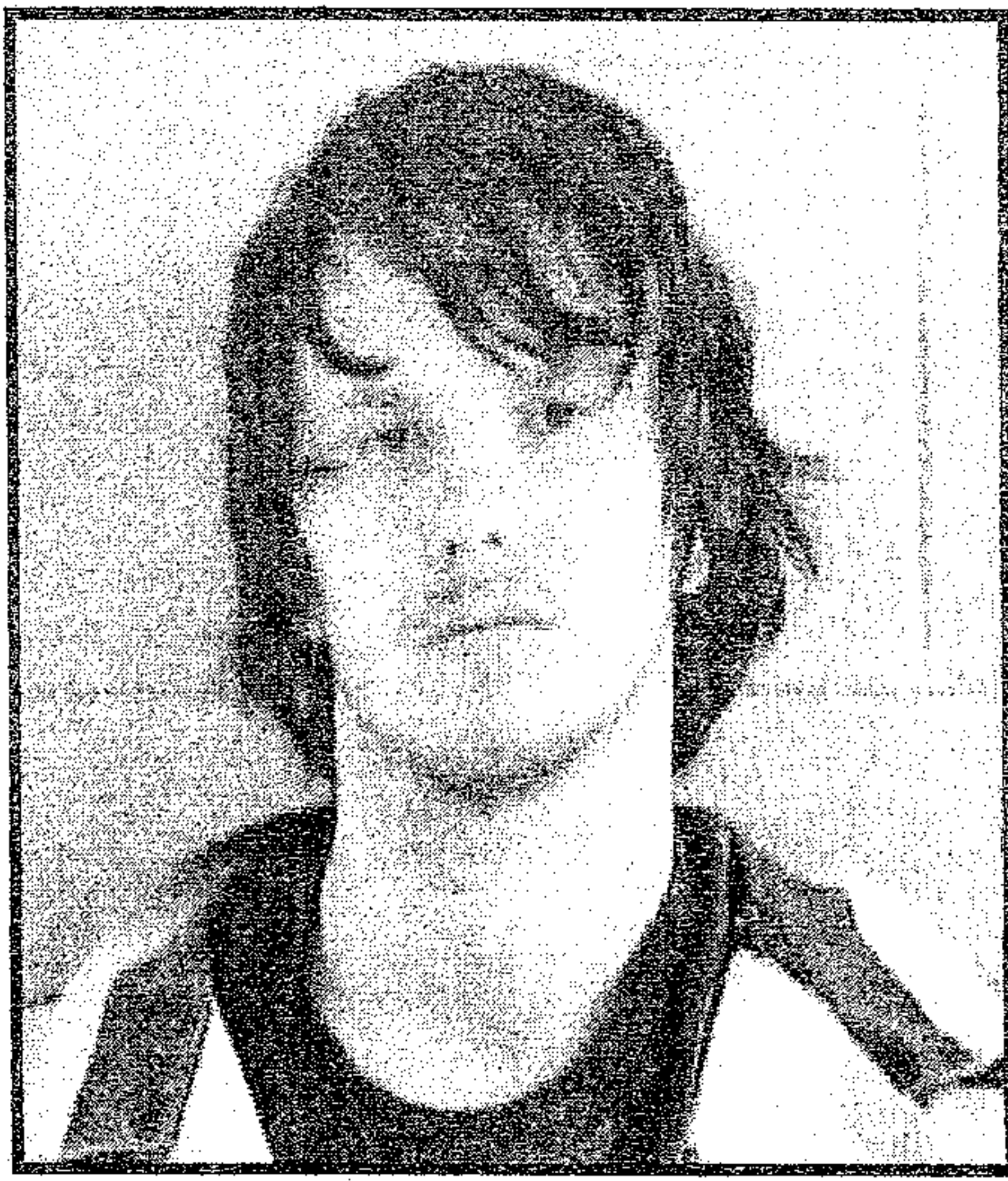





**Meth**

Johnny Mark Murray, 49 Webb Ave Loudon, was charged with Possession of SCHII over 28 gm (school zone) & Conspiracy to distribute methamphetamine.

James Newell, 27 McDaniel Lane Lenoir City, was charged with Possession of SCH II over 26 grams, & Conspiracy to distribute meth.

Anthony Desola, 21 Donald Drive Lenoir City, was charged with Possession of SCH II over 26 grams, & Conspiracy to distribute meth.

According to the report Agents from the 9th Drug Task Force, Loudon CO. Sheriff Office, Tenn. Bureau of Investigation, and Tenn. Highway Patrol participated in a joint operation.

During the course of an ongoing narcotics investigation, to arrest individuals involved and recover a substantial amount of crystal meth being transported and distributed in the Loudon Co. area. During this operation the THP observed a green vehicle on Interstate 75 traveling N into

Loudon Co. The vehicle then quickly exited at exit 68 onto Pond Creek Rd. where two Agents again spotted the vehicle. The vehicle continued and appeared to be avoiding detection or close proximity to Law Enforcement units until it was finally stopped by THP and LCSO pulling into a driveway within 1000 feet of Loudon Elementary School. This vehicle was driven by Johnny Mark Murray.

Agents developed credible information that this vehicle was transporting a substantial amount of Crystal Meth from Georgia to Loudon County. Based on this current and credible information and the erratic behavior observed due to Law Enforcement presence. During the traffic stop a drug detection dog was deployed. After a positive alert to the presence of narcotics in the vehicle, per Sheriff's Officer handler, the vehicle and occupants were searched. This search resulted in locating over 30 grams of a substance that tested positive for the pres-

ence of methamphetamine. It was determined that the drugs found were in the possession of or acquired for the three occupants of the car, Johnny Mark Murray, Anthony Desola, and James Newell. Some of these narcotics were intended to be distributed to one or more individuals with the knowing intended purpose of drug sales. All 3 subjects were charged and placed under arrest. 9th Drug Task Force Officer Brendan Deboer made the arrest.

Armes received a call of a possible drunk driver traveling E on I-40 described as a gold vehicle. Dispatch had received several call

are absolutely true and inspired by the Holy Spirit of God, and that God uses His word to teach us how to have a relationship with Him..... when we let Him.

The Apostle Peter not only authored the Book of I Peter, he also walked with Jesus. Peter saw Jesus heal the sick, raise the dead, give sight to the

blind and feed the five thousand with a couple of fish and a few small loaves of bread. Peter saw Jesus walking on the water and Jesus allowed him to walk on the water as well. Peter saw Jesus beaten and crucified, and then spent time with Jesus after God raised Him from the dead. Peter saw Jesus ascend to heaven and was in the upper room when the Holy Spirit descended upon all

of them and they began to boldly preach the gospel and see thousands come to Christ. Peter was there! He saw almost everything I write about week after week. I'm reminding you of this so that as you read today's scripture, you will believe these words to be true and compare Peter's advice to your life as it is right now.

Peter was writing this letter to the Christians of Asia Minor (Present-day Turkey). This letter would have been carried by a courier over rugged land, across treacherous seas and through desolate territory. As the courier traveled, he would stop along

the way in both large cities and small villages to read Paul's letter to the followers of Christ. Here is a small portion of the first letter;

I Peter 1:13-21 (NKJV) (13) Therefore gird up your minds, be sober, and rest your hope fully upon the grace that is to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ; (14) as obedient children, not conforming yourselves to the former lusts, as in your ignorance; (15) but as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, (16) because it is written, "Be holy, for I am holy."

(17) And if you call on the Father, who without partiality judges according to each one's work, conduct yourselves throughout the time of your stay here in fear; (18) knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver or gold, from your aimless

conduct received by tradition from your fathers, (19) but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot. (20) He indeed was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you (21) who through him believe in God, who raised Him from the dead and gave Him glory, so that your faith and hope are in God.

For those who may have some difficulty understanding some of the terms used in this passage I will share a red-neck rendition that may help a little;

To gird up our minds simply means to keep our focus on Christ. Paul refers to being sober, meaning to be watchful and to use sound mental and spiritual judgment. (I also believe that using that term in a literal sense (see TGN ctd. pg. 8)










would surely help in that regard as well) Paul encourages the Jews and Gentiles alike to place our hope in the eternal life that we will have when Jesus returns. As we expect our children to obey the rules and standards that we set within our own homes, God also expects us as His children to obey His commandments and live a holy life before Him. One side note to consider is that God loves us as much as we love our own children. He loves us so much that He allowed His own Son to endure horrible torment so that we would have a way to Him. Do you love anyone so much that you would allow your child to be crucified for them? Me neither!

Peter refers to God's word way back in Leviticus 11:44 when he says, "As it is written, 'be holy, for I am holy'".

This means that God has set a much higher standard to Christian living as what modern day America deems acceptable. I am convinced that modern day Christians are so conscious of not offending others that we tolerate what is clearly sin within our own circle of influence and the result of this is that folks are dying every day around us without Christ, but I digress!

Verse 17 reminds us that although God loves us as His children, we are each equally accountable for our actions while on earth. God is a righteous judge and there are no favorites. Regardless of who we are, how much money we have, how politically connected we are, how much we have given to our church; we will each bow to our knees before an Almighty God and give an account of our lives. Peter reminds us that we should live our days on earth in fear. I believe this

is somewhere between a holy terror and a reverential awe. I often mention that our every breath is a gift from God but maybe some folks don't consider that a reality. We literally only breathe as long as God lets us. This fact alone gives us a reason to fear Him, praise Him and give thanks to Him every morning that we see the sun rise. I love my Dad unconditionally, but I grew up with reverential fear of the punishment associated with violating his rules. The fear of the Lord is like that but multiplied by a million!

The remaining verses in today's scripture remind us that Jesus is perfect in every way. He lived without sin, He gave His life for you and me as a sacrifice for our sins, and He rose from the grave during Peter's generation according to God's timing. Although Jesus came to earth to fulfill God's plan at that time, it is important

to know that Jesus was with God long before His 33 years on earth. I like the way John says it in John 1:1, "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God." Jesus is the Word, and He is also the Way.

The letter that Peter sent to Christians across the world to Asia Minor

over two thousand years ago can be found and still has validity within the pages of every Bible on earth, including yours. If you're not allowing God to speak to you through His Word, you are not having a true relationship with your Creator! The Good News is that you could start today. Thanks
