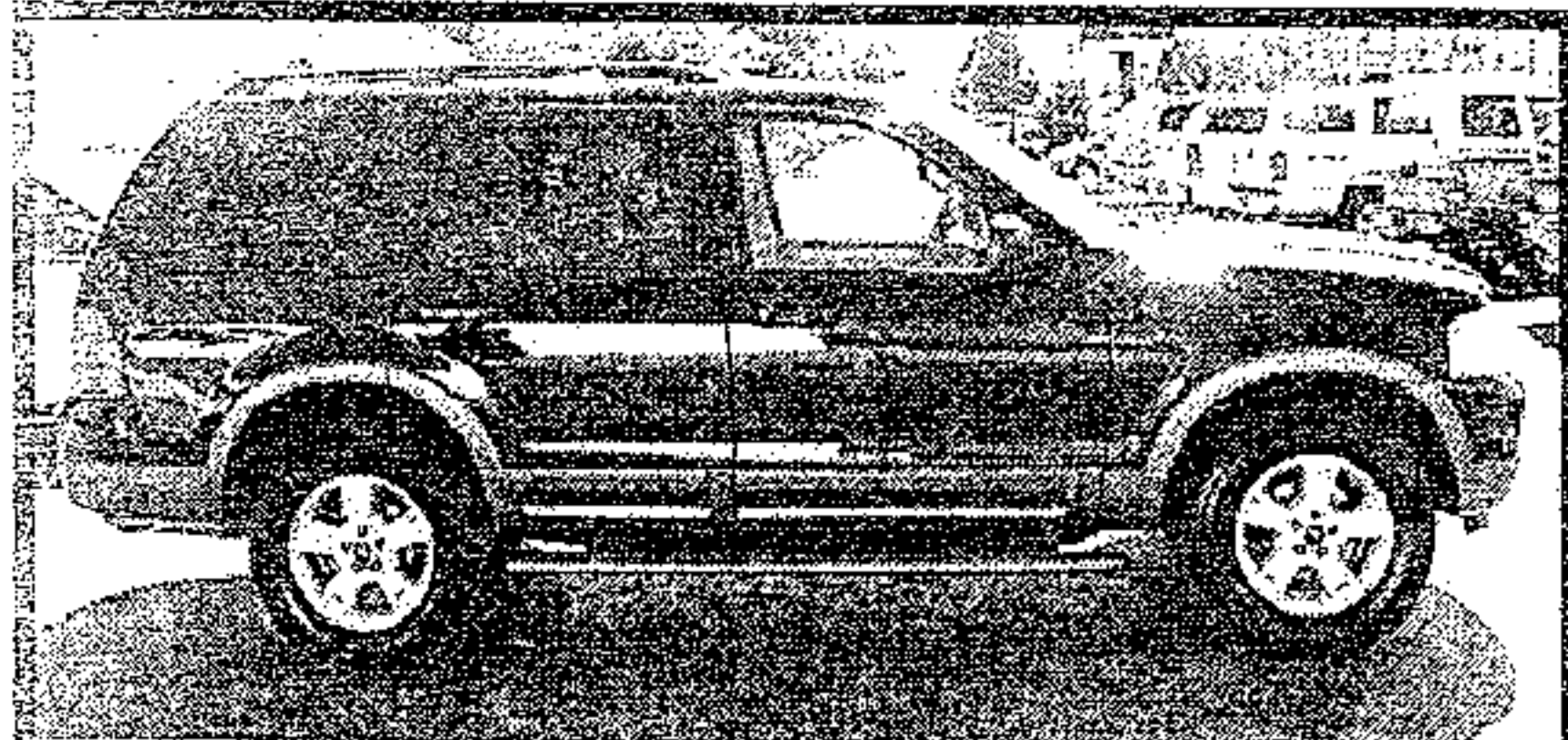

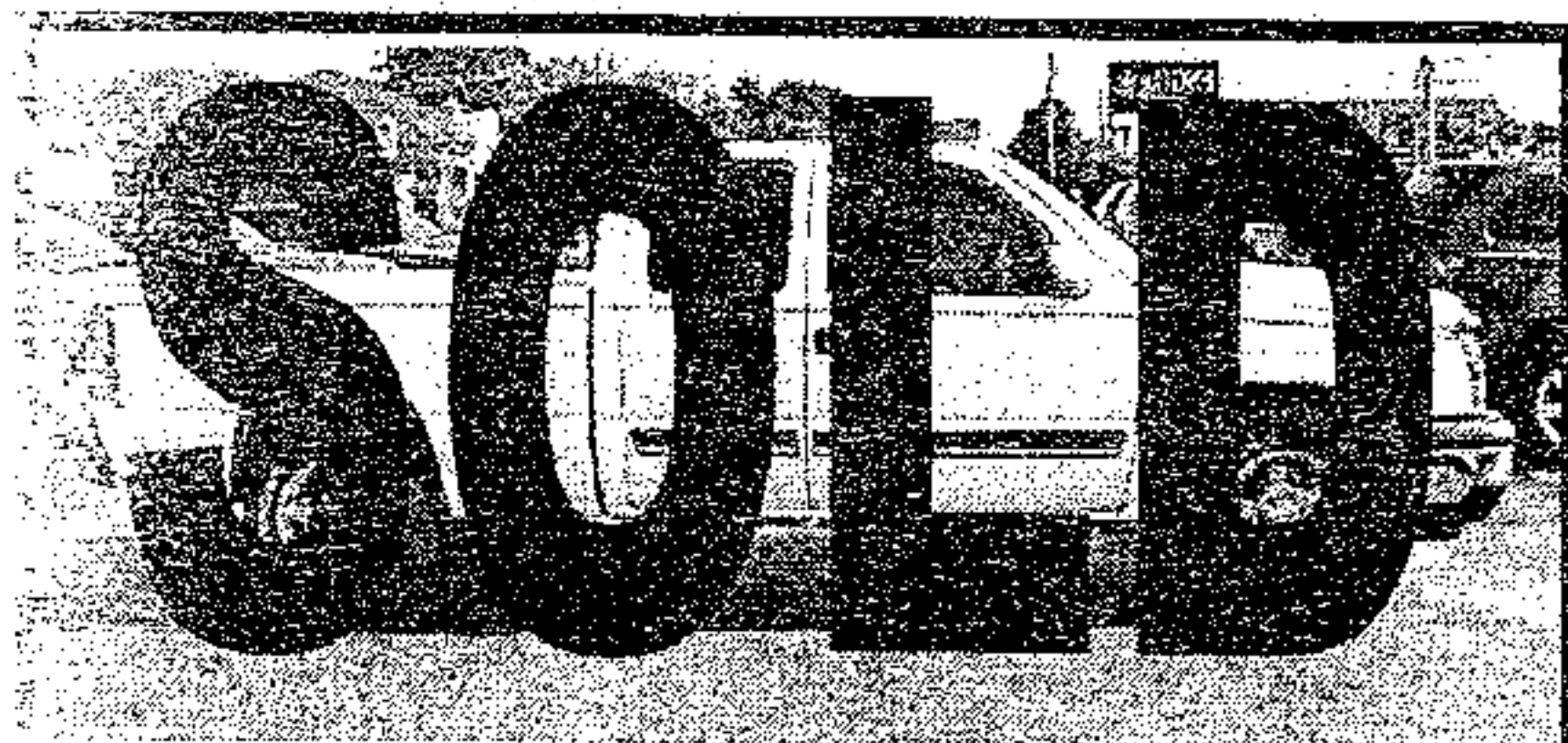

of probation out of Monroe County.

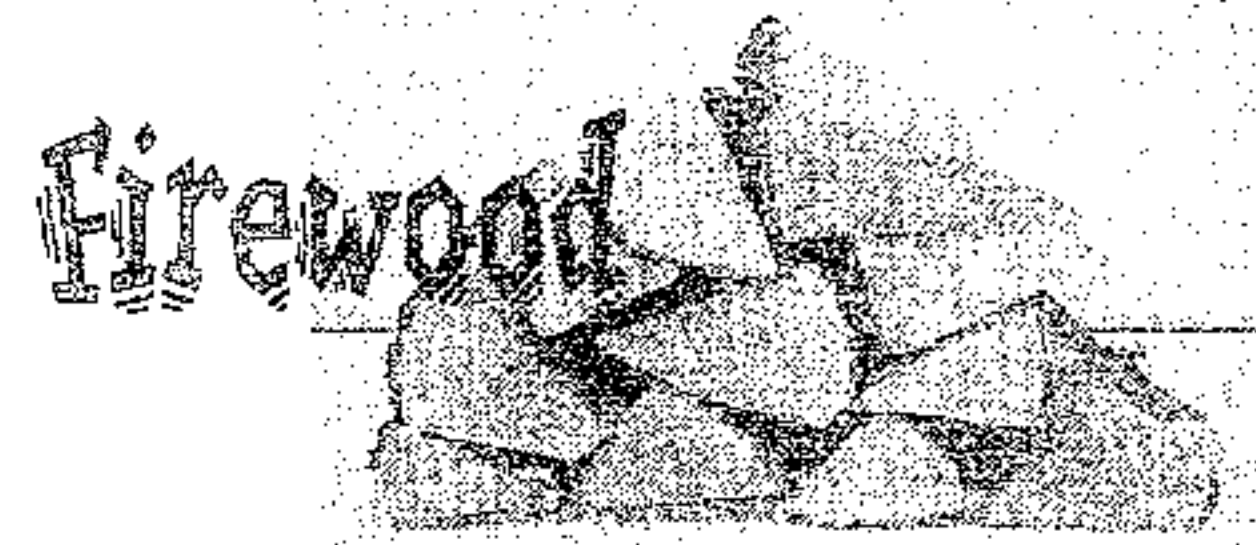
