Unwanted guest flees arrest

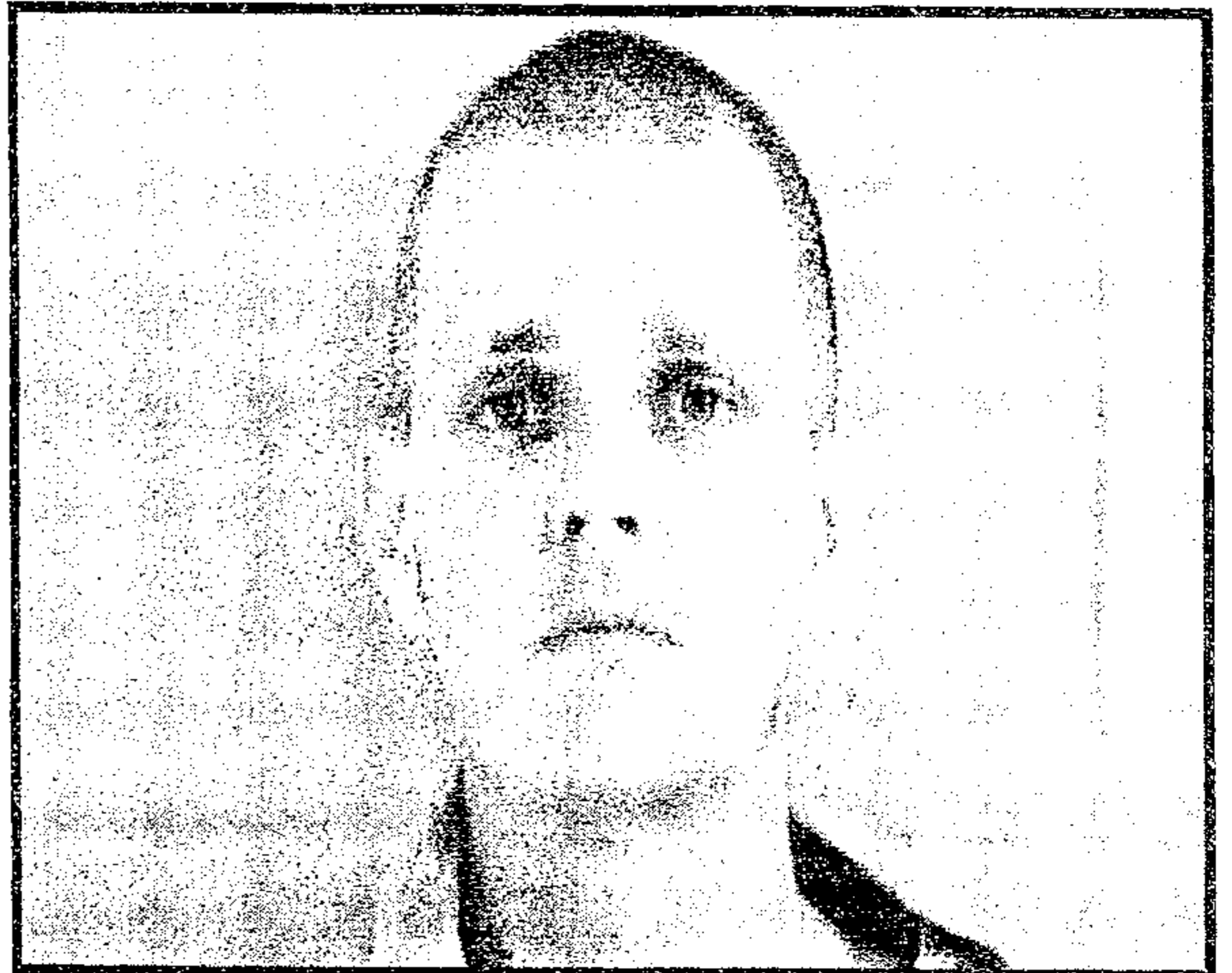
