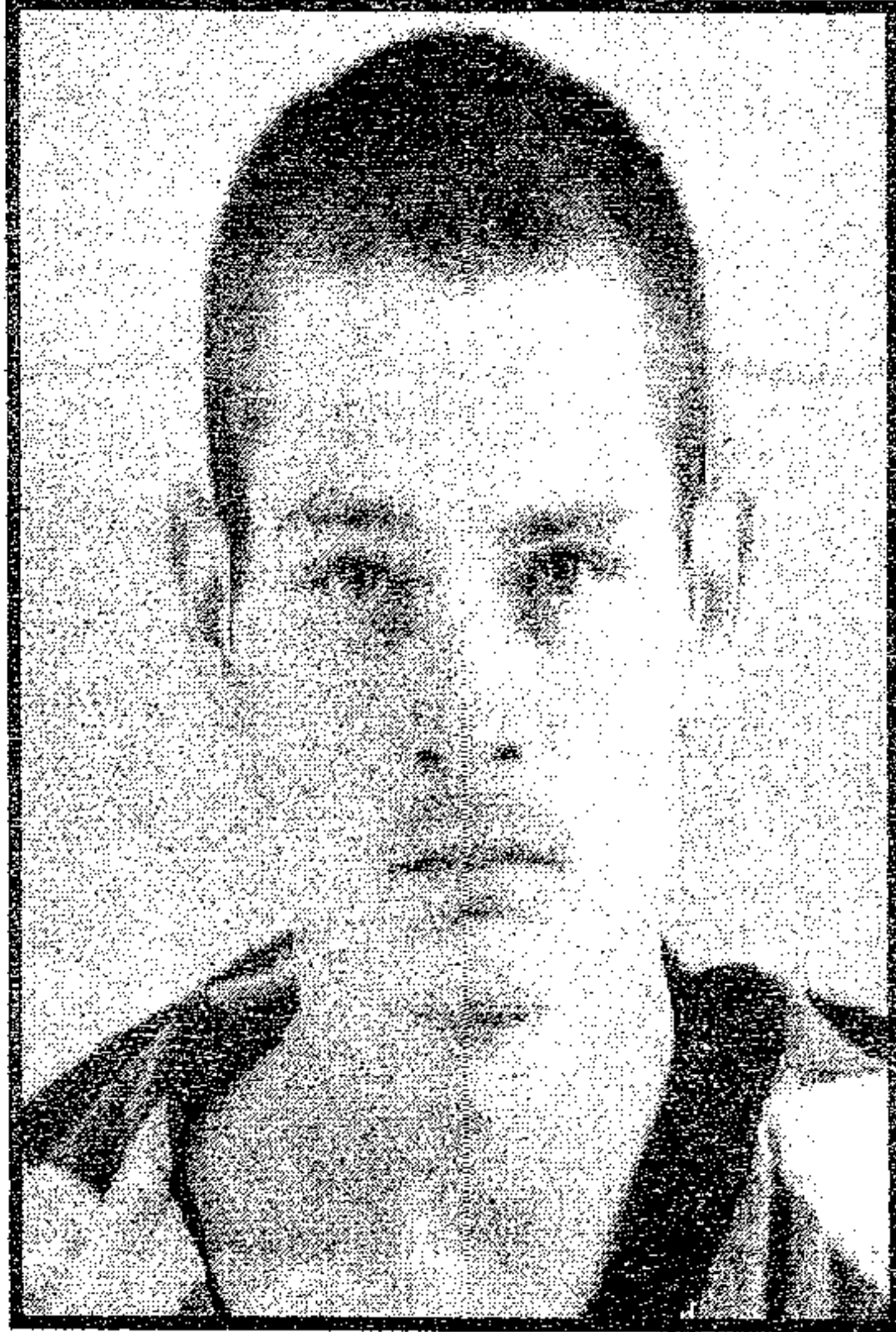

Shannon Noble, 25, Highway 95 North Greenback, was charged with Manufacture/sell/Poss. of controlled Substance, and Maintaining a

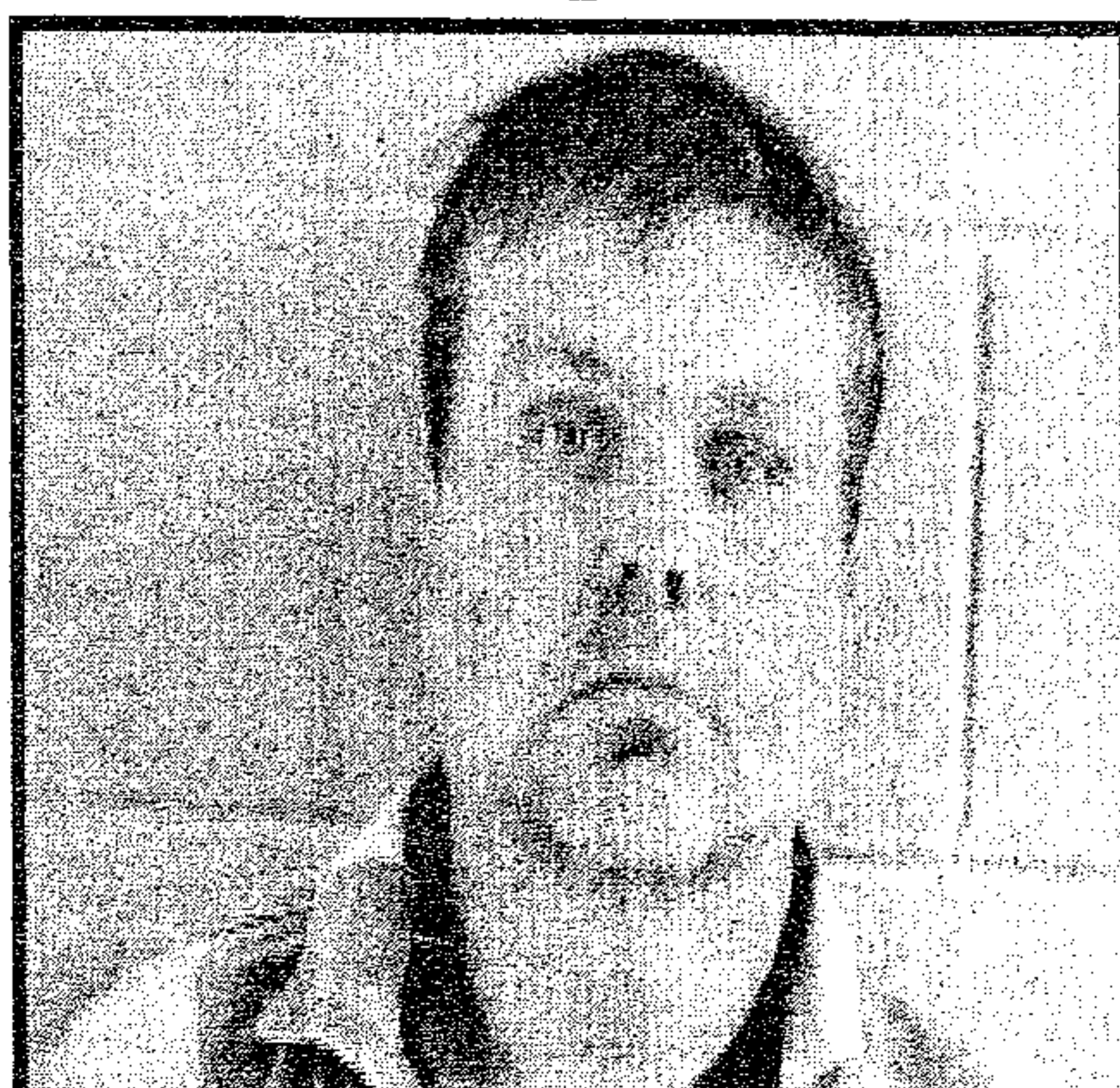

stated that the residence is for sale as a part of the divorce and an agent and the victim was going to show the house and the defendant showed up at the showing and was aware that she was not to be at the residence.




