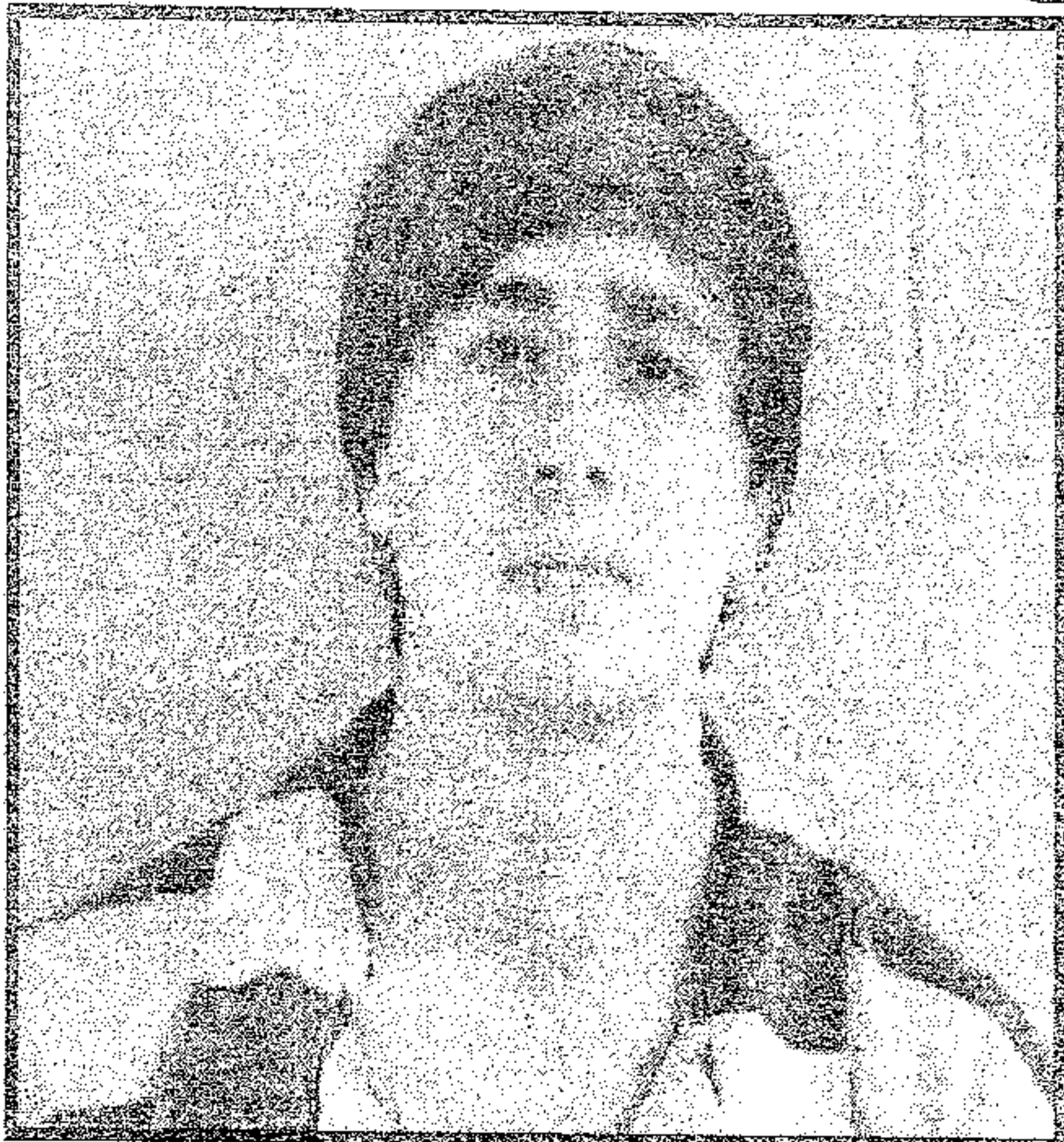

ing on neighbors doors. Upon Officer arrival James was located in some bushes he was then placed under arrest. Officer Brandon Nix LPD made the arrest.

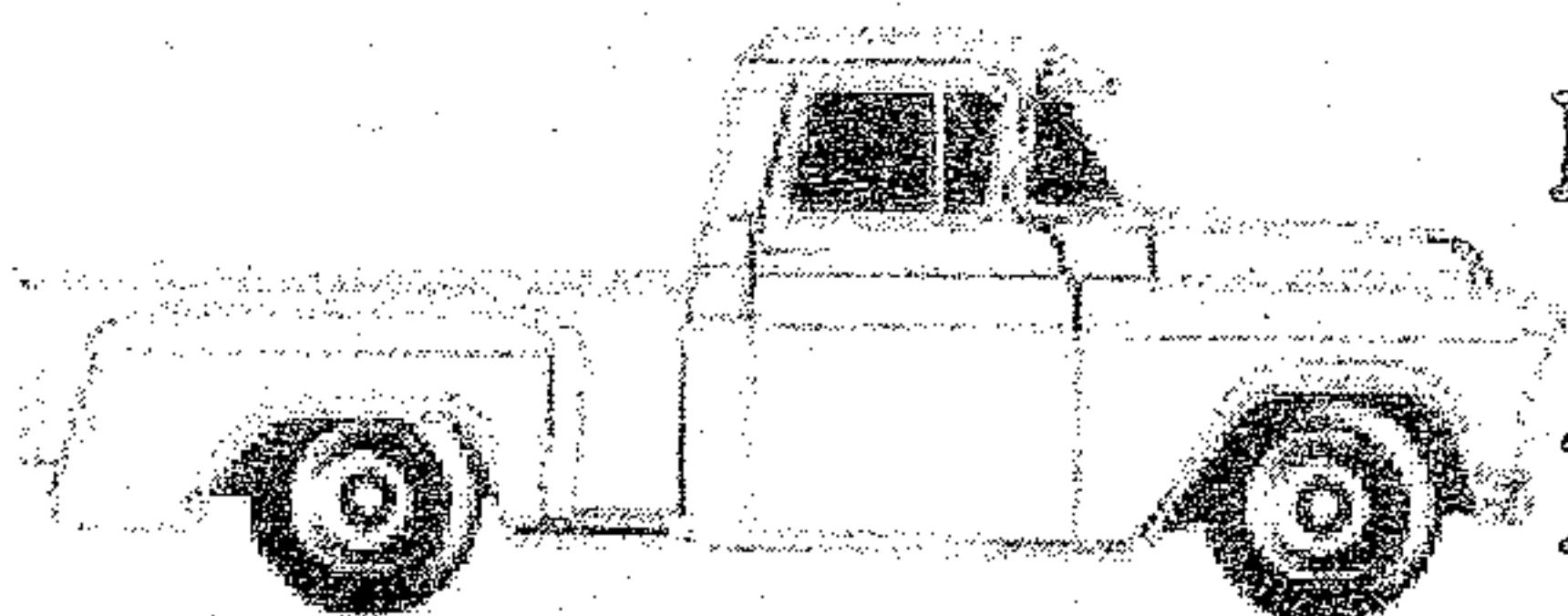
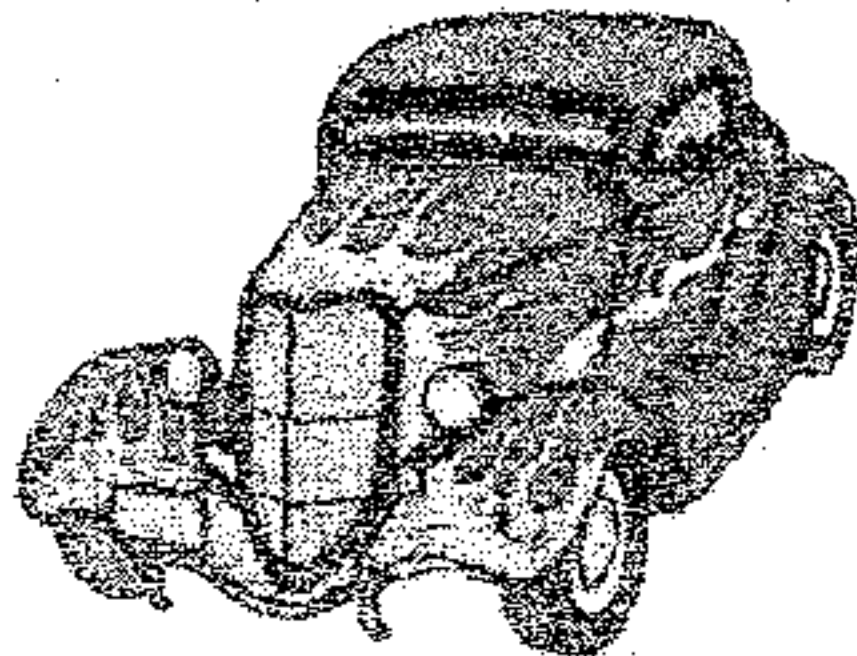
