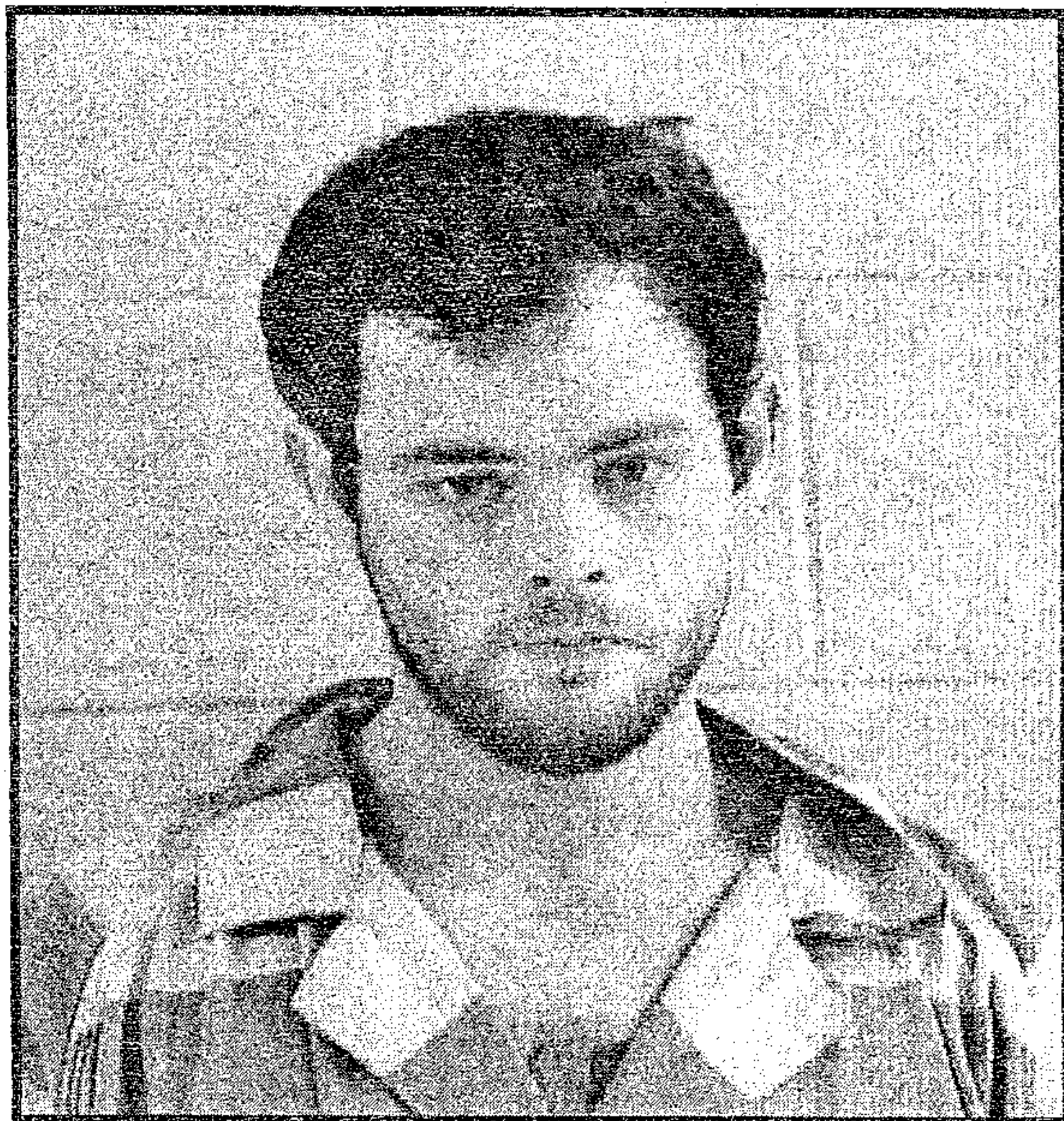


## Teen charged in burglary and vandalism following assault

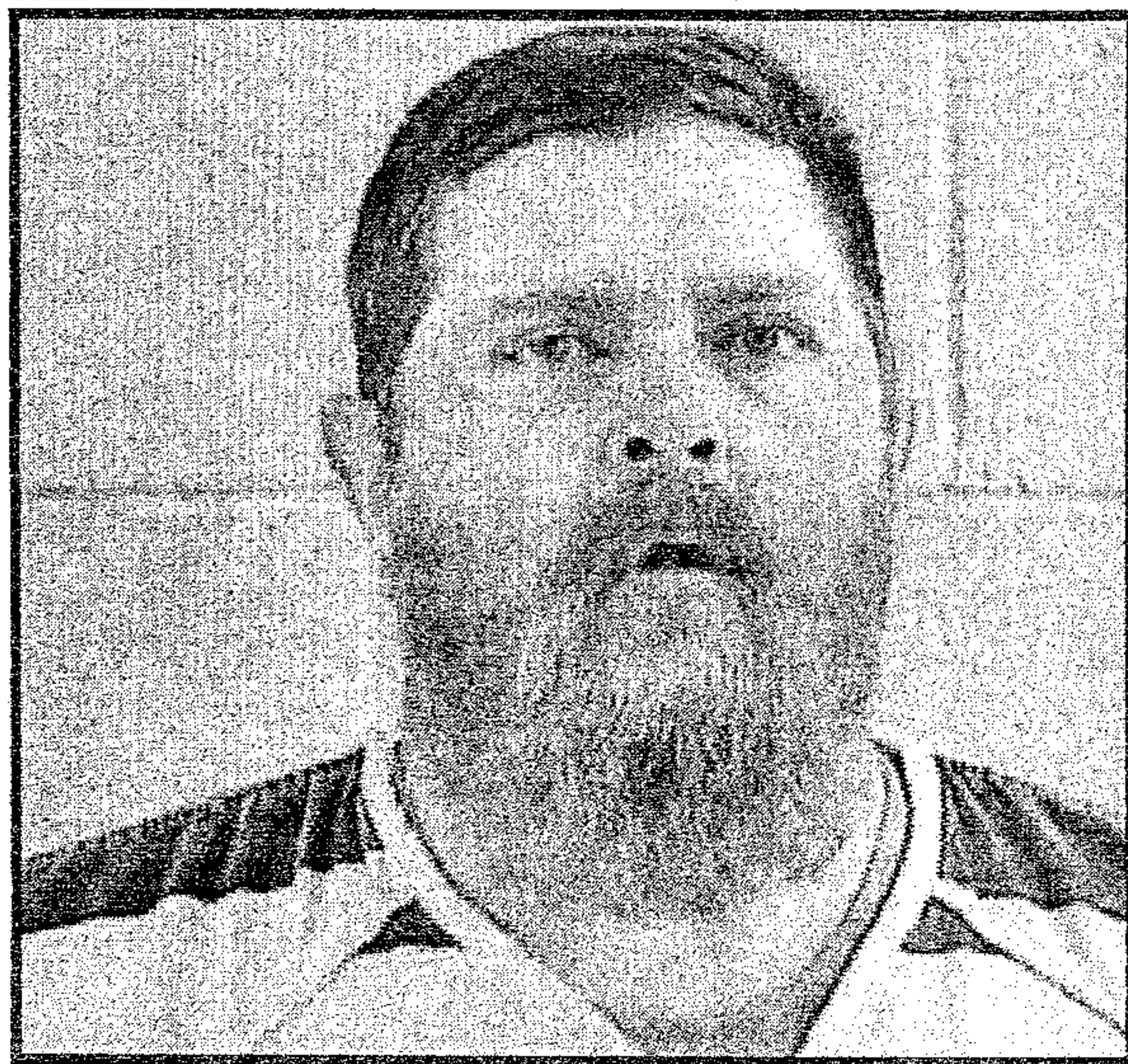

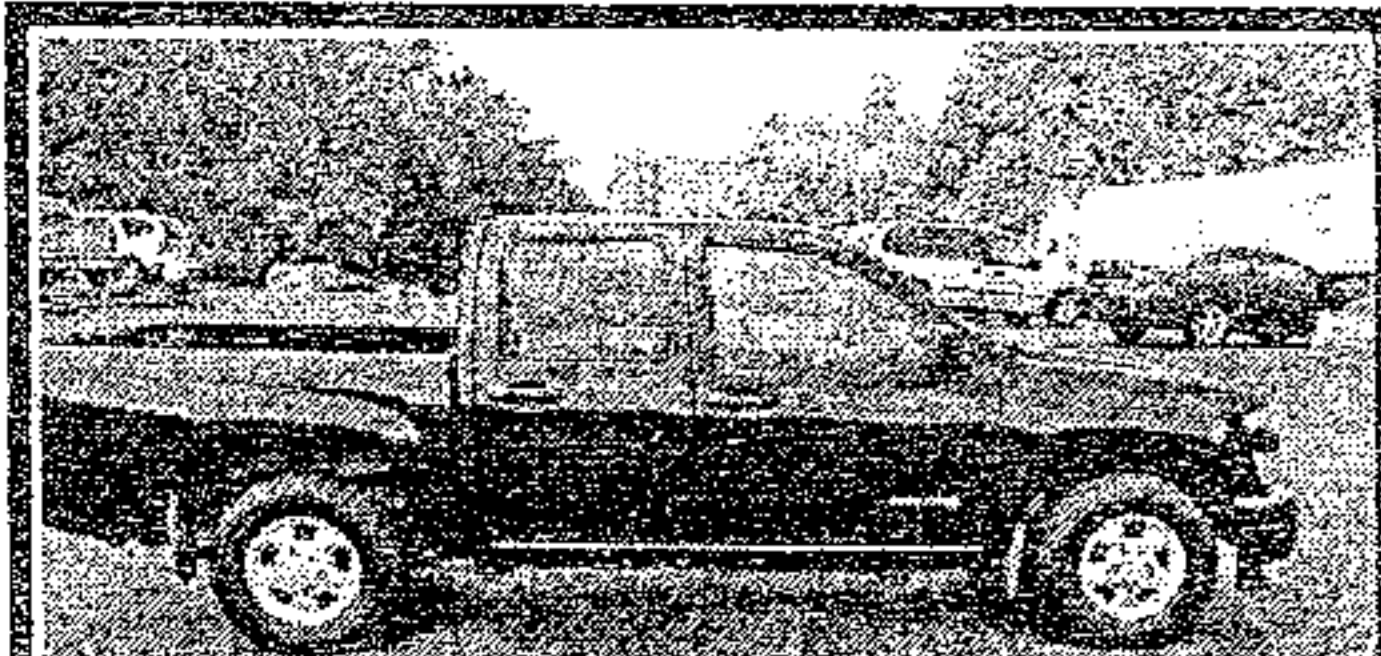

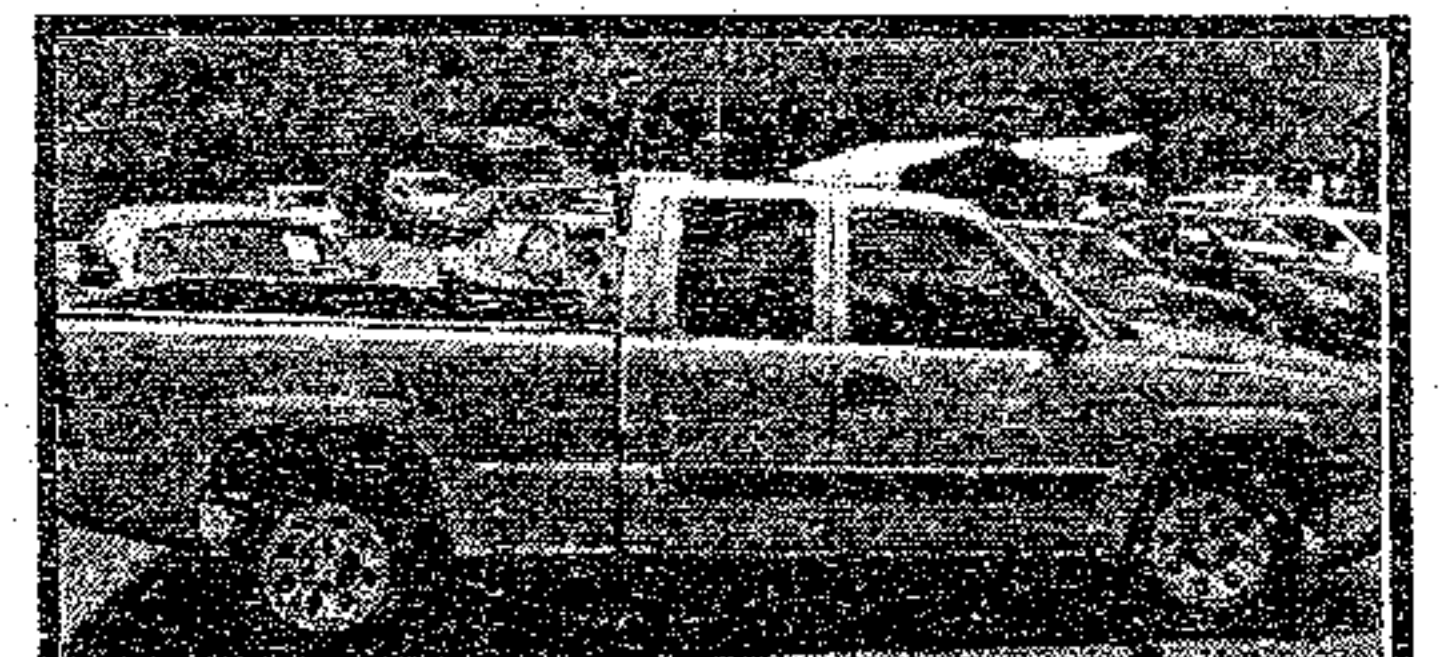

JENKINS WAS PLACED UNDER ARREST FOR DUI AND WAS READ THE TENNESSEE IMPLIED CONSENT LAW.

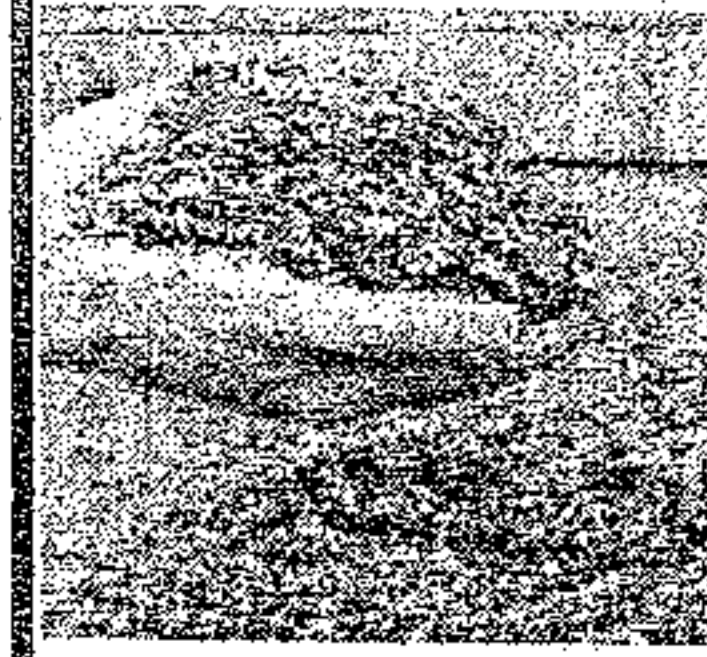

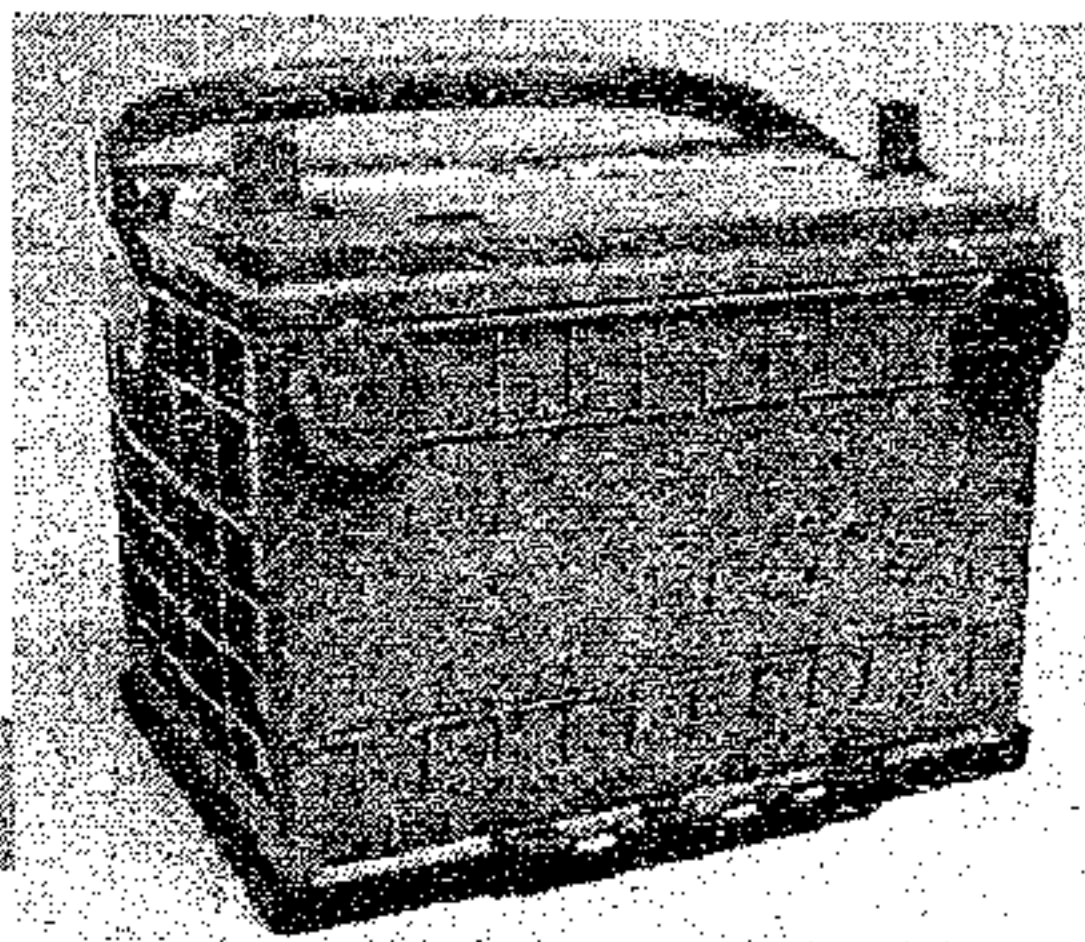

ACCORDING TO THE REPORT CPL MICHAEL WATKINS, LCSO WAS DISPATCHED TO MARTEL ROAD TO A PHYSICAL DOMESTIC FIGHT OF WHICH THE
