Deputy made contact with a red truck on HWY 321. Deputy attempted to stop said vehicle on 321 but the vehicle turned into Buddy's Bar-B-Que and came to a stop in a parking stall. Deputy did make contact with the driver and identified him as Mr. Anthony Harrison by his Florida DL. He provided. Mr. Harrison appeared to be very nervous, had red watery eyes, and his pupils were constricted to that of a pin point. Also

noticed that Mr. Harrison had a small child in the back passenger seat without a booster seat sleeping. Deputy did have Mr. Harrison exit the vehicle and he agreed to a field sobriety test, and performed poorly. Mr. Harrison was asked if he had anything illegal in his vehicle he stated no. Mr. Harrison was asked for consent to search vehicle stated yes then retracted his statement and stated no he did not want me going through his vehicle. K-9 Dagger and Officer Sennett

arrived on scene. Officer deployed Dagger on the vehicle for an air sniff. Dagger did alert in the vehicle indicating that the odor of narcotics were in the vehicle. 
The Deputy explained to Mr. Saul why he was






