Subsequently, vestigators, working in conjunction with the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), obtained a search warrant for the entirety of Farrad's Facebook account. Once executed, law enforcement discovered a variety of photographs showing him holding, posing with, and displaying a Springfield, Model XD, .45 caliber, semiautomatic pistol. The pictures were taken from inside Farrad's bathroom and were uploaded in quick succession in October 2013.

On January 5th 2016 During forensic Interview of (4 yrs old) he

revealed that he was touched in a sexual manner by his grand mothers boy friend Terry Shelton on more than one occasion and every time this happen in his home in Terry's bedroom which is located at Hines Valley Rd. Lenoir City. When asked if he had told anyone about this he said he had told his dad that Terry had touched him and his dad Chris-

topher Hart told Terry not to this again. He also stated that he had told his mother Katelyn Perdue and grandmother. On same date Terry Shelton was interviewed and admitted to three counts of child rape, during his interview he made the statement that the first time was on December 29 th 2015 and that victim told everyone in the house that he

had touched him and Chris Hart told him to stop or he would make him leave. On January 2nd and 3rd Terry raped Zakary again in his bed room at Hines valley Rd. The referral came about on January 4th when Department of Child Services was inthe house doing a drug exposed child referral and victim told the caseworker of DCS that Terry Touched him and pointed to

his penis. Upon interviewing Chris Hart he did state that his son the victim did tell him that Terry had touched him but didn't think it was in sexual manner but did tell Terry he would have to leave if he didn't Quit. This Did happen in Loudon County TN. Both Christopher and Katelyn were placed under arrest.
