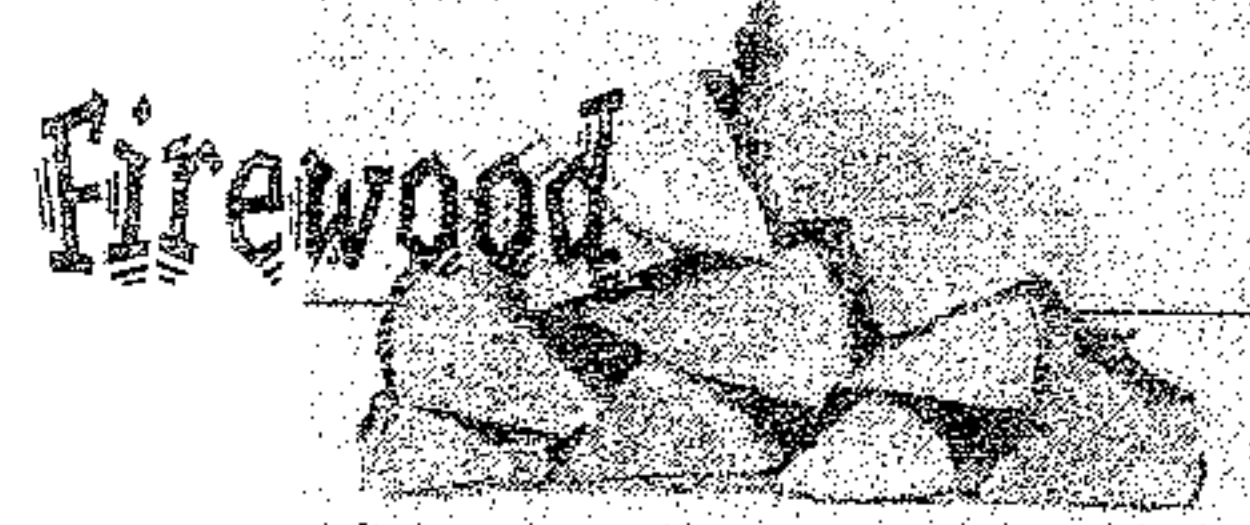
It was determined that John was a danger to himself and other and was placed under arrest.
