PAUL BOVARD, 26 COLLINS ST, LOUDON WAS CHARGED WITH THEFT OVER A \$1000.

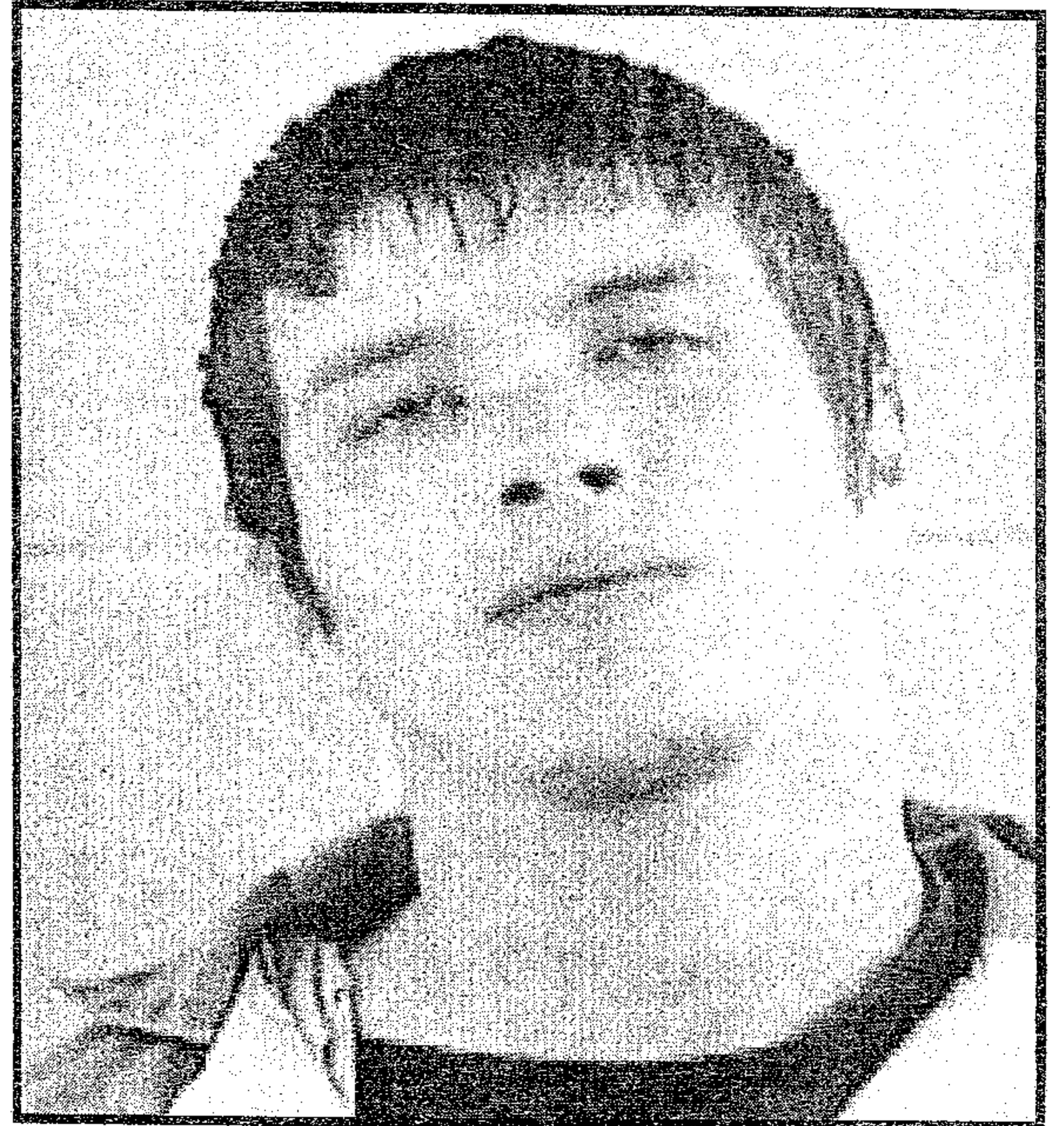
