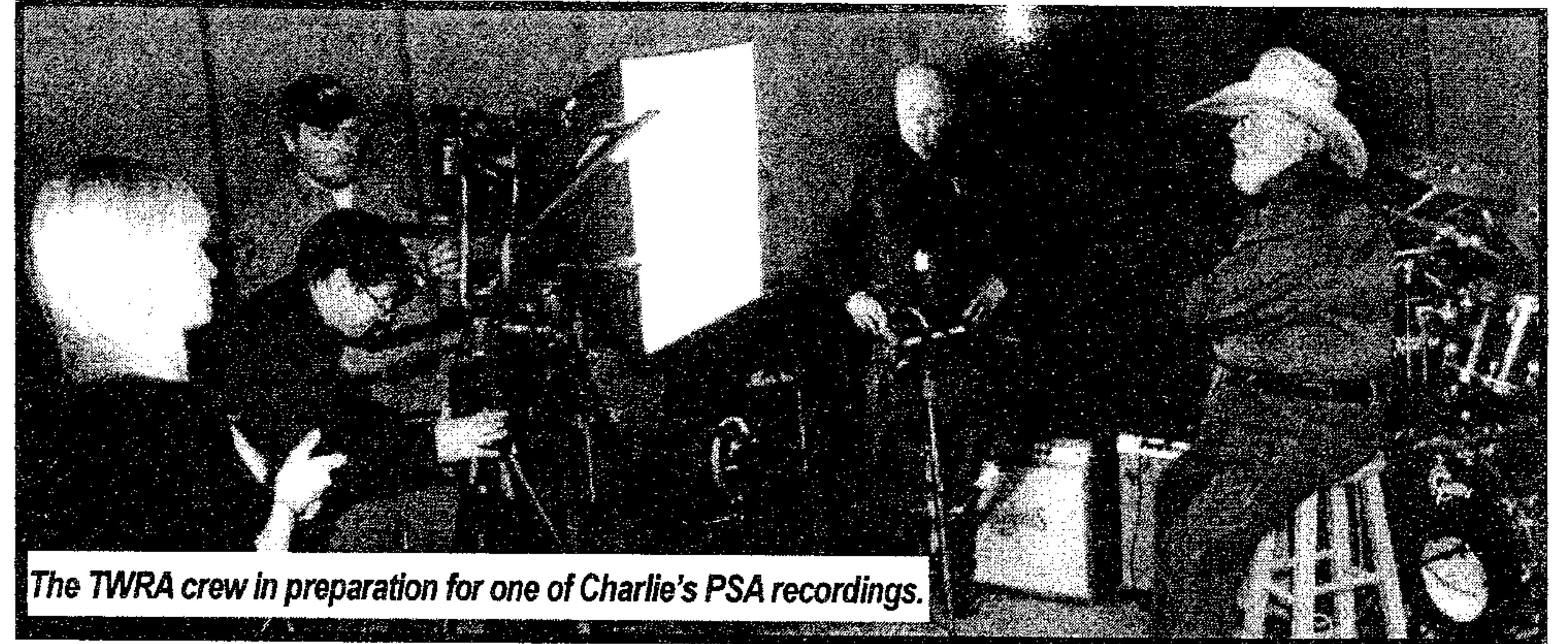

**Bolt**

Deputy Chris Hutchens, LCSO reported he observed a vehicle on Hwy 72 near Vonore Road that was speeding 69mph in a 55mph zone and followed he it. The deputy observed

the vehicle swerve several times and stopped it. The driver was identified as Aaron Bolt.

Mr. Bolt stated he had not consumed any alcoholic beverages, but the deputy reported Bolt had a strong odor

of an alcoholic beverage on his person and performed poorly on sobriety tasks.

The lawman told Mr. Bolt he was using three sets of cuffs to provide less strain due to Mr. Bolt having a large frame, but when he attempted to place him in the cuffs, Bolt stiffened up and would not comply.

The deputy stated when Bolt was told he would be tasered if he did not comply, Bolt became calm and got into the patrol car, however he would not put his leg into the car and continually asked the deputy not to arrest him because his wife is a teacher.

When Bolt would not

comply with putting his leg in the car and when the deputy attempted to put his leg in the car, Bolt grabbed him and dragged the deputy into the back seat of the car, attempting to get his taser.

When Bolt could not get the officer's taser, he went after his weapon and was able to get the weapon un-snapped from the holster, while the deputy worked to free himself by all means and call for backup.

The deputy reported Bolt laughed at him, telling him to come on, but when he heard the other sirens approaching, he released the deputy and was taken into custody without further incident.

Aaron Scott Bolt, 37, of Steekee Creek Road, Loudon was charged with aggravated assault, resisting arrest, DUI 3rd, and refusal of implied consent. Deputy Chris Hutchens, LCSO made the arrest.

Investigator Jeff Russell charged a Knoxville man theft after he reportedly stole a ring from a local woman's residence, then sold it at a Knoxville jewelry store.

Sean Taylor Atchley, 27, of Rushland Park Blvd, Knoxville was charged with theft over \$500.

According to a warrant filed by Investigator Jeff Russell, LCSO CID, on or about November 3, 2012, the victim reported her black hills gold ring was missing from her residence and she felt Sean Atchley had taken the ring without permission.

Upon further investigation the investigator found that Sean had sold the ring to Fountain City Jewelers in Knoxville. The victim identified the ring as being hers.

Deputy John Maple, LCSO made the arrest.

**Man charged after beaten and choked victim freed**

According to the warrant, filed by the victim, she reported her boyfriend, John Phelps, was staying with her at her residence in Lenoir City. She stated she was sitting on top of him when he struck her in the mouth with a closed fist. A few hours later, the victim fixed her something to eat and went back to the bedroom and she reached across the bed to get her medication when Phelps yelled at her "I told you not to wake me up b%\$#!" and took his forearm and pushed the victim to her side of the bed.

Phelps then got on top of the victim and began striking her with a jewelry box around her face. The victim acted like she was knocked out in an attempt to make him stop but Phelps picked up a glass of wine and threw it in her face to bring her to. Phelps then began choking the victim with his hands. The victim put her fingers in the attackers eyes to get him to stop and then attempted to reach for the phone and call 911 but Phelps got the phone away from her and pulled it out of the wall.

At this time the victim tried to get away but Phelps pulled her back down and punched

her in the mouth with a closed fist. The victim did get away from Phelps and ran to the living room to call 911 but Phelps followed her and pulled the phone from that wall as well. The victim had visible bruising over her entire face, ears and arms. After this altercation, John Phelps left the residence. An order of protection and report was filed the same day.

John Richard Phelps, 57, of Ridgecrest Drive, Maryville, was charged

with assault by domestic violence. Deputy Jason Arden LCSO made the arrest.

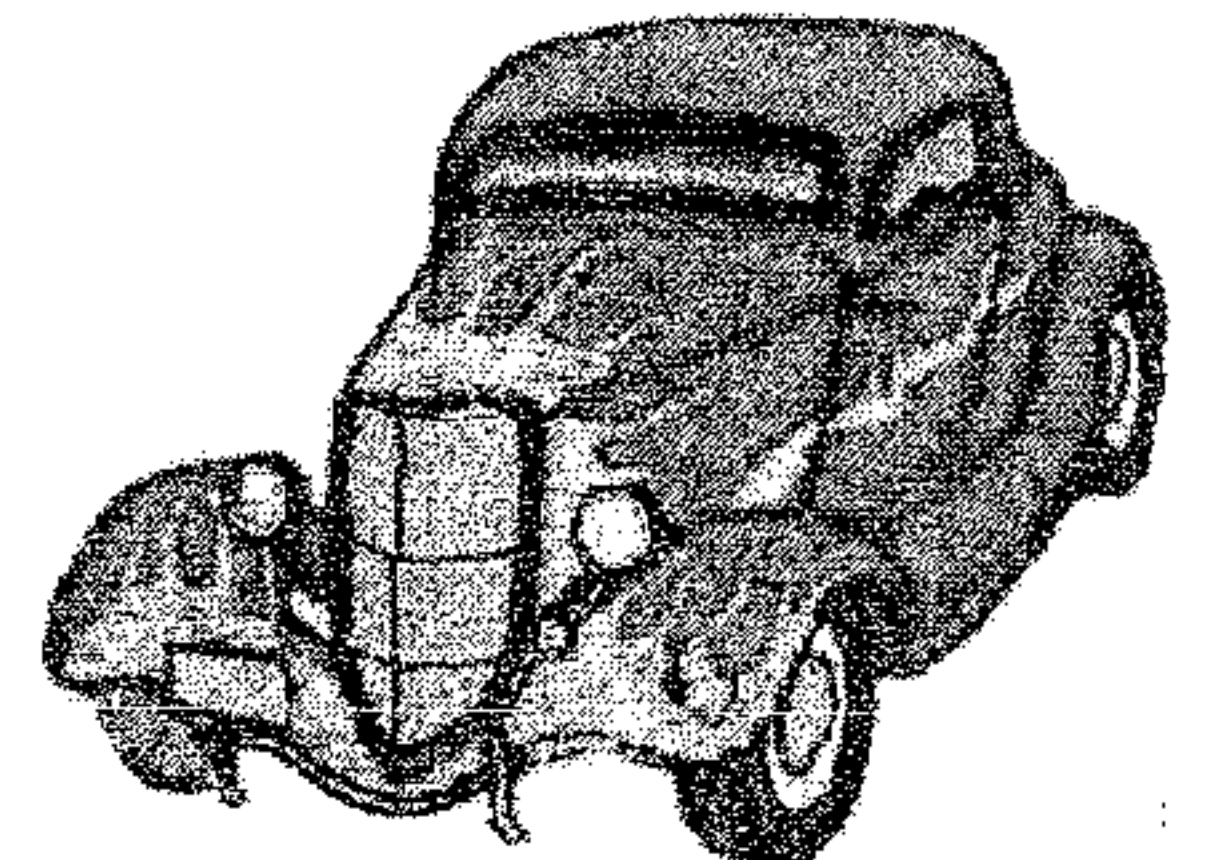
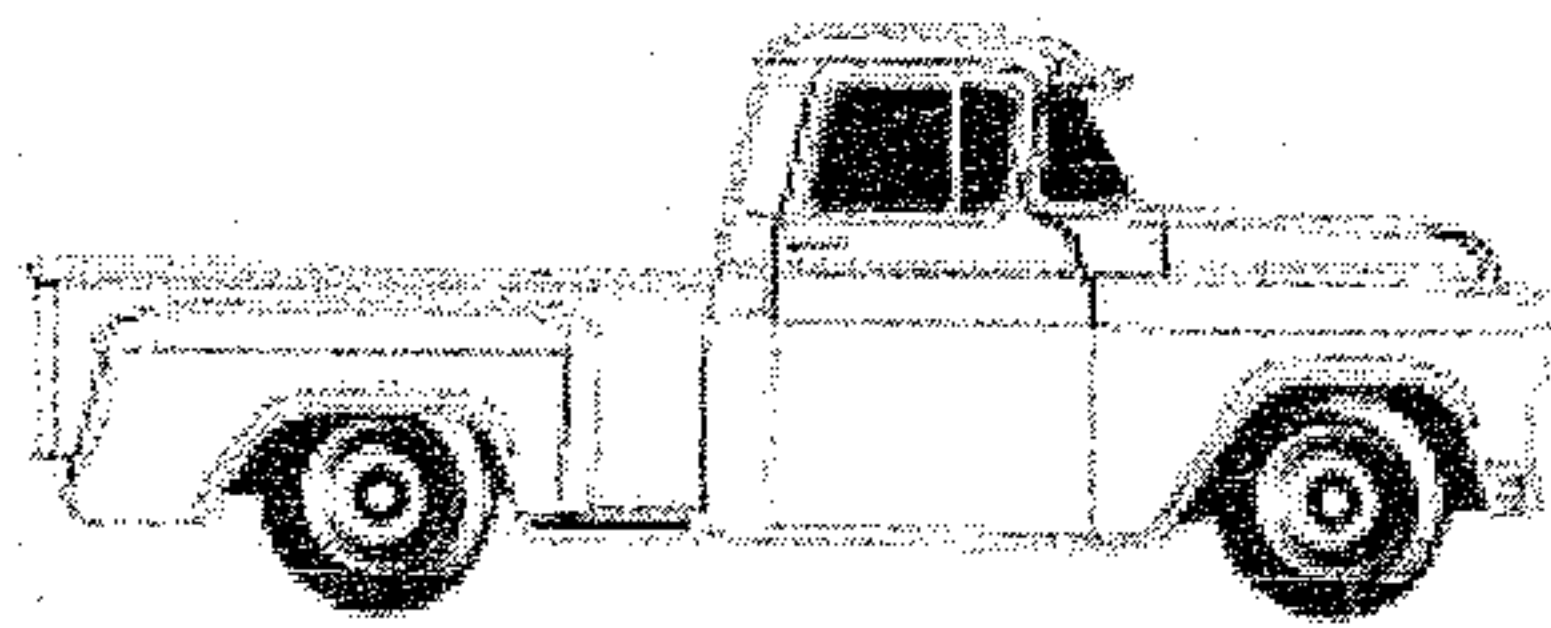

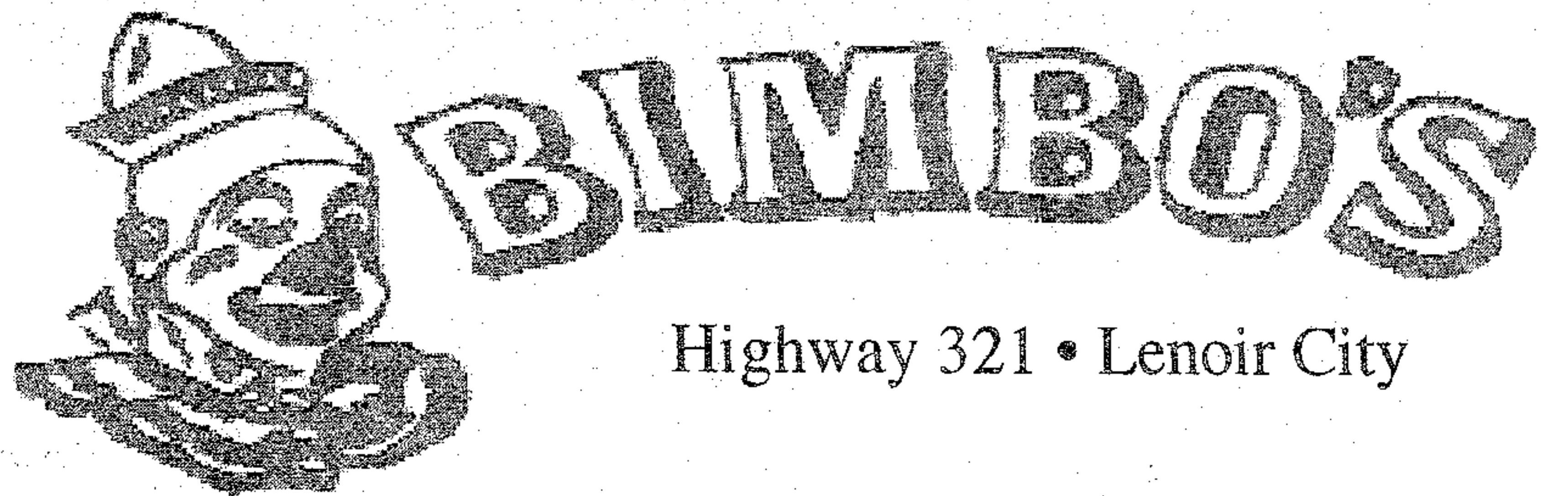

**Lethcoe**

A Tellico Plains man faces theft charges after he and at least three other persons allegedly worked together on two separate occasions to steal several head of cattle from a Philadelphia location in early November, 2012. The cattle were then sold in Alabama and Athens, Tennessee.

According to a warrant filed by Detective Jeff Russell, LCSO CID, on or about November 3, 2012 Christopher Vernon Lethcoe, James Matthew Kiser and James Gary Hill did go to a field located on Dry Valley Road in Philadelphia. In the field were several black cows. Mr. Kiser and Mr. Hill backed a cattle trailer up to a gate

and loaded four cows and those cattle were taken to a location in Sweetwater at a Chris-Gunter's residence.

The cattle were picked up the next day by Chris Lethcoe and Gary Hill and were taken to Russellville, Alabama where they were sold at an auction house.

On or about the 5th of November the same two subjects, Hill and Kiser, along with Chris Lethcoe went back to the same field and loaded four more cattle and did the same and left them overnight at the same place and took these cattle to Athens Stockyard and sold them to an unknown person outside of the sale. Hill and Lethcoe took these cattle

to the sale.

The victim did not give anyone permission to take these cattle.

Christopher Vernon Lethcoe, 24, of Croft Road, Tellico Plains was charged with theft over \$10,000.

Deputy T. Scarborough, LCSO made the arrest.

Kiser was taken into custody on January 22, 2012 for his alleged role in the crime and was also charged with theft over \$10,000. He has since been charged with hindering a secured creditor after reportedly selling a car he still owed more than \$3000 on to a scrap yard where it was crushed.

Kiser is due to appear in court February 13, 2013 on both charges.
