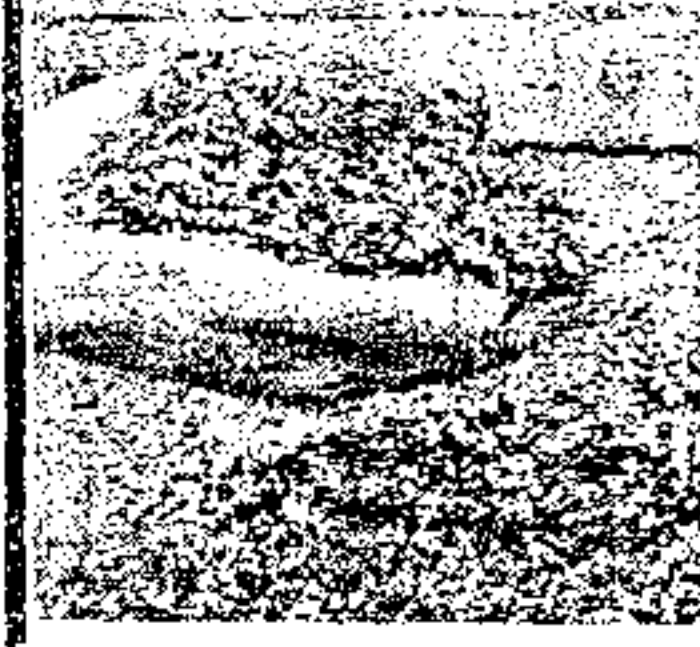
THE BACK SEAT OF THE VEHICLE.







question; are you giving your first 10% back to God? Are you then giving to others who have needs even if it causes you to suffer a little? Can God see that you love your neighbor as yourself? Do your prayers only benefit yourself, or are you trying to bring honor and glory to God by the things that you are asking of Him?

James is telling Christians that we must choose to either love the world or choose to love God, but we cannot have it both ways. Here is the same instruction given by Jesus Christ Himself and recorded in Mathew 6:24, "No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate one and love the other,

or else he will be loyal to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and man."

I am convinced that we now live in a society that is satisfied with living as the world lives, but dropping by the church house on Sundays to relieve the guilt and appear to others as Godly. If our daily lives have no appearance of Godliness, who do we think we are deceiving?
