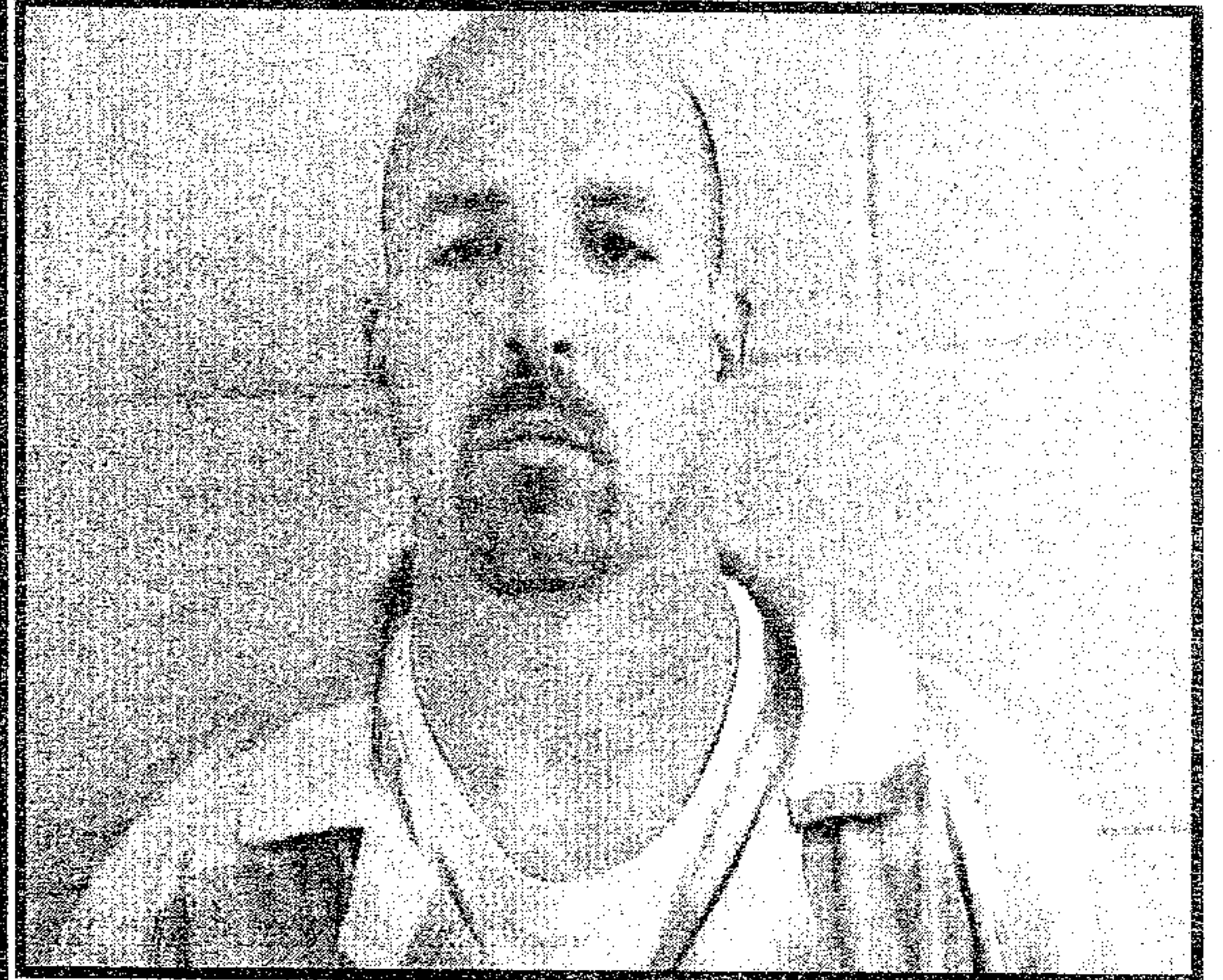
An inmate at the Loudon County Jail has racked up even more charges following an incident that occurred in the jail

It was very obvious that the male was giving false information. The male subject was patted down and a small plastic baggy of marijuana was found in his short pocket. The male was placed under arrest.

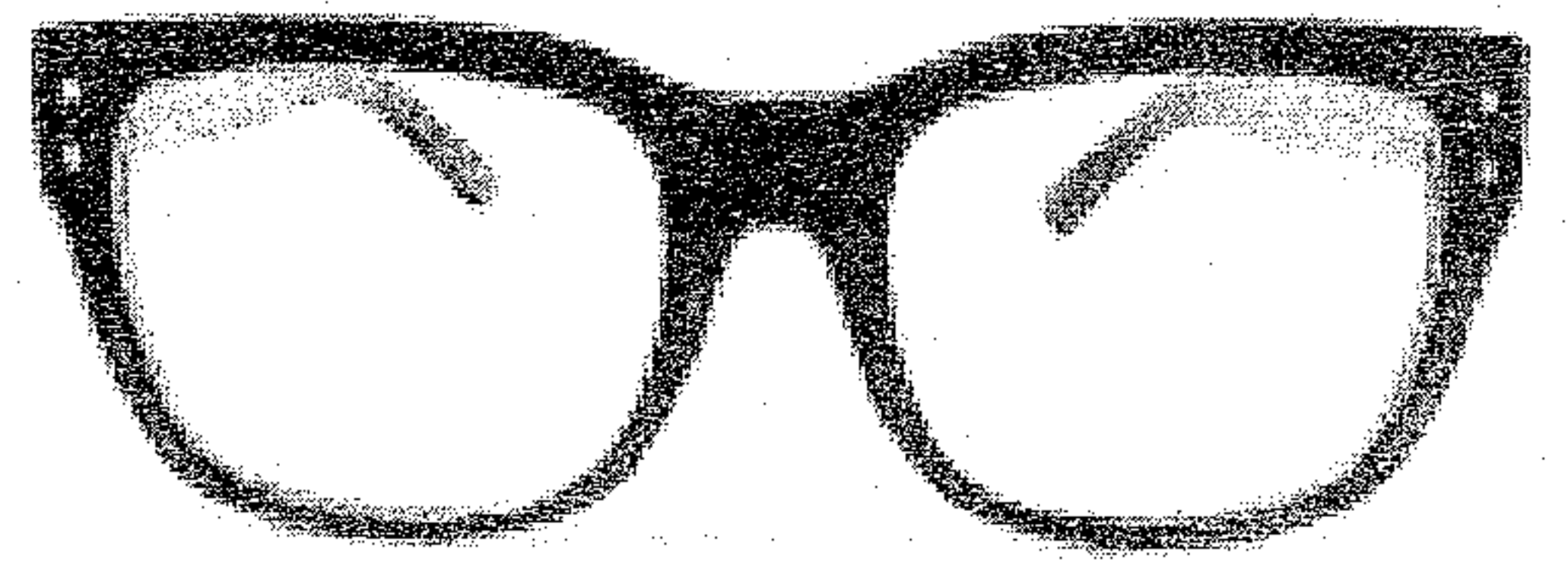
It was later learned his name was Nicholas Bahr and had an active Warrant out of Monroe Co. cpl. Michael Watkins LCSO made the arrest.

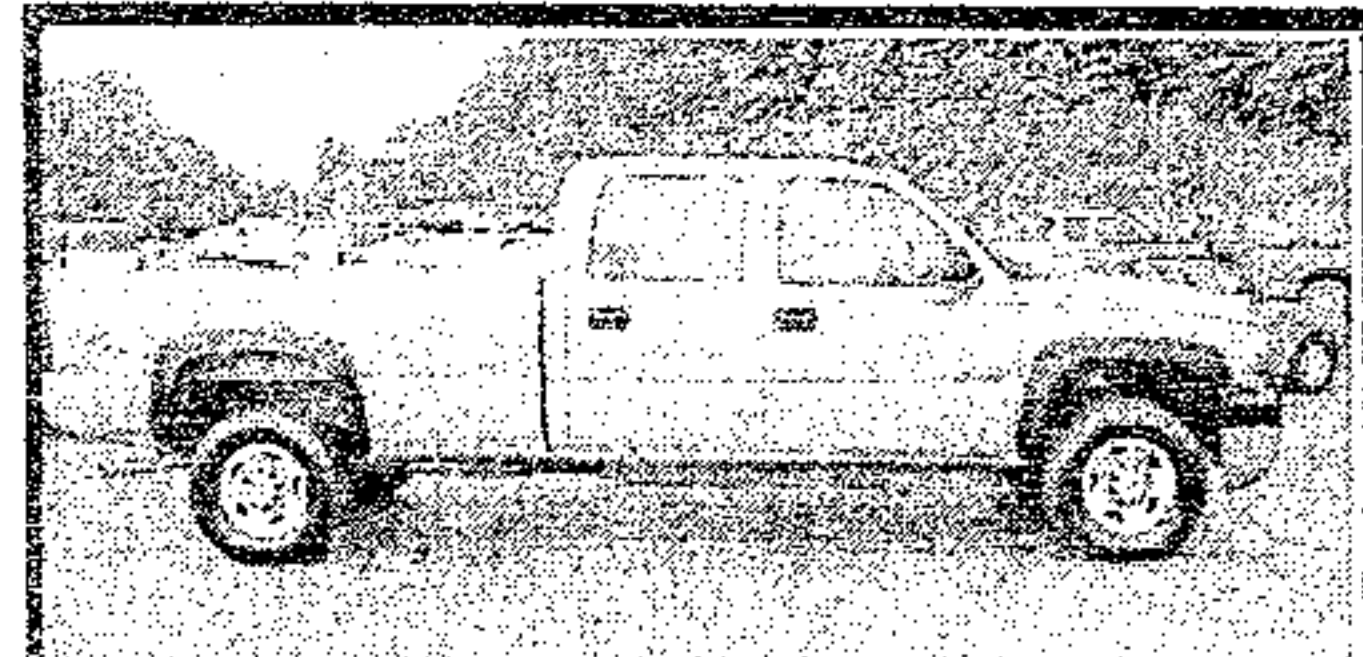

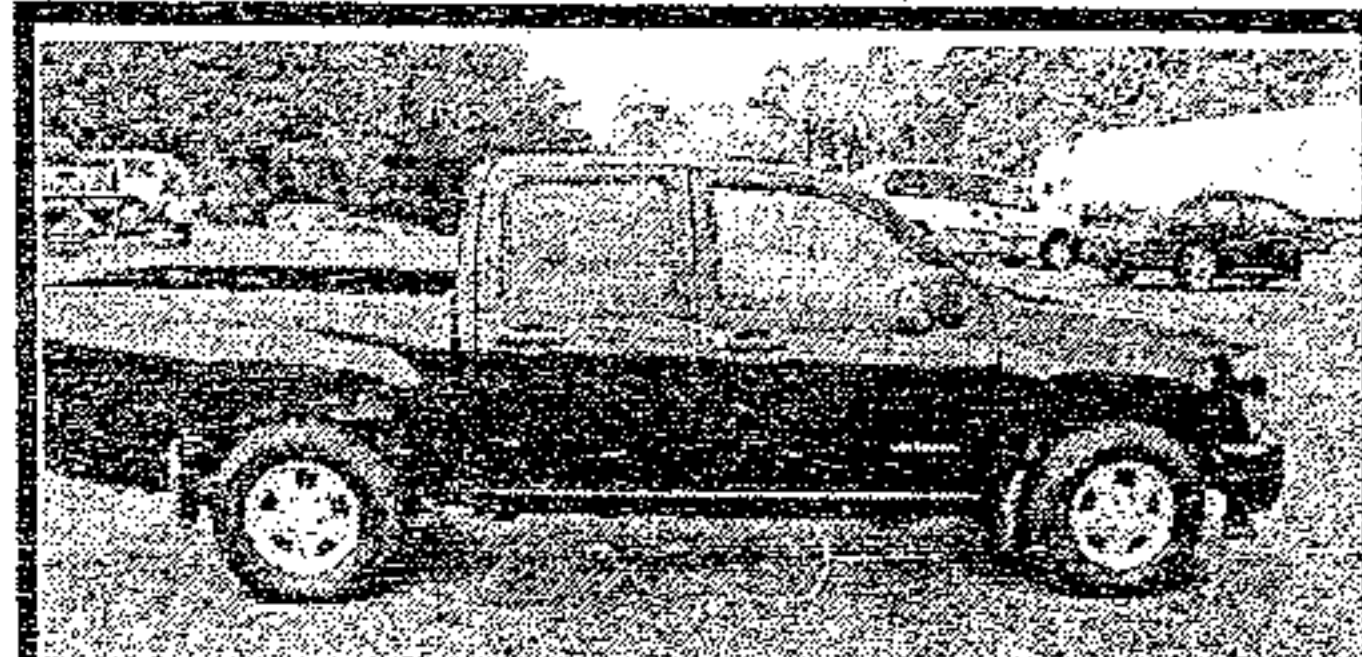

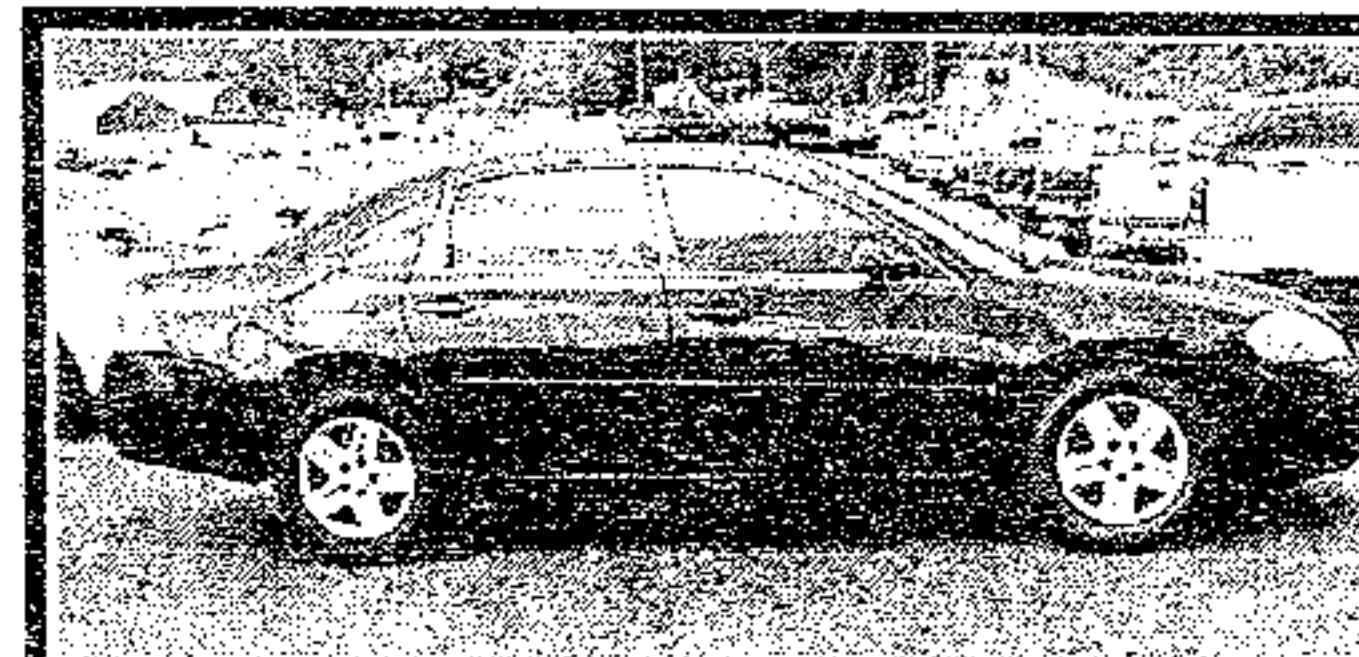
