And I will say to my soul, "Soul, you have many goods laid up for many years; take your ease; eat, drink and be merry." (20) But God said to him, "Fool! This night your soul will be required of you; then whose will those things be which you have provided?" (21) "So is he who lays up treasure for himself, and is not rich toward God."

I realize that the focus of this parable is about "stuff", but I am also confident that it can be useful in considering the way in which each of us live. I am not wealthy and never have been, but if my life's focus is only about preparing to take care of myself then I am no different than the man with a plentiful crop.

I have the best employer that one could hope for with all the trimmings associated with midlevel management of a division of law enforcement detectives. Just as the man in the parable, I have a plentiful crop in the fields of my life; but look what Jesus says about farming;

Luke 10:2 (NKJV) Then He said to them, "The harvest is truly great but the laborers are few; therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest.

Where is the focus of your life? Are you working in the Lord's fields or are you building barns? You don't have to sell everything you own, quit your job and move across the country to be an effective witness for Christ;

that is just the calling God has placed on our hearts. You should, however, make sure that you are investing in the lives of others and that your own life is a reflection of the love of Christ and nothing else. None of us are promised tomorrow so let's give Jesus all that we have today!
