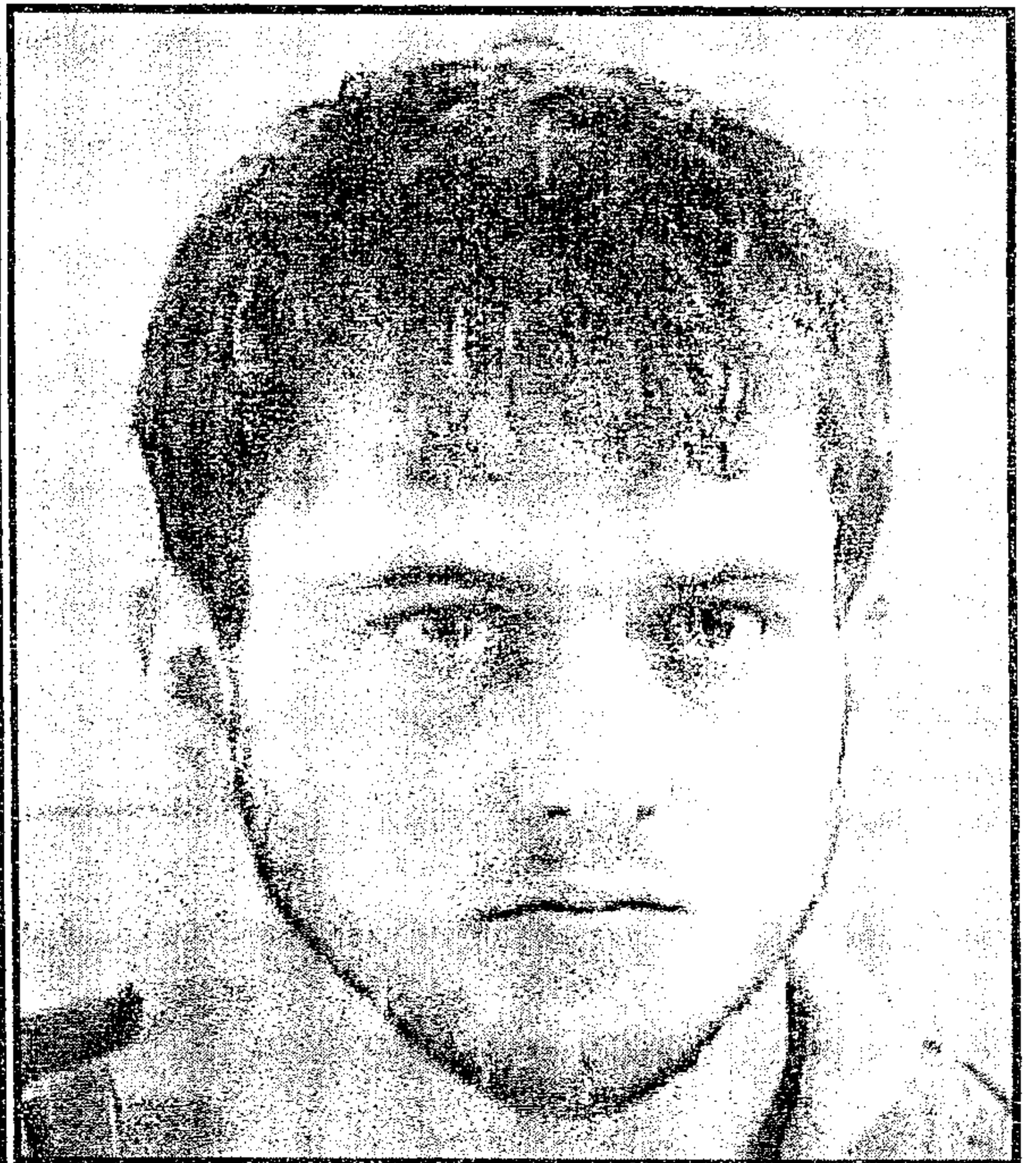
Irate wife of upset truck driver goes off
