ducted an investigation in the Hope Haven neighborhood in Loudon City. The neighborhood is directly behind Loudon Elementary School and Middle School. During the investigation agents conducted a traffic stop on a black Isuzu occupied by Jeremy Palmer and William Crew. Just prior to the stop Palmer

and Crew had discarded two bags of meth trash that agents retrieved.

The residence on Hope Way was searched and during the investigation several items were recovered that were used in the operation of methamphetamine lab. Also recovered in the back bedroom was a 9mm handgun in the bedroom closet. The bedroom contained Palmers clothes and belongings where he sleeps. Jeremy Palmer was interviewed and admitted to purchasing at least four boxes of pseudo ephed-

rine based products from local pharmacies in order to manufacture meth within the past five weeks. Palmer is a convicted felon currently on community corrections in Tennessee for a previous meth lab.

Jeremy Palmer, 35, of Hope Way, Loudon, was charged with possession of a weapon by a prohibited person (felon), manufacture of methamphetamine (school zone) and promoting the manufacture of methamphetamine. Agent Brendan Deboer, 9th DTF made the arrests.
