

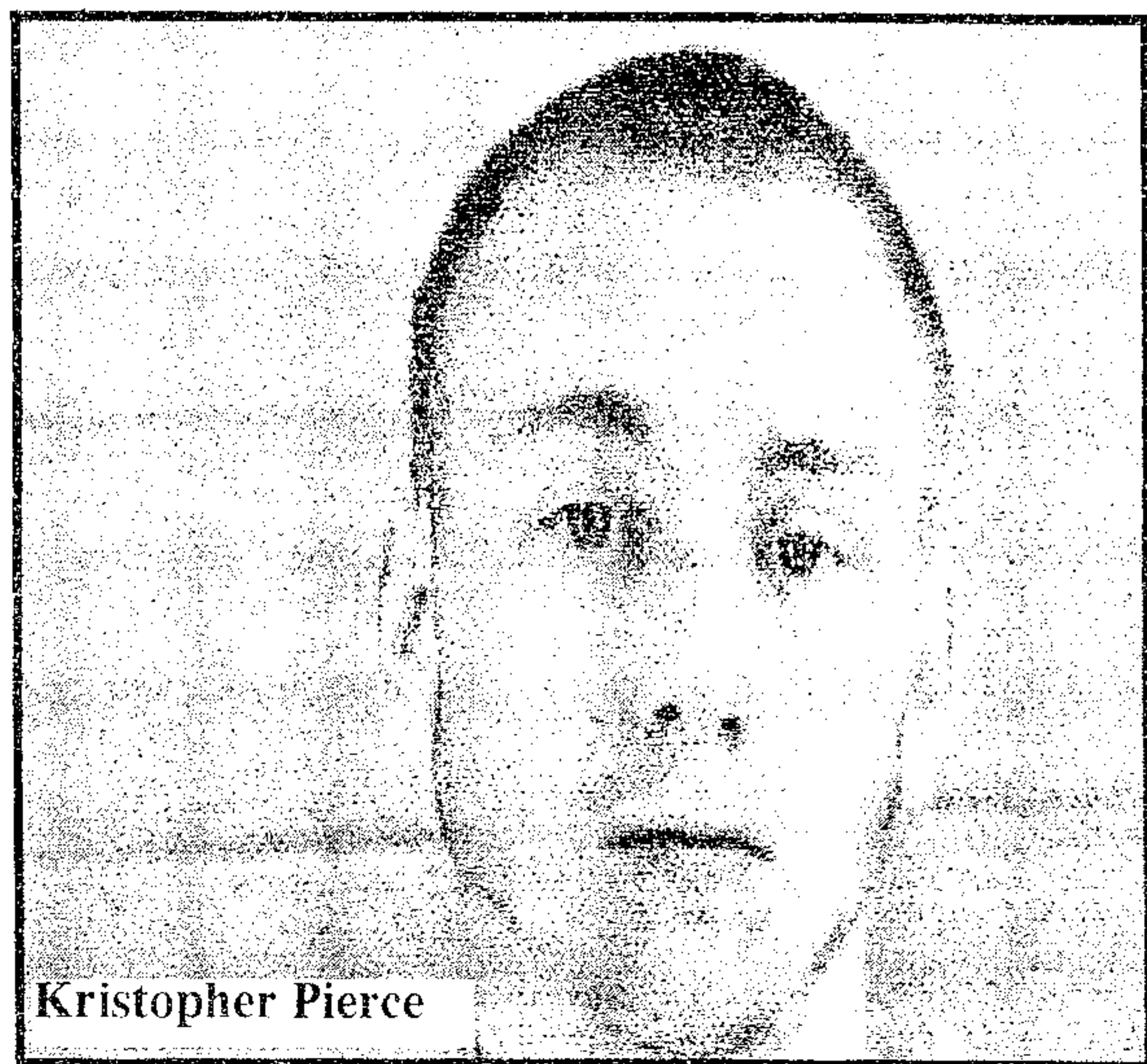

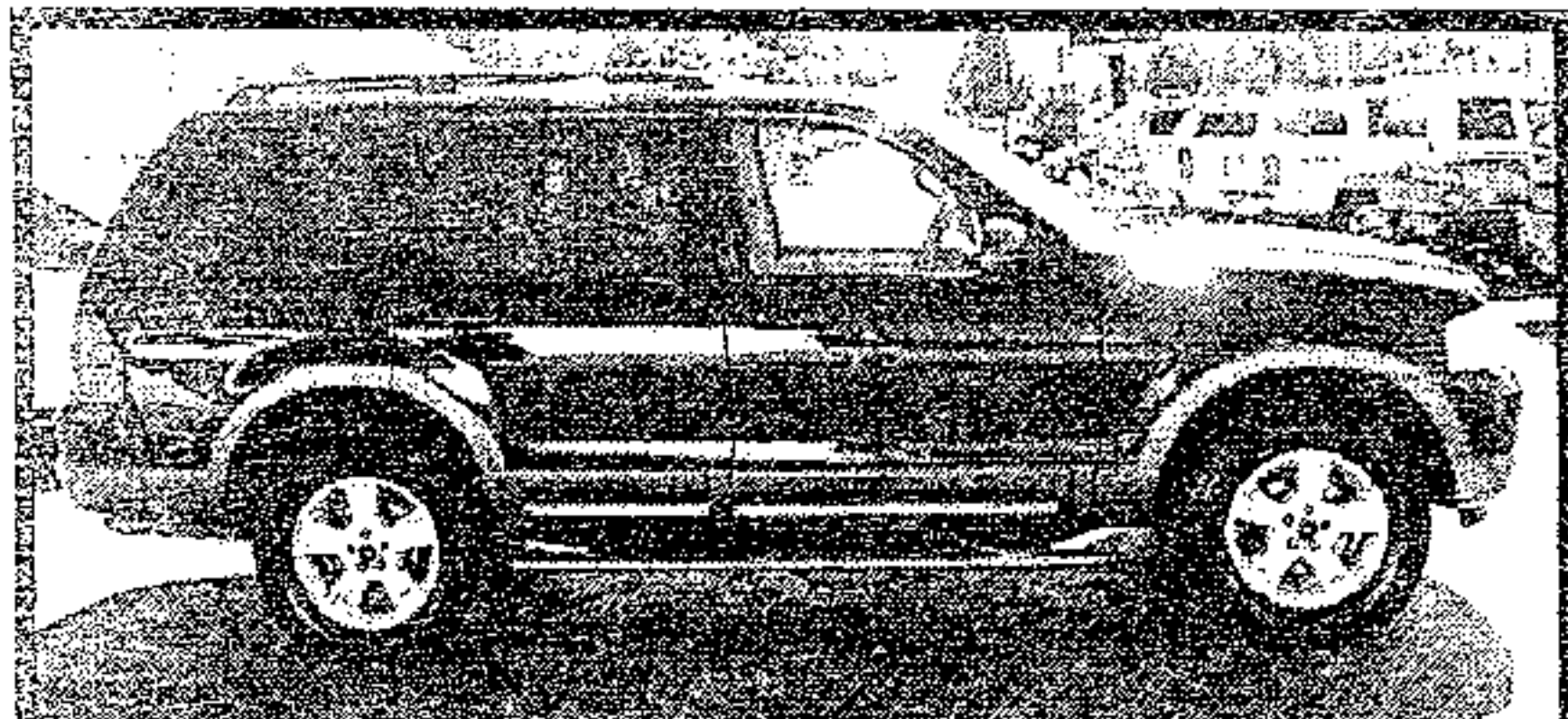

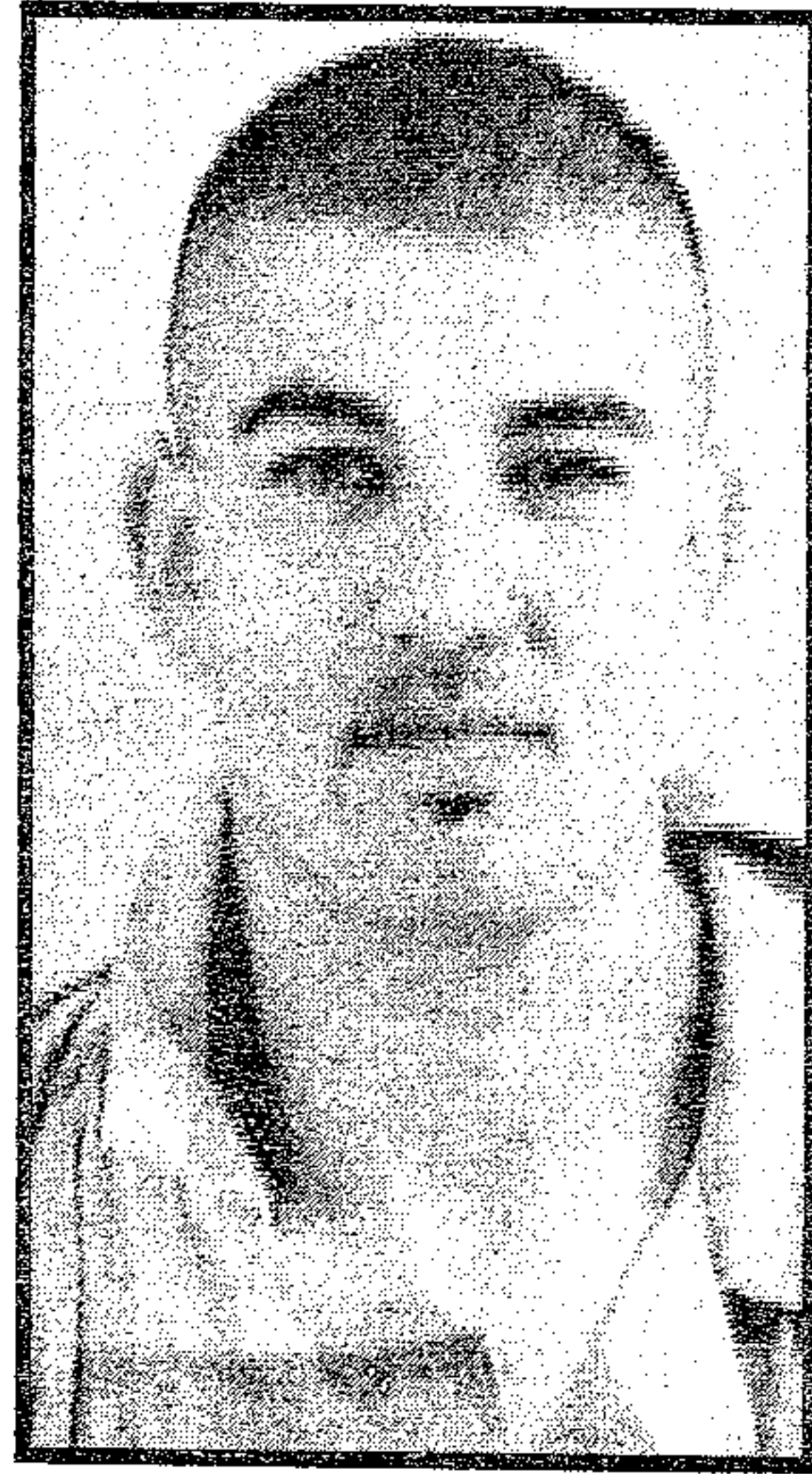


ing from the vehicle. The Deputy attempted to wake Mr. Green by tapping the window, when that failed the
