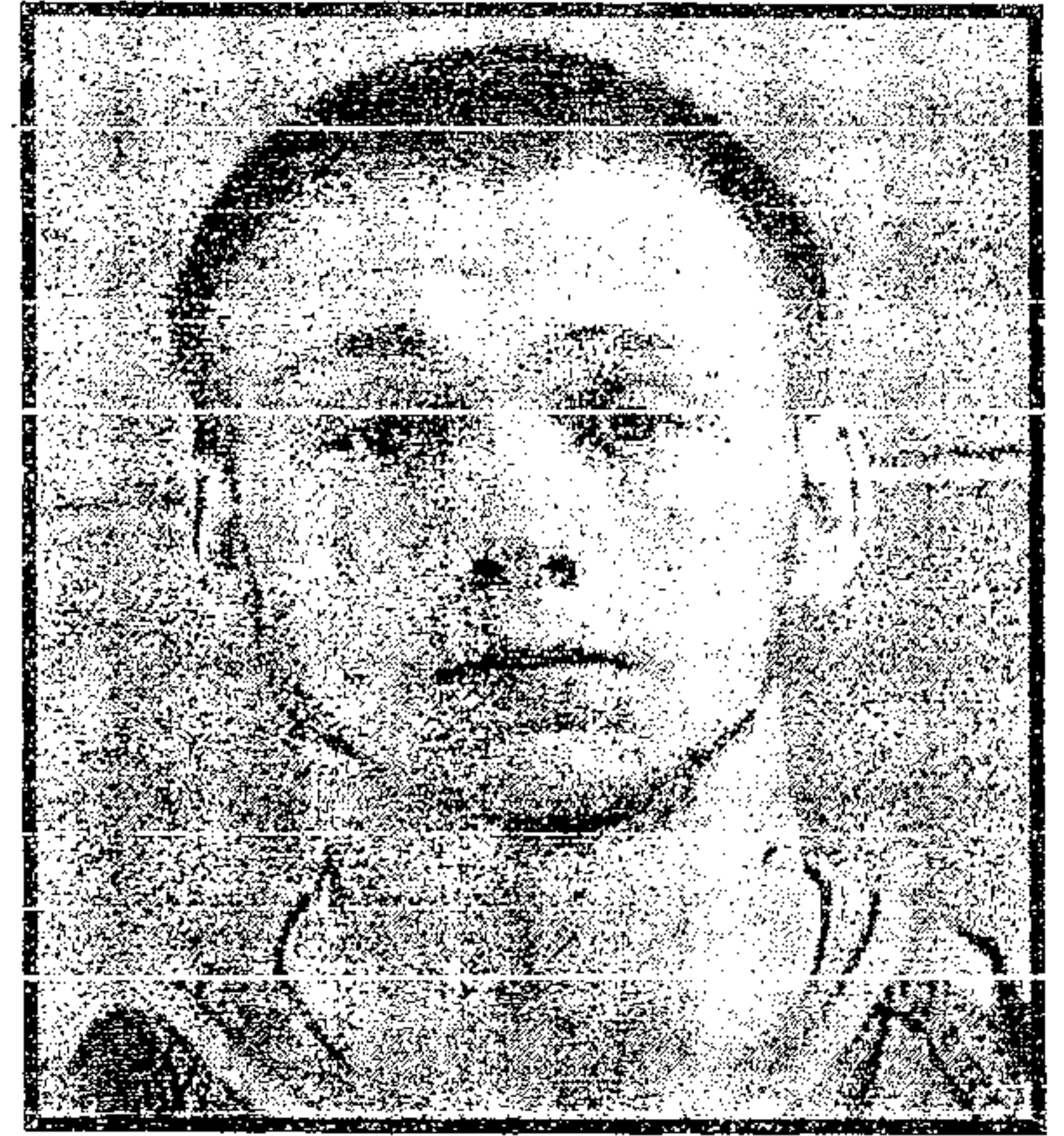

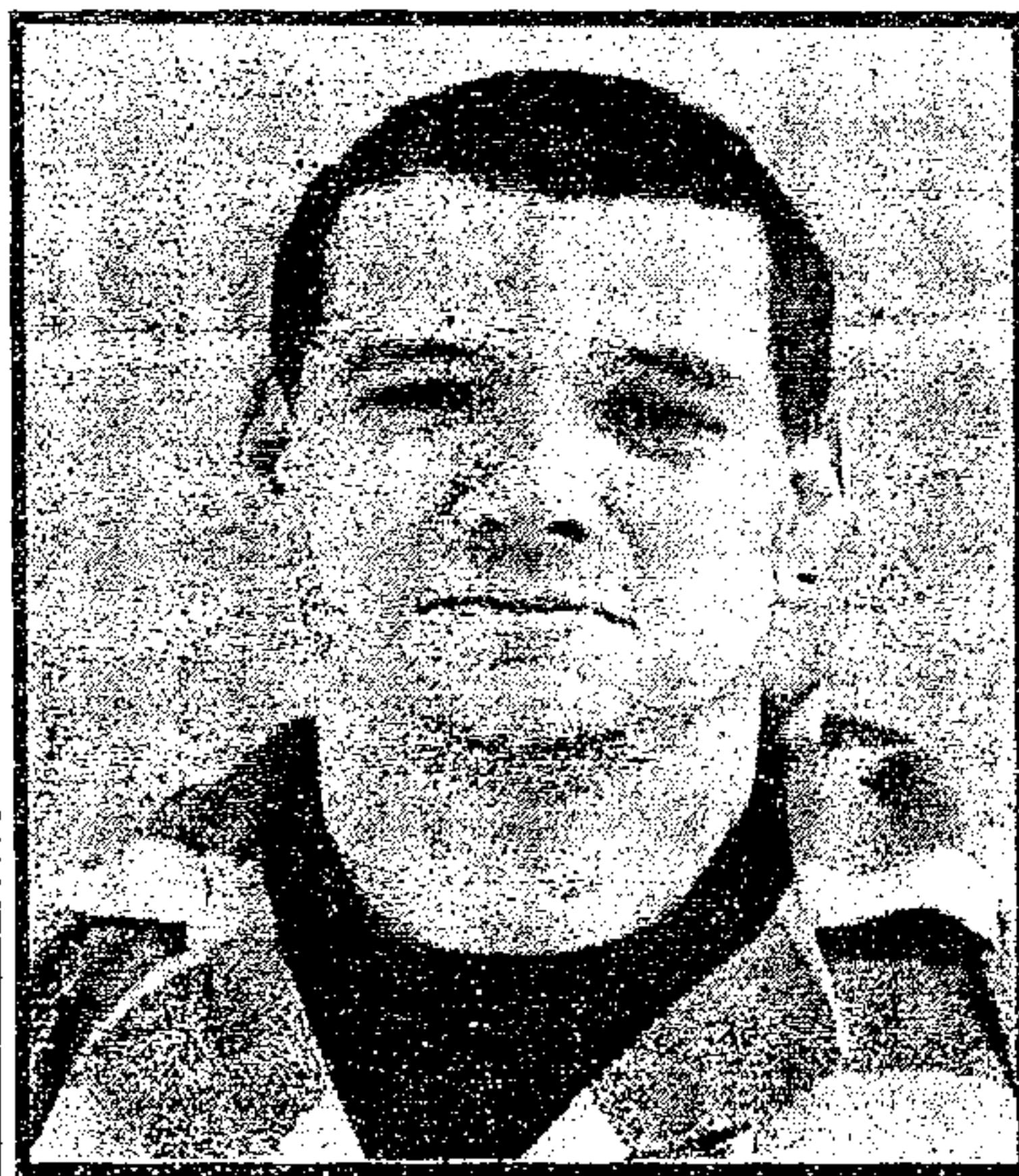

men just minutes after they allegedly robbed a family member of one of the men of her prescription pain medication just moments after she walked out the door of a local pharmacy.

Randall Lynn Randy Garrett, 38, Turkey Pen Road, Maryville was charged with criminal responsibility for

facilitation of felony and possession of controlled scheduled II substance for resale.

Landon Blair Melton, 19, Colonial Circle Road, Maryville was charged with robbery and possession of controlled schedule II substance for resale.

According to affidavits, Garrett and Melton went to Food City on Highway 321 in Lenoir

City where Garrett knew his aunt was getting her pain medication prescription filled. Garrett stayed in the vehicle, while Melton watched the victim pick up her medicine. When the victim got to the parking lot, Melton grabbed her medicine out of her hand and ran.

The lawmen reported Melton ran back to the vehicle where Garrett

was waiting and the pair then fled the parking lot. They were apprehended at a location

on East Broadway approximately three minutes after the robbery (see Robbery ctd. pg. 3)

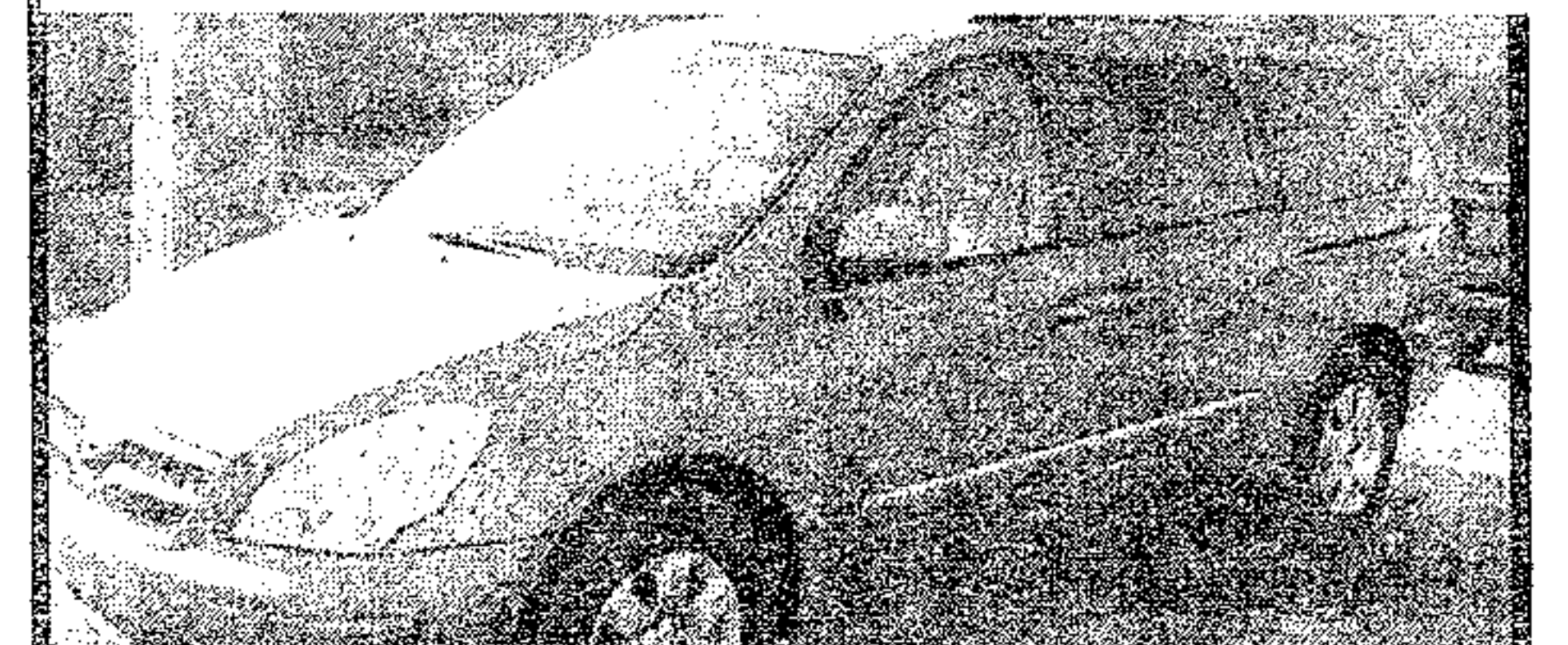

pills as they are the number one problem in Loudon County even over meth and marijuana.

Several vehicles, U.S. currency and other assets were also seized from those suspected in selling drugs in and around Loudon County.

In the roundup Joy Elizabeth Barron, 41, of Evans Way, Lenoir City, was charged with sale and delivery of schedule II controlled substance. According to the warrant, on September 12, 2012 agents with the 9th DTF conducted a controlled purchase of three 30mg schedule II oxycodone pills for \$105 from Joy Barron at her residence on Evans Way in Lenoir City. The controlled buy was accomplished using an undercover drug agent

who has conducted numerous drug investigations throughout their law enforcement career. The buy from Joy was recorded the pills were identified as Oxycodone, a schedule II narcotic. Officer B. Burley, 9th DTF made the arrest.

Angel Colon, 23, of Fout Town Rd, Lenoir City, was charged with sale and delivery of schedule VI controlled substance. According to the warrant, on January 7, 2013 a confidential source under the direction of Agent Brendan Deboer, 9th DTF conducted a controlled purchase of marijuana. The transaction occurred between the confidential source and Angel Colon in front of his mothers house on Atlanta Street in Loudon. The source handed Colon \$50 in pre-recorded buy money and Colon handed the source a

plastic baggie containing a green leafy substance believed to be marijuana. Officer Kent Russell, LPD made the arrest.

Kristopher Pierce, 18, of Stockton Valley Road, Loudon, was charged with facilitation of sale and delivery of schedule VI controlled substance. According to the warrant, on July 2, 2012 agents from the 9th DTF conducted a controlled purchase of marijuana from Crez Mayotte at the BP Gas Station in Loudon. Accompanying Mayotte was her, at the time

boyfriend, Kristopher Pierce. Mr. Pierce was believed to be confined to house arrest at the time of the deal and was in fact in the Loudon City area distributing marijuana with Mayotte. The drugs came from the vehicle that Mayotte and Pierce were in and after the deal Pierce was seen talking with Mayotte while he pumped gas into the car. Officer Kent Russell, LPD made the arrest.

James Johnson, 39, of E. 6th Avenue, Lenoir City, was charged with possession of a schedule II controlled substance. According to the warrant, on February 21, 2013 James Johnson was at his residence on E 6th avenue, Lenoir City where officers from the Lenoir City Police Department and the 9th DTF arrived to serve an arrest warrant on another subject at that residence. 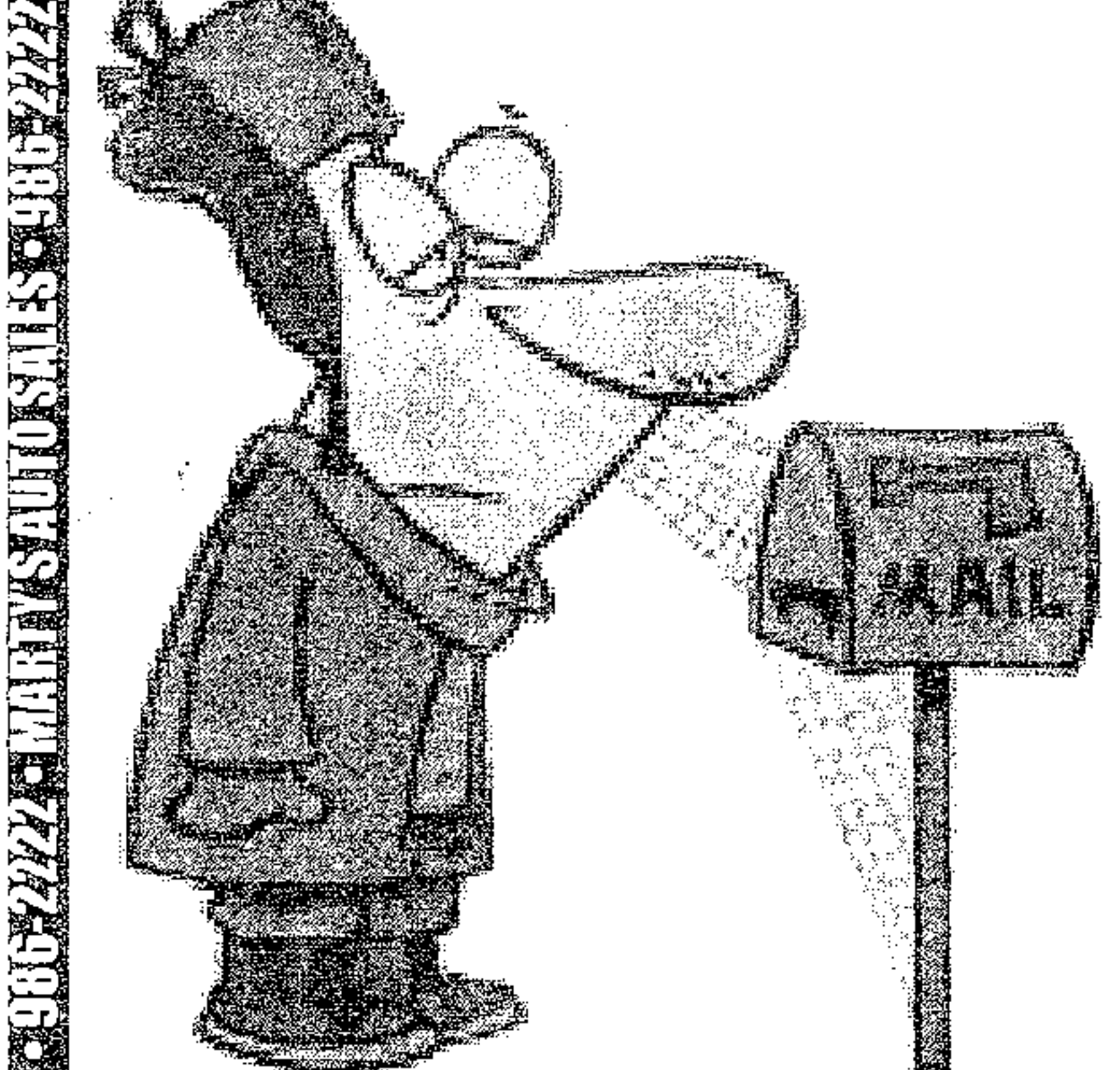
